Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including four as a head coach at Nevada and 14 as a professional head coach.

In his five years as a collegiate head coach, Musselman has won at least 20 games each season (24, 28, 29, 29 and 20) to post a 130-46 record and .739 winning percentage - ninth-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined winning percentage of .626 (553-330).

Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons Michael and Matthew and the couple has a daughter Mariah.

Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

**Razorbacks Return to North Little Rock**

- Arkansas will host Old Dominion in its annual trip to North Little Rock. The contest versus the Monarchs is set for Dec. 19 at Simmons Bank Arena.
- This is 19th consecutive season Arkansas has played in North Little Rock and the 21st time overall, posting a 12-9 record in the venue.
- The Razorbacks have won four straight in North Little Rock and seven of the last eight.
- Arkansas has never faced Old Dominion.

**Two Big Neutral Site Match-Ups**

- Arkansas will play in the **MGM Resorts Main Event to benefit Coaches vs. Cancer** as part of a nationwide collaboration between the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).
- The event will be played in Las Vegas' T Mobile Arena on Nov. 20 (two first-round games) and Nov. 22 (consolation and championship). The field includes Arkansas, Louisville, Colorado State and San Francisco.

**ARKANSAS BASKETBALL IN LAS VEGAS**

- Arkansas is a combined 0-3 in Las Vegas.
- On Dec. 30, 1989, then #11 Arkansas traveled to then #12 UNLV and lost 101-93. The Razorbacks and Runnin' Rebels both finished the 1989-90 season in Denver at the Final Four with UNLV taking home the title.

- Arkansas played two games in Las Vegas in Nov. 2012. After winning two games at home as part of the Las Vegas Invitational, the Razorbacks dropped two contests in Las Vegas to Arizona State (11/23/12) and Wisconsin (11/24/12).

**ARKANSAS- OKLAHOMA SERIES**

- Border rivals Arkansas and Oklahoma announced a multi-year, men's basketball series to be played in consecutive years at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Okla., with the first game in the series set for December 12, 2020.
- Located midway between the Arkansas (116 miles) and Oklahoma (125 miles) campuses, the BOK Center offers a central location that caters to alumni and fan bases from both universities. Tickets for the matchup will be divided at midcourt to create a unique 50-50 atmosphere for fans from each school.
- The Arkansas and Oklahoma series includes 28 games dating back to the 1938-39 season. Arkansas owns a 16-12 advantage in the series, including a 5-0 record when the teams play on a neutral court. The teams have never met in Tulsa.

**ARKANSAS BASKETBALL IN TULSA**

- Arkansas has never played in Tulsa's BOK Center.
- The last time Arkansas played in Tulsa was Nov. 30, 2003, an 81-74 victory over the Golden Hurricane at the Donald W. Reynolds Center.
- Arkansas is 9-15 all-time versus the Golden Hurricane in Tulsa.
- Arkansas is 1-2 all-time versus Oral Roberts in Tulsa.
- Arkansas faced Oklahoma State once in Tulsa (Mabee Center) on Dec. 9, 2000, a game the Cowboys won 74-73.

**HOGS #1 IN NCAA DEFENDING 3; Other Stats Among NCAA/SEC Leaders**

- The Razorbacks held opponents to shooting 29 percent or worse from 3-point range 20 times last season. In SEC play, Arkansas held Texas A&M to 28.6% (1/4), LSU to 26.7% (1/8), Ole Miss to 23.1%, Vandy to 25%, Alabama to 25.8%, Auburn to 25.8%, Missouri to 18.3% (2/8), Missouri to 19.0% (2/22), Tennessee to 23.5% (2/26) and Vandy to 25% (3/11).

**^ 27.2% 3-point defense: Led NCAA / Led SEC**

- Arkansas only committed 11.5 turnovers/gm in 2019-20 and just 10.1 in SEC play – **both were the fewest in SEC** – while **forcing a league-best** 16.0 turnovers/gm.

• Overall, Arkansas committed single-digit turnovers 10 times: 8 vs South Dakota, 8 vs Tulsa, 9 versus Texas A&M, 7 at LSU, 7 vs Vandy, 7 at Mississippi State, 8 vs Mizzou, 7 vs Tennessee, 6 at Georgia and 5 vs LSU.

• Opponents had five steals or less 21 times, including zero versus Vanderbilt (1/15).

- Arkansas had an **SEC-best** 253 steals last season and 128 in SEC games – trailing South Carolina for the lead. Arkansas has double-digit steals eight times this year – 14 vs Rice, 13 vs Texas Southern, 11 vs North Texas, 11 vs Montana, 15 at Georgia Tech, 12 vs Tulsa, 11 at Alabama and 14 vs Auburn.

- The Razorbacks forced at least 15 turnovers on 20 occasions last season, including a season-high 27 in the season opener versus Rice. TCU had 19. Auburn had 18 turnovers; Texas A&M (2x), Alabama and Missouri had 17 turnovers; Ole Miss, Vanderbilt, Kentucky, South Carolina and Miss State (2/15) each had 16 and Florida into 15.

- Prior to having 16 turnovers in the regular-season finale at Texas A&M, Arkansas only committed 26 turnovers in its previous four games (8 vs Mizzou, 7 vs Tennessee, 6 at Georgia and 5 vs LSU). The Hogs committed just 10 turnovers at Alabama and versus Auburn. Overall, the Hogs committed 10 or less

turnovers 15 times in 2019-20.

- Arkansas ranked 3rd in the nation in points per possession (0.976) according to Synergy Stats.
- Top 2 were Oregon (1.054) and South Dakota (.980)
- Arkansas ranked 5th in the nation in FT Rate (42.5) while opponents were 320th (40.9) according to KenPom.com.

**3-Ball Streak Continues**

- On Feb. 9, 2019, Mason Jones made a 3-pointer at 18:43 of the first half at South Carolina to mark the 1,000th-straight game Arkansas made at least one triple.
- Arkansas fans were getting nervous the streak might end versus Texas Southern in 2019-20. The Razorbacks were 0-of-13 from distance in the first half. However, Isaiah Joe opened the second half with a triple and would make six in the period en route to 29 second-half points - 33 total.
- Arkansas ranks fourth on the NCAA active list of teams that have made at least one 3-pointer.

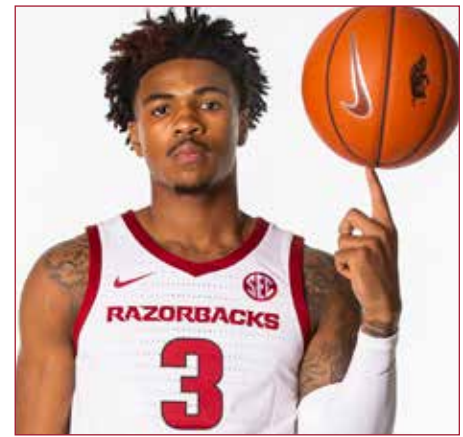
