- » Arkansas is the fifth youngest team in terms of returning scholarship players under the current head coach
- » Junior Jessica Jackson has scored in double figures in 14 of the 16 games she has played in this season
- » Jackson has scored 20+ points in seven games this year including 25 pts versus #13/15 Tennessee. It was the 17th 20+ point game of her career
- » Jordan Danberry scored 10 points and was in double figures for the fifth time this season against Tennessee
- » Arkansas opens the SEC season facing five ranked teams in the Associated Press Poll - the only team in the Big Five Conferences to do so
- » Arkansas has outscored six opponents in the first half - all wins by the Razorbacks
- » Arkansas trailed Tennessee after the first half and came back to win
- » Arkansas has outscored or been even with nine opponents in the second half
- » Arkansas has had more three pointers in three games and tied one opponent this year
- » Arkansas has been tied with or out-rebounded 11 of 17 opponents
- » Arkansas has had fewer turnovers in 11 of 17 games this year

LAST TIME OUT ...

- The win over Tennessee is just the third all-time against the Lady Vols
- The win is the second-ever in Fayetteville - the first time was in 1996
- The most recent win over UT (prior to tonight) was in 2012 in Knoxville in overtime
- The win is the second for the Razorbacks against a ranked opponent this year
- The victory is the fifth win over a ranked team in the year-plus under head coach Jimmy Dykes
- Arkansas has outscored six opponents in the first half - all wins by the Razorbacks
- The Razorbacks trailed Tennessee at the break. It is the first win for Arkansas this year when trailing at the half
- Arkansas has been tied with or out-rebounded 11 of 17 opponents
- Arkansas has had fewer turnovers in 11 of 17 games this year
- Arkansas forced 24 UT turnovers while having just 17 of their own
- The combination of Jessica Jackson, Kelsey Brooks, Devin Cosper, Melissa Wolff and Alecia Cooley have played a team-high 56:00 minutes together
- This combination has scored 113 points - the most of any combo for Arkansas
- Jackson, Devin Cosper, Wolff, Cooley and Jordan Danberry are a close second with 47:42 minutes played together
- Jackson has scored in double figures in 14 of her 16 games
- She has seven 20+ point games
- She has 11 with 15+ points
- She has three double-digit rebounding games
- Three double-doubles
- Sophomore Devin Cosper has scored in double figures in eight games
- Her 11 points against Tennessee is the fourth time she has amassed that number
- Freshman Jordan Danberry recorded her fifth double figure scoring game
- It is her second consecutive game with double digits

OUR OPPONENT

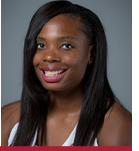
- Mizzou's win over No. 6 Mississippi State was the highest ranked opponent defeated by Mizzou since the Tigers beat No. 4 Baylor, 64-61, on Jan. 4, 2006 at Mizzou Arena.
- Thursday's win was Mizzou's first ever against Mississippi State. The Bulldogs now lead the all-time series 4-1.
- The Tigers improve to 9-1 at home this season, 11-0 when allowing 60 or less points and 14-0 when outrebounding its opponent.
- Mizzou shot 51.7 percent (15-of-29) from the field in the first half, marking the 14th time this season the Tigers have shot better than 50 percent from the field in a half.
- Freshman guard Sophie Cunningham scored 22 points on 8-of-14 shooting, the most points she has scored since finishing with 21 against Texas State on Dec. 21. It was Cunningham's sixth 20-plus point output in her first 17 career games.
- Cunningham's 22 points are the most points she has scored in an SEC game.
- The Tigers connected on 11 shots from beyond the 3-point arc, the fifth time this season Mizzou has made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Junior forward Jordan Frericks had 10 points and 10 rebounds, her fourth double-double this season and the fifth time she has posted double-digit rebounds this season. For her career, Frericks now has 21 career double-doubles.

