» #FASTEST40 FACTS »

• Arkansas has equaled its best 14-game start in the Mike Anderson era with a 12-2 record. The 2014-15 team opened the year 13-2.

• Arkansas joins No. 4 UCLA and No. 14 North Carolina as the only high-major teams in the country to score 70-plus points in 14 games this season. The Razorbacks last scored 70-plus in each of their first 14 games in 1994-95.

• With Tuesday's win at Tennessee, Arkansas jumped 13 spots in the NCAA RPI to check in at No. 29. The Razorbacks are 3-2 against top 100 RPI teams with their only losses coming to two teams in the top 10.

• Dating back to last season, Arkansas has won three consecutive SEC road games and is looking to win four straight for the first time since the 1994-95 season.

• Arkansas has recorded runs of at least 10-0 on 14 different occasions this year, including a season-high 21-0 run against Austin Peay on Dec. 3. The Razorbacks have multiple 10-0 runs in five of 14 games this year.

• The Razorbacks have held opponents scoreless for three-plus minutes 23 times this year, including at least once in 11 of 14 games this season. Arkansas held UT Arlington scoreless for a season-best 7:11 during the second half, going on a 15-0 run.

• Arkansas and Kentucky are the top two scoring teams in the SEC with the Wildcats averaging 94.0 points per game and the Razorbacks following at 82.6.

» THE KENTUCKY SERIES »

• Kentucky's last conference loss in Rupp Arena came at the hands of Arkansas on Feb. 27, 2014, in a 71-67 overtime decision. Since then, the Wildcats have won 20 straight SEC games at home.

• Arkansas has won four of the last eight meetings against Kentucky, with three of those victories coming against a ranked Wildcat squad.

• The Razorbacks have road wins over 10 different SEC opponents in the last three-plus years, joining Florida (11) and Kentucky (13) as the only schools to accomplish the feat.

THE SPLASH ZONE EFFECT »

Arkansas ranks second in the SEC in 3-point field percentage at .373, but has the third fewest attempts in the league at 233, which is 108 fewer than league-leader Auburn.

The Razorbacks have made at least one 3-pointer in 920 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 7, 1989 against Texas.

CHARITY STRIPE »

The Razorbacks are second in the SEC and rank 10th in the country in free throw percentage at 77.5 percent, averaging 19.4 made free throws per game. Arkansas has made 78.4 percent of its free throws over the last five games.

Over the last 91 seconds of Tuesday's game against Tennessee, the Razorbacks combined to go 11-of-12 (91.6 percent) from the charity stripe to close out the Volunteers on their home court. Macon went 8-of-8 during that span, Barford sank both of his, while Kingsley split a pair.

Arkansas is one of two schools (Notre Dame) that has two players in the top 50 in free throw percentage in the country.

The Razorbacks are the only school to have two players (Macon and Hannahs) in the top five of the SEC in free throw percentage.

Macon is 25th in the nation and third in the SEC in free throw percentage at 90.6 percent (58-64).

Dusty Hannahs is shooting 89.8 percent (44-49) from the charity stripe this season, 27th in the nation and fourth in the SEC.

Macon (29) and Hannahs (26) each have streaks of 25-plus made free throws this season.

BUILDING BLOCKS »

Moses Kingsley is T-9th in the country with 3.0 blocks per game this season and has recorded at least one block in 44 of his last 47 contests.

Has multiple blocks in 10 games, and is T-11th in the country with three games of 5+ blocks. T-4th with nine games of 3+ blocks.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »

Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning high-major player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 20 double-doubles in his career.

TRANSITION GAME ON POINT »

Arkansas has outscored its opponents in fast break points in all but two games this season and holds a commanding 193-87 (+106) edge in the transition game. The Razorbacks have scored 20+ fast break points four times this season.

THE MODEL OF EFFICIENCY »

Of the 979 players in the country with 25-plus assists, Manuale Watkins is 18th in assist/turnover ratio at 3.6. He ranks second in the SEC and eighth among high-major players. He has eight turnovers in 303 minutes of action.

THE 90-POINT PLATEAU »

Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90-plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history. The Razorbacks have scored 90-plus points in five of the first 12 games for the first time since the 2001-02 season.

ELITE COMPANY »

With 10 points and 10 rebounds at Minnesota, Moses Kingsley became the eighth player in program history to reach 800 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks as a Razorback.





The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20-win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.
