ALABAMA LOCKER ROOM

GENE STALLINGS: "We were able to overcome some big penalties. I thought our special teams improved this week. We were on the plus side of givaway-takaway but we lose a couple of players. They'll both need knee surgery. Kitchens has been doing a pretty good job. He's making some key throws when he has to. We are pleased with his progress. We won the game, period. There were tough conditions we created for ourselves. Stats don't amount to a hill of beans if you don't win. Riddle did a good job. Rêmember he ran for 900 yards last year. Curtis is just playing a little better. That's why this is one of the biggest games in his career. This puts us 4-0 and was Alabama's 1,000th game. We're undefeated in conference, not 1-1. We don't have to depend upon someone else beating somebody. Arkansas has a pretty good team. They run the option extremely well and their defense played good. They're tough on both sides. They have a lot of young players and I can't see them doing anything but getting better. They have a good plan. Their quarterback last year had a lot of experience. This quarterback looks like a fine player and will get better. A win is a win is a win. There are no bad wins and no good losses."

MIKE VAUGHN: "(On last TD pass) It's a play we run on the goalline. I went in motion and the cornerback bit on the fake. I went behind him and Freddie made a good throw. I guess I made a good catch. In the huddle on the drive, Freddie said we had to punch it in. I felt great about the first touchdown of the season. Credit the offensive line and the defense played well. They went man on the goalline and that gave me time to get behind them. HE was offbalance or something, I guess. I jumped over him to get it. We didn't want any deju vu. We were not going to let them come back and win."

FREDDIE KITCHENS: "I'm proud of this team, the way we hung in there. Arkansas has some good talent over there. (On his size) Sometimes my size can be an advantage. I feel fine about my size. In our offense, our quarterbacks are not supposed to run the ball a lot. It just happens sometimes. I never saw the last touchdown throw. I just heard the crowd.orlididn't really know where to put the ball because the defender played it perfectly. I just threw it up to gim him (VAughn) a chance. Our offense showed we can get it done when we need to, just like the defense. They stopped them when they had to. This is a big win on the road. They beat us last year but we weren't worried about revenge."

COACH DANNY FORD: "Our football team stepped it up and met the challenge. We had an opportunity to win. We could have helped ourselves if we had not let them in at the end of the first half. Our defense played hard and well most of the time. Our defensive coaches had a good plan and for the most part we executed it well.

"Our offense hung in there against an outstanding defense. Alabama is very good. Their linebackers are as good as we will play against although there are a couple more teams that have linebackers that good. We broke the draw play on them. I wish Chukwuma would have run for the corner. He has great speed and could have outrun them. He made the wrong cut. Then they made a great play to strip it

"When it was 10-7, if we could have held them we would have felt good about our chances. But, we asked our defense to hold them all day. We had two people there when they floated a duck on that 50-yard pass but we didn't make the plays The touchdown was a great athletic play. We had it played well but Michael Vaughn

made a great play.
"I'm proud of our team for laying it on the line. I'm not into moral victories. We aren't doing enough yet to win football games like this. But, no team I've coached at Arkansas ever played any harder. We can play better, though. We have some heartbroken kids in this locker room. They tried to win for the University of Arkansas and the people of Arkansas. I hurt for them.

"We have to demand this kind of effort every week. I saw what kind of effort we can give. I know what they can do. It's up to the coaches to get that type of effort our of our players every week. There won't be any excuses against Northeast

Louisiana. We need this kind of effort next week against them.

"The crowd was tremendous. Except for a few who don't understand field position football, they were great. We couldn't have asked for better. In the fourth quarter when Alabama was backed up, the crowd made it tough on them. They had to use a timeout. That's what we see when we go on the road in the SEC. Our young people are worth having a crowd like that. We need to get the crowd and the team together. That's how we will build a program. We appreciate their support and need them there next week."

ANTHONY EUBANKS: "Our offense did a good job. We improved a lot from two weeks ago. Once again, turnovers decided the game. Small mistakes here and there with the ball are what caused us the loss. This game, even though we lost, is going to help our football team build confidence. To come out the way we did and play an Alabama team ranked 13th is something to learn from. We had trouble throwing the ball most of the afternoon but on the touchdown Pete made a great read and put the ball where any receiver could have caught it. I just told myself to keep my legs moving and try to get into the end zone."

MELVIN BRADLEY: "Everybody doubted if I would be able to play well with Geno Bell out of the game. I wanted to establish that I can play with any SEC nose guard. I really wanted to prove myself in front of our home crowd and the other SEC teams. The key was to keep hustling. Even if the ball didn't come my way, I kept running knowing I could get there. As a team we came together on the defensive side. We told ourselves that we were going to use all our heart to try to stop the 13th ranked team in the country. We tried our hearts out."

PETE BURKS: "We worked so hard today but still came up short. People doubted we could play with Alabama. We proved them wrong because we had a chance to win. Even though it's a loss, I feel better after this game than after SMu. This team is talented and after time we will come together and play well. Alabama has a good defense but I still think we could have moved the ball down the field. I'm disappointed with the loss but happy with our effort."
