COACH DANNY FORD: "Our football team was not ready to play in the first half. We were very nonchalant. We took their licks and just stood around. It looked

like a junior high team against a high school team.

"In the second half we battled, fought and scraped like Razorbacks. Like it's benn all year, though, we had trouble moving the football. And, we had a big penalty that killed our momentum. We had just scored and recovered an onside kick then we got a holding penalty. Still, I was most proud of the way we fought in the second half. Clint Stoerner gave us a lift. We had no running game at all.

"I will talk about this in our post season press conference but here are some of our priorities for next year. Number one is replacing 11 seniors. That isn't a large number but they gave us great effort. We appreciate every one of them. Being a Razorback means something to players like Mark Smith, who had tears in his eyes in the dressing room. We need more players like Mark Smith, who want to be here and want to play hard. To go forward and compete in this conference we need a commitment by this football team. We will be older next year. We need to get bigger and stronger in the weight room.

"We think we are on to a good recruiting year. We feel positive about it right now. We have only 11 seniors to replace but our players need to determine whether or not they are willing to pay the price to win in the SEC. Those that aren't willing

need to let us know now so we can sign more players this February.

"We need to get a junior college quarterback to challenge the ones we have here now. We need a junior college linebacker to help replace the three seniors we lose there. We need a junior college cornerback who can make plays and help us defend the pass better. We need a junior college offensive tackle to help replace the three we lose. So, we could go after as many as four junior college players. We need the junior college players to help us win, not just compete, next year.

"I also need to sit down with Coach Broyles to make sure we're on the same track. I know how to win football games. I let it slide a little bit this year after having the success we had last year. I know we need to mix the run and the pass but we have to be effective running the ball so we can be effective throwing it. Our defense has to learn to get off the field on third down. We got hurt again today by LSU making third down plays. That's a major area of improvement we need next season.

'We had great fan support today. I don't know if ducks could have flown today

it was so bad. We are very appreciative of every fan who was here."

CLINT STOERNER: "It felt good to get on the field and contribute. When I went in, Coach was letting me drop back and try to hit the open receiver. On one play we had a third and 34 and hit Snowden. It gave the team some confidence. I felt a lot more comfortable on the field today than I have in the past. It is a huge confidence builder for myself and the team to make big plays when it counts. All I am thinking about, though, is the loss. With the season being over, I want to sit down, clean some things up and look toward the spring. I knew I wouldn't start this year but my goal since coming to Arkansas has been to start as a sophomore. I love to compete and I know we have three great quarterbacks who want the job next year. I'm just going to try my best."

OSCAR MALONE: "I was really nervous because it was my last game. We let LSU get two quick scores and could never seem to get back in the game. Give our team credit, though, because we came back in the second half and played hard. This loss is tough to take. In my four years at Arkansas, I've never regretted anything and have been happy to be a Razorback.'

VINCENT BRADFORD: "This is a tough way to go out but give LSU credit for playing hard. They were the better team this afternoon. After spotting them 14 points, our defense reevaluated what it was doing and made good stops. It's just tough to lose."

LSU DRESSING ROOM

COACH GERRY DiNARDO: "Obviously it was a great win. We played hard. This is very exciting as it should be. This is a great and well deserved win. I feel we had a terrific first half. In the second half the defense didn't play as well as it should and the offense didn't score. On the onside kick, we thought they touched it before it went 10 yards but the official said no. We were looking for it since the penalty allowed them to kick from the 50.

"I thought that in the nine games we won this year, we were fairly evenly matched with each team. Our run defense was much better this game except for the fact we didn't contain well. Much like last year, this is going to give us momentum

going into the post season."

KEVIN FAULK: "Our main goal coming into the season was to get nine wins. We did that. It was really important for our offense to score in the first quarter. We kind of had a letdown in the second quarter but we did enough to win the game. I think I ran the ball well. The offensive line blocked really well, too. The cold and wetness was not a factor at all."

ANTHONY McFARLAND: "When I first got here all they talked about was bringing a championship to LSU. Now we have a piece of that championship. Now it's time for us to go bowling. Our defense played hard. We worked hard all week to try to stop the run. Our defense stepped up today and did a good job of doing that. Our goal was to get to a big and better bowl. We couldn't have done that without a win today."

DAVID LaFLEUR: "I was happy with the way we came out in the first quarter. We kind of took it to them. We self destructed in the second quarter but we were able to bounce back. It feels like we are on top of the world."
