2021-22 Highlights

• Was 28-9 overall

- ^ Won at least 28 games for sixth time in school history and the most wins since 1994-95 (32-7).
- ^ Won at least 25 games for the second straight year and the 15th time in school history.
- ^ 53 wins over the last two seasons is most wins in back-to-back years since the Razorbacks won 63 in the 1993-94 and 1994-95 seasons.
- ^ 73 wins in the three-year Eric Musselman era is the best start to a Razorback coaching tenure by 11 wins (Eddie Sutton won 62 games in his first three seasons).

• Was 13-5 in the SEC

- ^ Won 13 SEC games in back-to-back seasons.
- ^ Won at least 13 SEC games for the sixth time with the school record being 14 SEC wins.
- ^ Arkansas finished fourth in the SEC regular season (although the Hogs had a chance to win the SEC title on the final day of the season).
- Arkansas earned a double bye at back-to-back SEC Tournaments for the first time since it was instituted (2013).

• Reached the Elite 8 for the second straight year

- ^ Arkansas and Houston were the only two schools to reach the Elite 8 in each of the last two years.
- ^ It was the 11th Elite 8 appearance, and the Hogs make their 13th Sweet 16.
- ^ It was the first time Arkansas made back-to-back Sweet 16 appearances since earning three straight in 1994 (national champion), 1995 (national runner-up) and 1996 (Sweet 16).
- ^ Arkansas' six wins in the NCAA Tournament over the past two seasons were more NCAA wins than the program had experienced in the previous 23 seasons (5 dating back to 1998).

• Was ranked 8th in the final coaches poll

- ^ It marked the second straight year the Razorbacks finished the year ranked among the top 10, finishing 6th in 2020-21.
- ^ Since 1996, Arkansas has only finished in the coaches poll top 25 six times.
- ^ The last time Arkansas had back-to-back top 10 finishes in the coaches poll was 1994 (#1) and 1995 (#2). (Arkansas finished among the coaches top 10 in six straight years (#4 in 1990; #5 in 1991; #10 in 1992; #10 in 1993; #1 in 1994 and #2 in 1995).

NOTE: The final AP poll is conducted prior to the NCAA Tournament and Arkansas was ranked 17th in 2021-22 final poll.

Williams Selected by OKC

- Jaylin Williams decided to forego his collegiate career after two years On the Hill and became the 41st Razorback to be selected in the NBA Draft when the Oklahoma City Thunder selected him with in the fourth pick of the second round (34th overall pick).
- He is the first Razorback the Thunder have selected in the NBA Draft and Williams becomes the 16th-highest picked player in school history. (Note: Dean Tolson was selected in the fifth round by the Seattle Supersonics, which became the Thunder, in the 1974 NBA Draft.)
- It marks the fourth-straight year a Razorback has been taken in the NBA Draft, joining fellow Arkansas natives Daniel Gafford, Isaiah Joe and Moses Moody. Joe, Moody and Williams played for Musselman, and Joe and Williams were high school teammates at Fort Smith Northside..

Arkansas defeated #1 twice; Makes History

- Arkansas made NCAA history with its two wins over the AP #1 teams.
 - Defeated AP #1 Auburn 76-73 (ot) on Feb. 8 before a record crowd (and TV audience) in Bud Walton Arena
 - Defeated AP #1 and NCAA tournament overall #1 seed Gonzaga in the Sweet 16
- ^ Arkansas became the first team to ever beat an AP #1 team in the regular season (Auburn) and defeat the AP #1 in the NCAA Tournament (Gonzaga).
- ^ Also, no men's college basketball team had beaten two different No. 1 teams from the AP poll in the same season since 1992-93 when Georgia Tech beat Duke and North Carolina in the same season. (Both regular-season games.)
- ^ Arkansas became the 16th #4 seed to defeat a #1 seed in the Sweet 16 and the first since Michigan State beat Virginia in 2014 (NCAA)
- The two wins vs #1 this season gives Arkansas a 3-11 record all-time when playing the top-ranked team in the nation
- Arkansas claimed its first win ever versus a #1 seed in the NCAA Tourney.

