

Played his freshman season at Butler before transferring to Temple ... Played 11 of the Owls' 16 games in a COVID-shorted 2020-21 season, missing the first five games due to injury ... Only played the first seven games to receive a medical redshirt in 2021-22 ...

#### 2022-23 (R-Junior at Temple):

Ranked 10th in the NCAA (led the American Athletic Conference) in free throw percentage (.898) ... Ranked 4th in the AAC in scoring (17.9 ppg) ... Also ranked second in 3-pointers made per game (2.85), sixth in 3-point percentage (.350) and 10th in free throws made (97) ... Led the team in scoring 15 times, led the team in rebounding five times and led the team in assists three times ... Scored 20 points in a team-best 13 games, including a four-game stretch early in the season and a five-game stretch late in the year ... The five-game streak was the longest streak of consecutive 20-point games by an OWI since the 2018-19 season ... Named American Athletic Conference and Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Week (12/4) ... Averaged 24.5 points per game in the Owls' 2-0 week .. Shot 15-for-34 from the field (44.1%), 8-for-18 from 3-point (44.4%) and 11-for-11 (100%) from the line ... Against La Salle, scored a game-high 22 points, including 4-of-8 from three-point range ... Followed that a season-high 27 points in a win over VCU while setting a career-high with four steals ... MVP of Basketball Hall of Fame Showcase despite the Owls' going 1-2 ... Scored a game-high 24 points in win over Rutgers ... Tallied 17 points against St. John's ... Scored 26 of the team's 49 points (thanks to 10-of-20 shooting from the field) in the finale versus Richmond ... Posted team highs in points (15), rebounds (8) and assists (6) in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore ... Tallied 21 points in a win over #16 Villanova ... Pumped in a game-high 24 points in a loss to #3 Houston ... Had a game-high 26 points, including nine in overtime, in a 77-70 win over UCF Tallied 25 points, including seven of the team's nine in overtime, in the win over USF ... Was voted preseason second team All-American Athletic Conference.

#### 2021-22 (Junior at Temple):

Received a medical redshirt as he only played seven games before suffering a season-ending injury to his left foot (fractured fifth metatarsal) in La Salle game (12/1) ... Was leading the AAC in scoring (21.4 ppg), and wsa leading the team in field goal percentage (.538/2nd AAC), three-point percentage (.488/1st AAC) and 3's per game (3.0/2nd AAC) at time of injury ... Led the team in scoring in six of his seven games ... Scored 20 or more points in five of the seven ... Named AAC Player of the Week for his 29-point effort in the win over Delaware, going 0-of-18 from the field, 2-of-3 from 3-PT and 7-of-8 at the line ... Had 22 in the opener versus Maryland-Eastern Shore and followed that with a 26-point effort versus Southern Cal ... Prior to his injury, scored 28 versus Elon, 29 versus Delaware and 22 versus LaSalle (the game he was injured) ... Made five 3's in the Southern Cal and Elon games ... Added eight rebounds versus Elon.

#### 2020-21 (Sophomore at Temple):

Third Team All-American Athletic Conference ... Second Team All-Philadelphia Big 5 ... Led team in scoring (15.0 ppg) while ranking second on the team in rebounding (6.4 rpg) ... Played in 11 games with four starts ... Missed the first five games due to a

hamstring injury ... Had three double-doubles including 22 points and 11 rebounds versus Tulsa (1/26), 32 and 10 versus South Florida (2/21) and 18 and 10 versus South Florida in the AAC Tournament ... Joined starting lineup for the last four games, starting at Tulsa ... Led the team in scoring and assists in all four of his starts and rebounding in three of the four ... In his first start at Tulsa, led the team in points (21), rebounds (7) and minutes (35) ... Scored a career-high 32 points versus South Florida (2/21) and grabbed 10 rebounds for his second double-double...Also dished a career-high five assists ... Overall, played in 11 games, averaging 31.4 mpg (2nd on the team) ...Had first collegiate double-double, scoring 22 points and grabbing 11 rebounds in a win over Tulsa (1/26) ... Also had a double-double, 18 points and 10 rebounds, in season-ending loss to USF in AAC Tournament ... Scored 14 points and grabbed six rebounds in 32 minutes (2nd most on the team) in loss to #8 Houston ... Scored in double figures eight times.

#### 2019-20 (Freshman at Butler):

Helped the Bulldogs to a 22-9 record before the season was canceled during the Big East Tournament ... Played in 24 games, averaging 3.0 points, 1.0 rebounds and 10.9 minutes ... Posted double-figures in two games with a season-high of 11 points coming in the season-opening win over IUPUI ... Scored 10 points in the win over Southern, adding a season-high four rebounds ... His four assists at Creighton (2/23) were a season-high.

#### **High School:**

Ranked as the 82nd-best prospect in the 2019 class by ESPN, as well No. 120 by Rivals and No. 126 by 247 sports (all three rated him as a four-star recruit) ... Averaged 23.7 points per game as a senior at Trenton Catholic ... Was the 2018-19 Times of Trenton Boys Basketball Player of the Year and the Trentonian's Area Player of the Year ... Scored at least 30 points eight times during his senior season ... Participated in the 2019 American Family Insurance High School Slam Dunk Contest as part of Final Four Weekend ... Scored more than 1,000 points in high school despite missing his sophomore season due to injury ... Team won the Burlington County Scholastic League-Liberty Division title and the 2019 Mercer County Tournament crown ... Named to the NJHoops.com All-Mercer County Team ... As a junior, averaged 18.5 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists ... Attended St. Joseph's High School as a sophomore alongside his brother, Tyus ... Played on the 2017 summer circuit with New Jersey Playaz, and averaged 13.4 points, 3.9 rebounds and 2.2 assists in Nike EYBL play.



