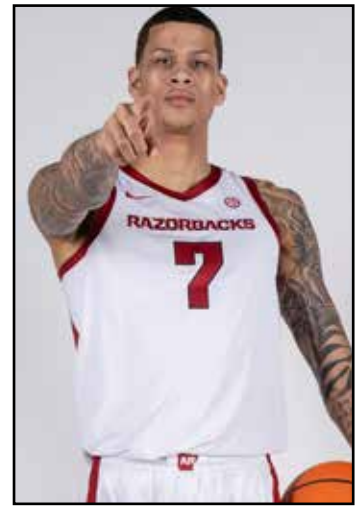

After making two free throws to put Arkansas up six and, on the TTU ensuing possession, Brazile had his aforementioned blocked shot to seal the win ... • **QUEENS:** Scored a then career-high 26 points, **making a career-high 9 FG (9-of-11) and a career-high 5 3PT (5-of-7)** ... Added three assists and three steals ... Made his first 7 shots overall, including 5 3-pointers, and scored 18 first-half points ... • **JAMES MADISON:** Stuffed the stat sheet with seven rebounds, three assists, three blocked shots and two steals ... • **TENNESSEE:** Played one of his best all-around defensive games and tied for the team lead with seven rebounds ... • **at Ole Miss:** Scored 18 points (4-of-6 3PT) ... Hit 2 key 3's inside the final minute of the first half and two 3's late in the second half to secure the win ... Tied for the team lead with six rebounds ... • **VANDERBILT:** Was praised by Coach Calipari for playing his best overall game ... Recorded his **fourth double-double with 10 points and 14 rebounds** ... The 14 boards tied his SEC career ... Had a then career-high five assists and **tied his career-high with four steals** ... • **LSU:** Had a team-best seven rebounds and a team-best three steals ... Hit a "dagger 3" with 50 seconds left that essentially secured the win ... • **at Oklahoma:** Had another solid stat line and, **for the fourth time this season, blocked a shot that essentially won the game** ... Finished with seven points, seven rebounds, four assists and two blocked shots ... **With Arkansas up two, blocked at shot with 12 seconds left that helped secure the win** ... • **KENTUCKY:** Just missed a double-double with 16 points and a team-high eight rebounds while adding three blocked shots ... • **at Miss State:** Scored 19 points with four blocked shots, four assists and eight rebounds ... For the first time in his career, played all 40 minutes in a regulation game ... • **at LSU:** Tallied his **fifth double-double** with 14 points and 12 rebounds ... Had 11 defensive boards ... **Tied his career high with four steals** ... Had a season and **SEC career-high five blocked shots** ... • **AUBURN:** Continued his strong play with 11 points, seven rebounds and four blocked shots ... In the second half, scored 9 points with three blocked shots as Arkansas was able to pull away for the 13-point win ... **at Alabama:** Played a career-high 46:37 ... Had 11 points and eight rebounds while continuing his rim protection with three blocked shots ... Had five points and two blocked shots in the two overtime periods ... • **MISSOURI:** Dished out a **career-high six assists** ... • **TEXAS A&M:** Had five assists and just missed a double-double with 14 points and eight rebounds ... • **TEXAS:** Saved his best for his last home game as a Hog ... Hit a "dagger" 3-pointer with 38 seconds left in OT to give Arkansas a 2-point lead ... Added three steals, including one with 12 seconds left to help seal the win ... • **SEC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:** Averaged 14.7 points and 10.0 rebounds with two double-doubles and **one of the best final 4 minutes in SEC Championship history** ... • **vs Oklahoma (SEC):** Had 12 points and 11 rebounds with two blocked shots ... • **vs Ole Miss (SEC):** Tallied 16 points and 10 rebounds with two steals ... His 10th rebound led to him being fouled and he went 1-of-2 at the line with three seconds left to provide the winning score ... • **vs Vanderbilt (SEC):** Continued to dominate the Commodores, scoring 16 points with 9 rebounds, three blocked shots and two steals ... Was 6-of-9 from the field and 4-of-5 from 3PT ... Up 2 inside 4 minutes to play, Brazile scored 8 points in a 12-0 run with a pair of 3-pointers and a dunk with a steal, a deflection and a blocked shot ... • **vs Hawaii'i (NCAA):** Had 19 points, 6 rebounds and three blocked shots ... Had three dunks, including one highlight-reel slam ... • **vs High Point (NCAA):** Just missed a double-double with 8 points and 8 rebounds, adding four assists.