At the NCAA Tournament

- Arkansas earned its 35th NCAA bid and 2nd straight.
- Arkansas made its 11th NCAA Elite appearance and second straight.
- ^ It was the first time Arkansas has made consecutive Elite 8 berths since winning the national title in 1994 and finishing runner-up in 1995.
- ^ LAST YEAR: Arkansas advanced to the NCAA Elite 8 before falling to eventual national champion Baylor.
- The Razorbacks own a 48-33 all-time record in NCAA action.
- This was the sixth time in program history Arkansas has earned a No. 4 seed and the 13th time to be among the top-4 seeds since the NCAA began its current seeding process for the 1979 championship.
- ^ The previous #4 seeds came in 1999, 1993, 1990, 1983 and 1982.
- Arkansas is 18-8 in 1st Rd games, 11-10 in the 2nd Rd, 8-5 in Sweet 16 games and 6-5 in 8 games.

Hogs vs Auburn & Kentucky, 2 Most Watched MBB Games; Lots of Eyes in NCAA

- A Bud Walton Arena record crowd of 20,327 was on hand to witness the Razorbacks defeat #1 Auburn. Three weeks later, a capacity crowd of 19,200 saw the Hogs take down #6 Kentucky.
- According to ESPN, the Arkansas-Auburn contest was the most-viewed, regular-season men's college basketball game on ESPN2 since December 2018. The audience peaked at 1.96 million during overtime.
- According to ShowBuzzDaily.com, the Arkansas-Kentucky game on CBS was the fourth-most viewed sporting event on Saturday (Feb. 26) – tops in college hoops – with 2.4 million viewers.

• IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT:

- ^ The Duke-Arkansas pulled a 5.2 and 10.34 million on TBS
- ^ It ranks as the third-most watched Elite Eight game ever on cable
- Overall, the Hogs played in 2 of the 6 most-viewed primetime programs during the second weekend of the Tournament (Nielsen)

Hogs Led NCAA in Attendance for 2nd Straight Year

- Thanks to a record crowd of 20,327 for Arkansas' upset over #1 Auburn, the Razorbacks led the NCAA in attendance for the second straight year.
- #1 NCAA-Best Total** **361,412** 19 total game, including 14,685 at North Little Rock's Simmons Bank Arena
- #3 in NCAA for avg./game** 19,022 **Arkansas' 18-game average at Bud Walton Arena alone was 19,263**
- In a COVID restricted year last season, Arkansas led the NCAA in both total home attendance (72,822) and home average (4,284).

Arkansas vs Top 25; QUAD1

- Arkansas was 5-2 versus top 25 teams with six of those games coming over the last 14 games. AP top 25 wins included:
 - road win at #12 LSU
 - home win over #1 Auburn
 - home win over #16 Tennessee
 - home win over #6 Kentucky
 - NCAA Sweet 17 win over #1 Gonzaga
- Losses were at #11 Tennessee and vs #9 Duke in the Elite 8.
- Including the NCAA Tournament, Arkansas was 8-7 versus NCAA QUAD1 opponents, including an 8-4 mark in its final 12 QUAD1 games.
- For the season, Arkansas was: **8-7 vs QUAD1 • 8-1 vs QUAD2 • 5-1 vs QUAD3 • 7-0 vs QUAD4**
- Despite its late-season success AND reaching the NCAA Elite 8, Arkansas fell from 20th to 21st in the final NCAA NET.**

Tough Final Stretch

- The Razorbacks played arguably the toughest schedule in the country to close the season (in fact, it was **THE TOUGHEST RATED** for the final five regular-season games according to ESPN BPI).
- Through the SEC Tournament, **nine of Arkansas' final 10 opponents ended the year as NCAA QUAD 1 opponents**,
 - The Hogs posted a **6-3 record vs those QUAD 1 opponents** including wins:
 - vs then AP #1/final NCAA NET #13 Auburn
 - vs final NCAA NET #7 Tennessee
 - vs final NCAA NET #9 Kentucky
 - two wins** over final NCAA NET #20 LSU (one at home and one in the SEC Tournament quarterfinal).
 - road win at final NCAA NET #61 Florida
- IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT**
 - Arkansas defeated Vermont, who had won eight straight and 22 of 23 with its lone loss coming in overtime (75-74)
 - Arkansas defeated New Mexico State, the WAC Regular Season and Tournament champions
 - Arkansas defeated the #1 overall seed Gonzaga

