## THE #FASTEST40 FACTS

- Arkansas leads the all-time series with LSU 32-28, but the Tigers have won two straight against the Razorbacks, including a buzzer beater victory in Bud Walton Arena last year.

- The Razorbacks have seen eight of their 14 losses come by four points or fewer, including three of those in overtime.

- Arkansas leads the SEC and ranks No. 11 in the country in three-point field goal percentage at .403 and is on pace to break the school record of .395 set during the 1992-93 season.

- The Razorbacks are one of two teams (St. Bonaventure) in the country with three players averaging 16-plus points per game with Kingsley (16.1), Hannahs (16.1) and Bell (16.0). The scoring trio has combined to produce 33 games of 20-plus points.

- Dusty Hannahs has made 26 of his last 27 free throws over the last nine games and leads the SEC with a .883 free throw percentage on the year. He ranks No. 14 in the country and No. 4 among high major players.

- Jabril Durham is one of seven players in the country with six double-digit assist games this season. He has six of the 17 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and is the only player in the country with multiple games of 10 points, 10 assists and five steals.

- Anthlon Bell needs one three-pointer to pass with Razorback legend and all-time leading scorer Todd Day for third place on the program's list for three pointers made. Both players currently sit at 226.

- The Abuja, Nigeria, native has been named one of 10 finalists for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award as the nation's top center.

## STARTING FIVE >>

### #4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Is second in the SEC and ranks No. 13 in the country with 6.5 assists per game.
- Scored a career-high 17 points against Missouri (Feb. 20) and added six assists and no turnovers.
- Is the only player in the country to record two games of 10-plus points and assists and five-plus steals.
- Recorded his third double-double of the year with 12 points and 10 assists against Auburn (Feb. 17).
- One of seven players in the country with six double-digit assist performances this year.
- Has six of the 17 double-digit assist games in the SEC this year.

### #5 || Anthon Bell (G)

- With 24 points at Florida on Feb. 3 he came the 39th 1,000 point scorer in program history.
- Ranks 32nd in program history with 1,075 career points.
- Has 226 career three-pointers, tied with Todd Day for fourth all-time.
- Ranks No. 2 in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage (.443) and No. 3 in three-point field goals made (78).
- Is tied for No. 4 in program history with 226 career three-pointers.
- Named the SEC Player of the Week on Jan. 11 after averaging 25.5 points per game and making 11 treys.

### #3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Is averaging 18.8 points per game in 15 games in Bud Walton Arena.
- Has scored 20-plus points in seven of the last 13 games and a team-best 12 times this year.
- Has made 26 of 27 free throws over the last seven games and leads the SEC with a .883 free throw percentage.
- Scored 21 points in the first half against Texas Tech, turning a 10-point deficit into a four-point lead in nine minutes.
- Scored a career-high 26 points against Mississippi State (Jan. 9) on a career-best eight three-pointers.
- Is one of three players in school history to make eight three-pointers in an SEC game.

### #33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Name the SEC Player of the Week on Feb. 1 after averaging 17.5 points and 11 rebounds in two home wins.
- Is one of three only player in the SEC with double-doubles in each of his last three games.
- One of 10 finalists for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award as the nation's top center.
- Joins LSU's Ben Simmons as the only individuals in the SEC with 14-plus double-doubles on the year.
- Has six double-doubles in the last nine games.
- Has scored in double figures in 26 of the 27 games this season reached the 20-point mark six times.
- Is one of six high major players with 14-plus double-doubles on the year.

### #55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Has started 20 of 27 games this year.
- Tied a career-high with four blocks last time out against Missouri (Feb. 20).
- Led the team with eight rebounds at Mississippi State (Feb. 9).
- Tallied a career-high four blocks in only nine minutes in upset win over No. 5 Texas A&M (Jan. 27).

## WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell and Dusty Hannahs have combined to hit 147 three-pointers, making them the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC. Bell has hit a three-pointer in all 27 contests this year and Hannahs has connected in 23 of 27 games.

• The Razorbacks have the top two single-game three-point field goal percentages in school history this season, shooting 9-for-13 (.692) against Evansville on Dec. 8 and 16-for-24 (.667) against Mississippi State on Jan. 9.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 68 of the last 75 games dating back to the 2013-14 season, including 25 of 27 games this season.

• Against Mississippi State (Jan. 9), Arkansas' 16-for-24 performance made it the third team in the country to make 16-plus threes and shoot at least 66.7 percent while doing so.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 901 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.

### THREE'S COMPANY >>

• Arkansas has three starters shooting above 80-percent from the free throw line with Dusty Hannahs (.883), Anthlon Bell (.838) and Jabril Durham (.822). The last time the Razorbacks had three starters complete a season shooting 80-percent from the charity stripe came during the 1974-75 season.

### HELP YOURSELF >>

• Jabril Durham is one of five players in the country with six double-digit assist games this season. He has six of the 16 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 14 in the nation with 6.5 assists per game. Durham is the only player in the country with multiple games of 10 points, 10 assists and five steals.

### THANKS EDDIE >>

• On Saturday Feb. 20, former Arkansas men's basketball head coach Eddie Sutton was honored with a banner recognizing his Hall of Fame career at Bud Walton Arena during a special ceremony at halftime of the Missouri game.

