THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- In the last 15 years, Arkansas has dropped its SEC opener eight times. In those eight years, the Razorbacks have won their second league game twice, including in 2013 against Vanderbilt.

- Over the last 25 SEC regular season games dating back to 2013-14, Arkansas has a record of 18-7, the second-best mark in the SEC behind Kentucky (22-3). Vanderbilt is 10-15 over the same stretch.

- Arkansas is 20-11 all-time against Vanderbilt, including a 10-2 mark in BWA.

- Mike Anderson has posted a record of 28-7 (.800) against SEC opponents in Bud Walton Arena.

- Moses Kingsley is the only power five conference player in the country averaging at least 15 points, 10 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game.

- Kingsley is the first Razorback in 30 years with eight double-doubles through the first 12 games.

- Jabril Durham is one of six players in the country with four double-digit assist games this season. He has four of the 10 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 5 in the nation with 7.3 assists per game.

- Kingsley's eight double-doubles is tied for the ninth-most in the country and second-most in the SEC behind LSU's Ben Simmons (10).

- Kingsley is one of 12 players in the nation with five-plus blocks in three different games this year.

- The Abuja, Nigera native is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

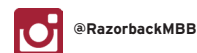
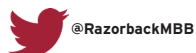

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 5 in the country with 7.3 assists per game.
- Has four of the 10 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year.
- Is one of six players in the country with four-plus double-digit assist games this season.
- One of seven players in the nation to record a game of double-digit points and assists and five-plus steals.
- Is one of two players in the league with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Is second in the SEC with 38 made three-pointers this season.
- Has scored double-digits in 12 of the first 13 games this year.
- Hit the game-tying three-pointer at Dayton with 1.4 seconds left to force OT.
- Has three games with five made three-pointers this year.
- Named to the NIT Tip-Off All-Tournament Team after sinking 9-of-15 threes and scoring 31 point.

#21 || Manuele Watkins (G)

- Has six double-digit scoring games in his career, all coming this season.
- Made his first collegiate start against North Florida and scored 11 points.
- Has consecutive double-digit scoring efforts two different times this season.
- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has 13 consecutive double-digit scoring games and four 20-point efforts to start the year.
- After one double-double in two seasons, he has eight in 13 games to open the year.
- First Razorback in 30 years with eight double-doubles through the first 12 games.
- Is one of three players in the nation (Only player in Power 5) averaging 15 points, 10 rebounds and 2.5 blocks.
- One of 22 players in the country averaging a double-double, including one of 10 from a power five conference.
- Is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.
- Tied for ninth in the country with eight double-doubles this season.
- Leads SEC with 35 blocks and is one of 11 players in the nation with five-plus blocks in three games this year.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Has made 11 consecutive starts and started 12 of 13 games this year.
- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against North Florida.
- Made his first career start as a Razorback in the season opener.

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Missed the Stanford, Northwestern State and Wake Forest games with an ankle injury suffered in Ga. Tech game.
- Posted first career double-digit scoring effort against Tennessee Tech.
- Dished out a career-high five assists and tied a career mark with seven rebounds against North Florida.
- Made a career-high four free throws at Texas A&M (Jan. 2).

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Has led Arkansas in scoring in six games, all coming off the bench.
- Ranks No. 5 in the SEC in three-pointers made (30) and No. 2 in three-point field goal percentage (.455).
- Has a team-high five 20-plus point games.
- Scored a season-high 23 points against Evansville.
- Has started the year 43-for-49 (.878) from the free throw line.
- Ranks No. 3 in the SEC in free throw percentage.
- Set a career-high with a 10-for-10 performances from the free throw line against Evansville.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Has five double-digit scoring efforts in his first 13 collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State and Tennessee Tech.
- Made his first collegiate three-pointer in his SEC debut at Texas A&M (Jan. 2).
- Blocked a career-high two shots against Evansville.

#31 || Anton Beard (G)

- Reinstated to the program on Nov. 16 following resolutions in the legal and the campus judicial processes.
- Joined team-related activities and practice on Nov. 16.
- Was suspended for the fall semester and the first nine games of the year.
- Scored a career-high 15 points at Dayton.
- Is 7-for-15 (.466) from behind the arc over the last four games.
- Tallied a career-high tying five assists at Dayton.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State.
- Has recorded a block in 53 of his 96 collegiate games.
- Tallied a season-high four blocks in 14 minutes against Evansville.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell ranks second in the SEC with 38 three-pointers made, while Dusty Hannahs is fifth with 30 treys this season. Arkansas is the only SEC team to have two players with 30-plus made three-pointers on the year.

