### Florida Dressing Room

Head Coach Steve Spurrier: "Wuerffel said that this was fun at the start of the third quarter. This is the first time in a while it has been this close at halftime. I was really proud of our team really coming out and playing hard in the second half. The passing was excellent in the second half when we had to make something happen. I was really proud of our entire team because this was a game that we really needed a victory. Arkansas is tough. They were tough to run on, so we had to throw against them. They challenged us on every down. This is not the first time we have struggled in a balf, but that happens. Arkansas is playing well offensively."

"These Arkansas people get mad when you keep throwing the ball. It must be against the rules here in Arkansas."

QUARTERBACK DANNY WUERFFEL: "They (Arkansas defense) did a good job. Number 96 Hale) bull-rushed hard. Their defense kept their ears pinned back. I'm very thankful things worked out. Arkansas really came ready to play. We got a good win against a team that was really ready to play us. The Razorback offense and defense gave it all they had today. I wasn't trying to make a stat today. I was just trying to play the game. It was the coaches' decision late in the fourth quarter (for him to play) and I just try to do the best I can. "

OT ZACH PILLER: "I think we had a real struggle in the first half. There was no excuse for how we played. We had some penalties that really killed us. But we bounced back in the second half. I had a pretty good attitude at the beginning of the game but I didn't come out and play quite as well as I should have. Danny really took a beating in this game."

LB JAMES BATES: "Arkansas had a good offense and they fought hard today. We had a few plays we just took off on. We knew our offense would get it rolling again and they did. We've got to do our job no matter what. We had to go out and execute and we've just got to keep getting better if we're going to do a good job against LSU and Auburn."

COACH DANNY FORD: "We played hard for a half. We felt good about our chances coming out in the third quarter. We missed a field goal in the first half that would have had us in better shape. We couldn't have started the third quarter better. We stopped them, then created a turnover. But, we lost sight of where we want to be. We blocked in the back for a penalty, then we missed a field goal. After that they threw to open people and made things happen. We didn't make anything happen in the second half.

"We put our defense in a bad position in the second half. We suffered a turnover late in the third quarter when it was still a ball game. Our defense

had just held them but couldn't hold them any longer.

"We got more our of our young people than the score indicated. We made some terrible mistakes. We left the tight end open, got beat on the post pattern and allowed them to throw deep. They went after the ball harder that we did.

"Danny Wuerffel is a well coached quarterback and he has great receivers. They make it difficult on you if your defense is on the field as much as ours was in the

second half.

"We really had our shot at them. We caught them at a good time, right before they played LSU. We aren't a very smart football team. We either don't understand what is being taught or we aren't being taught well enough. Florida has a little better athletes than we do right now. You can't make the kind of mistakes we did and expect to beat them."

TAILBACK OSCAR MALONE: "We came out and played well in the first half. Things seemed to change, though, in the second half. We didn't come out with the same excitement and enthusiasm as we did early in the game. The key for Florida was their big plays. They have a Heisman Trophy candidate, so they want to show him off to the country. I can tell why they are ranked number one in the country. If we could have avoided a few mistakes, we could have been in this game longer."

NOSE GUARD MELVIN BRADLEY; "We have a very young team and this is something we can learn from. We came out and gave all we had. Early in the game we tried to get the crowd into it. They were screaming and we were playing with all our hearts. I'm not pleased with the outcome of the game. There were many mistakes that got us behind. It's the little things that beat us, missed blocks, penalties and all around slow play. After the first half, Florida came out and buckled down and showed us why they are ranked number one in the country. Our goal coming into this game was not to play soft. Most teams try to finesse Florida on defense. We decided early in the week we would come after them with everything we had. Maybe next time we will get them."

QUARTERBACK PETE BURKS: "We are a young football team and we could not afford to make mistakes and still hope to win. There are a lot of positives that can come out of this game. We don't have to let our heads hang down. The whole game turned around in the second half. Florida stepped it up a notch and we couldn't seem to follow them. Our defense did a great job all afternoon of giving us opportunities to score. We just couldn't seem to put the ball into the end zone. I'm disappointed we couldn't capitalize on what our defense did. In the first half we came out and mixed things up, running here and passing there. We could do that because our defense and special teams were giving us good field position. In the second half we didn't have as good a field position and it seemed like we got more conservative. I guess it is because when you play the number one team, you can't push too much. I just really wish we would not have been as conservative in the second half."