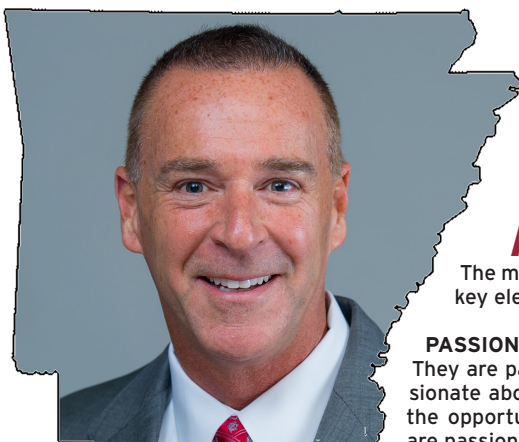

FASTEST TO 1,000

Jessica Jackson surpassed the 1,000 career point mark at South Dakota Nov. 18. She entered the year with 962 career points in her first two seasons and scored her 1,000th point in the first period at SDSU, ranking 27th at that time. Arkansas' all-time leading scorer Bettye Fiscus (2,073) is the only player to outscore Jackson in her first two seasons. Fiscus finished her sophomore season with 1,131 career points. WNBA All-Star Shameka Christon is Arkansas' second all-time scorer with 1,951 career points. She scored 844 points after two seasons. **Jackson currently has 1,242 career points ranking 16th.**



ALSO MOVING UP

- » Kelsey Brooks began the season ranked 49th all-time in scoring. Brooks tallied 633 career points in 62 games prior to the start of the 2015-16 season. She has 86 points this year, 719 career points and ranks 41st overall.
- » Melissa Wolff ranks 49th in career scoring with 636 career points.

ACTION JACKSON

Jessica Jackson was the second fastest player in program history to reach 1,000 career points. She is on pace to become the 19th player in program history to score at least 1,000 career points and grab at least 500 career rebounds. Jackson enters the Missouri game with 1,242 points and 492 rebounds - just eight shy of the mark.

Jackson is also on pace to become just the seventh player to score at least 1,000 career points, grab at least 500 rebounds and have at least 100 career blocks. Jackson currently has 98 rejections and needs just two more to move into this elite group.

FANTASTIC FOUR

Arkansas returns just four players from a year ago. That is the fewest returning players among SEC teams this season. Despite that low number, the Razorbacks return 63.59 percent of its scoring from a year ago with 1,221 of the team's 1,920 points coming from Jessica Jackson, Kelsey Brooks, Melissa Wolff and Khadijah West. Three of Arkansas' four leading scorers from last season (Jackson, Brooks and West) return.

TOUGH START TO SEC SCHEDULE

Arkansas faces one of the toughest starts to the SEC schedule for the second consecutive season. Last year, the Razorbacks opened SEC play with three of its first four opponents ranked in the AP Top 15. They were one of just two programs in the Power 5 Conferences to do that.

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2/2 South Carolina, vs. No. 13/10 Texas A&M, at No. 7/6 Mississippi State and vs. No. 13/15 Tennessee (AP/Coaches). The Razorbacks also faced No. 5 Texas, No. 7 Oregon State and have No. 10/9 Kentucky, No. 20/RV Missouri, and have Georgia, Auburn and Florida who are all receiving votes.

MORE ABOUT THE SCHEDULE

Arkansas opens SEC play facing five consecutive opponents who started conference play ranked in the AP Top-25 (Dec. 28). The Razorbacks are the only team in the SEC to open with five teams who were ranked as of Dec. 28, and they face six ranked teams in the month of January. Arkansas also faced two other league teams who are getting votes in the poll. Several other SEC teams play at least five ranked teams in January but Arkansas is the only one to start that way.

In addition to being the only team in the SEC to start with that schedule, Arkansas is the only team in the power five conferences to begin with such a tough league start. Several members of the ACC have three or four ranked conference opponents on their January schedules but none start like the Razorbacks. No one in the Big 12 faces more than two ranked conference opponents in January. No one in the Big Ten has more than three. The Pac-12 has several teams who face five ranked conference opponents in the month of January but, again, no one who starts with five consecutive ranked conference teams.