18 Wins Over the Final 22 Games

- Arkansas lost 5-of-6 at one point, including an 0-3 start to SEC play.
- Starting Jan. 12 vs Mizzou in Bud Walton Arena, the Razorbacks reeled off a nine-game win streak – including a victory over #1 Auburn – which was snapped with a one-point loss at Alabama (Feb. 12).
- However, the Hogs won their next five after Alabama with home wins over ranked Tennessee and Kentucky squads before falling (by four points) in the regular-season finale at Tennessee. Arkansas also lost to Texas A&M in the SEC semis and Duke in the Elite 8.
- Over the 22-games...
 - Arkansas held 14 of the 22 opponents to below 40% FG shooting
 - Arkansas held 16 of 22 opponents to below 31% 3PT shooting
 - Arkansas out-rebounded 13 of 22 opponents, including +18 vs West Virginia.

Climbing the NET, 93rd to 20th ... Before Finishing 21st

- Arkansas fell to a season-low 93rd in the NCAA NET after losing at Texas A&M on Jan. 8 as the Razorbacks had dropped 5-of-6 games.
- After beating Missouri at home** (and starting its streak of winning 15 of its last 18), **Arkansas jumped 14 spots to 84th.**
- The Hogs followed that with a win at LSU (Feb. 15) and shot up 30 spots to 54th.**
- Arkansas steadily climbed the NET to a season-best 20th after the SEC Tournament.**
- BY COMPARISON**, the next best improvement by a current NET top 25 is St. Mary's who went from 43rd on Jan. 8 to 19th. Also, of the teams in the NCAA NET 90-100 on Jan. 8, the best improvement other than Arkansas is Oregon going from 91st to 76th.
- Despite reaching the NCAA Elite 8, Arkansas fell from 20th after the SEC Tourney to 21st in the final NCAA NET.**

Speaking of Rising from the Ashes

- After an 0-3 start to SEC play, Arkansas won eight straight league games (and added a ninth to the total with a win over West Virginia in the SEC-Big 12 Challenge) prior to falling at Alabama.
- (Per ESPN): Arkansas is **FIRST major conference team** to win eight consecutive conference games immediately following an 0-3 (or worse) start to league play **since UCLA accomplished the feat in 1981-82.**

Freebies; A Musselman Trademark • 1st NCAA in FT / 1st in SEC in FT%

- Arkansas led the NCAA by making 633 free throws and attempting 833.**
 - Arkansas made at least 20 free throws in a game 12 times this season – including four of the last seven.
- When getting to the line, Arkansas was productive as it LED THE SEC (32nd in the NCAA) in free throw percentage at 76.0%.**
 - Arkansas shot over 80% at the line 15 times, including eight of the last nine.
- In general, Eric Musselman's collegiate teams do a great job getting to the free throw line. In fact, his teams have either ranked 1st or 2nd in their respective leagues and among the NCAA top 25 in each of his first seven years.

One of the Best FT Shooting Teams in School History

- Not only did Arkansas lead the NCAA in free throws and lead the SEC in free throw percentage...
- ^ **76.0 FT% this season ranks 3rd in school history**
- ^ 633 free throws made ranks **3rd** in school history
- ^ Arkansas shot **75.1% at the line in SEC games, the second-best percentage in school history.**
- ^ 301 free throws made in SEC games ranks **4th** in school history

One of the Best Rebounding Teams in School History

- Arkansas out-rebounded its opponents 22 times.
- ^ Arkansas was 19-3 when out-rebounding opponents this year and is 29-6 in such games in the Musselman era.
- ^ Arkansas grabbed **1,399 rebounds this season - 4th most in school history**
- ^ **Arkansas grabbed 682 rebounds in SEC games to set the school record** and the team's rebound average in SEC games of 37.9 ranks second.
- **Arkansas ranked 2nd in the SEC in defensive rebounding pct, getting 74.8% of the available off opponent misses.**
- ^ Arkansas has held opponents to single-digit offensive rebounds 25 times, six or fewer offensive rebounds 14 times.
- ^ Arkansas has held opponents to single-digit, second chance points 22 times.

