• **2020-21 Preseason All-SEC second team (Coaches)** ... Team's leading returning scorer from 2019-20 ... One of three Razorbacks – only returning one – to play all 66 Arkansas games the last two seasons.

2019-20 (So.):

Played in all 32 games, starting 24 ... Despite shooting 32.9% from 3-pt for the season, shot a team-best 45.6% (31-of-68) from "3" over the last 14 games ... Strong play began when Isaiah Joe missed the TCU game due to injury ... Sills scored in double figures 10 times over the last 14 games ... Named **Collegiate Hoops Roadshow All-Tournament** ... Scored 17 points in the finale versus Northern Kentucky and had five steals over the four games ... Tied for the team lead with six rebounds versus North Texas and added his first career blocked shot ... Had 11 points at Georgia Tech, including three shots at the rim over one of the nation's top shot blockers, James Banks III ... Led team with season-high four assists while grabbing four rebounds in the overtime win ... At Western Kentucky, led the team for the first time in his career in scoring as he pumped in a then career-high 20 points ... Was 7-of-11 from the field, making three 3's ... Scored 18 of his 20 in the second half (6-of-6 from the field, 3-of-3 from 3PT and 3-of-3 at the free throw line) ... Scored 10 at Indiana, hitting a key trey late in the game to get the Hogs to within two (61-59) ... Added five rebounds ... In the SEC opener versus Texas A&M, scored 13 versus Texas A&M - 11 in the first half ... Added four rebounds and two steals ... Hit a trey as time expired in the first half ... Singled out by Aggie head coach Buzz Williams for his "pesky" play ... Scored nine in playing a regulation career-high 35:23 at Ole Miss ... Hit a shot in the lane with 3:56 left to tie the game (68-68) ... Drew seven fouls in the game ... Grabbed a career-high seven rebounds versus Vanderbilt, adding 13 points, two assists and two steals ... With Isaiah Joe out with injury, had his best game versus TCU ... Scored 18 points in his first game coming off the bench, making 7-of-8 from the field, including 3-of-3 from 3-point range ... Added two steals ... Had a sneaky really good game at Alabama, playing an SEC career-high 39:07 minutes and tying a career-high with three steals ... Only scored seven points, but they were all big ... Down 12-0, he got Arkansas on the board with a layup at 16:34 ... Drained a 3-pointer at 7:41 to get Arkansas to within one, 22-21 at 7:41 ... Got a steal that led to two made free throws for a six-point lead (30-24 at 4:22) ... In the second half, had a steal at 13:46 and one at 9:01 as Arkansas would go up seven (64-57) ... Stepped up big again with Isaiah Joe's absence versus Auburn to produce his best career SEC game with 14 points and career-highs in 3's made (4), steals (4) and minutes (40:50) ... Tied then SEC career-high with 15 points vs Miss State (2-of-4 from 3PT and 3-of-3 FT) ... Hit a 3-pointer to give Arkansas a 75-72 lead to cap a 36-16 run in erasing a 17-point, second-half deficit ... Set then SEC career-high with 17 points versus Mizzou, making 4-of-6 from 3PT ... Made three clutch triples down the stretch - up two with 7:45 to put Hogs up five; up to with 6:14 left to go back up five and with 1:33 left made a trey to go up eight and secured win ... Continued strong play off the bench, scoring 13 with four rebounds, in the win over Tennessee ... Made back-to-back 3's in the first half to give Arkansas a 15-point lead ... Hit a trey in a 9-0 run to turn a two-point lead into an 11-point cushion ... Had career-high 21 points at Georgia with six rebounds, his second-best career total ... After going down 14-0 to start the game, Sills came off the bench and immediately scored 11 points (hit 3 treys and a layup) ... Hit two early 3's off the bench to give Arkansas an early 9-6 in the win over LSU, a lead it would not relinquish ... Finished with 13 points despite going 3-of-8 at FT line ... Made his first five 3-point attempts and scored 20 points in the SEC Tournament win over Vanderbilt ... The triples made were a career high ... Overall, was 5-of-6 from 3PT and 6-of-8 from the field.

2018-19 (Fr.):

Started the last eight games and started second half prior to that at Auburn to solidify his spot as a starter over the last eight ... In his eight starts, scored double figures four times (five times all season), including a career-high 18 at Indiana in the NIT, a then career-high 15 points at Kentucky, 11 at Vanderbilt and 11 versus Alabama ... Made a career-high four 3-pointers at Indiana and three each at Kentucky, at Vanderbilt and versus Alabama ... Had a career-high three steals vs. Ole Miss ... At Auburn, had a career-high four rebounds ... Over the last eight games, shot a team-best 64.3 percent from 3-point range (18-of-28), 50 percent from the field (25-of-50) while averaging 10.1 points per game ... Prior to starting role, was 1-of-10 from 3-point range over a 13-game span ... Was the first sub off the bench (solo or tied) in 13 of the first 25 games prior to getting starting role ... Handed out a career-high six assist versus FIU ... As part of his nine points versus Western Kentucky, scored six straight over two minutes in the second half to tie the game at 62-62 (8:35 mark) and made a free throw to tie the game at 70-70 with 4:32 left ... Had a break-out game in his SEC debut - a win at Texas A&M - with 14 points ... 13 of those points came in the first half, including eight straight at one spell, as the Razorbacks led 33-32 at halftime ... Had five assists and no turnovers in 18 minutes in the overtime loss versus LSU ... Started the second half at Auburn ... Made (5) and took (8) career-high free throws ... Added a career-high four rebounds ... Played 23 minutes and led the team with three assists ... Earned first career start versus Texas A&M (2/23) and scored seven points on 3-of-6 shooting ... At Kentucky, scored a then career-high 15 points (making 3-of-5 3-pointers and 4-of-4 at the line) ... Made back-to-back 3-pointers to start the second half and gave Arkansas its largest lead of the game (15 points) ... In the Ole Miss win, had a career-high three steals as well as a career-high five deflections ... At Vandy, made 3-of-3 from 3-point range, scored 11 points and had four assists ... Followed that with another 11-point performance in the regular-season finale win versus Alabama, making 3-of-5 from 3-point range ... At Providence, hit the Razorbacks' first 3-pointer from the NIT experimental FIBA distance as Arkansas started the game 5-of-5 from long range ... Finished 2-of-4 from distance and played second-most career minutes (27) ... Closed the season with a career-high 18 points at Indiana, making a career-high four 3-pointers.

