Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including four as a head coach at Nevada and 14 as a professional head coach.

In his four years as Nevada head coach, Musselman won at least 24 games each season (24, 28, 29 and 29) to post a 110-34 record and .764 winning percentage - sixth-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with an overall winning percentage of .624 (566-340).

Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons Michael (22) and Matthew (17) and the couple has a daughter Mariah (8).

Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

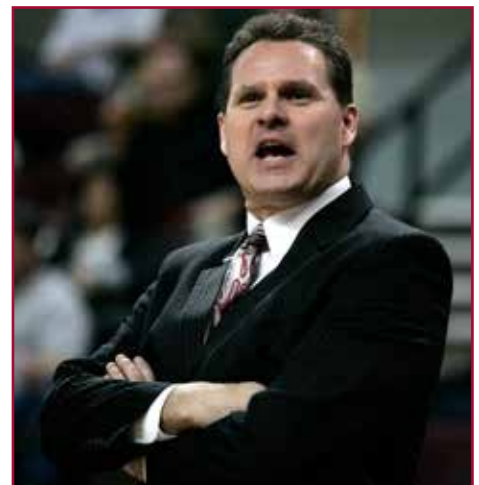

Season 97 for Razorbacks

- Arkansas opens its 97th season of basketball in 2019-20 and the first under head coach Eric Musselman.
- Overall Record 1,688-955 (.639)
 - All-Time SEC Record 243-219 (.526)
 - Bud Walton Arena All-Time Record 359-85 (.809)
 - Bud Walton Arena All-Time SEC Record 153-62 (.717)
- Two teams – Texas A&M and Rice – were on Arkansas’ schedule in the program’s first year of basketball (1923-24).

Musselman Era Begins

- Eric Musselman was named Arkansas’ 13th head men’s basketball coach on April 7, 2019 and introduced to the fans on April 8. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including four as a head coach at Nevada and 14 as a professional head coach.
- In his four years as Nevada head coach, Musselman won at least 24 games each season (24, 28, 29 and 29) to post a 110-34 record and .764 winning percentage – seventh-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with an overall winning percentage of .624 (566-340).
- Nevada was 29-5 in 2019-18, won its third straight Mountain West regular-season title, earned a NCAA Tournament berth for the third straight year and ranked among the nation’s top 25 all season, including 16 weeks inside the top 10. The Wolf Pack finished 20th in the AP poll and 23rd in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Razorbacks to Play on Nolan Richardson Court

- The court at Bud Walton Arena will bear the name of Hall of Fame and legendary University of Arkansas men’s basketball coach Nolan Richardson during the 2019-20 season. A resolution submitted by Chancellor Joseph Steinmetz to the University of Arkansas System Board of Trustees to name the court was adopted at a March 28, 2019 Board of Trustees meeting in Hot Springs, Arkansas.
- While the head basketball coach, Richardson led the Razorbacks to an overall record of 389-169, setting a school record for wins and a .697 winning percentage. He led Arkansas to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances including six Sweet 16’s (1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996), four Elite Eights (1990, 1991, 1994, 1995), three Final Fours (1990, 1994, 1995) a national runner-up finish (1995) and the 1994 NCAA Championship, the first in school history.
- He also coached Arkansas to five conference championships including three in the Southwest Conference (1988-89, 1989-90, 1990-91) along with SWC tournament championships in the same seasons. Richardson also guided the Razorbacks to two Southeastern Conference championships (1991-92, 1993-94), an SEC Western Division title (1994-95), and three trips to the SEC tournament championship including an SEC tournament title in 2000.
- In Richardson’s 22 combined years as a head coach at the collegiate level – at Western Texas Junior College, the University of Tulsa and the University of Arkansas – he compiled a record of 508-206 (.711) and became the only head coach in college basketball history to win a National Junior College Championship, NIT Championship and NCAA Championship.
- Coach Richardson was elected to the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2014, the University of Arkansas Sports Hall of Honor in

1996 and the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame in 1998. He was also honored with a banner in Bud Walton Arena in 2015.

New Arc, No Problem

- The 3-point arc has been moved back nearly two feet for the 2019-20 season. However, Arkansas has experience with the new arc as it was used during last year’s NIT.
- The Razorbacks shot nearly 40 percentage points better in its two NIT games from 3-point range (.383) compared to the rest of the season (.342).
- The Razorbacks made their first five 3-point attempts at Providence and finished the game making 10-of-21 – 47.6%.
- Overall, the Razorbacks ended the season shooting the ball well from long range. Over their last seven games, the Razorbacks made over 45 percent from 3-point range five times, including:

3-Ball Streak Continues

- Mason Jones made a 3-pointer at 18:43 to mark the 1,000th-straight game Arkansas has made at least one triple
- Arkansas ranks fourth-tied on the NCAA active list of teams that have made at least one 3-pointer.

