THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- The Razorbacks are making their second appearance in New York for the NIT Season Tip-Off after playing in the tournament in 1990. Arkansas opened with a 98-88 victory over Duke that year, before falling to Arizona 89-77 in the championship.
- Dating back to last year, Arkansas has won seven consecutive games following a loss.
- Arkansas is 3-11 in the state of New York, with two victories over City College of New York (1943, 1944) and one against Duke (1990).
- The Razorbacks are 0-1 all-time against Stanford, dropping the only contest to the Cardinal 60-53 on Jan. 3, 1948. Arkansas is 12-14 against current Pac-12 teams with its only winning records coming against Arizona (6-2) and Oregon (3-0).
- Dusty Hannahs ranks No. 1 in the country in three-point field goal percentage at .684 among players that have made 13-plus treys on the year. He has made seven of his last eight three-point attempts after going 2-for-3 from long range against Georgia Tech (Nov. 26).
- Moses Kingsley is one of five players in the SEC with double-digit blocks on the year after recording at least one block in all four games this season.

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 | Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the country with 7.8 assists per game.
- Has two of the three 10-plus assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Recorded a career-high 11 assists against Charleston Southern.
- Had 10 assists vs. Southern, more than any Arkansas player during the 2014-15 season.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Georgia Tech.

#5 || Anthion Bell (G)

- Is 295 points away from becoming the program's 39th player with 1,000 career points.
- Has four straight double-digit scoring efforts for the first time in his career.
- Has made multiple three-pointers in five straight games dating back to last year.
- Set career-highs in field goal attempts (20) and three-point attempts (13) against Akron.
- Came off the bench to score 14 points in 27 minutes vs. Southern University.

#24 | Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Played a season-long 29 minutes against Georgia Tech in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.
- Pulled down a career-high five rebounds against Charleston Southern.
- Scored 12 points in 26 minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Was one of three Razorbacks with multiple steals vs. Southern University (2).

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has four consecutive double-digit scoring games to start the year.
- Opened the year with back-to-back double-doubles.
- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- First Arkansas player since 2008-09 to have consecutive 12-plus rebounds to start the year.
- After one double-double in two years, he has two in as many games to open the year.

#55 | Keaton Miles (F)

- Tied a season-high with two field goals against Georgia Tech in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Played a season-long 19 minutes against Georgia Tech.
- Recorded season highs in points (5) and rebounds (5) against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first career start as a Razorback vs. Southern University.

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Tied career high for points with four against Charleston Southern and Akron.
- Set a career-high with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first collegiate start against Akron.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Ranks No. 1 in the country in three-point field goal percentage among players that have made 13-plus treys on the year
- Has led Arkansas in scoring in back-to-back games.
- Has hit seven of his last eight three-pointers over the last two games.
- Went 5-for-5 from behind the arc against Charleston Southern for a game-high 21 points.
- Was the fourth player in program history to make five treys in a game without a miss.
- Has started the year 16-for-16 from the free throw line and has made 31 straight foul shots dating back to his days at Texas Tech.
- One of 18 players in the country with a perfect free throw percentage.

#21 | Manuale Watkins (G)

- Recorded a season-high three assists and four steals against Georgia Tech in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Played a season-high 23 minutes against Georgia Tech.
- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.
- Is 7-for-8 from the free throw line in the last three games.

#50 | Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (5), blocks (2) and minutes (15) against Georgia Tech in NIT Tip-Off.
- Went 3-for-4 from the free throw line against Georgia Tech.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Pulled down two rebounds against Charleston Southern.

THE OPPONENT >>

- Stanford plays in the Pacific-12 Conference (Pac-12) and are 2-3 on the season. The Cardinal went 2-0 in NIT Season Tip-Off preliminary action vs. Green Bay and Charleston Southern. In terms of common opponents, both Stanford and Arkansas have defeated and scored exactly 93 points against Charleston Southern. Since then, Stanford has lost three consecutive games vs. SMU, at St. Mary's (Calif.) and against No. 8/9 Villanova at Barclays Center last night.
- The Cardinal lost to the Wildcats 59-45 in an ultra-low-scoring contest. Stanford shot just 26 percent from the field and made only 2-of-9 threes. Although it held Villanova to only 31 percent shooting and had a 55-35 rebounding edge, the Cardinal lost the turnover battle 23-6 and ultimately lost to the Big East favorite by 14. Three Stanford players reached double digits in rebounds while two of the Cardinal scored 10-plus points in the game.
- Head coach Johnny Dawkins is in his eighth year with Stanford, with a record of 143-103 (.581) in seven-plus seasons. Under Dawkins, the Cardinal have two NIT championships and reached the Sweet 16 in 2014. Dawkins was an assistant coach at Duke under Mike Krzyzewski during the 1998-99 season, then spent the following 10 seasons as associate head coach before accepting the main job at Stanford.

HELP YOURSELF >>

• Jabril Durham's SEC-leading 7.8 assists per game through the first four contests ranks No. 9 in the country and is on pace to set a school record. The program mark for assists per game in a season is 6.6 by Kareem Reid in 1995-96.

PERFECT CHARITY >>

• Dusty Hannahs is the only SEC player with a perfect free throw percentage on the year, making all 16 of his attempts. Dating back to his days at Texas Tech, Hannahs has sank his last 31 free throws. He has career .682 free throw percentage in 132 attempts.

DOUBLE DIGIT MADNESS >>

• Arkansas has four players averaging double figures, but Dusty Hannahs, Moses Kingsley and Anthlon Bell have each scored double-digit points in all four games on the year. None of the three players had scored in double figures in four consecutive games before the current steak.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

- Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.
- He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

THREE-POINT BARRAGE >>

- Arkansas made at least six three-pointers in all four games this season.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 47 of the last 52 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 878 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance from long range against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- Arkansas has had a player make five three-pointers in three of four games this season after doing so just twice all of last year last year.

#NYLONBELL>>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons. Bell is also just 295 points shy from 1,000 career points.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 295 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 164 career three-point field goals, which ranks t-7th all-time in school history.
- Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.
- Moses Kinglsey is six blocks away from breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 69-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas is one of only four teams (Kentucky, Ohio State and Syracuse) in the country with 65+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.
- Arkansas has won 26 of its last 27 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 41-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

AN HISTORIC LOOK BACK >>

- Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.
- Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
