GAME NIGHT STORY LINES

• The Ragin' Cajuns and Razorbacks meet for the first time since December 16, 2004. (Cajuns fell, 82-68 in Fayetteville). Arkansas leads the all-time series, 3-1.

• Fourth-year head coach Garry Brodhead is nine wins away from becoming the second-winningest coach in the history of the Louisiana program. He currently trails Ross Cook (57 wins) and J. Kelley Hall (86) on the Cajuns' all-time coaching ledger.

• Senior guard **Keke Veal** moved into seventh place on the Cajuns' all-time scoring list (1,097) in the Cajuns' 52-51 loss at Houston last Sunday. The 12 points for Veal in that game bumped her ahead of Aronji Johnson (9th - 1,086) and Yolanda Jones (8th - 1,090).

• Cajuns senior guard **Kia Wilridge** averaged a team-high 15.0 points per game last week (team-best 54.2% shooting) with a season-high of 19 points at Houston last Sunday. She added four assists and a steal in 57 minutes in the two games.

• Entering this week, Wilridge needs two assists to pass Charlotte Green (238) for sole possession of eight-place on Louisiana's all-time list. She owns 196 career steals and sits six shy from passing Green (201) for sole possession of third-place in Cajuns history.

• Three of the Top 7 scorers in the Sun Belt Conference are Ragin' Cajuns. Junior **Jaylyn Gordon** (16.0 ppg), is fifth, senior **Keke Veal** (14.3 ppg) ranks sixth and senior **Kia Wilridge** (14.0 ppg) sits in seventh among Sun Belt Conference players.

• The Cajuns offense is outscoring opponents by an average of 18.6 points per game this season.

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GAME NOTES

SETTING THE SCENE: The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns (2-1) women's basketball team enters the week looking to rebound from a final minute 52-51 loss at Houston last Sunday.

The Cajuns defense has been strong through the first three games of the 2015-16 season, holding opponents to just 52.7 points per game, third-lowest in the Sun Belt Conference.

Louisiana travels to Guaynabo, Puerto Rico this week for the San Juan Shootout. They are scheduled to play the University of Arkansas this Friday, Nov. 27 at 1:30 p.m. CST and will end the weekend with a 1:15 p.m. CST tip-off against Sacred Heart on Saturday, Nov. 28.

The Razorbacks come into Friday's matchup with a record of 2-2, having lost their last two games. Junior forward Jessica Jackson has posted a double-double average of 21.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game (both team highs). Junior guard Kelsey Brooks is averaging 9.8 points per contest and has dealt out a team-best 15 assists.

Sacred Heart begins the San Juan Shootout winless at 0-3 this season, with two of those losses coming at home. Their offense features a trio of scorers averaging double-digit points this season in Hannah Kimmel (17.3), Adaysha Williams (15.3) and Alissa Tarsi (11.0). Kimmel is also pulling down a team-high 9.0 boards per game. The Cajuns are 0-1 against Sacred Heart in the all-time series, losing 75-60 back on November 29, 2003.

PRESEASON HONORS: Seniors **Keke Veal** (First Team) and **Kia Wilridge** (Second Team) were selected to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team. Last season, Veal earned All-SBC Preseason honors for the third straight season. The honor marked Veal's debut on the All-Sun Belt Conference Preseason First Team. Last season, she paced the Cajuns offense with an average of 14.9 points per game. The Opelousas, La. native has led the Cajuns in scoring in two of her three seasons. She was also named the 2015 Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) MVP after averaging a team-high 21.0 points and 5.8 rebounds per contest, helping lead Louisiana to the WBI Championship.

For Wilridge, it is the second consecutive Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team honor of the Crowley, La. native's career. She is coming off a season in which she tallied 12.3 points per contest. She was also tied for the second-most blocked shots on the defense with seven. Wilridge was the first Cajun to record 100-plus steals in a season since 1989-90 (Kim Perrot).

COACH BRODHEAD AT THE HELM: Louisiana head coach Garry Brodhead is in his fourth season at the helm of the Ragin' Cajuns women's basketball program, finishing with 23 wins last season, the most in a single season since 2006-07 (25). Brodhead guided the team to 15 victories at home in 2014-15, a program record. He is currently the third-winningest head coach in Cajuns history (49). He needs nine wins to pass Ross Cook (57) for second on the program's all-time list.