• The Razorbacks went 9-for-13 (.692) from long range against Evansville on Dec. 8, marking the best three-point field percentage in school history for a single game with eight-plus attempts.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 56 of the last 61 games dating back to the 2013-14 season.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 887 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.

HELP YOURSELF >>

• There have been 10 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year, and Jabril Durham is responsible for four of them. He ranks No. 5 in the country with 7.3 assists per game and is one of two conference players with multiple double-digit assist games this season.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

• Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

COMMODORE KILLERS >>

• Arkansas has two 30 point games against Vanderbilt and both have come in the last six years. Rotnie Clarke dropped 36 on the Commodores in 2011, the fourth most points in program history for an SEC game, and Bobby Portis poured in 32 against Vandy last January in a 12-point victory.

#BEASTMO FOR REAL >>

• Moses Kingsley is the first Razorback in 20 years to record a game of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks, and the junior has accomplished the feat twice this season. He is one of two players in the country to reach the stat line multiple times this year.

MO BLOCKS PLEASE >>

• Kingsley is on pace to record 87 blocks this year, which would rank sixth all-time in program history for blocks in a single season and the most since Delvin Johnson in 2010-11. Oliver Miller's 112 blocks in 1991 is the school's all-time mark. Kingsley currently leads the SEC and ranks No. 18 in the nation with 35 blocks, recording two-plus blocks in eight contests.

THE BIG MAN COMPARISON >>

• Through the first 13 games of the season, Moses Kingsley is putting up nearly identical numbers to SEC Player of the Year and 2015 NBA First Rounder Bobby Portis. #BeastMo leads in four categories, while #BP has the edge in three.

ANDERSON TOP 3 IN SEC >>

• Mike Anderson is ranked as the No. 3 head coach in the Southeastern Conference according to Sporting News Magazine, joining Kentucky's John Calipari and Auburn's Bruce Pearl as the best coaches in the SEC.

• He is one of 11 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Ole Miss' Andy Kennedy are the only coaches in the SEC to appear on the list.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

• Anthlon Bell is 149 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

• Bell has 186 career three-point field goals, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.

• Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now sixth all-time with 122 career blocks and leads the SEC this season with 35 blocks.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

• During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 73-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the second-most home wins in the country during this span.

• Arkansas (73-9) is one of only two teams (Kentucky, 78-4) in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.

• Arkansas has won 30 of its last 31 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 45-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

• Vanderbilt enters Tuesday's matchup at 8-5 overall and 0-1 in SEC play. The Commodores lost 90-82 to LSU on Saturday in their first conference action of the year. After beginning the season 5-0, Vandy has gone 3-5 in its last eight contests. In terms of common opponents, both Arkansas and Vandy have lost to Dayton, while the Commodores defeated Wake Forest at the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, while the Razorbacks lost to the Demon Deacons in Winston-Salem, N.C.

• Even though Vandy only has two players averaging double figures, the Commodores have the 63rd-best scoring offense in the country and fifth-best in the SEC at 79.8 points per game. They have six players contributing at least 8.5 points per contest, led by sophomore guard Wade Baldwin IV at 14.8 and junior center Damian Jones with 12.5. The Commodores rank in the top 35 nationally in blocks per game (5.4), defensive rebounds per game (29.1), field goal defense (36.8 percent) and three-point field goal defense (27.4).

• Head coach Kevin Stallings is in his 17th season at Vanderbilt, with a record of 321-212 (.602) in 16-plus seasons. He's the all-time winningest coach in Commodore history, with 43 victories more than Roy Skinner's second-place mark of 278. In 33 seasons as a player, assistant coach and head coach, Stallings' clubs have made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances.

SERIES NOTES >>

• Arkansas leads the all-time series 20-11, including a 10-2 record in BWA.

• Arkansas has won 10 of the last 14 meetings against the Commodores.

• The fewest points the Razorbacks have ever allowed in an SEC game came against the Commodores on Jan. 12, 2013, winning 56-33 in Bud Walton Arena.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
