Played his freshman season at Missouri before transferring to Arkansas ... Wore #2 for his first two years at Arkansas and #4 as a junior in 2024-25 ... Granted a medical redshirt for the 2022-23 season ... Participated in the 2024 NBA Draft Combine ... Became the 17th player in program history to reach 500+ points, 275+ rebounds and 75+ blocks as a Razorback ... Among those 17, he has the fewest career games played (66) and started (33).

2024-25 (Jr. at Arkansas):

• Played in 34 games with 13 starts, including each of the last nine contests ... Averaged 6.8 points and 5.4 rebounds for the season ... Led the team in total rebounds (184), was second in blocked shots (38) and was second in 3-point percentage (.364) ... However, over the last nine games, averaged 11.3 points and 9.1 rebounds with four double-doubles ... Made 16 of his 24 season 3's over the last nine games (16-of-41 / 39% 3PT) ... Missed two-plus games after rolling his ankle early in the Troy win ... Had his best overall game of the season versus Michigan in the Jimmy V Classic ... Had a career-high three steals with a season-high 13 points (6-of-8 FG; 1-3 3PT) ... Added highlight-reel dunk that was #4 Play of the Day on ESPN ... Came up with a huge blocked shot with 15 seconds left and hit a free throw with 14 ticks left to provide the eventual 89-87 final score ... Continued his strong play versus Central Arkansas with 11 points, team-best seven rebounds and a season-best five blocked shots ... Had a career-high six blocked shots versus Oakland and leading the team with eight rebounds ... Versus Georgia and facing the Hog's largest deficit (15 points with 15:24 left), Brazile sank a 3-pointer and made two free throws to start the second-half comeback ... With Adou Thiero out with an injury versus Texas (Feb. 26), Brazile stepped into the starting lineup and played one of his best games of the season ... Scored a then SEC career-best 12 points (scoring just 10 points in the previous six games) with eight rebounds ... Was 5-of-6 from the field, including 2-of-3 from 3-point, and played an SEC career-high 39:44 ... Played a key role in Arkansas leading by 12 at the half with his 10 points and six rebounds ... At Vanderbilt, registered his first double-double of the year ... Scored a season and SEC career-high 16 points with a season and SEC career-high 14 rebounds ... For the second-straight game, had a double-double versus Mississippi State with 11 points and 11 rebounds ... Only played 2:55 in the first half (0 pts, 1 reb) after picking up two quick fouls then played all 20 minutes of the second half and had a double-double in the final 20 minutes (11 pts & 10 rebs) ... Started postseason play by leading the team with a season-high with 16 points versus South Carolina in the SEC Tournament ... Added seven rebounds and a career-high four steals ... Had a key tip-in rebound with 1:38 left to put the Hogs up four ... In game two of the SEC Tourney (vs Ole Miss), recorded his third double-double in a six-game span ... Had 15 points (6-of-8 FG / 2-4 3PT) with a team-high 11 rebounds (nine in the second half) ... Had a season-high six offensive boards (all in the second half) ... Made 79 baskets for the year, 52 of the 79 came by either dunks (28) or 3-pointers (24) ... Despite missing 8-plus games, led the Hogs in rebounding a team-best 12 times ... Versus Stanford at the Battle 4 Atlantis, had a career-high 17 rebounds (career-high eight offensive) and recorded his third career double-double, adding a season-high 14 points ... Made a 3-pointer to start second OT ... Was 6-of-6 at the free throw line and played a career-high 45:52 ... The next night, versus Memphis, recorded a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds (seven offensive) ... Granted a medical redshirt after he suffered a season-ending knee (ACL) injury in the first half of the UNC Greensboro contest (game nine of the season) ... Averaged 11.8 points and 6.0 rebounds ... Was the team's top 3-point shooter (37.9%; 11-of-29) ... In the season opener versus North Dakota State, recorded his first career double-double with a then career-highs of 21 points and 12 rebounds ... Made 7-of-14 FG and a then career-high 3-of-6 3PT ... Posted his second career double-double versus South Dakota State with 13 points (5-9 FG / 1-1 3PT / 2-2 FT) and 10 rebounds ... In the Maui Invitational, scored 17 points versus Creighton, making a season-high seven field goals with a season-high three blocked shots ... Followed that with a breakout game versus San Diego State as he led his team in scoring with 20 points and added nine rebounds while playing a season-high 40:05 minutes ... Scored 18 of his 20 after halftime, including 16 in the second half (4-of-7 FG / 3-of-4 3PT / 5-of-6 FT) ... Ranked third in the SEC (47th in the NCAA) in blocked shots (1.92 average) ... Was sixth among NCAA Division I freshmen in blocked shots per game ... His 1.92 blocks per game ranked third on the Missouri single-season list ... Had a blocked shot in 20 of his 24 games played ... 2024-25 (Fr.):