The Avengers

- Coach Eric Musselman is 16-5 when trying to avenge a loss as a collegiate head coach.
- ^ Nevada was 8-4 when trying to avenge a loss and **is 8-1 at Arkansas when trying to avenge a loss**
- **In Year One at Arkansas, Muss was 3-1**
- ^ LSU, Missouri and Tennessee: all three games, lost on the road first and then won the return game at home
- ^ **Miss State (0-1): lost at MSU then lost on a tip-in basket at the buzzer at home in the 2nd meeting**
- **In Year Two at Arkansas, Muss was 3-0**
- ^ Missouri: lost at home and later won at Mizzou
- ^ LSU: lost on the road first and then won the return game at home
- ^ Alabama: lost on the road first and then won the return game at home
- **In Year Three at Arkansas, Muss was 2-0**
- ^ Miss State: lost on the road first and then won the return game at home
- ^ Texas A&M: lost on the road first and then won the return game at home



RAZORBACK FIRSTS IN NCAA TOURNEY GAMES

VERMONT

- ^ **Stanley Umude** played 40 minutes in both NCAA Tourney games. In the Vermont win, he became **the first Razorback to play 40 minutes in an NCAA game and have zero turnovers.** (NOTE: Au'Diese Toney played 39:53 versus Vermont and did not commit a turnover.
- ^ **Arkansas only committed five turnovers, the fewest by a Razorback squad in an NCAA Tourney game.**

NEW MEXICO STATE

- ^ Despite giving up a 4-point play with 1 second left before halftime, **Arkansas held New Mexico State to 17 first-half points, the fewest by an Arkansas opponent in an NCAA Tourney game.** The previous mark was 18 by Wyoming in 1941.
- ^ **JD Notae had eight steals to tie a school record for thefts in an NCAA Tourney game** (tying for 2nd-most in any Razorback game).
- ^ **Jaylin Williams had 15 rebounds to set the school record for rebounds in an NCAA Tourney game.**

GONZAGA

- ^ Arkansas became the first team to defeat AP #1 in the regular season (Auburn) and AP #1 in the NCAA Tournament (Gonzaga)
- ^ Claimed its first ever win over an NCAA #1 seed

Valuing the Ball in the NCAA

- Arkansas only committed five turnovers versus Vermont.
- ^ Tied a season low (also had just five in game 3 versus Northern Iowa) and was the seventh single-digit effort this season
- Arkansas had 12 turnovers and 12 steals versus New Mexico State.
- ^ Of the 12 turnovers, five were charges called on the Razorbacks (four by JD Notae)
- ^ The 12 steals were the most by the Hogs since getting 11 in a loss at Alabama and eighth double-digit effort of the season.
- Arkansas only committed eight turnovers versus Gonzaga while forcing 15
- ^ It was the 8th time to have single-digit turnovers this year.
- Arkansas committed 11 turnovers versus Duke but forced 15.

Defensive Firsts During 9-Game Win Streak

- Arkansas held its opponents below 40% shooting from the field each of the first six games of the nine-game win streak, including 29.2% vs Mizzou.
- ^ The last time Arkansas held six-straight opponents to less than 40% shooting was games 7-12 of the 2013-14 season.
- ^ **Arkansas is the only school to hold 6-straight, major-conference opponents under 40% shooting this season.** (HogStats)
- **For the first time in program history versus SEC competition, Arkansas held its opponents below 40% shooting in five straight games.**
- ^ **Arkansas is the only SEC school in the last 15 years to hold five-straight league opponents shooting under 35% (34.8%) AND force at least 90 turnovers in a five-game span.** (Jared Burson, ESPN researcher)
- ^ It is also the first time any Musselman-coached college team has held opponents to shooting below 40% in five straight.
- **For the first time since Arkansas joined the SEC, the Razorbacks held league opponents below 60 points in back-to-back road games:** LSU only scored 58 (Jan. 15) and Ole Miss was held to 55 Wednesday.
- ^ The last time Arkansas held conference opponents below 60 in back-to-back road games was TCU (L, 51-45) and Baylor (W, 88-59) in 1989 while members of the Southwest Conference.