• Sutton spent 36 years as a NCAA Division I basketball coach and became the first coach to take four schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 1974, Sutton took over the Arkansas program and over the next 11 seasons, he compiled a record of 260-75, including five Southwest Conference championships, nine NCAA tournament appearances and a Final Four appearance in 1978. Sutton helped lead the Razorbacks to national prominence, including coaching the Triplets, Sidney Moncrief, Ron Brewer and Marvin Delph, Joe Kleine and other Razorback greats.

### #BEASTMO FOR REAL >>

• Moses Kingsley is the first Razorback in 20 years to record a game of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks, and the junior has accomplished the feat twice this season. He is one of two players in the country to reach the stat line multiple times this year, joined by New Mexico State's Pascal Siakam.

### FROM YEAR-TO-YEAR >>

• Arkansas lost six players off last season's NCAA Tournament team, including four 1,000 point scorers. Without skipping a beat, Mike Anderson continues to develop players from one year to the next.

• Through the first 25 games of the season, Moses Kingsley is putting up nearly identical numbers to SEC Player of the Year and 2015 NBA First Rounder Bobby Portis. #BeastMo has 14 double-doubles compared to 10 for Portis.

### #NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons. He currently leads Dusty Hannahs by 10 treys for the team lead.

### A LEGEND IN THE SEC >>

• Former Arkansas great Pat Bradley has been named an Allstate® SEC Legend the conference office announced on Feb. 19. He will be recognized at the 2016 SEC Tournament in Nashville, Tenn.

• A four-time letterman from 1996-99, Bradley earned All-SEC honors in 1997 and 1998. He is fifth on Arkansas' career scoring list with 1,765 points, leading the Razorbacks in scoring for three consecutive seasons. He holds the school record for career three-pointers made (366), is 11th on Arkansas' career field goals made list (576) and led the team in free throw shooting all four years. His .858 career free throw percentage is the third-best in school history.



## RIGHT ON PACE >>

- Jabril Durham is on pace to record 208 assists this season and finish 11 assists shy of the school record, which is currently held by Kareem Reid with 219 helpers in 1995-96.
- Anthlon Bell is on pace to knock down 93 three-pointers and finish nine treys shy of Scotty Thurman's single season record of 102 treys in 1994-95. Bell's career total is on pace to be fourth-best in program history.
- Head coach Mike Anderson is one win away from his 100th win at Arkansas and his 300th win overall. He would become the seventh coach in program history to reach 100 wins at the helm of the Razorbacks.

## RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

- With 24 points at Florida on Feb. 3, Anthlon Bell became the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points. He is currently 32nd in school history with 1,075 points.
- Bell has 226 career three-point field goals, which is good for a tie for fourth place with Razorback legend and the program's all-time leading scorer Todd Day.
- Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now fifth all-time with 149 blocks and is tied for the SEC lead with 62 blocks.

## PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

- The Razorbacks are 7-3 all-time against Associated Press top five teams in Bud Walton Arena, including consecutive wins against No. 5 Texas A&M Wednesday night and No. 2 Florida in 2013.
- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 78-11 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span behind Kentucky and Ohio State.
- The Razorbacks are 12-3 in Bud Walton Arena this season and have held a double-digit lead in all 12 victories, including a 20-point edge against six teams.

## THE OPPONENT >>

• LSU is 16-11 on the year with a 9-5 record in SEC play. On Jan. 13 in Baton Rouge, LSU defeated Arkansas in the teams' first meeting of the season by a score of 76-74. The Tigers have lost three out of their last four games, with the lone win being a 76-71 victory over No. 15 Texas A&M on Feb. 13 at the Maravich Center. Most recently, LSU lost at Tennessee by 16 points on Saturday, only three days after falling to Alabama 78-69 at home on Wednesday.

• Freshman phenom Ben Simmons is the key to the Tigers' cog, averaging 19.4 points per game, while leading the SEC with 11.9 rebounds per contest and 18 double-doubles. He also ranks fifth in the league with five assists and third in the SEC with 1.8 steals per game. Still, LSU has four other players (Hornsby - 13.1, Victor II - 12.6, Blakeney - 11 and Quarterman - 10.8) averaging in double figures for the top scoring offense in the SEC.

• Head coach Johnny Jones is in his fourth season with the Tigers, and has a 77-48 (.616) record in three-plus seasons in Baton Rouge. He went from 19-to-20-to-22 wins in his first three years at LSU. Jones came to LSU from North Texas, where he went 190-146 (.565) in 11 years in Denton. Jones played for the Tigers from 1980-85, starting 54 career games and appearing on the 1981 Final Four team.

## SERIES NOTES >>

• Arkansas leads the all-time series 32-28, including a 28-23 edge since Arkansas joined the SEC for the 1991-92 season.

• Arkansas has three 30-point performances against LSU, with Todd Day scoring 43 points on Jan. 11, 1992, and Lee Mayberry coming back later that season on March 3 tagging the Tigers for 35 points. Tommy Boyer also scored 35 against LSU in 1962.

• The Razorbacks played their last game in Barnhill Arena against LSU on March 3, 1993, defeating LSU 88-75 behind 19 points from Corliss Williamson.

• Arkansas' program record for three-pointers made in an SEC game came against LSU in 1992 when Lee Mayberry hit nine treys against the Tigers.

• Mike Anderson is 2-6 against LSU at Arkansas and 3-7 against the Tigers all-time as a head coach.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
