THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Dusty Hannahs, Anthlon Bell and Moses Kingsley is the only trio in the country to score double figures in all 10 games this season.
- Arkansas has never played North Florida, but is 4-0 all-time against current teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Arkansas last played an A-Sun school on November 11, 2011, defeating USC Upstate 83-63 in Mike Anderson's first game as head coach of the Razorbacks.
- Arkansas has won 29 of its last 30 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 44-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.
- Jabril Durham is one of four players in the country with four double-digit assist games this season. He has four of the seven double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 4 in the nation with 7.8 assists per game.
- Arkansas' last four opponents have entered the game with a combined record of 32-9.

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 4 in the country with 7.8 assists per game.
- Has four of the seven double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Is one of four players in the country with four-plus double-digit assist games this season.
- One of five players in the nation this season to record a game of double-digit points and assists and 5-plus steals.
- Is the only player in the league with multiple double-digit assist games this season.
- Is one of five players in the country with three games of five-plus steals this year.

#5 || Anthion Bell (G)

- Leads the SEC with 31 made three-pointers on the season.
- Has 10 straight double-digit scoring efforts to start the year.
- Has three games with five made three-pointers this year.
- Is one of 32 players in the nation with five-plus made treys in three games this season.
- One of four players in school history to lead the team in three-pointers made for three straight years.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Has five double-digit scoring efforts in his first 10 collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State and Tennessee Tech.
- Blocked a career-high two shots against Evansville.
- Played a career-long 30 minutes against Stanford in the NIT Tip-Off.
- Scored a career-high tying 14 points against Stanford.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has 10 consecutive double-digit scoring games and two 20-point efforts to start the year.
- After one double-double in two years, he has six in 10 games to open the year.
- One of 29 players in the nation averaging a double-double and one of 12 from a power five conference.
- One of five players from a power five conference averaging a double-double with 15-plus points per game.
- · Leads SEC with 26 blocks on the season.
- Pulled down a career-best 14 rebounds against Mercer.

#55 | Keaton Miles (F)

- Scored a career-high tying 11 points against Northwestern State.
- Has made eight consecutive starts and started nine of 10 games this year.
- Made his first career start as a Razorback in the season opener.

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Missed the Stanford, Northwestern State and Wake Forest games with ankle injury suffered in Georgia Tech game.
- Posted first career double-digit scoring effort against Tennessee Tech.
- Played a career-long 26 minutes against Tennessee Tech.
- Set a career with seven rebounds against Akron.
- Recorded a career-high two blocks against Charleston Southern.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Has led Arkansas in scoring in six of the last eight games, all coming off the bench.
- Ranks No. 3 in the SEC in three-pointers made (28) and three-point field goal percentage (.470).
- Has a team-high five 20-plus point games.
- Scored a season-high 23 points against Evansville.
- Ranks No. 5 in the SEC in scoring at 17.7 points per game.
- Has started the year 39-for-42 (.929) from the free throw line.
- Ranks No. 1 in the SEC with a .929 free throw percentage.

#21 | Manuale Watkins (G)

- Has four double-digit scoring games in his career, all coming in the last nine games.
- Has consecutive double-digit scoring efforts two different times this season.
- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest.
- Went 6-for-7 from the field against the Demon Deacons.

#31 || Anton Beard (G)

- Reinstated to the program on Nov. 16 following resolutions in the legal and the campus judicial processes.
- Joined team-related activities and practice on Nov. 16.
- Was suspended for the fall semester and the first nine games of the year.
- Scored six points in 18 minutes against Mercer in his return to action.
- Went 2-for-3 from behind the arc against Mercer.
- Named to the SEC All-Freshman team last season after starting the final 16 games of the year.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State.
- Has gone 14-for-18 from the charity stripe in the last seven games.
- Has recorded a block in 52 of his 93 collegiate games.

