

# STANLEY UMUDE



G | Gr.Sr. | 6-6 | 210 San Antonio, Texas || Warren HS / South Dakota

Pronounced UH-Moo-day ... Member of the Southeastern Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Leadership Council ... Played four seasons at South Dakota, ... Tabbed first team All-Summit League twice (2021 and 2019) and earned second team all-league honors in 2020 ... Graduated from South Dakota in the spring of 2021 with a degree in general studies ... Is pursuing a second undergraduate degree at Arkansas in Arts & Sciences ... Scored 1,520 points at South Dakota to rank 11th on the Coyotes' all-time list while pulling down 549 rebounds (24th in USD history) with 183 assists, 91 blocked shots (8th in USD history) and 55 steals.

### 2020-21 (Senior at South Dakota):

Tabbed first team All-Summit League ... Voted NABC second team All-District 12 ... Led the Coyotes in scoring, ranked ninth in the NCAA and was second in the Summit League with 21.6 points per game while averaging 20.9 points in league play ... Ranked 32nd in the NCAA (2nd in the Summit League) free throws made (115) and 38th nationally (third in the conference) in defensive rebounds (6.48 average) ... In the Summit League, ranked third in double-doubles (5), eighth in field goal percentage (.471), second in free throw attempts (144), eighth in free throw percentage (.799) and fifth in rebounds (7.0) ... Scored a career-high 41 points, making 17 field goals in the process, versus South Dakota State ... The 41 points tied for the fourth-best, single-game production in the nation for the season while his 17 field goals made were the most in NCAA Division I ... Recorded 20-plus points 14 times and 30-plus points five times ... Was one of three players in the nation to score 37 or more points twice ... A two-time Summit League Player of the Week ... The Summit League December Athlete of the Month ... Recorded games of 24 and 23 in USD's two games at the conference tournament in Sioux Falls, S.D., to earn a spot on the Summit League All-Tournament team.

### 2019-20 (Junior at South Dakota):

Earned second team All-Summit League ... Started in all 32 games on the season ... Second on the team with 16.7 points per game, a mark that increased to 17.1 points during conference play ... Grabbed 6.3 rebounds per game which ranked second on the team ... Swatted a team-high 1.3 blocks per game to rank second in the Summit League while is total of 43 ranks ninth-best on the USD single-season list ... Ranked in the Summit League top 10 in scoring (9th, 16.7 ppg), free throws made (6th, 117), field goal percentage (.9th, .459), double-doubles (5th, 5) and defensive rebounds (5th, 5.84 avg.) ... Scored a season-high 28 points against Western Illinois (Feb. 12) ... Attempted a single-game record 20 free-throws and made 14 against Oral Roberts (Feb. 15) ... Recorded 27 double-digit scoring games ... Scored 20 or more points on nine occasions, which was second on the team ... Grabbed 10 or more rebounds five different times, leading USD ... Notched five double-doubles on the season, leading USD ... Led USD in scoring 13 times ... Recorded 43 blocks on the season, which ranked ninth in a single-season in program history ... Voted preseason Summit League Player of the Year.

### 2018-19 (Sophomore at South Dakota):

Voted first team All-Summit League ... Earned Summit League Player of the Week on Jan. 14 ... Had the top freshman-to-sophomore year point-per-game increase in the nation at 13.3 points per game ... Had the nation's largest point-per-game increase for players who played for same Division I team in back-to-back seasons ... Played in all 30 games making 18 starts ... Averaged a team-best 14.4 points per game ... Points per game average increased to 17.1 in conference games, ranking sixth in the league ... Grabbed 5.5 rebounds per game, ranking second on squad ... Ranked second in Summit League (1.23 avg.) and fourth in total rejections (37) ... Led the team and was ninth in the league in field goal percentage (.491) ... Scored a season-high 32 points at Purdue Fort Wayne (Jan. 30) ... Became just the third Coyote in six seasons to tally 30-plus points ... Grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds at North Dakota State (Dec. 29) ... Tallied three double-doubles on the season, leading USD ... Had 10 or more rebounds on four occasions ... Scored 20 or more points in eight games ... Tallied double digits in 19 games ... Led USD in scoring in 13 games.

### 2017-18 (Freshman at South Dakota):

Saw action in 14 games as a true freshman ... One of two true freshman to see action ... Averaged 3.4 minutes and 1.1 points per game ... Played a season-high 13 minutes against Northland College (12/21) ... Scored a season-best nine points and grabbed a season-best three rebounds against Peru State (2/11) ... Saw action in all three Summit League Tournament games.

### **High School:**

Played at Warren High School ... Averaged 23.2 points, 6.2 rebounds, 2.4 blocks and 2.1 assists per game as a senior ... Earned 28-6A All-District honors as a sophomore and senior ... Averaged 24 points per game before sustaining an injury during junior season.

