2025-26 HIGHLIGHTS:

• **SOUTHERN:** Had one of the best debuts by a Razorback in program history ... Scored 22 points which rank as the **second-best scoring output by a rookie Hog in a debut** (behind Patrick Beverley's 29) ... **Scored 20 first-half points, which is a record by a Razorback rookie in a debut** (HogStats) including nine straight for the Hogs to close the first half

- **at Michigan State:** Tied for the team lead with 16 points while leading the team in assists
- **UCA:** Led the team with 21 points ... Spurred the second-half blow out by scoring 17 points in the period, making 3s in 3-straight trips ... Added six rebounds
- **SAMFORD:** Led the team with 20 points and five assists
- **vs DUKE:** Led the team with 21 points, making 4-of-8 from deep, and adding five assists
- **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (12/8):** Averaged 17.5 points, nine assists and five rebounds in wins over #6 Louisville and Fresno State ... **vs #6 LOUISVILLE:** Recorded his **first career double-double with 17 points** and a then career-high 10 assists while adding five rebounds ... Scored 11 of his 17 points in the second half ... Specifically, Acuff finished the game scoring 9 of the Hogs' final 15 points (3-5 FG, 3-3 FT) with an assist and a rebound ... Overall, he was just the third Razorback, regardless of class, to have 10 assists versus an AP top 25 ... **vs FRESNO STATE:** Had a game-high 18 points and eight assists with just one turnover and five rebounds ... Spurred a second-half surge as he scored 11 second-half points (4-of-6 FG • 3-of-5 3PT) with five assists ... During a 22-6 run to start the second half, Acuff scored 8 of his 11 second-half points (3-3 FG • 2-2 3PT) with an assist and a steal
- **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (12/15): vs TEXAS TECH:** Repeated as SEC FOW and tabbed *Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week* ... Scored 20 points with eight assists (vs 2 turnovers) ... Was +17 in the seven-point win ... Had a personal seven-point scoring run for the Hogs in both the first and second half
- **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (12/22):** Averaged 25 points, 8.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals vs Queens and Houston ... **vs QUEENS: Became the first Razorback (on record) to have 20-plus points and 10-plus assists in a game with ZERO turnovers** ... Finished with a then career-high 23 points and tied a then career-high with 10 assists, adding a then career-best three steals ... **vs HOUSTON:** Scored a then career-high 27 points to go with seven assists and five rebounds
- **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (01/05):** Also tabbed *Naismith National Player of the Week* and *NCAA March Madness National Freshman of the Week* and *Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week* ... Averaged 23.0 points and 5.0 assists versus JMU and UT ... **JAMES MADISON:** Scored a quite 17 points, making 3-of-6 from deep, with six assists ... **TENNESSEE:** Had a then career-high 29 points (9-of-16 FG) and made two "dagger" 3-pointers in the second half ... Scored 19 second-half points ... Down two (53-51 with 12 to play), scored 16 of the Hogs' final 35 points, including a 3-pointer with 3:49 left as the shot clock was running out and a 3-pointer with 2:09 left to put the Hogs up 11

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (01/12):** Selected *SEC Freshman of the Week for a record fifth consecutive week* ... Averaged 22.5 points and 5.0 assists at Ole Miss and at Auburn ... **at Ole Miss:** Led the team with 26 points, scoring 20 in the second half ... Added 9 assists (six in the second half) ... Through scoring and assists, accounted for 49 of the Hogs 94 points ... Was a career-best 11-of-12 at the FT line ... **at Auburn:** Led Arkansas with 19 points

• **SOUTH CAROLINA:** Recorded his **third double-double with 18 points and a career-high 13 assists** ... **Had zero turnovers** - the most assists by a Razorback without a turnover ... The 13 assists ties for 6th-most by a Razorback in a game overall, is 2nd-most by a Hog in an SEC game and 2nd-most by a Razorback frosh

• **at Georgia:** Led the hogs with 20 points and six assists ... Added a **career-high four steals and career-high tying six rebounds**

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (01/26):** ... Averaged 24 points and 5.5 assists in leading Arkansas to wins over #15 Vanderbilt and LSU • **VANDERBILT:** Led the team with 17 points (3-of-7 3PT) and tied for the team lead with five assists ... **LSU:** Scored a then career-high 31 points (13-of-19 FG • 4-of-7 3PT) with six assists and a **career-high two blocked** shots ... Dominated the second half by scoring 24 points (10-of-11 FG • 3-3 3PT) with five of his six assists ... Made his final 10 shot attempts ... With Arkansas down 59-56 with 9:45 left in the game, Acuff took over ... Scored 12 of the Razorbacks' next 15 points (assisted on the other 3) to give the Hogs a 71-67 lead, a lead Arkansas would not relinquish ... Started the half with alley-oops to Trevon Brazile and Billy Richmond III ... Then, after an LSU basket, Acuff assisted on a Karter Knox 3-pointer to put the Hogs up 61-61 ... Blocked two shots, both on the same LSU possession ... First block went out of bounds and on the second one, got the rebound and went coast-to-coast for a layup and a 64-61 lead ... Scored the Razorbacks' next nine points for the 71-67 lead ... Also had two key assists inside the final five minutes, including Trevon Brazile's "dagger 3" with 50 seconds left

• **at Oklahoma:** **Posted his fourth career double-double** by leading the Hogs with 21 points and 10 assists with zero turnovers ... Down one inside the final minute, made an old-fashion 3-point play to put the Hogs up 2