#### 2022-23 (Freshman at Washington):

Pac-12 All-Freshman Team member ... Was the only Husky to play in all 32 games, making 21 starts ... Averaged 10.0 points and 3.1 assists and a 1.87 assist-turnover ratio ... His assist-turnover ratio led all Pac-12 freshmen and ranked seventh in the league overall ... Named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on Feb. 20 ... Led Washington to an overtime victory over Oregon with 27 points (11-of-15 FG), seven rebounds and five rebounds, playing 42:49 ... Became the first Husky since Markelle Fultz and just the fifth on record (since 1996-97) to have 27, seven and five in a game ... Followed that with 12 points and a season-high eight rebounds in a win over Oregon State ... Made first career start against North Florida (hame two of the season) and he pumped in 21 points with three assists and zero turnovers ... Followed that with a 26-point performance (4-of-6 from 3-point range) versus Utah State ... Became the first UW freshman to lead the team in scoring in consecutive games since Isaiah Stewart in 2020 ... His four three-pointers were the most by a UW freshman since RaeQuan Battle in 2020 ... Had a season-high eight assists and five rebounds at Arizona State ... Came away with a season-high four steals against Stanford (1/12/23) ... Scored 21 points against #6 Arizona.

#### **HIGH SCHOOL:**

The leading scorer in Nike's EYBL 2022 Peach Jam, averaging 22.6 points on 46.7 percent shooting for The Family ... Played at PHHoenix Prep in Arizona after previously competing at Beecher High School in Flint, Mich. ... In 2021 at Beecher High, led them to a 16-1 record in a COVID-abbreviated season and averaged 26 points, 9.3 assists, 6.6 steals and 4.7 rebounds ... Was the Michigan Division 3 Player of the Year and capped the season with a 37-point performance in a championship-game win.

Came to Fayetteville after playing his freshman season (2021-22) with the Missouri Tigers.

#### 2022-23 (Sophomore at Arkansas):

Granted a medical redshirt after he suffered a season-ending knee (ACL) injury in the first half of the UNC Greensboro contest (game nine of the season) ... Only played nine games, all as the team's sixth man ... Averaged 11.8 points and 6.0 rebounds ... Was the team's top 3-point shooter (37.9%; 11-of-29) ... In the season opener versus North Dakota State, recorded his first career double-double with a then career-high 21 points and a career-high 12 rebounds ... Was 7-of-14 FG and made a career-high 3-of-6 3PT ... Was also 4-of-5 FT ... Posted his second career double-double versus South Dakota State with 13 points (5-9 FG • 1-1 3PT • 2-2 FT) and 10 rebounds ... In the Maui Invitational, scored 17 points versus Creighton, making a career-high seven field goals with a season-high three blocked shots ... Followed that with a breakout game versus San Diego State as, for the first time in his career, led his team in scoring with 20 points and added nine rebounds ... For the third time this season, tied his career high with three 3's made ... Also played a career-high 40:05 minutes ... Scored 18 of his 20 after halftime, including 16 in the second half (4-of-7 FG • 3-of-4 3PT • 5-of-6 FT) ... Tied his career high with two steals, one coming with Arkansas down two with seven seconds left to set-up the game-tying basket too force overtime ... In his final full game prior to the injury – versus San Jose State – led his team in scoring with a career-high 23 points ... Was 8-of-9 from the field (1-2 3PT) and 6-of-8 FT with five rebounds, two assists and two blocked shots ... Also had career highs in FG made (8) and FT made (6).

#### 2021-22 (Freshman at Mizzou):

Missed the first eight games of the season with an undisclosed medical condition ... Came off the bench in his first two games played for the season (Eastern Illinois and at Kansas) before starting the final 22 games of the year ... Played in 24 games with 22 starts last season and led the Tigers in blocked shots 20 times. ... Averaged 6.3 points and 5.0 rebounds ... Ranked third in the SEC (47th in the NCAA) in blocked shots (1.92 average) ... Was sixth among NCAA Division I freshmen in blocked shots per game ... His 1.92 blocks per game ranks third on the Missouri single-season list ... Had a blocked shot in 20 of his 24 games played ... Recorded a block in 12-straight games, including a stretch of 11-straight with multiple blocks ... Had a career-high six blocks against Illinois, which tied for the fourth-most in a single game by any Mizzou player and the third-most by any MU freshman ... Added 11 points ... Scored a season-high 15 points in the Tigers' season finale versus LSU in the SEC Tournament ... Had a season-high 10 rebounds with four blocked shots in the Tigers' regular-season finale versus Georgia, including five offensive boards ... Made a season-high 2-of-3 from 3-point range and scored 10 points with two blocked shots at Kansas ... Recorded 11 points at LSU ... Just missed a double-double in the first-round SEC Tournament win over Ole Miss with nine points and nine rebounds ... Had a season high in free throws made and attempts (5-of-7) ... Had five-plus rebounds 14 times (including eight times with seven-plus boards).

#### **High School:**

Named a 2021 MBCA All-State selection and first team All-Ozark Conference ... Ranked the fourth-best prospect in the state of Missouri by 247 Sports and the No. 178 prospect nationally ... Won the Missouri Class 6 state championship at Kickapoo ... Averaged 13.2 points, 7.5 rebounds as a senior while shooting 73% from the field ... Averaged 11.2 points and 5.1 rebounds per game at Parkview High School as a junior.
