QUICK HITTERS

- ★ The Commodores improved to 9-10 on the year and 3-4 in SEC play with a 68-66 win over #19/21 Florida on Saturday in Gainesville. Vanderbilt had four players score in double figures, led by Matthew Fisher-Davis, who tallied 19 points. Luke Kornet and Riley LaChance added 11 points, and Nolan Cressler chipped in 10 points.
- ★ The win was the Commodores' first win over a ranked Florida team in Gainesville since 2001.
- ★ Vanderbilt, who won the 2016 meeting, won in back-to-back years in Gainesville for the first time since 1990 and 1991.
- ★ The Commodores won their first road game against a ranked opponent since Dec. 29, 2011, in a win at Marquette (74-57).
- ★ Vanderbilt made 10 threes for the ninth time this year - the Commodores are now 8-1 on the season when making 10 or more threes.
- ★ Vanderbilt won their first game this year when scoring 70 points or less (1-6).
- ★ Vanderbilt leads the SEC in three-point field goal percentage (39.0%), threes made (9.8) and free throw percentage (77.5%) in all games. The Commodores rank eighth nationally in free-throw percentage and are 16th in 3's made per game.
- ★ VU's current RPI strength of schedule is 6th, and its non-conference schedule is ranked 3rd.
- ★ The meeting with Arkansas will be the 34th between the two schools and the 15th meeting at Vanderbilt.
- ★ The Commodores lost a 90-85 overtime contest last season against the Razorbacks, on Jan. 5, 2016, in Fayetteville.
- ★ In SEC play, Kornet is ranked in the top 10 in eight categories (Rebounding, FG%, 3FG%, 3FG Made, Blocks, Off. Rebounding, Def. Rebounding, Minutes Played).
- ★ Riley LaChance leads the SEC in three-point field goal percentage in all games (56.9%) and in SEC games only (53.1%). He is fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.3) and seventh in the league in assists (4.1) in all games. In three's made, LaChance ranks fifth in all games (2.2) and sixth in SEC games only (2.4).
- ★ Matthew Fisher-Davis leads the team in scoring with 16.4 points per game, while Kornet adds 13.4 points, with Roberson (10.3) and Riley LaChance (10.2) each adding double figure scoring.
- ★ Fisher-Davis is eighth in the SEC in scoring in all games and fifth in SEC games only (17.4), and second in the league in three's made (2.8) in all games and first in league games only (2.9). He shoots 39.0% from three in all games, which is sixth in the SEC.
- ★ Fisher-Davis now has 203 career threes and is currently ninth on Vanderbilt's all-time career three's made list.
- ★ Roberson ranks third in the SEC in defensive rebounding and is fourth in rebounding (7.3) in all games. In SEC games only, he ranks sixth in rebounding (7.0), seventh in free-throw percentage (83.3%), fourth in defensive rebounding (5.1), and seventh in minutes played (32.9).
- ★ Senior guard Nolan Cressler, who transferred from Cornell after his sophomore season, eclipsed the 1,000 point barrier against Tennessee after scoring 10 points. He now has 1,030 points in his career after scoring 10 points at Florida. Cressler has scored in double figures in six of his last eight games, and has started the last two contests.
- ★ The Commodores are in their 84th season of SEC basketball - Vanderbilt is one of the founding members of the Southeastern Conference. Vanderbilt recently won their 700th league game at Florida.
- ★ Making three's is not a new thing for this year's Commodore team. Combined in their career, current players have made 735 career threes.

Kornet Excels in Classroom

Senior center Luke Kornet has been named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll in the three years he has played at Vanderbilt, and also been named a CoSida All-District Academic Selection in his sophomore and junior seasons. He was also recently named to the NABC Good Works team for his work in the Vanderbilt and Nashville communities and named a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award.

Kornet is double majoring in computer science and mathematics.

Memorial Gym close to 1,000

The matchup with Tennessee was the 997th regular season game played at Memorial Gym.

The Commodores have a 778-218 record at the SEC's oldest facility, a winning percentage of .782.