- UNLV, Vanderbilt and Princeton have made a 3-pointer in every game since the NCAA adopted the rule in 1986-87. (Princeton has only played 935 games). Kentucky is the only other team to make a 3-pointer in over 1,000 games. However, the Wildcats’ streak ended March 2018 at 1,047 games (0-for-6 vs. Davidson in NCAA first round).

Best in the NCAA Returning

- Isaiah Joe and Jalen Harris are among the top returning players in the NCAA in their respective stat categories.
 - ^ **ISAIAH JOE** ranks sixth among returning players after making 113 3-pointers last season.
 - ^ **JALEN HARRIS** ranks ninth among returning players after posting 2.86 assist-to-turnover ratio.

Fire Power Returning

- Arkansas is the only SEC team to have two of the league’s top 20 scorers returning for 2019-20.

Putting Joe’s Freshman Year in Perspective

- Isaiah Joe set school records for 3-pointers made in a season (113), **ranked fourth on the NCAA all-time list for 3’s by a freshman in a season and tied the SEC freshman record for 3’s in a season.**
- Here is the kicker. With 113 3-pointers made this season, **Joe only needs to make 40 more 3’s to enter the ARKANSAS ALL-TIME list for triples made.**

For Openers

- Arkansas will open the Eric Musselman era by hosting Rice on Nov. 5.
- The Razorbacks have won 44 straight home openers, including a 26-0 record in openers inside Bud Walton Arena, and have won 45 of the last 48 seasons openers.
- The Razorbacks had a streak of 23 consecutive season openers end last year with an overtime loss to Texas in the ESPN Armed Forces Classic in El Paso.
- Eric Musselman is 4-0 in both home and season openers. Over the last three seasons, his season opener was also his home opener. In his first year as a collegiate head coach, Nevada opened the season with a win in Hawaii and returned to Reno to win its home opener.

Speaking of Rice

- The Arkansas and Rice rivalry dates back to the Razorbacks’ first season of basketball, 1923-24. The two squads played twice that year – both in Rice and Arkansas’ second-to-last series of the year.
- Arkansas owns a 102-41 advantage in the series, including a 55-11 mark in games played in Fayetteville.
- Arkansas has won 15 straight in the series and 40 of the last 43. Rice is one of three teams Arkansas has beaten at least 100 times along with TCU (104) and Texas A&M (103).
- With 143 games played, Rice is Arkansas’ fourth-most common. The leaders being Texas A&M (158; 102-56), Texas (155; 87-68), SMU (155; 96-59), Rice (143; 102-41), Baylor (143; 95-48) and TCU (142; 104-38).
- However, the Razorbacks and Owls have only played once since Arkansas left the Southwest Conference to join the SEC for the 1991-92 season. That lone meeting was on Dec. 17, 2005 in Little Rock, a game Arkansas won 80-61.

Speaking of Former SWC Foes

- Arkansas will host former Southwest Conference foe TCU in the Big 12/SEC Challenge on Jan. 25.
- Like Rice, TCU was on Arkansas’ schedule the first year the Razorbacks fielded a team (1923-24). Despite being Arkansas’ sixth-most common opponent, the Razorbacks have not faced TCU since Feb. 16, 1991, the year Arkansas left the Southwest Conference to join the SEC.
- As noted above, TCU in Arkansas’ sixth-most common opponent, having played 142 previous times, with the Razorbacks owning a 104-38 advantage in the series. Also noted above, TCU joins Rice and Texas A&M as the programs the Razorbacks have amassed a least 100 wins against.
- Arkansas was able to take a large lead in the series thanks to a 25-game win streak spanning from the 1972-73 season until 1982-83. After the streak was snapped, the series was fairly even with Arkansas owning a 9-7 advantage – including two straight wins – to close out the rivalry in 1991.

Razorbacks in Big 12/SEC Challenge Game

- The annual Big 12/SEC Challenge will take place on Jan. 25 and the Razorbacks will host TCU.
- Arkansas will be playing in its sixth consecutive Challenge and is 2-3 in such games.

- Including those 283 combined meetings with Rice and TCU, Arkansas owns a 271-111 record versus its 2019-20 non-conference opponents.

