### THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Arkansas is set for its first true road game of the 2015-16 season, traveling to Wake Forest for a Friday night matchup with the Demon Deacons.
- The Razorbacks are 3-4 all-time against Wake Forest, but have won three of the last five meetings, including a 30-point victory last year in BWA. Arkansas won its only game in Winston-Salem, N.C., picking up a 75-59 victory on Dec. 23, 1998.
- Arkansas is 21-29 all-time against current teams in the ACC, posting a conference-high three wins against Louisville, North Carolina and Virginia.
- Jabril Durham is one of four players in the country with three double-digit assist games this season. He has three of the six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 4 in the nation with 8.0 assists per game.
- · Dusty Hannahs leads the SEC in three-point field goal percentage (.515), free throw percentage (.958) and ranks fifth in scoring (18.0).
- Dusty Hannahs and Moses Kingsley are the No. 3 scoring duo in the SEC, combining to score 34.7 points per game.

### **STARTING** FIVE >>

### #4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 4 in the country with 8.0 assists per game.
- Has three of the six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Is one of four players in the country with three double-digit assist games this season.
- One of four players in the nation to record a game WITH double-digit points and assists and five-plus steals.
- Against Northwestern St., he became the first Razorback in 20 years with 14 pts, 10 assists and five steals in a game.
- Recorded first career double-double against Northwestern State with 14 points and 10 assists.
- Is the only player in the league with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

### #5 || Anthion Bell (G)

- Leads the SEC with 19 made three-pointers on the season.
- Named to the NIT Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after sinking 9-of-15 threes and scoring 31 points in two games.
- Has two games with five made three-pointers this year.
- Went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.
- Is 261 points away from becoming the program's 39th player with 1,000 career points.

### #24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Has five double-digit scoring efforts in his first six collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists Tuesday against Northwestern State.
- Played a career-long 30 minutes against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Scored a career-high tying 14 points against Stanford.
- Pulled down a career-high five rebounds against Charleston Southern.

### #33 | Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has six consecutive double-digit scoring games and two 20-point efforts to start the year.
- One of 13 players in the country to average at least 16 points and 10 rebounds.
- Joins LSU's Ben Simmons as the only SEC players averaging a double-double on the season.
- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- First Arkansas player since 2008-09 to have consecutive 12-plus rebound games to start the year.

#### #55 | Keaton Miles (F)

- Scored a career-high tying 11 points Tuesday against Northwestern State.
- Recorded a career-high five field goals made against Northwestern State.
- Has made four consecutive starts and started five of six games this year.
- Played a season-long 29 minutes against Stanford.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Stanford.

### #1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Sat out last two games after suffering an ankle injury against Georgia Tech.
- Tied career high for points with four against Charleston Southern and Akron.
- Set a career with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first collegiate start against Akron.

### #3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Ranks No. 1 in the SEC with a .515 three-point field goal percentage.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring in three of the last four games.
- Ranks No. 5 in the SEC in scoring at 18.0 points per game.
- Has started the year 23-for-24 from the free throw line.
- Ranks No. 3 in the country with a .958 free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.

### #21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against Northwestern State.
- Has two double-digit scoring efforts in his career, both coming in the first six games of the year.
- Dished out a career-high five assists against Northwestern State.
- Played a season-high 25 minutes against Stanford.
- Scored a career-high 14 points against Charleston Southern.

### #50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) Tuesday against Northwestern State.
- Has gone 5-for-6 from the charity stripe in the last three games.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.
- Played in 27 games with 25 starts last season at Kennesaw State.

### **WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>**

- Anthlon Bell (19) and Dusty Hannahs (17) are the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC, sinking 36 treys on the year.
- Arkansas has had a player make five-plus three-pointers in four of six games this season after doing so just twice all of last year.
- Arkansas has made at least six three-pointers in all six games this season.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 49 of the last 54 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 880 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- Hannahs ranks No. 1 in the SEC with a .515 three-point field goal percentage, making 17 of 33 attempts from behind the arc.
- Hannahs is one of four players in school history to make five-plus three-pointers in a game without a miss when he went 5-for-5 against Charleston Southern.
- Bell went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.
- After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

### **HELP YOURSELF >>**

• There have been six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year, and Jabril Durham is responsible for half of them. He ranks No. 4 in the country with 8.0 assists per game and is the only conference player with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

### PERFECT CHARITY >>

• Dusty Hannahs leads the SEC with a .958 free throw percentage, making 23-of-24 attempts on the year. Prior to his miss against Stanford in the NIT Season Tip-Off, Hannahs had made 34 straight free throws dating back to his days at Texas Tech. He ranks No. 3 in the country in free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.

### **BRAND NEW HOG >>**

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

### **DOUBLE DIGIT MADNESS >>**

• Arkansas has four players averaging double figures, but Dusty Hannahs, Moses Kingsley and Anthlon Bell have each scored double-digit points in all six games on the year. None of the three players had scored in double figures in four consecutive games before the current steak.



### ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

- Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.
- He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

### **#NYLONBELL >>**

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

### **RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>**

- Anthlon Bell is 261 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 170 career three-point field goals, which ranks 6th all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.
- Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.
- Moses Kinglsey is five blocks away from passing Bobby Portis and breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

### PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 70-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the second-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas (70-9) is one of only two teams (Kentucky, 74-4) in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.
- Arkansas has won 27 of its last 28 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 42-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

### THE OPPONENT >>

- Wake Forest, from Winston-Salem, N.C., is 5-2 on the season. The Demon Deacons return home after four games away from LJVM Coliseum, including three in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, where they went 2-1. In Hawaii, Wake defeated Indiana (82-78) and lost to Vanderbilt (86-64), before edging UCLA (80-77) in the consolation game. Most recently, the Demon Deacons were in Piscataway, N.J., where they defeated Rutgers (69-68) in a B1G/ACC Challenge matchup.
- Wake has five players averaging double figures, as well as one just missing the cut at 9.7 points per game. Senior forward Devin Thomas leads the way with 18.4 points and 11.3 rebounds per game, which ranks second in the ACC. Even though the Demon Deacons are 5-2, they are being outscored by 10 total points thus far. All five of their wins have been by eight or fewer points, while their two losses have been by nine and 22 points. On average, Wake outrebounds its opponents by 7.1, but they also commit 5.1 more turnovers per contest.
- Head coach Danny Manning is in his second season with Wake, with a record of 18-21 (.462) in one-plus seasons. Manning came to Winston-Salem from Tulsa, where he coached the Golden Hurricane for two years. During the 2013-14 season, Tulsa won the Conference USA Tournament and earned a bid in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 13 seed, where they lost to UCLA (76-59) in the first round. Manning is regarded as one of the best college basketball players of all time, earning the 1988 Naismith National Player of the Year award and leading Kansas to a 1988 National Championship. He holds the Jayhawk records for most points (2,951) and rebounds (1,187) and ranks 10th all-time in NCAA scoring.



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