Dores Drain Threes

Vanderbilt made 19 threes against High Point on December 6, which set a new school record for threes in a game, surpassing an 18-three performance at Tennessee on January 8, 2005.

The Commodores also set a new record for most 3-pointers made at Memorial Gym, passing the old mark of 16 that was set on Jan. 8, 1994 vs. South Carolina and then matched on Feb. 11, 1995 vs. Arkansas. The Commodores hit 12 of their 19 3-pointers in the first half.

VU Makes Gamewinner

The Commodores made their first game-winning basket in almost four years against Chattanooga on December 17, when Luke Kornet made a three with 2.9 seconds remaining to give VU the 76-74 win over the Mocs.

The game-winner was the first since Kevin Bright made a 15-footer from the baseline on February 27, 2013, to defeat Georgia, 63-62, at Memorial Gym.

Neutral Site Does

Vanderbilt has played in four neutral site games already this season - against Minnesota in Sioux Falls, S.D., the season opener vs. Marquette (Veterans Classic, Annapolis, Md.) and the two games at the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational (Butler, Santa Clara).

- ★ Arkansas leads the series 22-11 overall, but the Commodores lead the series in Nashville, 8-6.
- ★ Vanderbilt freshman guard Payton Willis hails from Fayetteville, Arkansas, the Commodores' first player from the state of Arkansas since Ralph Childs (1955-56). Overall, Willis is Vanderbilt's third player from Arkansas.

FAYETTEVILLE (AP) -- Arkansas has been involved in plenty of close games this season.

The Razorbacks just haven't had much experience winning them - until Tuesday night.

Anthlon Bell scored a season-high 26 points, Moses Kingsley added 25 and Arkansas forced 26 turnovers in a 90-85 overtime victory against Vanderbilt.

Arkansas (7-7, 1-1 SEC) won its first game decided by five points or less this season after playing in its third overtime in five games.

"After the disappointing losses, we needed this one to get our confidence back," Kingsley said.

Kingsley did his part by scoring in double figures for the 14th time this season. He and Bell, who hit 6 of 10 from 3-point range, scored consistently for Arkansas, which rebounded after its 23-point loss at Texas A&M in a SEC opener last Saturday.

Arkansas also leaned on its defense to pressure Vanderbilt into its season-high for turnovers. The Commodores had 14 during a first half in which the Razorbacks started slow, but managed to build a 40-32 lead behind Kingsley's 10 points and Bell's nine.

"We actually talked about that at pregame," Bell said. "We knew that a lot of pressure bothers them because they want to come down and run their offense and have people go from A to B."

Bell and Kingsley helped Arkansas quickly stretch its lead to 13 points early in the second half by scoring five quick points. But the Razorbacks went nearly five minutes without a field goal, while the Commodores used a 20-4 run to take a 52-49 lead.

Kingsley and Bell combined to score Arkansas' next 16 points, setting up a back-and-forth finish in regulation.

Vanderbilt guard Wade Baldwin IV made a driving layup with 12.8 seconds left to give the Commodores a 75-74 lead. After an Arkansas timeout, Bell knocked down a 3-pointer to make it 77-75 with two seconds left.

Damian Jones caught a full-court pass over 6-foot Arkansas guard Anton Beard and drove to the basket for a dunk at the buzzer to force overtime.

"We were just hoping to throw the ball down there and get an attack on the basket," Vanderbilt coach Kevin Stallings said. "Damian made a heck of a play I thought."

The 7-foot Jones equaled career highs with 24 points and 15 rebounds for Vanderbilt (8-6, 0-2).

"It shouldn't have happened," Arkansas coach Mike Anderson said. "There shouldn't have been any switching. We had guys matched up by size with each other. (Beard) should not have been over there on the big fella. It was just miscommunication.


"But our guys, they didn't put their head down."

Instead, Arkansas turned to its defense. The Razorbacks forced five turnovers in overtime and converted the Vanderbilt mistakes into eight points. Arkansas outscored Vanderbilt 29-9 off turnovers.

