**Series vs. Arkansas**

Southern Illinois is 2-3 all-time versus Arkansas, including a 1-1 mark on the road. The Salukis won at Barnhill Arena in overtime in 1971, and lost 86-72, in 1985. They have never played in Bud Walton Arena.

The only time the teams have met in the last 30 years was at on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 23, 2006, at the Old Spice Classic in Orlando. The Razorbacks won, 61-53, in overtime. Jamaal Tatum led SIU with 17 points, Randal Falker added 14, and Bryan Mullins had nine assists for a team that would end the season in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

**Series vs. SEC**

The Salukis are 9-21 all-time against current members of the SEC, including a 3-7 mark on the road. The road wins came at Arkansas, Mississippi and Missouri.

Barry Hinson is 2-9 lifetime versus the SEC, including an 0-3 mark against Arkansas while coaching at Missouri State. Both of his SEC wins came against Texas A&M. (Complete list on page 4)

**Senior leadership**

The Salukis' senior class (Sean O'Brien, Leo Vincent, Mike Rodriguez, Tyler Smithpeters) has the most returning career points and rebounds of any school in the Missouri Valley Conference. In fact, 25 percent of the returning scoring in the MVC comes from SIU's four seniors.

**Mike Rodriguez nearly doubles his career-high in scoring**

PG Mike Rodriguez (5-10, 165, Sr.) had a career-high 29 points in the opener against Wright State on Friday, nearly doubling his previous best of 15 versus Air Force on Nov. 13, 2015. Interestingly,

that game was also the team's season-opener.

Rodriguez also led the team with six assists against the Raiders. His assist-to-turnover ratio (1.88) last year was the ninth-best single-season ratio in school history.

**Road Warriors**

The Salukis were 4-0 in non-conference road games last year, winning at Sam Houston State, North Texas, Murray State and Saint Louis. The Salukis have not lost a non-conference road game since falling at SEMO on Dec. 10, 2014. Hinson is 12-12 in non-conference road games at SIU.

**Sean O'Brien voted Preseason Second-Team All-MVC**

F Sean O'Brien (6-7, 215, Sr.) is SIU's top returning scorer (12.1 points), rebounder (6.0 rebounds) and shot blocker (29 blocks). He was also second on the team in assists (63). The savvy veteran first cracked the lineup early in his freshman campaign, and has started 90 of the last 91 games, including a current streak of 68-consecutive starts.

**Leo Vincent delivers in first start**

G Leo Vincent (6-1, 192, Sr.) was named to the MVC's All-Bench team last year. He played in all 32 games, never started, but was the team's fourth-leading scorer (8.1 points). Against Wright State, he made his first-career start and scored 19 points to go with a team-high six rebounds.

**Saluki lineup features trio of junior college starters**

Three Saluki starters (Mike Rodriguez, Leo Vincent and Thik Bol) came to SIU via the junior college route. The last time Southern started three juco players in a game was on Feb. 22, 2012 when Mamadou Seck, Jeff Early and T.J. Lindsay started at Drake.

**Salukis take on Power Five foes**

SIU plays at three Power Five opponents this year — Arkansas, Minnesota and Louisville. Previously, the only Power Five game SIU has played under Hinson was a 72-59 loss at Missouri on Nov. 12, 2013.

**Dawg Bites**

- The 54 points allowed in the second half to Wright State were the most in the Hinson era, surpassing the 49 surrendered at Chicago State in 2013. The 32 personal fouls were also a high for the Hinson era.
- SIU was 7-2 in games decided by five points or less last year. The Salukis are 0-1 this season.
- SIU's roster has three foreign-born players — Rudy Stradnieks (Latvia), Thik Bol (Sudan), Leo Vincent (Liberia).

**School-record 17 home games at SIU Arena**

Southern Illinois will host a school-record eight non-conference home games for a total of 17 home games this season — the most in school history.

The Salukis have a 522-184 (.740) record all-time at SIU Arena, which opened in 1964, including a 12-4 mark last season. The arena underwent a \$29.9 million renovation prior to the 2010-11 season.

**Saluki turnaround**

The Salukis won 22 games a year ago, the most wins since 2007. It was the program's first winning season since 2008. Three times last season, the Salukis rallied from double-digit deficits to win. They trailed Air Force (-15) before rallying to win, 77-75. They trailed at Sam Houston State (-18) before winning, 86-81, in OT. They trailed Illinois State (-12) before winning 81-78.

**Tyler Smithpeters climbing all-time 3-point list**

G Tyler Smithpeters (6-4, 198, Sr.) ranks sixth all-time in career 3-point shooting percentage at SIU (.395). He is 20th overall in 3-pointers made (98). In his career, 69 percent of his shot attempts have come from 3-point range.

**Sell-Out No. 25**

In the Jan. 9 game against Wichita State, SIU recorded its first sell out since Mar. 1, 2014, vs. Illinois State — a span of 24 games. There have been 25 sold-out games in the 51-year history of the facility. A dozen of those sell-outs took place between 2001 and 2008, when the Salukis made six-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. SIU has an 18-7 record in sold-out home games. The current capacity for SIU Arena is 8,284.

**Quick Facts**

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities... Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.

**1967 NIT Champions**

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

**2002-08 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids**

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008. The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia. The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

**Five at-large NCAA bids**

Southern Illinois received four at-large NCAA bids in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

**Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story**

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He

was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them.

According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.