• **KENTUCKY:** Led the team with 22 points, including 17 in the second half ... In fact, scored 13 in a 22-11 run to start the second half to turn a 7-point halftime deficit into a 4-point Razorback lead ... **at Miss State:** Led the Hogs with 24 points, 12 in each half, adding eight assists

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (02/16):** Selected *SEC Freshman of the Week for a record seventh time* ... Averaged 29.5 points and 6.0 assists, while shooting 62.2% from the field and 57.1% from 3-point range, in wins at LSU and versus Auburn ... **at LSU:** Tied his then career high with 13 made field goals (also did it vs LSU the first time they met) and **took a career-high 22 shots** ... Finished with 28 points and five assists ... Also tabbed *Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week* ... **AUBURN:** Tied his then career high with 31 points, while adding seven assists with just one turnover... **Posted career high, making 7 triples (7-of-10)** ... Overall, he shot an efficient 10-of-15 (67.7%) from the field ... The Hogs, up six at halftime, opened the second half with a 15-2 run ... Acuff made three 3's over the span and assisted on two of the other three baskets ... Opened the half with alley-oops to Trevon Brazile and Billy Richmond III ... Then, after a Richmond basket, Acuff made 3's on the Hogs' next three possessions to cap the 15-2 run ... Overall, Acuff accounted for 15 of the team's first 17 points in the second half with three 3's and three assists.

• **SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (02/23):** For the first time, was named the Player of the Week and, with his seven Freshman of the Week honors, he has earned the most SEC weekly honors in a season, made a career-high 11 free throws. **AP National Player of the Week, USBWA Oscar Robertson Award co-National Player of the Week and CBS Sports National Freshman of the Week** ... Averaged 34.5 points, 5.0 assists and 4.5 rebounds at No. 25 Alabama and versus Missouri ... **at Alabama:** Had one of the best games in NCAA history, scoring a **career-high 49 points** (on just 27 shot attempts) while **playing all 50 minutes – WITH JUST ONE TURNOVER** – in the double-overtime loss ... Hit a 3-pointer with 12 second left to force overtime ... During the game, set two Arkansas freshman season records for most points and most field goals made ... Overall, was 16-of-27 from the field, 6-of-10 from 3PT and 11-of-12 at the line ... **The 49 points are the most by a freshman against a team ranked in the AP Top 25 in NCAA history**, the second-most by a Razorback in a game and the most points in an SEC game by any Razorbacks player.

• **MISSOURI:** Scored 20 points with five assists and zero turnovers ... Attempted a career-high 13 free throws ... For the second-straight game and third time this season, made a career-high 11 free throws.

• **TEXAS A&M:** Scored 22 with seven assists and three steals ... Struggled in the first half, going 1-of-10 FG (0-of-3 3PT) ... In the second half, scored 17 points (6-of-9 FG) ... Took over down the stretch ... With Arkansas leading by five (67-62), made a jumper with 9:01 left ... That started a streak of making six straight field goals (6-of-7 to close the game) ... From 9:01 to 4:40, he scored 11 of the Hog's 16 points to push a 5-point lead to 13 ... Overall in the final 9:01, he **scored 17 of the Hog's final 32 points** with two assists and a steal.

• **TEXAS:** Had one of the best statistical games in the NCAA this year with 28 points and 13 assists ... Was 4-of-6 from 3-point and 8-of-10 at the line.

• **SEC TOURNAMENT MVP:** Averaged 30.3 points and 7.7 assists, shooting 43.5% (27-of-62) from 3PT, to lead Arkansas to its second SEC Tournament title and first since 2000 ... **His 30.3 points per game average is an SEC Tournament record** ... **His 91 points were the second-most by any player in SEC Tournament history, but the most by a player to only play three games.** NOTE: Tennessee's Allan Houston scored 98 points (24.5 avg) in four games in 1991 and the previous most by a player over three games was Tennessee's Dale Ellis with 80 (26.7 avg) in 1983 ... He is the first D1 player with at least 30 points and 10 assists in a conference tournament in the last 30 years ... The 11 assists are the most by a Razorback in the SEC Tournament and the most by any player for the SEC Championship game ... His 30 points tied for the second-most points in an SEC Championship game (the record is 32) ... **vs Oklahoma (SEC):** Scored 37 points – the second-most by a Razorback in the SEC Tournament - with five assists and five rebounds ... Made a key jumper with 27 seconds left off an inbound pass as the shot clock was expiring to put the Hogs up four ... **vs Ole Miss (SEC):** After a slow start - four points in the first half - finished with 24 points and seven assists ... **vs Vanderbilt (SEC):** Had 30 points and 11 assists ... **Scored or assisted on 33 or Arkansas' 39 points from 4:58 in the first to 9:08 in the 2nd half** ... Was 5-of-8 from 3-point, including 2 key 3-pointers with 49 seconds and four seconds left in the first half.

• **vs Hawai'i (NCAA):** Had 24 points and seven assists ... **Joined Meleek Thomas (21 pts & 5 assists) as the only frosh duo to have at least 20 points and five assists in an NCAA Tournament game.**

• **vs High Point (NCAA):** Led the Hogs with 38 points (23 in the second half) and six assists ... Was 3-of-6 from deep and 11-of-13 at the line ... With the score tied at 83, Acuff went on a personal 7-0 run to help secure the win, making two layups and a 3-pointer ... Sealed the win with 2 free throws with 8 seconds left ... The 36 points are the most by a Razorback in an NCAA Tournament game.

• **vs Arizona (NCAA):** Scored 28 points, going 11-of-14 at the free throw line (the 11 makes ties his career high and 14 attempts are his career high).