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE: Through three games this season, the Cajuns are plus-8.3 in turnover margin, good for second in the Sun Belt Conference. They have committed 42 turnovers, but have taken the ball away from opponents 67 times, an average of 22.3 turnovers created per game, also second in the conference.

WELCOME BACK: Returning from redshirt seasons are senior **Brooklyn Arceneaux** and junior **Sylvana Okde**. In 2013-14, Okde averaged 10.9 points and drained a team-high 74 three-pointers. That season, Arceneaux finished as the team's second-leading scorer (among players in at least 25 games played) averaging 10.5 points and adding 5.2 rebounds per contest. Arceneaux has averaged 4.0 points and 4.3 rebounds in three games as a starter this season. She also leads the team with five steals. Okde has yet to appear in a game this season.

GORDON FOR THREE: Junior guard **Jaylyn Gordon** is currently tied for third in the Sun Belt Conference with six three-pointers, an average of 2.0 per game. She sits in seventh-place all-time in Cajuns history with 116 three-point field goals made, and needs 28 to pass Onna Charles (143) for sole possession of sixth in program history. She has also fired off 419 career three-point attempts, trailing current teammate **Sylvana Okde** (435) by 17 for sixth on Louisiana's all-time list.

VEAL SEEING DOUBLE: Senior guard Keke Veal has scored in double-figures in 17-straight games dating back to last season.

WHAT'S NEXT? The Cajuns will play a conference game at ULM next Thursday, December 3 for a 5 p.m. tip-off.

Houston, Texas – The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns women's basketball team's bid for the program's first 3-0 start in back-to-back seasons was crushed, falling in the final two minutes, 52-51 to the University of Houston at Hofheinz Pavilion Sunday afternoon.

Cajuns (2-1) senior guard Kia Wilridge dropped a season-high 19 points on the Cougars to go with two assists and a steal. Fellow senior guard Keke Veal added 12 points, moving into seventh place in program history in scoring (1,097 points). Reigning Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week Jaylyn Gordon chipped in 10 and missed the potential game-winning three-pointer as time expired.

Wilridge and sophomore forward Simone Fields teamed up for nine points in the opening quarter, helping the Cajuns build a 15-7 lead just 6:58 minutes into the contest.

Houston cut into the Cajuns lead sparked by a pair of treys from Serithia Hawkins, but Veal and Wilridge knocked down back-to-back jumpers, extending the UL lead to 23-15 with 5:10 left in the second quarter.

The Cougars scored 15 of the game's next 19 points to take a 30-27 lead into halftime. Houston manufactured eight points off Cajuns turnovers and took advantage of seven second-chance points in the second stanza.

Trailing 32-28 in the early stages of the third quarter, Gordon splashed a three-pointer while Wilridge dropped in a layup giving the lead back to Louisiana, 33-32 at the 7:05 mark.

After the two foes traded baskets, Veal connected from beyond the arc and Wilridge chipped in four points to make it a 42-34 game in favor of Louisiana.

Houston kept the contest close, ending the third quarter on a 6-1 run to trim the Cajuns' lead to 43-40.

After the Cougars evened the game at 43-43 just eight seconds into the fourth quarter, Wilridge answered with a layup to put the Cajuns back in front by two points. Back-to-back layups by Houston gave the Cougars a 47-45 lead with 7:49 to play.

Veal split a pair of free throws after drawing a foul, which was followed by a layup from Wilridge, giving the Cajuns a 48-47 edge.

The two foes went nearly 3 ½ minutes without scoring a point until 3:31 left in the game when Kierra Graves knocked down a pair of free throws which put Louisiana in a 49-48 hole.

Gordon drew a foul, sending her to the charity stripe, but split the pair, tying the game at 49-49 with 3:15 left.

A turnover by Houston on the ensuing possession turned into a fast-break opportunity for the Cajuns, who took a 51-49 lead on a layup by Veal with 2:07 remaining in the contest.

Houston came back on the next possession to hit what proved to be the game-winning three-pointer by Marche' Amerson with 1:53 on the clock.