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

- Anthlon Bell (31) and Dusty Hannahs (28) are the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC, combining to sink 59 treys through nine games for 5.9 makes per contest.
- Arkansas has had a player make five-plus three-pointers in five of 10 games this season after doing so just twice all of last year and taking the previous 41 games to accomplish the feat.
- The Razorbacks went 9-for-13 (.692) from long range against Evansville on Dec. 8, marking the best three-point field percentage in school history for a single game with eight-plus attempts.
- Arkansas has made at least five three-pointers in all 10 games this season.
- The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 53 of the last 58 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 884 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.
- Hannahs ranks No. 3 in the SEC with a .475 three-point field goal percentage, making 28 of 59 attempts from behind the arc.
- Hannahs is one of four players in school history to make five-plus three-pointers in a game without a miss when he went 5-for-5 against Charleston Southern.
- Bell went 5-for-5 from long range against Stanford in a span of six minutes and 34 seconds, taking Arkansas from a two-point deficit to a 19-point lead.
- After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

HELP YOURSELF >>

• There have been seven double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year, and Jabril Durham is responsible for four of them. He ranks No. 4 in the country with 7.8 assists per game and is the only conference player with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

PERFECT CHARITY >>

• Dusty Hannahs leads the SEC with a .929 free throw percentage, making 39-of-42 attempts on the year. Prior to his miss against Stanford in the NIT Season Tip-Off, Hannahs had made 34 straight free throws dating back to his days at Texas Tech. He ranks No. 5 in the country in free throw percentage among players with 40-plus attempts.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

SHARP SHOOTERS >>

• Arkansas has shot 50 percent or better from the floor four times this year, including three time in the last five games. The Razorbacks are unbeaten when shooting at least 50 percent from the field and a perfect 4-0 when shooting 45 percent or better behind the arc.



ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

- Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.
- He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 190 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 179 career three-point field goals, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.
- Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now sixth all-time with 113 career blocks and leads the SEC this season with 26 blocks.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 72-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the second-most home wins in the country during this span.
- Arkansas (72-9) is one of only two teams (Kentucky, 74-4) in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.
- Arkansas has won 29 of its last 30 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 44-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

- The Ospreys, from Jacksonville, Florida, play in the Atlantic Sun (A-Sun) Conference and are 10-4 on the season. North Florida has won four consecutive games, all at home, scoring 80-plus points in each of those games. In all, the Ospreys are 7-0 at UNF Arena and 3-4 away from home; the losses were at Louisville, Saint Louis, LSU and Dayton. North Florida's most notable win came vs. Illinois. a 93-81 neutral-site win in the season opener.
- North Florida is the most deadly three-point shooting team in the nation, averaging 13.1 made threes per game (1st), while shooting 44.6 percent from beyond the arc (4th). Six Ospreys average at least one made trey per contest, with Trent Mackey and Beau Beech leading the way. Mackey leads the team with a 50-for-95 (52.6 percent) mark from deep, while Beech is second on the club with a 45-for-94 (47.9 percent) total on three-pointers. But while Beech averages 15.6 points and Mackey adds 13.1, Dallas Moore leads the team with 19.9 per game. Overall, North Florida scores 86.5 points (9th) as a team and has scored 100-plus three times in 14 contests.
- Head coach Matthew Driscoll is in his seventh season with the Ospreys, with a record of 106-104 (.505) in six-plus seasons. A Pittsburgh native, Driscoll got his first head-coaching gig at La Roche College in 1993. After four years with the Redhawks, he bounced around as an assistant coach before heading to Baylor as an assistant from 2003-09. With Driscoll's help, the Bears vaulted into national contention and he was hired by the Ospreys in 2009. North Florida won its first A-Sun title in 2014-15 with a 12-2 conference record and advanced to the NCAA Tournament, finishing the year at 23-12 overall.

HISTORIC LOOK BACK >>

- Arkansas finished 27-9 overall last season and 13-5 in the SEC, earning the No. 2 seed in the SEC Tournament and advanced to the championship game for the first time since 2008 and the sixth time in program history.
- Bobby Portis emerged as one of the top players in the country last year, earning SEC Player of the Year honors and All-America honors, before going to the Chicago Bulls with the 22nd overall pick in the NBA Draft. The Little Rock native became the first player in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds by the end of his sophomore season
- The Razorbacks finished the 2014-15 season ranked in the top 25 nationally in 10 different categories, including turnover margin (8th), total assists (8th), assists per game (11th), free throws made (15th), total steals (17th), scoring offense (18th), free throw attempts (19th), win-lost percentage (21st), offensive rebounds per game (23rd) and assist turnover ratio (25th).
- Arkansas had a total home attendance of over 290,000 fans last year and ranked second in the SEC with 15,519 fans per game.
- Bud Walton Arena continued its rise in attendance last season, increasing the average fans per game for the fourth straight year and ranking No. 11 in the country.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