3-Ball Streak Ends After 33 Years

- Arkansas had made a 3-pointer in 1,092 games prior to going 0-of-11 from deep in the 16-point win over South Carolina on Jan. 18. **The last game Arkansas did not make a 3-pointer was when the Razorbacks went 0-for-2 at Texas on Jan. 07, 1989.**
 - It was the third-longest active streak in the NCAA at the time behind UNLV (1,144 games) and Duke (1,130 games).
 - IRONICALLY**, Miss State went 0-of-14 from 3-point range vs South Carolina in 2022.
 - IRONICALLY**, Arkansas made its 1,000th straight triple (by Mason Jones) versus South Carolina in Columbia in 2019.
 - IRONICALLY**, Vanderbilt had its 3-point streak end at of 1,080 games nearly two years ago to the date, going 0-of-25 in a home loss to Tennessee on Jan. 15, 2020. Kentucky is the only other SEC school to have a streak of 3-pointers made go over 1,000 games. The Wildcats drained a triple in 1.047 game before going 0-of-6 in an NCAA first round win over Davidson in 2018.
 - UNLV and Princeton are the only two teams to make a 3-pointer in every game they have played since the 3-point line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.
 - According to @sports_ref database, Arkansas's 16-point win was the largest margin of victory in a game which the winning team did not make a 3-pointer. **IRONICALLY**, the previous record was 10 points by Alabama in a win over South Carolina on Jan. 12, 2011.
- Arkansas only made one 3-pointer 22 times during the 1,092-game streak.**
 - The last time Arkansas made just one (1-of-9) was in the Hog's 2021 Sweet 16 win over Oral Roberts (by Jalen Tate).
 - Five of the 22 times, Lee Mayberry saved the streak by making Arkansas' only 3-pointer.
 - Arkansas is 7-0 in games it did not make a 3-pointer since 1986-87. (HogStats.com)**

Razorbacks/SEC Win 2022 SEC-Big 12 Challenge

- The ninth annual SEC-Big 12 Challenge took place Jan. 29, 2022, and the Razorbacks defeated West Virginia, 77-68.
- Overall, the SEC won this year's Challenge, 6-4 thanks to wins by Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Alabama, Kentucky and Ole Miss. The SEC has won back-to-back Challenges but the Big 12 leads 48-41 in the games overall.
- Arkansas played in its eighth consecutive Challenge and is 4-4 in such games – 4-0 at home and 0-4 on the road.

Win at Florida Snapped Losing Streak in Gainesville

- Arkansas claimed an 82-74 come-from-behind win over Florida (Feb. 22) on the road. The win snapped a 14-game losing streak to the Gators in Gainesville dating back to Feb. 28, 1995.

Alabama Was The Rarest of Losses

- The recent starting lineup of JD Notae, Au'Diese Toney, Staley Umude, Trey Wade and Jaylin Williams lost for the first time. Also, the Razorbacks lost despite reaching several metrics that have traditionally added up to a win.
- Perhaps the biggest "upset" among the numbers is Arkansas (and Coach Musselman) lost despite holding an opponent to fewer than 70 points. IT WAS THE FIRST LOSS FOR ARKANSAS UNDER MUSS IN SUCH GAMES.**
- After that Alabama loss, Coach Muss fell to 42-1 at Arkansas when holding opponents under 70 points (24-1 when holding opponent between 60-69 points) and dropped to 106-8 overall as a collegiate coach (68-7 when holding opponent between 60-69 points).

Tennessee (on the road) Was Another Rare Loss

- After losing at Tennessee in the regular-season finale, head coach Eric Musselman said: **"If coming into the game and someone said 'You are going to have 16 offensive rebounds, you are going to out-rebound Tennessee, you are going to have less turnovers than Tennessee, you are going to have more steals than Tennessee - a high, high steals team,' I would have thought, alright, we are going to win the game."**
- Arkansas played its worst half since SEC play began, allowing Tennessee to make 9-of-12 3-pointers and the Vols scored 50 first-half points ... the most since Tennessee scored 50 versus Razorbacks in Knoxville two years ago.
- However, down 23 (18:33 left), Arkansas went on a **14-2 run** to get to within 11. Later, down 19 (8:44 left), went on a **24-7 run, ending on an 12-1 spurt** to get to within 2 with 16 ticks left. Arkansas came up empty on its final two possessions and Tennessee went 2-of-4 at the line to provide the four-point margin of victory.