With 1.5 seconds left and the Houston Cougars at the free throw line, Alecia Smith missed a pair of shots, which set up a final play for Louisiana. Veal inbounded the ball and found Gordon near the top left corner, but the shot missed, snapping the Cajuns two-game win streak.

The Cajuns shot 50% (10-of-20) from the free-throw line and were held to just 39.6% shooting (19-of-48) from the field.

Entering his fourth season at the helm of the Ragin' Cajuns women's basketball team, Garry Brodhead has already seen growth in the program that he took over in the summer of 2012. Brodhead owns a career record of 47-49 entering the 2015-16 season.

Last season, Brodhead guided the Cajuns to their best season since 2011-12, winning 23 games and claiming the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) Tournament Championship. At season's end the Cajuns had three players named to the All-Louisiana Women's Basketball Team (Keke Veal, Kia Wilridge, Jaylyn Gordon). Veal and Wilridge also garnered All-Sun Belt Conference Third Team honors.

During the 2013-14 season, Brodhead helped the Ragin' Cajuns to a 14-16 record, their best record since the 2006-07 season, with 11 underclassmen on the 12-member roster.

Sophomore Sylvana Okde proved to be one of the offensive leaders for Louisiana for the second-straight season, leading the squad with 10.9 ppg. Brooklyn Arceneaux also had a successful sophomore campaign for Louisiana, averaging 10.5 ppg and 5.2 rpg, to be named to the All-Sun Belt Third Team. Louisiana won four of its final six games of the 2014 regular season to earn the No. 7 seed in the Sun Belt Conference

Tournament. The Ragin' Cajuns ended up falling to No. 2 seed Western Kentucky, the eventual tournament champion, in the quarterfinals by a score of 67-61.

Brodhead brought a new style of play to the Cajuns, one that consisted of speed, shooting and pressing, immediately making an impact. The squad was led offensively in 2012-13 by a pair of freshmen, local talent Keke Veal (St. Thomas More), and Houston native Sylvana Okde (Westbury Christian). The duo averaged 13.1 and 10.2 points per game, respectively, and combined for over 300 points from behind the arc.

Brodhead was named the 12th head coach in school history on April 2, 2012 and went on to lead the Cajuns to a 10-21 record in his first season.

He spent the previous five seasons as an associate head coach at McNeese State, where he helped guide the Cowgirls to a 52-15 record from 2010-2012, and back-to-back Southland Conference champions and NCAA Championship appearances.

Locally, Brodhead is best known for his accomplishments during a 10-year stint as head girls' basketball coach at Lafayette's Teurlings Catholic High School. In his time he won one state title, and compiled a 297-78 record with the Lady Rebels.

Along with the state championship, he led the squad to nine district titles, and advanced to the semifinals of the state tournament six times, finishing as runner-up once and winning the 2002 State Championship. His 2000-01 squad was ranked in the USA Today Top 25, and three times he saw his team ranked No. 1 in the state.

Personally, Brodhead was named district coach of the year in nine of his 10 seasons. He was also named parish coach of the year three times and Acadiana coach of the year twice.

The Lafayette native graduated from Louisiana in 1980 with a degree in Business Administration. He was also a student-athlete, competing as a pole vaulter on the Ragin' Cajuns 1976-80 track and field teams.

He returned to Louisiana in 1994 to spend a season as a graduate assistant coach with the women's basketball team.

Along with college and high school coaching on his resume, Brodhead has spent time as an AAU coach, leading the Acadiana Stars to the national championship tournament multiple times, finishing eighth in 1997 and fifth in 2006.

Brodhead and his wife, Andrea, have three children (Blair, Ashley and Beau) and three grandchildren (Cellie and Emmie Richard and Brannon Boyd).

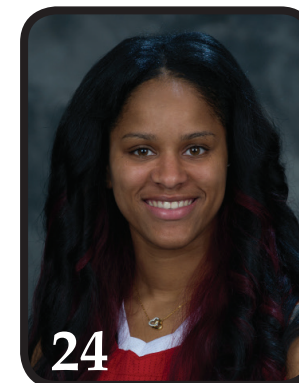
