THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- The Razorbacks face Evansville for the first time in program history Tuesday evening, welcoming the Purple Aces to BWA for a showdown on SEC Network.
- Arkansas has won 56 of its last 57 games at home against unranked non-conference opponents, including a 42-1 mark under Anderson.
- Arkansas is 26-13 (.667) against current teams from the Missouri Valley Conference, with 24 of those meetings coming against Missouri State and the Razorbacks holding an 18-6 record against the Bears.

- Jabril Durham is one of four players in the country with three double-digit assist games this season. He has three of the six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 3 in the nation with 8.0 assists per game.

- Dusty Hannahs ranks No. 3 in the country with a .962 free throw percentage and leads the SEC in three-point field percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.

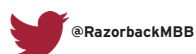

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 3 in the country with 8.0 assists per game.
- Has three of the six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Is one of four players in the country with three-plus double-digit assist games this season.
- One of four players in the nation this season to record a game of double-digit points and assists and 5-plus steals.
- Against Northwestern State he became the first Razorback in 20 years with 14 points, 10 assists and five steals.
- Is the only player in the league with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Named to the NIT Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after sinking 9-of-15 threes and scoring 31 points in two games.
- Has two games with five made three-pointers this year.
- Is tied for the SEC lead with 20 made three-pointers on the season.
- Went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.
- Is 248 points away from becoming the program's 39th player with 1,000 career points.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Has five double-digit scoring efforts in his first seven collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State.
- Played a career-long 30 minutes against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Scored a career-high tying 14 points against Stanford.
- Pulled down a career-high five rebounds against Charleston Southern.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has seven consecutive double-digit scoring games and two 20-point efforts to start the year.
- Ranks second in the SEC with 9.7 rebounds per game.
- Has four double-doubles through the first seven games.
- First Razorback in six years to open the season with consecutive double-doubles.
- First Arkansas player since 2008-09 to have consecutive 12-plus rebound games to start the year.
- After one double-double in two years, he has four in seven games to open the year.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Scored a career-high tying 11 points against Northwestern State.
- Recorded a career-high five field goals made against Northwestern State.
- Has made five consecutive starts and started six of seven games this year.
- Played a season-long 29 minutes against Stanford.
- Tied a career-high with five rebounds against Stanford.

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Sat out last three games after suffering an ankle injury against Georgia Tech.
- Tied career high for points with four against Charleston Southern and Akron.
- Set a career with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.
- Made his first collegiate start against Akron.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Ranks No. 2 in the SEC with a .488 three-point field goal percentage.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring in four of the last five games.
- Ranks No. 5 in the SEC in scoring at 17.6 points per game.
- Has started the year 25-for-26 from the free throw line.
- Ranks No. 2 in the country with a .962 free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.
- Went 5-for-5 from behind the arc against Charleston Southern for a game-high 21 points.

#21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest.
- Went 6-for-7 from the field against the Demon Deacons.
- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against Northwestern State.
- Has three double-digit scoring efforts in his career, all coming in the first seven games of the year.
- Dished out a career-high five assists against Northwestern State.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State.
- Has gone 9-for-10 from the charity stripe in the last four games.
- Had two blocks in 13 minutes of action at Wake Forest.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.
- Came to Arkansas after playing one year at Auburn and two at Kennesaw State.

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell (20) and Dusty Hannahs (20) are the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC, sinking 40 treys on the year.

• Arkansas has had a player make five-plus three-pointers in four of seven games this season after doing so just twice all of last year.

• Arkansas has made at least five three-pointers in all seven games this season.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 50 of the last 55 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 881 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.

• Hannahs ranks No. 2 in the SEC with a .488 three-point field goal percentage, making 20 of 41 attempts from behind the arc.

• Hannahs is one of four players in school history to make five-plus three-pointers in a game without a miss when he went 5-for-5 against Charleston Southern.

• Bell went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.



HELP YOURSELF >>

• There have been six double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year, and Jabril Durham is responsible for half of them. He ranks No. 3 in the country with 8.0 assists per game and is the only conference player with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

PERFECT CHARITY >>

• Dusty Hannahs leads the SEC with a .962 free throw percentage, making 25-of-26 attempts on the year. Prior to his miss against Stanford in the NIT Season Tip-Off, Hannahs had made 34 straight free throws dating back to his days at Texas Tech. He ranks No. 2 in the country in free throw percentage among players with 20-plus attempts.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

DOUBLE DIGIT MADNESS >>

• Arkansas has four players averaging double figures, but Dusty Hannahs, Moses Kingsley and Anthlon Bell have each scored double-digit points in all seven games on the year. None of the three players had scored in double figures in four consecutive games before the current streak.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

• Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.

• He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

• Anthlon Bell is 248 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

• Bell has 168 career three-point field goals, which ranks t-6th all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.

• Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive years.

• Moses Kingsley is three blocks away from passing Bobby Portis and breaking into the top 10 of career blocks in school history.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

• During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 70-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the second-most home wins in the country during this span.

• Arkansas (70-9) is one of only two teams (Kentucky, 74-4) in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.

• Arkansas has won 27 of its last 28 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 42-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

• The Purple Aces, from Evansville, Indiana, play in the Missouri Valley Conference and are 7-1 on the season. Evansville has won four consecutive games, including most recently an 85-81 victory at Murray State on Saturday. The Purple Aces played in The Wooden Legacy over Thanksgiving, going 2-1 with wins over Santa Clara (69-57) and UC Irvine (75-56) following an opening-game loss to Providence (74-64).

• Senior guard DJ Balentine leads the Purple Aces with 22.3 points per game, which is 14th among all Division I players. He also averages a team-best six assists, while shooting 50.4 percent from the field. On the inside, senior center Egidijus Mockevicius is posting double-double numbers with 17.5 points and 13.5 rebounds per contest. He also leads Evansville with 2.6 blocks on average. Overall, the Purple Aces are second in the nation in assists per game (22.4) and fourth in the country in field goal shooting (53.2 percent).

• Head coach Marty Simmons is in his ninth season with Evansville, with a record of 133-135 in nine-plus seasons. In the 2014-15 season, the Purple Aces went 24-12 and won the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament, going 5-0 in postseason play. Their overall record was the program's best since 1991-92. As a player, Simmons played two years at Indiana before transferring to Evansville for his final two seasons of eligibility. He averaged 22.4 points as a junior and 25.9 as a senior, leading the Purple Aces to a 1988 NIT victory over Utah.

AN HISTORIC LOOK BACK >>

• Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.

• Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Little Rock native became the first player in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds by the end of his sophomore season.

• The Razorbacks finished the 2014-15 season ranked in the top 25 nationally in 10 different categories, including turnover margin (8th), total assists (8th), assists per game (11th), free throws made (15th), total steals (17th), scoring offense (18th), free throw attempts (19th), win-lost percentage (21st), offensive rebounds per game (23rd) and assist turnover ratio (25th).

• Arkansas had a total home attendance of over 290,000 fans last year and ranked second in the SEC with 15,519 fans per game.

• Bud Walton Arena continued its rise in attendance last season, increasing the average fans per game for the fourth straight year and ranking No. 11 in the country.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