IN SEC GAMES ONLY, Hogs Had the Best Defense

- Arkansas allowed less than 60 points in 7 times in SEC action, including two times holding an opponent below 50 points (Mizzou had 43 and Tennessee had 48) and **the Razorbacks RANKED SECOND in scoring defense in SEC games at 67.11 ppg.** (Tennessee took overall as the leader over the last two games and had an SEC season average of 66.44)
- Arkansas showed dramatic improvement defending the 3-point shot. The Hogs ranked 10th in the SEC in 3PT FG% defense for the season (32.7%). **In 18 league games, Arkansas RANKED FOURTH in defending the 3-ball at 301%.**
- Arkansas held 11 SEC opponents to less than 40% shooting from the field and **RANKED SECOND in the conference in field goal percentage defense for league games at 39.7%.** (Auburn leads at 38.0%).
 - Williams was the only Hog in the positive (+2 in 33:36 minutes) in the 9-pt loss to Duke

Notae & Williams Make NCAA West Regional All-Tourney

- JD Notae and Jaylin Williams were voted to the NCAA West Regional All-Tournament team.
 - Notae averaged 17.5 points, 5.3 rebounds 4.3 assists and 3.0 steals.
 - Had 17 and 18 points in the first two rounds and 21 in the win over Gonzaga
 - Had 8 steals in the NM State game (tying a school record for most in an NCAA game)**
 - Williams averaged a double-double (14.3 pts and 11.8 rebs).
 - Had a double-double in all four NCAA games and added 10 assists
 - His 15 boards vs NM State is a school record for most in an NCAA ga,**

Notae Tabbed All-American; Selected USBWA District POY

- JD Notae was the National and SEC Sixth Man of the Year last season. However, he was not on any preseason national teams or watch lists. The postseason was a different story as Notae earned seven All-American honors.

- ^ He is the 33rd All-American in Razorback basketball history and the fourth in as many years.

Williams Gets National Honors

- Jaylin Williams was 1 of 6 players named to the **All-Glue team by The Athletic (Seth Davis)**.
- ^ It is the second straight year a Razorback has been honored by the Athletic as Justin Smith was selected to All-Glue Team last season.
- Williams, who was voted to the SEC All-Defensive Team, was named to the **CollegiateInsider.com Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America Team**.

Notae and Williams Named All-SEC; All-District

- JD Notae and Jaylin Williams are the **first pair of Razorbacks to be selected for the Coaches All-SEC first team since** Scotty Thurman and Corliss Williamson accomplished the feat in **the 1994 and 1995 seasons**.
- ^ Note: Todd Day and Lee Mayberry were named first team All-SEC by the AP in 1992 and both were named the coaches All-SEC team - one team, 11 members.
- Williams **added SEC All-Defensive team honors** to join Daniel Gafford (2019) and Lee Mayberry (1992) are the only Razorbacks to be named first team All-SEC and selected to the SEC All-Defensive team.
- With Notae earning 1st team honors and Williams being 2nd team by the media, it marked the first time since 2018 two Razorbacks were honored by both the coaches and media.
- **Notae and Williams** were additionally selected for the **USBWA 10-person All-District VII team** and the **NABC All-District 20 second team**.

Notae Scores 1,000th Point ... Again • Record Book Finish

- **JD Notae scored his 1,000th point in a Razorback uniform versus Texas A&M in the SEC semis. He finished his two-year Razorback career with 1,070 points.**
- ^ He only scored five points in that A&M game, but the 3rd, 4th and 5th points were an old-fashion 3-point play early in the second half to give him exactly 1,000 at Arkansas.
- ^ Scored 410 points last season and scored 660 this season.
- ^ Became the 45th player to score 1,000 points in a Razorback uniform. He tied Daryl Macon for 36th on the school's all-time list.
- ^ The 6th Razorback to accomplish the feat in two seasons joining Mason Jones (1,146), Jaylen Barford (1,087), Macon (1,070), Bobby Portis (1,047) and Dusty Hannahs (1,047).
- **Notae scored 929 points in two seasons at Jacksonville and scored his 1,000th career point six games into last season - at the 5:09 mark of 2nd half versus Central Arkansas.**
- ^ **Notae had 1,99 career points in his four seasons.**