One of three Hogs to play all 36 games and had 24 starts ... Averaged 8.3 points and 3.3 rebounds ... The ninth player in program history to reach 300+ points, 100+ rebounds, 30+ assists, 20+ steals and 10+ blocks as a freshman (HogStats) ... Was one of Arkansas' best players in the second half of the season ... The first 18 games, he averaged 16:39 minutes, 6.3 points and 2.8 rebounds while shooting 39.4% (39-99) from the field, 27.8% (15-of-34) from 3PT and 80% (20-of-25) at the line ... Over the final 18 games, averaged 30.9 minutes, 10.4 points, 3.8 rebounds while shooting 52.3% (57-109) from the field, 43.5% (20-of-46) from 3PT and 90.3% (53-66) at the line ... Led the team in scoring versus UMES with a career-best 21 points and was +44 in 24:10 played ... At Kentucky, scored 10 points, eight in the first half ... Hit a huge 3-pointer with 32 seconds left before halftime to give Arkansas 46-45 lead at the break ... Had two fast break dunks, one in each half ... Made four key free throws inside the final 1:10 to secure the win at Texas ... First, sank two free throws for an eight-point cushion then put the game out of reach with two free throws and 23 seconds left to put the Hogs up nine ... Had a career-high eight rebounds in the home win over LSU with nine points ... At Texas A&M, had his most efficient game scoring an SEC career-high, and led the team, with 17 points, going 7-of-9 from the field including 3-of-4 from 3-point ... Added five rebounds ... In the home win over Missouri, played a career-high 36:13 and scored 14 points (5-of-7 FG; 3-of-4 FT) ... Led the team with 11 points at South Carolina and added a career-high five assists ... 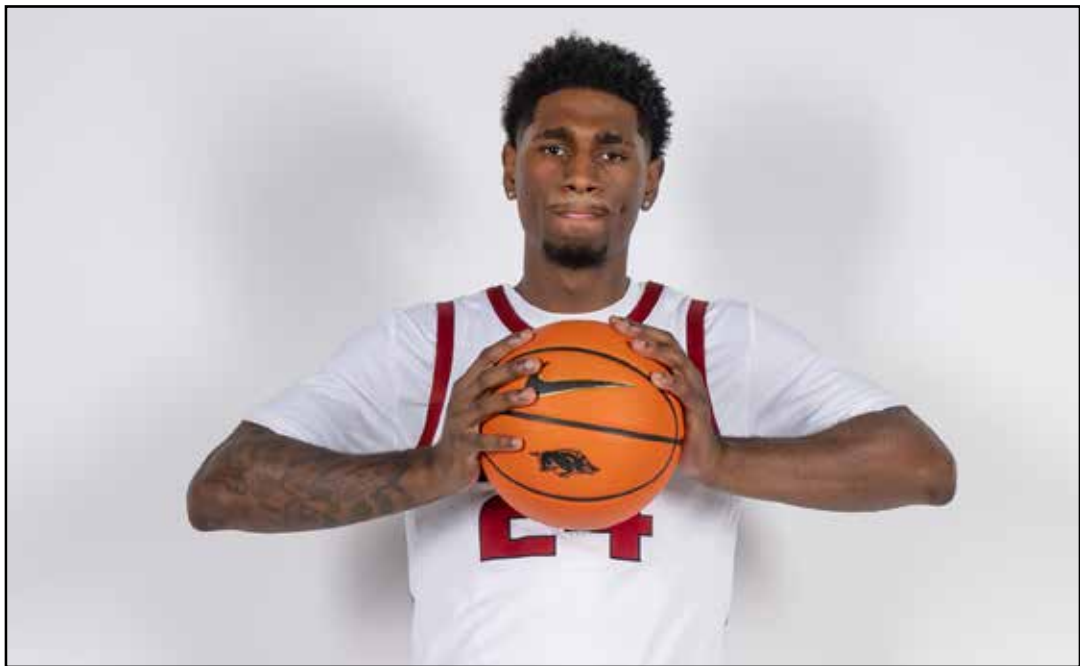
