THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- The Razorbacks are making their second trip to New York for the NIT Season Tip-Off after appearing in the tournament in 1990. Arkansas opened with a 98-88 victory over Duke that year, before falling Arizona 89-77 in the championship.

- Arkansas is 3-10 in the state of New York, with two victories over City College of New York (1943, 1944) and one against Duke (1990).

- The Razorbacks are 1-3 against Georgia Tech, with the last meeting coming in Honolulu, Hawaii, in 1984. Arkansas also dropped contests in 1965 and 1966, but won the first meeting on Dec. 30, 1961 in the Poinsettia Classic in Greenville, S.C.

- Arkansas is 11-2 all-time on Nov. 26, including six straight wins dating back to 1999. Seven of those victories have come on a neutral floor.

- Dusty Hannahs ranks No. 1 in the country in three-point field goal percentage among players that have made 11-plus treys on the year.

- Dusty Hannahs (11) and Anthlon Bell (9) have combined to make more three-pointers than 118 Division I teams.

- Moses Kingsley's nine blocks is more than 114 Division I teams and his 3.0 blocks per game is tied for the SEC lead.

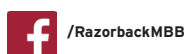

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks fifth in the country with 8.3 assists per game.
- Has two of the three 10-plus assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Recorded a career-high 11 assists against Charleston Southern.
- Had 10 assists vs. Southern, more than any Arkansas player during the 2014-15 season.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Akron.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Has three straight double-digit scoring efforts for the first time in his career.
- Has made multiple three-pointers in four straight games dating back to last year.
- Set career-highs in field goal attempts (20) and three-point attempts (13) against Akron.
- One of four players in school history to lead the team in three-pointers made for three straight years.
- His 160 career three-pointers is good for 7th in school history.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.
- Pulled down a career-high five rebounds against Charleston Southern.
- Scored 12 points in 26 minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Was one of three Razorbacks with multiple steals vs. Southern University (2).
- A consensus top-80 player in the class of 2015.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has three consecutive double-digit scoring games to start the year.
- Is one of three players in the SEC averaging a double-double.
- Opened the year with back-to-back double-doubles.
- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- Scored a career-high 22 points and added a career-high 3 steals vs. Southern.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Recorded season highs in points (5) and rebounds (5) against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first career start as a Razorback vs. Southern University.
- Scored 4 points and had 4 rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the season opener.
- Scored 10 points and added seven rebounds in the exhibition opener.

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Tied career high for points with four against Charleston Southern and Akron.
- Set a career with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first collegiate start against Akron.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Ranks No. 1 in the country in three-point field goal percentage among players that have made 10-plus treys on the year.
- Went 5-for-5 from behind the arc against Charleston Southern for a game-high 21 points.
- Was the fourth player in program history to make five treys in a game without a miss.
- Has started the year 11-for-11 from the free throw line.
- One of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his Razorback debut.

#15 || Lorenzo Jenkins (G)

- Led First Baptist Academy in Naples, Florida, to three straight district titles.
- Named the Florida Class 3A District 18 Player of the Year in 2014-15.

#21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.
- Is 6-for-6 from the free throw line in the last two games.
- Played a season-high 21 points against Charleston Southern.
- Grabbed a career-high 4 offensive rebounds vs. Southern University.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Pulled down two rebounds against Charleston Southern.
- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.

THE OPPONENT >>

• Georgia Tech is 3-1 on the young season, with two blowout wins and two one-basket games they split. In the two big wins, GT defeated Cornell and Green Bay by 65 combined points with a scoring average of 111.5 per game. In a 69-67 win against SEC opponent Tennessee, the Yellow Jackets survived when the Vols missed a three-pointer as time expired. GT was not so lucky in a 69-68 loss to ETSU, as the Bucs hit a trey as time expired to stun the hosts at McComish Pavilion.

• With their high-octane offense, the Yellow Jackets are scoring 90 points per game, with four seniors posting double-figure averages. Guard Marcus Georges-Hunt leads the way with 16.8 points per game, with a 50 percent mark from the field and is shooting a team-best 23-for-27 from the foul line through four games. Forward Nick Jacobs (15), forward Charles Mitchell (14.5) and guard Adam Smith (11.5) are the other top options for GT on the offensive end.

• On the defensive end, the Yellow Jackets are out-blocking their opponents 26-7 through four games, while holding them to 41.9 percent shooting from the field. GT is also controlling the glass, out-rebounding its opponents an average of 45.2-34, a plus-11.2 margin per contest.

• Head coach Brian Gregory is in his fifth year with the Yellow Jackets, with a record of 58-72 (.446) in four-plus seasons. Before coming to Atlanta, Gregory was the head coach at Dayton for eight seasons. He compiled a 172-94 (.647) record with the Flyers, which included two NCAA Tournament appearances and three NIT appearances, including an NIT championship in 2010.

DOUBLE DIPPING >>

• Moses Kingsley is one of just three players in the SEC averaging a double-double. He became the first Arkansas player in six years to open the year with back-to-back double-doubles.

HELP YOURSELF >>

• Jabril Durham's SEC-leading 8.3 assists per game through the first three contests ranks No. 5 in the country and is on pace to set a school record. The program mark for assists per game in a season is 6.6 by Kareem Reid in 1995-96.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

• Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.

• He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

THREE-POINT BARRAGE >>

- Arkansas made at least six three-pointers in all three games this season.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 46 of the last 51 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 877 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance from long range against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- Arkansas has had a player make five three-pointers in all three games this season after doing so just twice all of last year last year.

#NYLONBELL >>

- After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons. Bell is also just 309 points shy from 1,000 career points.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 309 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 160 career three-point field goals, which ranks t-7th all-time in school history.
- Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.
- Moses Kingsey is seven blocks away from breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 69-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas is one of only four teams (Kentucky, Ohio State and Syracuse) in the country with 65+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.
- Arkansas has won 26 of its last 27 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 41-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

AN HISTORIC LOOK BACK >>

- Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.

- Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Little Rock native became the first player in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds by the end of his sophomore season

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
