THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

• Arkansas is one of four teams in the country and the only power five conference program with three players averaging 15-plus points per game.

• Over the last 25 SEC regular season games dating back to 2013-14, Arkansas has a record of 18-7, the second-best mark in the SEC behind Kentucky (21-4). Missouri is 6-19 over the same stretch.

• Arkansas is one of six power five conference teams in the country to make at least 16 three-pointers in a game this season, and the only one to do so on fewer than 25 attempts. (16-of-24 vs Mississippi State)

• Moses Kingsley is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

• Jabril Durham is one of four players in the country with five double-digit assist games this season. He has five of the 11 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 3 in the nation with 7.5 assists per game.

• Durham is the only player in the country with multiple games of 10 points, 10 assists and five steals.

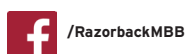

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 3 in the country with 7.5 assists per game.
- Is the only player in the country to record two games of 10-plus points and assists and five-plus steals.
- All 14 SEC teams played last Saturday and he had more assists (12) than six of those teams.
- One of four players in the country with five double-digit assist performances this year.
- Has five of the 11 double-digit assist games in the SEC this year.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Earned first SEC Player of the Week award on Jan. 11 after averaging 25.5 points per game making 11-of-17 treys.
- Is second in the SEC with 49 made three-pointers this season.
- Is one of 14 players in the country with five-plus treys made in five different games.
- Has scored double-digits in 14 of the first 15 games this year.
- Is averaging 22.3 points in conference play, the fourth highest in the league.
- Has scored 20-plus points in five of the last eight games.
- Has made 16 of his last 31 three-pointers (.516) over the last four games.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Started the last two contests after coming off the bench the previous 11 games.
- Scored a career-high 26 points against Mississippi State (Jan. 9) on a career-best eight three-pointers.
- Is one of three players in school history to make eight three-pointers in SEC play.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring a team-best seven times, with six of those coming off the bench.
- Ranks No. 4 in the SEC in three-pointers made (38) and No. 5 in three-point field goal percentage (.463).
- Has six 20-plus point games, tied for most on the team with Anthlon Bell.
- Has started the year 52-for-59 (.881) from the free throw line to lead the SEC.

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has 15 consecutive double-digit scoring games and five 20-point efforts to start the year.
- After one double-double in two seasons, he has eight in 15 games to open the year.
- First Razorback in 30 years with eight double-doubles through the first 12 games.
- Is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.
- Tied for 13th in the country with eight double-doubles this season.
- Leads SEC with 39 blocks and is one of 17 players in the nation with five-plus blocks in three games this year.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Has made 13 consecutive starts and started 14 of 15 games this year.
- Scored four of the final seven points in regulation as Arkansas forced OT against Vandy (Jan. 5).
- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against North Florida.

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Posted first career double-digit scoring effort against Tennessee Tech.
- Played a career-long 26 minutes against Tennessee Tech.
- Missed the Stanford, Northwestern State and Wake Forest games with ankle injury suffered in Ga. Tech game.
- Dished out a career-high five assists and tied a career mark with seven rebounds against North Florida.

#21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Has six double-digit scoring games in his career, all coming this season.
- Made his first collegiate start against North Florida and scored 11 points.
- Has consecutive double-digit scoring efforts two different times this season.
- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest.

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Has five double-digit scoring efforts in his first 15 collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State and Tennessee Tech.
- Made his first collegiate three-pointer in his SEC debut at Texas A&M (Jan. 2).
- Blocked a career-high tying two shots against Vanderbilt.

#31 || Anton Beard (G)

- Reinstated to the program on Nov. 16 following resolutions in the legal and the campus judicial processes.
- Joined team-related activities and practice on Nov. 16.
- Was suspended for the fall semester and the first nine games of the year.
- Scored a career-high 15 points at Dayton.
- Is 8-for-16 (.500) from behind the arc over the last six games.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State.
- Has recorded a block in 53 of his 98 collegiate games.
- Tallied a season-high four blocks in 14 minutes against Evansville.
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell and Dusty Hannahs have combined to make 87 three-pointers, tying Auburn's Kareem Canty and Bryce Brown for the top three-point shooting tandem in the SEC.

• Arkansas is the only team in the SEC to have two players make 35-plus three-pointers this season - Bell (49) and Hannahs (38).

• The Razorbacks have the top two three-point field percentages in school history for a single game this season, shooting 9-for-13 (.692) against Evansville on Dec. 8 and 16-for-24 (.667) against Mississippi State on Jan. 9.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 58 of the last 63 games dating back to the 2013-14 season, including every game this year.