The key stop came in the final seconds as Arkansas guard Jabril Durham had a steal and made two free throws at the other end to give the Razorbacks a five-point lead.

Durham finished with 11 points, six assists and four steals. Matthew Fisher-Davis scored a career-high 20 points for the Commodores, who have lost six of their past nine games after starting the season 5-0.

"We just had too many breakdowns in the end to be able to win the game," Stallings said.



700th SEC Win

Vanderbilt is in its 84th SEC season and is a charter member of the league. All time against current members of the conference, Vanderbilt is 700-689.

983

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 983 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank third only to UNLV and Kentucky for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

NBA Commodores

Vanderbilt was one of only three schools (Kentucky, Washington) with two first-round selections in the 2016 NBA Draft when Wade Baldwin IV was drafted 17th by the Memphis Grizzlies and Damian Jones was selected 30th by the Golden State Warriors. Baldwin IV and Jones became the sixth and seventh first-round picks, respectively, in the history of the program, joining Will Perdue in 1988 (11th, Chicago), Jeff Turner in 1984 (7th, New Jersey), Clyde Lee in 1966 (3rd, San Francisco), and John Jenkins (23rd, Atlanta), and Festus Ezeli (30th, Golden State) in 2012.

First Time This Season

With the win over Chattanooga on December 17, Vanderbilt won its first game this season when: trailing at halftime, trailing with five minutes remaining, tied with two minutes remaining, in a game decided by 3 points or less, when outshot by an opponent, when outrebounded by an opponent, and when an opponent scores 70 points or more.

Fisher-Davis in Top 10 for 3's

Matthew Fisher-Davis now has 203 threes in his Vanderbilt career and is in ninth in career threes made on the Commodores' all-time list.

Commodores make 16 3's vs LSU

Vanderbilt made 16 of 32 threes in route to a 96-89 win over LSU on December 29. So far this season, the Commodores have played four games when making 15 or more threes, and eight with 10 or more threes.

On December 29, the two teams combined to make 33 three pointers, which set a new SEC record for combined threes in a game.

Win on Road vs. Ranked Opponent

The Commodores won their first road game against a ranked opponent since Dec. 29, 2011, in a win at Marquette (74-57) defeating Florida on January 21, 2017, in Gainesville, 68-66,

DORES SIGN THREE

Head Coach Bryce Drew inked his first signing class in November, signing 6'2 guard Maxwell Evans, from Houston, Texas, 6'2 guard Saben Lee, from Tempe, Ariz., and Ejike Obinna, a 6'9 center from Enugu, Nigeria.

Evans is the number 16-ranked prospect in the state of Texas and 247sports.com ranks him as the 11th-ranked combo guard nationally.

Lee is a four-star prospect and the number 92-ranked player by Scout.com and the number 17 point guard by 247sports.com.

Obinna attends the Virginia Academy in Ashburn, Va., is a 4-star prospect by ESPN.com and Rivals.com, and is the 107th-ranked prospect in the class of 2017 by 247sports.com.

RECAP

GAINESVILLE (AP) -- Matthew Fisher-Davis' best game in weeks helped Vanderbilt and first-year coach Bryce Drew notch their biggest victory of the season.

Fisher-Davis scored 19 points, Nolan Cressler came up huge in the final minute and the Commodores upset No. 19 Florida 68-66 on Saturday. Vandy snapped a four-game losing streak and won consecutive games in Gainesville for the first time since 1991.

"It's been a tough stretch," Drew said. "We have lost a lot of close games. Our guys came out with a lot of energy today in a great environment."

The Commodores used a 12-0 run midway through the second half to take a seven-point lead and held on down the stretch in a game that featured six lead changes in the final 5 minutes.

Fisher-Davis had the go-ahead basket, a driving bank shot in the lane that put the Commodores (9-10, 3-4 SEC) up 64-63. They stayed in front from there, thanks to Florida's free throw woes. John Egbunu missed the front end of a 1-and-1, and then Kasey Hill missed another from the charity stripe with 1:04 remaining.