Prior to Arkansas:

Rated #3 player in the state of Arkansas by 247Sports.com and ESPN while being a consensus top 50 pick among the nation's top point guards ... Named to the USA TODAY All-Arkansas first team ... A two-time, first team 6A All-State selection (2017 and 2018) ... Helped guide Jonesboro High School to back-to-back 6A state championships ... Averaged 20 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.5 assists in 2017-18 ... As a junior, put up 15.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and two assists per game, leading the Hurricanes to a perfect 32-0 record that ended in a title game victory over former Razorback Daniel Gafford ... Played with Isaiah Joe and Ethan Henderson on the Arkansas Hawks AAU team.

Made the team as a walk-on for a second straight year ... Played in six games ... Grabbed five rebounds in six total minutes played, including three in the season opener versus Rice and two at Tennessee.

2018-19 (Jr. at Arkansas):

Redshirted as a walk-on, serving on the practice squad ... Sat out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

2017-18 (So. at Texas-Tyler):

Earned American Southwest Conference All-Conference Team honors at Texas-Tyler after setting an ASC single-season record for shooting percentage (.678) ... Also a member of the ASC East Division first team ... Selected to the Small College Basketball Watch List for the Bevo Francis Award of 2018, the top player who competes in the affiliations of NCAA Division II, NCAA Division III, NAIA Division I, NAIA Division II, USCAA and NCCAA ... Was a three-time ASC Player of the Week ... He led his league and ranked sixth in DIII ... He averaged 19.6 points per game - second in the ASC - and 7.8 rebounds ... Was back-to-back ASC East Player of the Week ... First honor (Nov. 20) came as he recorded 28 points and 13 rebounds then had 26 points 16 boards in Saturday's 86-68 victory at Southwestern The following week (Nov. 27) he scored 27 points and pulled down 12 rebounds in the Patriots' 92-81 win at Austin College ... Third honor came on Jan. 15 as he averaged 27.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game in a pair of ASC wins over Louisiana College and Belhaven at home.

2016-17 (Fr. at Texas-Tyler):

Earned ASC East Division All-Freshman Team ... Averaged 6.8 points and 3.8 rebounds per game ... Scored a season-high 20 points against Ozarks where he went 8-for-8 from the field and hit all four of his shots from the free-throw line ... Finished the season leading the Patriots with a 60.3 shooting percentage and had 99 rebounds.

2019-20 (So.):

Came on strong at the end of the 2019-20 season ... Of his 46 rebounds for the season, 33 came in the last eight games ... Named team's Player of the Game as he provided a huge spark off the bench in the first half versus Austin Peay ... During a 9-0 run - putting the Hogs up 25-18 - he had a dunk, three blocked shots and three rebounds ... The three rejections were a then career high and he finished with four rebounds in 7:26 played ... Grabbed three rebounds in three minutes versus Tulsa ... Had four career games over his last seven ... FIRST: had then career game in first career start (at Florida - Feb. 18) as he scored then career-high seven points in just 10 minutes before fouling out ... SECOND: In a win over Tennessee (Feb. 26), got his second career start and first at Bud Walton Arena ... Played a career-high 29:53 minutes, had a career-high nine rebounds, had a career-high nine deflections and tied his then career-high with three blocked shots (Entering the UT game, Henderson had only pulled down 12 rebounds with two blocked shot in his previous 14 career SEC games) ... THIRD: In the win over LSU (Mar. 4), scored a career-high 10 points, going 3-of-3 from the field with two dunks ... Made (4) and attempted (9) career-highs in free throws (Prior to LSU, Henderson was 3-of-9 at FT line for his career) ... Dished out his first career assist in an SEC game (three total for his career) ... FOURTH: Blocked a career-high four shots, adding eight deflections, at Texas A&M in the regular-season finale.

2018-19 (Fr.):

Played in 12 games and scored 11 points ... Had a breakout game at Providence in the first round of the NIT ... In the first 32 games of the season, Henderson played 28 minutes, was 2-of-3 from the field, scored five points and had six rebounds ... At Providence (Game 33) alone, played 18 minutes, was 3-of-6 from the field, scored six points and had five rebounds ... Had two rebounds and a blocked shot in eight minutes versus Montana State ... Grabbed two rebounds and dished out first career assist in UTA win ... Scored first career points versus FIU, making a basket and a free throw while getting his first steal ... Saw his first action in eight games at #3 Tennessee and responded well .. Scored on an offensive put-back and had two steals in four minutes of action ... Only played the final minute at Auburn, but had a blocked shot ... At Providence, set career highs in minutes (18), field goals made and attempted (3-of-6), points (6) and rebounds (5) ... Added two dunks ... Entered game the earliest of his career (15:44 in the first half) and scored at 14:16 to start an 8-0 to put Arkansas up 11.

Prior to Arkansas:
