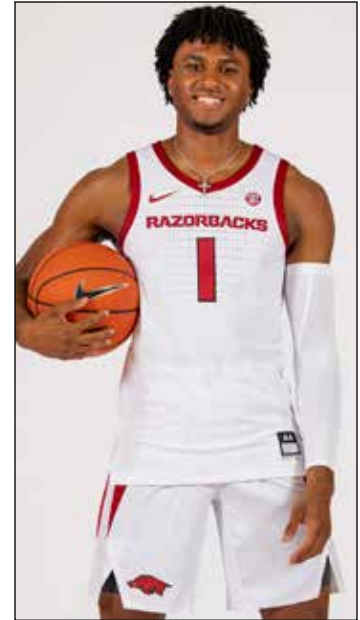

Ricky Council IV, the 2022 American Athletic Conference Sixth Man of the Year, played two seasons at Wichita State and will have three years of eligibility remaining ... Played in 49 games with nine starts with the Shockers and scored 458 points (9.9 avg) with 223 rebounds (4.6 avg), 65 assists, 38 steals and 17 blocked shots ... Shot 43.2 percent (161-373) from the field, 33.9 percent (38-112) from 3-point and 77.6 percent (125-161) from the line ... Was teammates with Trey Wade at Wichita State in 2020-21 and the duo helped the Shockers win the AAC regular-season title and earn an NCAA Tournament berth.

2021-22 (Sophomore at Wichita State):

Voted the AAC Sixth Man of the Year ... Started eight of the 28 games but he ranked second on the team in scoring 12.0 points, tops among AAC reserves ... He led the team in scoring 10 times, including eight of the last 12 games ... Scored in double figures in 17 games, including three with 20-plus points, and had 17 games with at least five rebounds, including two double-digit efforts ... Averaged 5.4 rebounds and was second on the team with 32 steals ... Led the team in rebounding three times and assists twice ... Made 84.9% (90-of-106) of his free throws to rank third in the AAC (63rd in the NCAA) ... Made 54-of-62 at the line over his final 12 games including a 16-of-20 effort vs UCF ... 16 makes ties for 3rd on the school's single-game best and 20 attempts is third ... Made the AAC Honor Roll three times ... First (Jan. 31) scored a career-high, 31-point effort in an 84-79 win over UCF ... Scored 22 points inside the final 11:08 and his 16 free throws made were the most by a Shocker in 59 years ... Second (Feb. 7) as he scored 20 points (7-of-7 FT) with seven rebounds and three steals in a win over SMU ... Third (Feb. 21) as he recorded a double-double (17 points and 10 rebounds in a two-points, overtime loss to Houston ... His first career double-double came vs Tulane (Jan. 12) with 12 points and a career-high 15 rebounds (12 defensive) ... Tallied a career-high six assists in 23, turnover-free minutes vs Norfolk State ... In a win over Oklahoma State, hit five-straight shots, accounting for 12 of his team-high 17 points in the final 10 minutes to help WSU erase an eight-point deficit ... Pumped in 20 points in the regular-season finale win over East Carolina.

2020-21 (Freshman at Wichita State):

Named to the AAC All-Freshman Team ... Appeared in 21 of the 22 games with one start and averaged 7.1 points and 3.4 rebounds in 15.6 minutes per game ... Made 12 3's on 44 percent accuracy and was 35-of-55 at the foul line (.636) ... Drew an average of 5.03 fouls-per-40-minutes ... Was one of the league's most impactful bench scorers, averaging 18.2 points-per-40-minutes (11th-best among AAC regulars) ... One of just three players to average 20+ points-per-40 during AAC play, putting up 20.3 points over 13 conference contests ... Earned AAC Freshman of the Week honors (Jan. 10) after scoring a season-high 23 points in 23 minutes against Cincinnati - the most points by a Shocker true freshman in nearly a dozen years ... Was 8-of-11 from the field and 7-for-11 at the line with six rebounds versus the Bearcats ... Scored 11 points in 17 minutes to key an upset of No. 6 Houston ... Eight of those points came in the last six minutes of the first half, helping the Shockers erase a 12-point deficit ... Had a breakthrough performance in the conference opener at Tulsa as he produced team-highs with 13 points and eight rebounds ... Earned a spot on the Dec. 21 AAC Honor Roll by delivering another 13 points and eight boards in a weekend win over Emporia State ... Made his first career start in his sixth career game against Newman and finished with eight points.

High School:

Three-star prospect, per Rivals and 247 Sports ... No. 391 nationally in 247 Sports composite rankings and No. 18 in North Carolina ... Third team all-state (all classes) and helped lead his team to North Carolina's Class 3A state quarterfinals with a 22-6 record ... District 6 Player of the Year ... Averaged 23 points, 9.5 rebounds and 5 assists as a senior ... Finished his career with more than 1,000 points ... Coached by Greg Motley ... Honor roll student and National Honor Society nominee who graduated among the top-10 of his class ... Member of Team Felton on the Under Armor circuit in the summer of 2019 while playing for Coach Fred Cannon.

Trevon Brazile (*pronounced Trev-In Brazil*) comes to Fayetteville after playing his freshman season (2021-22) with the Missouri Tigers and he will have three remaining years of eligibility remaining ... Played in 24 games with 22 starts last season and led the Tigers in blocked shots 20 times. ... Averaged 6.3 points and 5.0 rebounds and ranked third in the SEC (47th in the NCAA) in blocked shots (1.92 avg) ... Among NCAA Division I freshmen, ranked sixth in blocked shots average.

2021-22 (Fr. at Mizzou):

Missed the first eight games of the season with an undisclosed medical condition ... Came off the bench in his first two games played for the season (Eastern Illinois and at Kansas) before starting the final 22 games of the year ... Ranked third in the SEC (47th in the NCAA) in blocked shots (1.92 average) ... Was sixth among NCAA Division I freshmen in blocked shots per game ... His 1.92 blocks per game ranks third on the Missouri single-season list ... Had a blocked shot in 20 of his 24 games played ... Recorded a block in 12-straight games, including a stretch of 11-straight with multiple blocks ... Had a career-high six blocks against Illinois, which tied for the fourth-most in a single game by any Mizzou player and the third-most by any MU freshman ... Added 11 points ... Scored a season-high 15 points in the Tigers' season finale versus LSU in the SEC Tournament ... Had a season-high 10 rebounds with four blocked shots in the Tigers' regular-season finale versus Georgia, including five offensive boards ... Made a season-high 2-of-3 from 3-point range and scored 10 points with two blocked shots at Kansas. ... Recorded 11 points at LSU ... Just missed a double-double in the first-round SEC Tournament win over Ole Miss with nine points and nine rebounds ... Had a season high in free throws made and attempts (5-of-7) ... Had five-plus rebounds 14 times (including eight times with seven-plus boards).

Named a 2021 MBCA All-State selection and first team All-Ozark Conference ... Ranked the fourth-best prospect in the state of Missouri by 247 Sports and the No. 178 prospect nationally ... Won the Missouri Class 6 state championship at Kickapoo ... Averaged 13.2 points, 7.5 rebounds as a senior while shooting 73% from the field ... Averaged 11.2 points and 5.1 rebounds per game at Parkview High School as a junior.

Arkansas was 14-3 when Devo was the first sub off the bench, many of those coming as Arkansas went 18-4 to close the season and reached its second straight NCAA Elite 8 ... Averaged 8.3 points and was second on the team in assists with 102 ... Was preseason 2nd team All-SEC (coaches and media) ... Scored 16 points (6-9 FG and 4-7 FT) in the win over UCA with six rebounds, three assists and two steals ... Also had a team-best +30 in 27:27 minutes played ... Had a then career-high seven assists (all in the first half) vs Little Rock ... Versus Charlotte, scored 18 points with a career-high eight assists and four rebounds ... Also, held Charlotte's leading scorer (entered at 19.6 ppg) to just 10 points on 4-of-14 shooting (0-of-5 3PT) ... Pumped in a career-high 26 points versus Oklahoma while making a career-high four 3-pointers (entered the game with just 6 career 3's made)... Was a perfect 4-of-4 at the line while adding five rebounds and three assists ... In the Elon win, became the only Power 6 player since at least 2010-11 to have a game with 6+ assists, 6+ rebounds and no field goal attempts ... Had career highs in both free throws made (9) and attempted (10) at Texas A&M while scoring 13 points, 11 in the second half as Arkansas trimmed a 17-point deficit to 1 ... Added seven assists – an SEC career high – and seven rebounds, including four offensive boards ... At LSU, played the final minute of the first half and the second half despite losing his front tooth (face hit the floor when fouled on a breakaway dunk attempt) ... Had a season-high and tied his career high with eight rebounds (four offensive) ... Sank a key 3-pointer during Arkansas' 10- run late in the second half ... Versus #1 Auburn, was +15 (and the only Hog in double figures) in a four-point ... Had a career-high five steals and scored 10 points going 2-of-3 from 3-point range ... Led the team with +14, playing 18:29 in a 10-point win over Tennessee ... With the game tied, spurred an 11-1 run to give the Hogs a lead they would not relinquish ... Scored 19 points (7-of-10 FG • 2-of-3 3PT) with six rebounds and a team-best four assists with zero turnovers in a win at Florida ... Scored Arkansas' final five points to seal the win, including a breakaway dunk with 19 seconds left to go up seven ... Played 31:23 off the bench to help beat Kentucky ... Was 5-of-7 at the line (3-of-3 in one trip to put the Hogs up two with 5:22 left – was 2-of-4 inside the final 13 seconds to keep it a 2-possession game ... Made a key defensive rebound with five seconds left, saving the ball from going out of bounds after an Au'Diese Toney blocked shot ... Versus Vermont, had 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting ... "He saved us in the first half," said Coach Muss with his 10 points (4-of-5 FG), three assists and two steals ... Against #1 Gonzaga in the NCAA Sweet 16, scored six points, including two free throws with eight seconds left to secure a seven-point lead and the win ... Was the only Hog in double figures for Plus-Minus at +10.

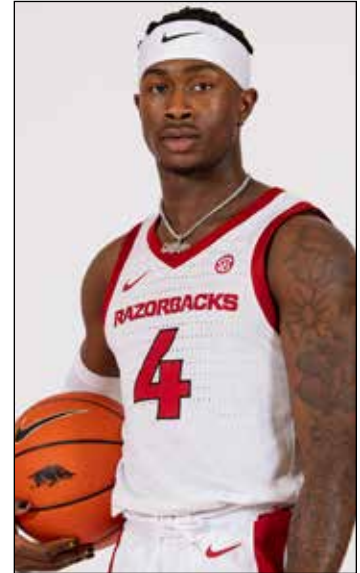

PLAY 3: With Arkansas now up six, 80-74, made a steal in what ESPN analyst Jimmy Dykes called "the best defensive play of the year" at the time ... The steal led to a fastbreak and two made free throws by Connor Vanover ... PLAY 4: With Arkansas now up eight, 82-74, sank a jumper from the left elbow as the shot clock was winding down to cap the 10-0 run ... In his first career start (vs Missouri Jan. 2), had four rebounds and three steals ... Was impressive on both ends of the floor in the win over Georgia ... Scored a season-high 20 points with seven rebounds, six assists and two steals ... Also did a good job guarding UGA point guard Sahvir Wheeler ... Had 10 deflections and tied Moses Moody with a Plus-Minus of +33 for the game ... Scored 10 points – all in the second half – in the win over Auburn (1/20) to help Arkansas erase a 12-point halftime deficit ...