"It's tough," Florida's Devin Robinson said. "A two-game losing streak, it's just tough right now."

Cressler made two free throws and then scored on a baseline drive that made it a four-point game in the final seconds. Still, Florida had a chance after KeVaughn Allen followed Hill's driving layup with a steal. But Allen's fall-away 3 from the wing -- in a two-point game -- rimmed out just before the final buzzer.

Florida coach Mike White blamed himself for not calling time out and setting up a better shot. He was more concerned with his team's lackluster defense. Vanderbilt shot 56.5 percent in the second half and finished the game by making 10 of 25 from 3-point range.

"It's absolutely incredible," said White, who spent all week trying to get his players to defend the 3-point line. "I guess I didn't do a good enough job explaining it."

Fisher-Davis had somewhat struggled since scoring 33 points in a win over Auburn earlier this month. He was considerably better against the Gators (14-5, 5-2), hitting 6 of 14 shots and three 3-pointers.

Cressler finished with 10, and Luke Kornet and Riley LaChance chipped in 11 each.

"Our offense runs best when we have four players in double figures," Drew said. "We thrive on ball movement and making the extra pass. Today was a great sign of when we do execute it, our offense moves smoothly and we can make shots."

HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 65TH SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 65th season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 950 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renowned for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.

**VANDERBILT BASKETBALL
QUICK HITTERS**

- This is the 114th year of Vanderbilt basketball, with the first season taking place in 1900-01. There were no teams in 1904-05 and 1905-06.
- The Commodores have been named to 14 NCAA Tournaments and 12 NIT's. Vanderbilt advanced to the Elite 8 in 1965 (field of 23), and the Sweet 16 in 1988, 1993, 2004, and 2007. The Commodores captured the NIT Championship in 1990 and finished runner-up in 1994.
- The Commodores are a charter member of the SEC, with the 2016-17 season being the 84th year in the conference.
- Vanderbilt is the only private institution in the SEC with the lowest enrollment of any of the 14 schools (6,738).
- Vanderbilt's Perry Wallace became the first African-American scholarship basketball player in the SEC when he took the court in 1967.
- The Commodores have 44 career 1,000-point scorers, with Shan Foster (2004-08) the all-time leading scorer with 2,011 career points.
- Vanderbilt has had 12 All-Americans since 1950. They are: Billy Joe Adcock (1950), Clyde Lee (1965), Tom Hagan (1969), Jan van Breda Kolff (1974), Will Perdue (1988), Billy McCaffrey (1993), Dan Langhi (2000), Matt Freije (2004), Derrick Byars (2007), Shan Foster (2008), and John Jenkins (2011).
- Vanderbilt had two players selected in the 2016 NBA Draft - Wade Baldwin IV, Memphis, 17th pick and Damian Jones, Golden State 30th pick - one of only three schools with two or more players drafted in the first round. In all, 37 Vanderbilt players have been selected in the NBA Draft since 1950.
- The Commodores had three players drafted in the first 31 picks of the 2012 NBA Draft - John Jenkins, Atlanta, 23rd pick, Festus Ezeli, Golden State, 30th pick, Jeffery Taylor, Charlotte, 31st pick - the most by the Commodores in one draft.
- The Commodores ended a 61-year SEC Tournament drought in 2012 by claiming the tournament championship in New Orleans, the team's first SEC tournament championship since 1951.
- Kevin Stallings is the winningest coach in Vanderbilt history with 322 total victories (17 years, 322-220).
- All three of the university's top all-time scorers played for Kevin Stallings (Foster, Jeffery Taylor, Matt Freije). John Jenkins, who is 10th on the list, also played for him.
- Vanderbilt's intercollegiate athletics teams are nicknamed the Commodores, in honor of the nickname given to founder Cornelius Vanderbilt, who made his fortune in shipping. Vanderbilt donated \$1 million to begin "Central University" in 1875 - the campus was later renamed for Cornelius because of his generosity. Cornelius never stepped foot on the campus that bears his namesake.