- \* Junior Anthony Eubanks pulled in six catches for 111 yards against the Gators. It was Eubanks' third 100-yard receiving game as a Razorback. Last week, Eubanks had 8 catches for 130 yards against Northeast Louisiana. Combining last week's performance and today's effort, Eubanks has 14 catches for 241 yards in the last two games.
- \* With his 111 yards receiving today, Eubanks moved into 9th on the Arkansas career receiving list. Eubanks has 1,131 yards in his career as a Razorback after passing Bobby Duckworth (1,042), J.J. Meadors (1,067), and Gary Anderson (1,075) in today's contest.
- \* Coming into today's game, Florida had outscored its opponents 91-6 in the 2nd quarter. Arkansas outscored the Gators 7-0 in the second period of today's game.
- \* The 52,318 fans that attended today's game marked the 5th largest crowd in Razorback Stadium history. It was the second largest crowd in Fayetteville for an SEC game. Last season, 52,728 fans watched Tennessee defeat the Razorbacks.
- \* Florida quarterback Danny Wuerffel's 462 yards passing set a record for most passing yards by a Razorback opposing quarterback. Wuerffel broke the mark of 457 yards earned by Houston's David Klinger in 1990. Florida's total of 462 yards also broke the team opponent record passing Houston who tallied 457 yards through the air.
- \* Razorback tailback Chrys Chukwuma earned a season high 83 yards on 21 carries. The yardage also set a career high for the freshman.

# UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA POST-GAME NOTES OCTOBER 5, 1996

- \* Florida has now won 16 consecutive SEC games, is 28-2 in its last 30 league contests and 47-6 in conference play under Steve Spurrier since 1990. Spurrier's league record (47-6, .887) is by far the best in SEC history.
- \* UF has compiled a 13-4 record versus Western Division opponents since the league began divisional play in 1992, including six straight wins. Of note, the Gators are 21-1 vs. SEC Eastern Division teams since 1992, including a current streak of 20 straight wins.
- \* The Gators have won 16 of their last 17 SEC games away from Florida Field, including a current streak of 15 straight. UF is also now 11-0-1 in its last 12 true away games (played at opponent campus stadium).
- \* Florida's passing yardage today sets a UF single-game mark versus a SEC foe.
- \* Florida has now opened the year 5-0 for the fourth season in a row.
- \* The Gators have outscored their opponents 160-20 in the first half this season and have yet to trail in any game. In addition, Florida scored on its opening drive today, on a 56-yard TD pass to from Danny Wuerffel to Reidel Anthony, marking the fifth straight game this season that the Gators have scored on their opening possession.
- \* Danny Wuerffel threw for 462 yards today, Setting a UF single-game mark. He now holds three of the top five single-game passing totals in school history.
- \* Wuerffel threw for four TD passes today, giving him 89 for his career and moving him into third place on the all-time NCAA Division I-A list, passing Troy Kopp of Pacific, who had 87. Wuerffel now trails just Ty Detmer (121) and David Klingler (91).
- \* Florida's offense gained 242 yards in total offense in the third period, while the UF defense held Arkansas to 46 yards in total offense.
- \* Reidel Anthony set career highs for receptions (9), yards (189) and TD catches (3) today. His 189 yards receiving is the fourth-best total in a game in UF history and second-best versus a SEC opponent. Chris Doering had 199 yards receiving vs. Mississippi State in 1993 was the most by a UF receiver in a SEC game.
- \* Wuerffel moved into sole possession of second place on UF's all-time 200-yard passing games chart with his 24th today, breaking the tie with John Reaves, who had 23 from 1969-71. He also earned his 10th career 300-yard passing game today, second-best in Gator history. Shane Matthews ranks first in school history with 15 career 300-yard passing games.
- \* Wuerffel also surpassed the 400-yard mark in a game for the third time in his career, setting a UF individual record. It marked only the sixth time a Gator quarterback has topped the 400-yard mark in a game. His previous 400-yard performances came against Mississippi State in 1993 (449) and Florida State in 1995 (443).
- \* Matt Teague had seven kickoffs today, with all seven going into the end zone and four being downed for touchbacks.
- \* Florida has now thrown for at least one TD pass in 71 of the last 72 games, including 54 straight.
- \* Under Steve Spurrier since 1990, the Gators are 46-4 when they score first.

- \* The Gator defense has now forced 16 turnovers over the first five games, leading to 73 points (42 directly and 31 indirectly). UF had forced 11 turnovers after five games last season.
- \* Steve Spurrier is now 3-2 in head-to-head meetings with Danny Ford, including wins in each of the last three meetings (today, the 1995 SEC Championship Game victory and a 21-17 victory in 1989 for Spurrier's Duke team over Ford's Clemson squad).
- $\star$  Florida now leads the all-time series with Arkansas, 2-1, after today's first-ever regularly-scheduled meeting between the schools.