• Against Mississippi State (Jan. 9), Arkansas' 16-for-24 performance made it the third team in the country to make 16-plus threes and shoot at least 66.7 percent while doing so.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 889 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.



RING THE BELL >>

• Anthlon Bell picked up his first SEC Player of the Week honor Monday after averaging 25.5 points per game last week in wins over Vanderbilt and Mississippi State. The senior knocked down 11-of-17 three-point attempts and currently leads the SEC with 15 treys in conference play.

CONNECTIONS >>

- Mike Anderson was previously the head coach at Missouri from 2006-11 before coming back to Arkansas.
- Melvin Watkins was previously at Missouri from 2004-11. He was retained when Anderson took over in 2006.
- Assistant coaches TJ Cleveland and Matt Zimmerman were at Missouri with Anderson from 2006-11.
- Arkansas Freshman Jimmy Whitt went to Hickman High School in Columbia, Missouri.

#BEASTMO FOR REAL >>

• Moses Kingsley is the first Razorback in 20 years to record a game of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks, and the junior has accomplished the feat twice this season. He is one of two players in the country to reach the stat line multiple times this year.

MO BLOCKS PLEASE >>

• Kingsley is on pace to record 83.2 blocks this year, which would rank eighth all-time in program history for blocks in a single season and the most since Delvin Johnson in 2010-11. Oliver Miller's 112 blocks in 1991 is the school's all-time mark. Kingsley currently leads the SEC and ranks No. 17 in the nation with 35 blocks, recording two-plus blocks in eight contests.

PORTIS IMPRESSION >>

• Through the first 15 games of the season, Moses Kingsley is putting up nearly identical numbers to SEC Player of the Year and 2015 NBA First Rounder Bobby Portis. #BeastMo has eight double-doubles compared to three for Portis.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

• Arkansas has had 27 former players go on to play in the NBA, including four this season as listed below.

RIGHT ON PACE >>

• Jabril Durham is on pace to record 241 assists this season and set the school record, which is currently held by Kareem Reid with 219 helpers in 1995-96.

• Anthlon Bell is on pace to knock down 104 three-pointers and break Scotty Thurman's record of 102 treys in 1995. Bell's career total is on pace to be fourth-best in program history.

• Head coach Mike Anderson is six wins away from his 100th win at Arkansas and his 300th win overall. He would become the seventh coach in program history to reach 100 wins at the helm of the Razorbacks.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

• Anthlon Bell is 98 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

• Bell has 197 career three-point field goals, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.

• Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now sixth all-time with 126 career blocks and leads the SEC this season with 39 blocks.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

• During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 75-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span behind Kentucky and Ohio State.

• Arkansas (75-9) is one of eight teams in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.

• Arkansas has won 30 of its last 31 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 45-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

• The Tigers are 8-7 on the season with a 1-1 record in SEC play. The Tigers lost 77-59 at Georgia in its conference opener, then responded with a 76-61 victory over Auburn at home Saturday night. In five non-conference games against power five teams, Mizzou went 0-5, losing by an average of 16.8 points per contest. Still, the Tigers are tough at home, where the team is 8-1 in the friendly confines of Mizzou Arena.

• The Tigers have 10 players who have played all 15 games and average at least 14 minutes per contest. Freshman forward Kevin Puryear leads the team with 12.5 points and 4.9 rebounds per game, shooting team bests of 50.4 percent from the field and 80.9 percent from the foul line in the process. Junior guard Wes Clark is the only other Mizzou player averaging in double figures, adding 10.1 points per game, as well as 2.9 assists from the two-guard position.

• Head coach Kim Anderson is in his second year with the Tigers and has a record of 17-30 (.362). Anderson came to Mizzou from Central Missouri, where he spent 13 years at the helm of the Division II program. In 2013-14, his last season with the Mules, the team won the National Championship en route to a 30-5 overall record.

SERIES NOTES >>

• Arkansas leads the all-time series 22-21, and the two teams have split six meetings since Missouri entered the SEC prior to the 2012-13 season.

• Arkansas has two 30-point performances against Missouri, with Scotty Thurman tagging the Tigers with 34 points in 1992 and Pat Bradley putting up 30 in 1996.

• The Razorbacks set the program record for blocks in a game against Missouri on Dec. 5 1995, swatting 18 shots in a 104-93 victory over the No. 11 Tigers.

• Arkansas ended Missouri's 34-game home winning streak on Dec. 8, 1990, taking down the Tigers 95-82 with the Razorbacks ranked No. 3 in the country.

• Head coach Mike Anderson faced Arkansas twice during his tenure at Missouri, falling 86-64 in 2006, before defeating the Razorbacks 94-91 the following year.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