- Arkansas will be facing Montana, Northern Kentucky and Valparaiso for the first time.
- Arkansas is a combined 23-0 versus Colorado State (2-0), North Texas (14-0), South Dakota (1-0) and Texas Southern (6-0).

Rare Trips to ACC & Big 10 for Hogs

- This year will mark just the first time Arkansas has played at Georgia Tech since Jan. 28, 1966 and the first time Arkansas has played a regular-season game at Indiana since the 1949-50 season. (NOTE: Arkansas played at Indiana in the second round of last year's NIT.)
- Arkansas will be traveling to an ACC gym for just the ninth time and first time since the 2015-16 season. This will be just the eighth time Arkansas has played at a Big 10 opponent.

^ **JEANTAL CYLLA** is a graduate transfer from UNC Wilmington and member of the Haitian national team. He played his first two years at Florida Atlantic before transferring to UNCW. In his three-year collegiate career, Cylla has scored 984 points in 96 career games.

^ **JIMMY WHITT JR.** played his freshman season at Arkansas and played his last two seasons at SMU. Whitt has scored 910 points in his 92 career games.

^ **CONNOR VANOVER** will have to sit the 2019-20 season per NCAA transfer rules. Vanover played his freshman campaign last season at Cal. Vanover is a native of Little Rock and played with current Razorback sophomore Reggie Chaney at Findley (Nev.) Prep.

^ **JD NOTAE** will have to sit the 2019-20 season per NCAA transfer rules. Notae played two seasons at Jacksonville University where he tallied 929 points (15.5 avg.), 328 rebounds (5.5 avg.), 163 assists (2.7 avg.) and 101 steals (1.7 avg.).

^ **ABAYOMI IYIOLA** will have to sit the 2019-20 season per NCAA transfer rules. Iyiola played two seasons at Stetson University where he tallied 656 points (10.4 avg.), 434 rebounds (6.9 avg.) and 58 blocked shots while adding 12 double-doubles.

No Ordinary Joe

- Isaiah Joe set four school records, set an SEC freshman record, tied an SEC freshman record and ranked fourth in NCAA history for 3's made by a freshman in a season.

- Joe was one of eight players in the NCAA to make at least 110 3-pointers and shoot at least 41% from long range.

✓RECORD 1: Joe set the Arkansas freshman record for 3-pointers made in a season at Missouri (making seven in the game on Feb. 12). He finished with 113 3-pointers, breaking the previous rookie mark of 83 by Rotnei Clarke in 2009.

✓RECORD 2: Joe broke the Arkansas record for 3-pointers made in SEC games only vs. Ole Miss (Mar. 2), making two in the win. He made 60 3-pointers in league action this season. The previous mark was 52 set by Anthon Bell (2016) and Janero Pargo (2002).

✓RECORD 3: Joe made four 3-pointers at Vanderbilt (Mar. 6) to break the school's single-season record. He finished with 113 triples for the season, breaking Scotty Thurman's mark of 102 3's made in 1995.

✓RECORD 4: Joe attempted 273 3-pointers - **WHILE LEADING THE SEC IN 3-PT %** - to break Pat Bradley's mark of 249 attempts in 1999.

✓RECORD 5: Joe made 113 3-pointers to tie the SEC freshman record for 3-pointers made in a season. Jamal Murray (UK) made 113 in 2015-16.

✓RECORD 6: Joe made made 3.32 3-pointers per game in 2018-19 to set the SEC record for 3's made per game in a season by a freshman.

• **RECORD WATCH 7:** Joe's 113 3-pointers ranks fourth (tied) on the NCAA list for triples in a season by a NCAA freshman. **Fellow 2018-19 freshman Antoine Davis of Detroit Mercy made 132 treys to break the NCAA freshman record previously held by Stephen Curry's (122).**

- In year one, Musselman's squad went from 232nd in assist-to-turnover ratio to 13th in year two and second in year three.

- In year one, Musselman's squad went from 208th in turnovers per game to 26th in year two and fourth in year three.

• Musselman's teams have ranked either first or second in his conference total assists in each of his four seasons as head coach.

SEC Tournament Returns to Bridgestone Arena

- The SEC Tournament will return to downtown Nashville at Bridgestone Arena for a second consecutive year and the eighth time over the last 19 years.

- Arkansas has been runner-up at SEC Tournaments held in Bridgestone Arena twice (2015 and 2017) and is 5-7 in games played in downtown Nashville.
