THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- The Razorbacks are off to a 3-1 start in SEC play for the first time in 18 years and the fifth time in program history. A win against LSU would be the third 4-1 start.
- Arkansas is one of four teams in the country and the only power five conference program with three players averaging 15-plus points per game.
- The Razorbacks are the only team in the SEC and one of two power five conference programs (Syracuse) to have two players make 40-plus three-pointers this season - Bell (51) and Hannahs (42).
- Arkansas is one of six power five conference teams in the country to make at least 16 three-pointers in a game this season, and the only one to do so on fewer than 25 attempts (16-of-24 vs Mississippi State).
- Tuesday's win at Missouri marked the best field goal percentage in school history for an SEC game (.627), while the 33-point victory is the largest margin of victory in SEC play in the Mike Anderson Era.
- The Razorbacks are No. 3 in the country in three-point field goal percentage at .450, sitting only behind the top two ranked teams in the country in top-ranked Kansas (.462) and No. 2 Oklahoma (.461).

- #NylonBell has made 17-of-31 (.548) three-pointers in league play and is the reigning SEC Player of the Week.
- Dusty Hannahs' eight three-pointers made against Mississippi State on Jan. 9 was the second-most in a game in Arkansas history in SEC play, only behind Lee Mayberry's nine threes against LSU in 1992.

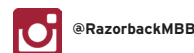

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 4 in the country with 7.4 assists per game.
- Is the only player in the country to record two games of 10-plus points and assists and five-plus steals.
- All 14 SEC teams played last Saturday and he had more assists (12) than six of those teams.
- One of four players in the country with five double-digit assist performances this year.
- Has five of the 12 double-digit assist games in the SEC this year.
- Is one of six players in the country with four games of five-plus steals this year.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Is the reigning SEC Player of the Week after averaging 25.5 points per game and making 11 treys.
- Needs one more three-pointer to become the sixth player in school history with 200 treys.
- Is second in the SEC with 51 made three-pointers this season.
- Is one of 15 players in the country with five-plus treys made in five different games.
- Has scored double-digits in 15 of the first 16 games this year.
- Has scored 20-plus points in five of the last nine games.
- Has made 18 of his last 36 three-pointers (.500) over the last five games.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Started the last three contests after coming off the bench the previous 11 games.
- Is 12-for-18 (.667) from behind the arc over the last two games.
- Recorded his seventh 20-point effort of the year with 20 points at Missouri (Jan. 12).
- Scored a career-high 26 points against Mississippi State (Jan. 9) on a career-best eight three-pointers.
- Is one of three players in school history to make eight three-pointers in an SEC game.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring a team-best seven times, with six of those coming off the bench.
- Ranks No. 4 in the SEC in three-pointers made (42) and No. 2 in three-point field goal percentage (.483).

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has 16 consecutive double-digit scoring games and six 20-point efforts to start the year.
- Has scored 20-plus points in four of the last six games.
- Is the first player in school history with two 8-for-8 shooting performances in a career (Southern and Missouri).
- After one double-double in two seasons, he has eight in 15 games to open the year.
- First Razorback in 30 years with eight double-doubles through the first 12 games.
- Is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Has made 14 consecutive starts and started 15 of 16 games this year.
- Scored four of the final seven points in regulation as Arkansas forced OT against Vandy (Jan. 5).
- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against North Florida (Dec. 22).

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Posted first career double-digit scoring effort against Tennessee Tech (Dec. 12).
- Played a career-long 26 minutes against Tennessee Tech (Dec. 12).
- Missed the Stanford, Northwestern State and Wake Forest games with ankle injury suffered in Ga. Tech game.
- Dished out a career-high five assists and tied a career mark with seven rebounds against North Florida (Dec. 22).

#21 || Manuele Watkins (G)

- Has six double-digit scoring games in his career, all coming this season.
- Made his first collegiate start against North Florida (Dec. 22) and scored 11 points.
- Has consecutive double-digit scoring efforts two different times this season.
- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest (Dec. 4).

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Had a career-high 15 points against Mizzou (Jan. 12) in his return to Columbia.
- Has six double-digit scoring efforts in his first 16 collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State and Tennessee Tech.
- Made his first collegiate three-pointer in his SEC debut at Texas A&M (Jan. 2).

#31 || Anton Beard (G)

- Reinstated to the program on Nov. 16 following resolutions in the legal and the campus judicial processes.
- Joined team-related activities and practice on Nov. 16.
- Was suspended for the fall semester and the first nine games of the year.
- Scored a career-high 15 points at Dayton.
- Had three double-digit scoring efforts in seven games this season.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State (Dec. 1).
- Has recorded a block in 53 of his 99 collegiate games.
- Tallied a season-high four blocks in 14 minutes against Evansville (Dec. 8).
- Grabbed three rebounds in eight minutes vs. Southern University in his debut as a Razorback.

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell and Dusty Hannahs have combined to make 93 three-pointers, making them the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC. Auburn's Kareem Canty and Bryce Brown rank No. 2 with 88 treys.

• The Razorbacks have the top two three-point field percentages in school history for a single game this season, shooting 9-for-13 (.692) against Evansville on Dec. 8 and 16-for-24 (.667) against Mississippi State on Jan. 9.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 59 of the last 64 games dating back to the 2013-14 season, including every game this year.