#### 2020-21 (R-Jr. at Arkansas):

#### Named the Bleacher Report National Sixth Man of the Year and the SEC Coaches Sixth Man of the Year.

Was Arkansas' first sub 16 times and Arkansas was 13-3 in those games ... Third on the team in scoring (12.8 ppg) but led the team in scoring 22.2 points per 40 minutes (Moses Moody was second at 19.9 ppg) ... Led the team in steals (46) and ranked 12th in the SEC in steals per game (1.44) ... Was seventh in the SEC in free throws made (92) ... Led team in scoring seven times ... Scored his 1,000th career point (5:09 of 2nd half) versus Central Arkansas ... Had a game-high 22 points versus the Bears, including 17 in the second half, adding three steals and six assists with just one turnover ... Versus Oral Roberts (Dec. 20), finished with 15 points, five rebounds, three assists and tied career-high with three blocked shots ... Scored 19 points in the win over Abilene Christian, including 17 in the second half ... Made two key 3-pointers - one to put Arkansas up 12 with 3:05 left and hit another to seal the win with 1:23 left ... Scored 21 in the win at Auburn, including 19 in the second half, with a season-high four assists ... Led the team with 19 points at Tennessee (season-best 63.6% shooting 7-of-11 FG) ... Led Arkansas and tied a then season-high with 22 points at LSU, including 14 in the first half ... Scored nine points during a 12-0 run for the Hogs ... Led the team with 19 points versus Ole Miss - 14 in the second half ... Had career-highs for free throws made (8) and free throws attempted - tied (9) versus the Rebels ... Scored 11 points in the win at Kentucky, including eight in the first half and making 2-of-3 from deep in the period ... Broke a mini slump with a 12-point performance in the Alabama win, making 2-of-4 from 3-point range ... His last triple gave Arkansas its largest lead (16 points with 5:22 left in the game) ... Played perhaps his best overall game – including his best defensive game – in the win over LSU ... Scored 18 points while tying a season-best with six rebounds (his most in an SEC game) and two steals while taking his fourth charge of the season ... Trumped that performance the next time out in the win at South Carolina with 21 points, five rebounds, five assists and five steals ... The 21 points and five assists both tie his best performances in an SEC game ... He became the first Razorback to have at least 20-5-5-5 in a game since Kareem Reid versus Louisville on Dec. 9, 1997 (HogStats.com) ... Only scored nine points in the season finale versus Texas A&M but they all came in the second half (making 6-of-6 FT) as Arkansas completed the come-from-behnd win ... In the SEC quarterfinal versus Mizzou, had a season-best 27 points - his best as a Hog and his fourth-best overall in his career - with four assists and four rebounds ... Added three steals in SEC semifinal versus LSU ... Made three key 3's versus Colgate in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament ... Added three steals ... Down four to the Raiders, Notae scored six straight to put the hogs up two with 10:20 left ... With the game tied, made a triple then added two free throws and Arkansas led the rest of the way ... Last 3-pointer came with 3:21 left to put the game out of reach ... Down 10 in the first half to Texas Tech, hit back-to-back 3-pointers to start a 20-8 run to end the first half and give Arkansas a 2-point lead ... Only scored once in the second half, a free throw with 19 seconds for a 2-point lead ... Grabbed the final rebound on the defensive end to seal to win over the Red Raiders ... In the Elite 8 contest versus Baylor, tied for the team lead in scoring with 14 points despite playing just 14:47 after fouling out with 13:38 left in the second half ... Was 5-of-6 from the field, including 2-of-2 from 3-point.

### 2019-20 (Jr. at Arkansas):

Sat out the season per NCAA transfer rules.

### 2018-19 (So. at Jacksonville):

Voted second team All-ASUN after averaging 15.5 points, 6.2 rebounds and 3.4 assists; all team highs ... Scoring average ranked fifth in the ASUN while ranking fourth in assists, fourth in steals (1.6) and 10th in rebounding ... Posted 24 games in double figures, including nine 20-point games, with nine games of five assists or more and three games with at least 10 rebounds ... Had three double-doubles, including a triple double at Kennesaw State (15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists ... First double-double was the game prior to triple double, posting 12 points with 13 rebounds versus Lipscomb ... Other double-double came versus Stetson as he scored 16 points and grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds ... Scored a career-high 40 points, adding eight rebounds and five assists, versus Florida Memorial ... Made 16-of-22 shots from the field and 5-of-6 from 3-point range ... Had 29 points and five assists in the regular-season finale versus Florida Gulf Coast ... Versus Indiana, posted 15 point and rebounds.

### 2017-18 (Fr. at Jacksonville):

Named ASUN Freshman of the Year after averaging 15.4 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.8 steals while shooting 41 percent from 3-point range ... Started all 28 games he appeared in until injuring his foot and missing the final five games of the year ... Scored 432 points, the second-most by a Dolphin freshman in a season ... Scored a then career-high 30 points vs. Middle Georgia State ... Scored 20 or more points seven times, four times in ASUN play ... Knocked down a season-best five three-pointers twice (at UAB, at Michigan) ... Hit two free throws with one second left to lead the Dolphins to a win at Stetson ... Led ASUN freshman in scoring (15.4 ppg), minutes (31.4 mpg) and steals (49) ... Was the ASUN Player of the Week once and Newcomer of the Week twice.

### High School:

Was a four-year starter at Newton High School ... Averaged 22 points, 5 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game ... Led his team to the 2016-17 7A Elite 8 with a 26-2 record ... 2016 GACA All-State member, Region Tourney Player of the Year and All-Region 2 AAAAAA team ... In AAU ball, was named the Atlanta Lightning MVP in 2014, 2016, and 2017.