 - Bobby Portis previously held the mark with 168 rebounds in SEC games in 2015.
- **ALSO SET THE SCHOOL RECORD FOR REBOUND AVG IN SEC GAMES AT 10.17.**
 - The previous record was 9.50 by Derek Hood (1999)

Notae Earns National and SEC Weekly Honors

- JD Notae averaged 26.0 points, 5.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds in wins at Florida and against #6/3 Kentucky. For his efforts, Notae was named both the National Player of the Week by both ESPN and Andy Katz/NCAA March Madness as well as being tabbed the SEC Player of the Week.
- At Florida, Notae had a team-high 22 points while adding six rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots in helping Arkansas snap a 14-game losing streak to the Gators in Gainesville. Notae scored five key points late in the game to secure the win. First, with Arkansas up one with 1:06 left, he drained a 3-pointer to put Arkansas up four. Then, after a defensive stop, Notae sank two free throws with 40 ticks left for a six-point cushion.
- Versus Kentucky, Notae had 30 points and eight assists as the Razorbacks defeated the Wildcats. **He became the first Razorback to have at least 30 and 8 in any game since the Hogs joined the SEC (1991-92). He additionally became the first SEC player to have at least 30 and 8 versus an AP top 10 team in the last 25 years.** It was the third time Notae has scored at least 30 points this season and his eight assists both tied a season-high and were a career-high in an SEC game.
- Notae led Arkansas to a 15-2 run to start the game versus Kentucky with eight points and two assists. (Notae accounted for 12 of the first 15 points.) While he only scored once inside the final 11:07, four of his eight assists came during the span, including assists on two of Jaylin Williams's three field goals when Williams scored 10 straight for the Hogs (3 FG and 4 FT) inside the final 4:38. His eighth assist of the game came with 1:22 left (to Williams) that put Arkansas up one (71-70), a lead the Hogs would not relinquish. Finally, up four with nine seconds left, Notae blocked a Ty Ty Washington shot to help seal the win.

- **vs. South Carolina**, only played 26 minutes due to foul trouble but still scored a career-high 19 – hitting a career-high 9-of-10 free throws.
- **vs. Texas A&M**, record his fifth double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds ... Added a career-high six steals with three assists and three blocked shots.

Williams Named SEC co-Player of the Week Part 2

- Jaylin Williams averaged 13.0 points and 13.5 rebounds to be named SEC co-Player of the Week (Feb. 21). He shared the honor with Vanderbilt's Scotty Pippen Jr.
- **At Missouri**, Williams had 13 points and 11 rebounds while leading the team in assists (4) and blocked shots (2). He did most of his damage in leading Arkansas to a 46-27 halftime lead with seven points, seven rebounds and four assists.
- **In the Tennessee win**, Williams posted a career-high 16 rebounds (15 defensive), including 10 first-half boards. He tied for the game-high honors with 13 points. In the second half, Arkansas out-scored the Volunteers by nine as Williams led all players with nine points and six rebounds in the period. Williams additionally drew four charges, tying his career high for a third time this season, and moving his school-record total to 41 on the season.

Umude Gets NABC All-Star Nod

- Stanley Umude helped Arkansas to an NCAA Elite 8 finished and was rewarded by going to New Orleans during the Final Four weekend to play in the National Association of Basketball Coaches/Reese's College All-Star Game.
- Umude was the 10th Razorback to play in the NABC All-Star Game and first since 2017 (Moses Kingsley). Others to play in the game include Sidney Moncrief (1979), Scott Hastings (1982), Darrell Walker (1983), Alvin Robertson (1984), Andrew Lang (1988), Ron Huery (1991) and Lee Mayberry (1992) and Darrell Hawkins (1993).

Zero for 6

- Twice this season – at Georgia and at Missouri – Stanley Umude made six treys in a game.