• Against Mississippi State (Jan. 9), Arkansas' 16-for-24 performance made it the third team in the country to make 16-plus threes and shoot at least 66.7 percent while doing so.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 890 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.

RING THE BELL >>

• Anthlon Bell picked up his first SEC Player of the Week honor Monday after averaging 25.5 points per game last week in wins over Vanderbilt and Mississippi State. The senior knocked down 11-of-17 three-point attempts and currently leads the SEC with 17 treys in conference play.

THREE-HEADED MONSTER >>

• With the trio of Moses Kingsley (17.3), Anthlon Bell (17.0) and Dusty Hannahs (16.5), Arkansas is one of four teams in the country and the only power five conference program with three players averaging 15-plus points per game (Eastern Washington, Richmond, St. Bonaventure).

25 AND COUNTING >>

• Over the last 25 SEC regular season games dating back to 2013-14, Arkansas has a record of 18-7, the second-best mark in the SEC behind Kentucky (22-3). LSU is 15-10 over the same stretch.

HELP YOURSELF >>

• Jabril Durham is one of four players in the country with five double-digit assist games this season. He has five of the 12 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 4 in the nation with 7.4 assists per game. Durham is the only player in the country with multiple games of 10 points, 10 assists and five steals.

#BEASTMO FOR REAL >>

• Moses Kingsley is the first Razorback in 20 years to record a game of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks, and the junior has accomplished the feat twice this season. He is one of two players in the country to reach the stat line multiple times this year.

NO BLOCKS PLEASE >>

• Kingsley is on pace to record 86 blocks this year, which would rank sixth all-time in program history for blocks in a single season and the most since Delvin Johnson's 91 blocks in 2010-11. Oliver Miller's 112 blocks in 1991 is the school's all-time mark. Kingsley currently leads the SEC and ranks No. 14 in the nation with 43 blocks, recording two-plus blocks in nine contests.

PORTIS IMPRESSION >>

• Through the first 16 games of the season, Moses Kingsley is putting up nearly identical numbers to SEC Player of the Year and 2015 NBA First Rounder Bobby Portis. #BeastMo has eight double-doubles compared to four for Portis.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

RIGHT ON PACE >>

- Jabril Durham is on pace to record 236 assists this season and set the school record, which is currently held by Kareem Reid with 219 helpers in 1995-96.
- Anthlon Bell is on pace to knock down 102 three-pointers and tie Scotty Thurman's single season record of 102 treys in 1994-95. Bell's career total is on pace to be fourth-best in program history.
- Head coach Mike Anderson is five wins away from his 100th win at Arkansas and his 300th win overall. He would become the seventh coach in program history to reach 100 wins at the helm of the Razorbacks.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- Anthlon Bell is 86 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.
- Bell has 199 career three-point field goals, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Next up on the list is Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.
- Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now sixth all-time with 130 career blocks and leads the SEC this season with 43 blocks.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 75-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span behind Kentucky and Ohio State.
- Arkansas (75-9) is one of eight teams in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.
- Arkansas has won 30 of its last 31 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 45-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

• The Tigers are coming off a 90-81 victory over Ole Miss on Wednesday at the Maravich Center, where they are 9-1 this season. In their first SEC home game, LSU upset No. 9 Kentucky by a score of 85-67, handing the Wildcats their third loss of the year. The Tigers were preseason No. 21 in the county before an early three-game losing streak, but LSU has gone 6-2 in its past eight contests.

• Freshman phenom Ben Simmons is the key to LSU, averaging 20.3 points per game while leading the SEC with 12.6 rebounds per contest and 12 double-doubles. He also ranks fourth in the conference with 5.3 assists and third in the SEC with 1.9 steals per game. Simmons was named the SportingNews.com mid-season Freshman of the Year on Wednesday before the Tigers' contest against Ole Miss. Still, LSU has three other players (Keith Hornsby - 14.9, Craig Victor II - 13.3 and Tim Quarterman - 11.6) averaging in double figures for the No. 2 scoring offense in the SEC.

• Head coach Johnny Jones is in his fourth season with the Tigers, and has a 71-43 (.623) record in three-plus seasons in Baton Rouge. He went from 19-to-20-to-22 wins in his first three years at LSU. Jones came to LSU from North Texas, where he went 190-146 (.565) in 11 years in Denton. Jones played for the Tigers from 1980-85, starting 54 career games and appearing on the 1981 Final Four team.

SERIES NOTES >>

• Arkansas leads the all-time series 32-27, including a 28-22 edge since Arkansas joined the SEC for the 1991-92 season.

• Arkansas has three 30-point performances against LSU, with Todd Day scoring 43 points on Jan. 11, 1992, and Lee Mayberry coming back later that season on March 3 tagging the Tigers for 35 points. Tommy Boyer also scored 35 against LSU in 1962.

• The Razorbacks played their last game in Barnhill Arena against LSU on March 3, 1993, defeating LSU 88-75 behind 19 points from Corliss Williamson.

• Arkansas' program record for three-pointers made in an SEC game came against LSU in 1992 when Lee Mayberry hit nine treys against the Tigers.

• Mike Anderson is 2-5 against LSU at Arkansas and 3-6 against the Tigers all-time as a head coach.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