First, he scored a team-best 19 points (6-of-8 FG and 7-of-8 FT) with seven rebounds and a season-high three assists. On defense, he held WVU's leading scorer Taz Sherman to 4-of-11 shooting and seven of Sherman's 15 points came in the final 2 minutes.
- **Versus Auburn**, turned in his second double-double as a Razorback with 14 points and 10 rebounds (5 offensive boards).
- **Versus Tennessee**, was just 1-of-6 from the field, but was 6-of-6 at the line. **However, he grabbed 10 rebounds (four offensive) and held UT's leading scorer to 7 points (2-of-13 overall and 1-of-9 from 3-point range).**
- **Versus LSU**, was as efficient as he has been in SEC games, coring 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting and making 6-of-6 at the line. He was once again a standout on defense, helping hold Xavier Pinson to 5-of-21 shooting (0-of-7 3PT).
- **Vs LSU (SEC)**, turned in his third double-double as a Razorback with a **season-high 22 points** (6-11 FG, 8-10 FT) and 10 rebounds (**season-high 7 defensive boards**).
- **Versus Gonzaga**, grabbed seven rebounds (four offensive) with nine points and two blocks.

Lykes Likes Line (Clutch Inside 3 Minutes)

- Chris Lykes had two impressive streaks at the free throw line, including 21 straight at the line spanning 5 games earlier in the year and a streak of 19 straight. **He was a perfect 13-of-13 at the line in the NCAA**
- **IN 2021-22 INSIDE THE FINAL 3 MINUTES OF GAME (AND OT), LYKES MADE 46-OF-49 (93.8%) AT THE FREE THROW LINE.**

BIG GAMES FOR LYKES

- He **led the team in scoring in back-to-back games** with 26 points versus Northern Iowa and 14 versus Kansas State.
 - ^ The 26-point performance versus UNI was two points off his career high and his 17th career 20-point game. **It was just the 11th time since Arkansas joined the SEC (1991-92) that a Razorback scored 26+ points off the bench.** (HogStats)
 - ^ Versus K-State, scored a game-high 14 pts (tied) and **was 10-of-10 from the free throw line inside the final 1:46 to seal the win.**
 - ^ Versus **Cincinnati**, Lykes was 8-of-10 from the free throw line, **including 4-of-4 inside the final 21 seconds to seal the win.**
- Lykes led Arkansas versus **Elon**, scoring 21 points on just eight field goal attempts. He **was 12-of-12 at the line.**
- **vs LSU (SEC)**: Pumped in 18 points (including 6 straight to give Arkansas a lead its would not relinquish as the first half ended) ... Was 7-of-8 at the line and added three steals.
- **vs NM State (NCAA)**: Was a perfect 7-of-7 at the line, all inside the final 5:24 ... **Was 4-of-4 inside the final 10 seconds to give Arkansas a 4-point lead both times.**

Devo "Saved Us"

- Davonte Davis "saved us" with his play in the first half versus Vermont, said head coach Eric Musselman.
 - ^ Had 10 of his 14 points in the period making 4-of-5 from the field (1-1 3PT) with all three of his assists ... Was +12 in the first half to be the only Hog in double figures in Plus-Minus
- * His play should not come as a surprise. Davis burst onto the national scene in last year's NCAA Tournament, helping the Razorbacks reach the NCAA Elite 8.
- Davis reached double figures in 5-of-8 of his NCAA Tournament games
 - ^ In eight career NCAA games, averages 11.0 ppg • 4.75 rpg • Shooting 46.3% FG and 90% FT

Très Magnifique

- Trey Wade was a late arrival to summer workouts as they waited for paperwork to clear. Then, he injured his knee and missed another month in the preseason.
- However, Wade was one of six Razorbacks to play in all 37 games. Although his production was inconsistent, the Razorbacks' season turned around with him in the starting lineup.
- Versus Missouri (Jan 12), had a breakout game with a season-high 17 points (7-10 FG) with five rebounds, three steals, three assists and two steals.
- Four games later, he spurred a win at Ole Miss with 12 pts (5-5 FG), five rebs and five assists.
- At Missouri, Wade recorded **his first double-double as a Razorback** (4th for his career) with 12 points and 11 rebounds.
- **Played a key role in the Sweet 16 win over #1 Gonzaga** ... The Zags were content with Wade shooting and he responded with 15 points (6-11 FG; 3-4 3PT) and seven rebounds while holding Chet Holmgren to just 11 points (5-9 FG).