2024-25 (Jr. at Arkansas):

• Played in 34 games with 13 starts, including each of the last nine contests ... Averaged 6.8 points and 5.4 rebounds for the season ... Led the team in total rebounds (184), was second in blocked shots (38) and was second in 3-point percentage (.364) ... However, over the last nine games, averaged 11.3 points and 9.1 rebounds with four double-doubles ... Made 16 of his 24 season 3's over the last nine games (16-of-41 / 39% 3PT) ... Missed two-plus games after rolling his ankle early in the Troy win ... Had his best overall game of the season versus Michigan in the Jimmy V Classic ... Had a career-high three steals with a season-high 13 points (6-of-8 FG; 1-3 3PT) ... Added highlight-reel dunk that was #4 Play of the Day on ESPN ... Came up with a huge blocked shot with 15 seconds left and hit a free throw with 14 ticks left to provide the eventual 89-87 final score ... Continued his strong play versus Central Arkansas with 11 points, team-best seven rebounds and a season-best five blocked shots ... Had a career-high six blocked shots versus Oakland and leading the team with eight rebounds ... Versus Georgia and facing the Hog's largest deficit (15 points with 15:24 left), Brazile sank a 3-pointer and made two free throws to start the second-half comeback ... With Adou Thiero out with an injury versus Texas (Feb. 26), Brazile stepped into the starting lineup and played one of his best games of the season ... Scored a then SEC career-best 12 points (scoring just 10 points in the previous six games) with eight rebounds ... Was 5-of-6 from the field, including 2-of-3 from 3-point, and played an SEC career-high 39:44 ... Played a key role in Arkansas leading by 12 at the half with his 10 points and six rebounds ... At Vanderbilt, registered his first double-double of the year ... Scored a season and SEC career-high 16 points with a season and SEC career-high 14 rebounds ... For the second-straight game, had a double-double versus Mississippi State with 11 points and 11 rebounds ... Only played 2:55 in the first half (0 pts, 1 reb) after picking up two quick fouls then played all 20 minutes of the second half and had a double-double in the final 20 minutes (11 pts & 10 rebs) ... Started postseason play by leading the team with a season-high with 16 points versus South Carolina in the SEC Tournament ... Added seven rebounds and a career-high four steals ... Had a key tip-in rebound with 1:38 left to put the Hogs up four ... In game two of the SEC Tournament (vs Ole Miss), recorded his third double-double in a six-game span ... Had 15 points (6-of-8 FF / 2-4 3PT) with a team-high 11 rebounds (nine in the second half) ... Had a season-high six offensive boards (all in the second half) ... Led Arkansas in the second half with 11 points (4-of-4 FG / 2-2 3PT) and nine boards while playing all 20 minutes ... In the NCAA opener versus Kansas, recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 11 points and 12 rebounds ... Only played 8 minutes in the first half due to foul trouble but had eight points and nine boards with two blocks in the second half ... Versus St. John's, just missed a double-double with eight points and eight rebounds ... Threw down two impressive dunks ... In the Sweet 16, had 11 points versus Texas Tech, including a 3-pointer with 1:24 left in OT to tie the game at 81-81.

Ranked ninth in the SEC in blocked shots/game (1.23) and 13th in total blocked shots (32) ... Also ranked 13th in the SEC with four double-doubles ... Made 79 baskets for the year, 52 of the 79 came by either dunks (28) or 3-pointers (24) ... Despite missing 8-plus games, led the Hogs in rebounding a team-best 12 times ... Versus Stanford at the Battle 4 Atlantis, had a career-high 17 rebounds (career-high eight offensive) and recorded his third career double-double, adding a season-high 14 points ... Made a 3-pointer to start second OT ... Was 6-of-6 at the free throw line and played a career-high 45:52 ... The next night, versus Memphis, recorded a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds (seven offensive) ... For the third time in four games, had a double-double versus Duke and earned SEC Player of the Week honor ... Had 19 points and 11 rebounds ... Was 6-of-9 FG, making a career-high four 3-pointers ... All 11 rebounds were on the defensive end ... Added two blocked shots ... Hit a key 3-pointer with 2:16 left to put the Hogs up 12 ... In the SEC opener versus Auburn, had 11 points (with three dunks) and led the team with seven rebounds and three blocked shots ... In his first full game back (after an 8-game absence), led the team with six rebounds in just 16:40 played versus Vanderbilt ... At Alabama, scored 12 points, tying a season-highs and getting SEC career-highs in field goals made (6) and attempted (12) ... Added six rebounds - five offensive ... In the SEC Tournament opener versus Vanderbilt, recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 13 points and 12 rebounds (9 defensive) ... Was 3-of-6 from 3-point range and led the team with four blocked shots ... *For the 2023-24 preseason, was 1 of 50 on the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year Trophy Preseason Watch List, 1 of 20 on the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List and preseason first team All-SEC by media and coaches.*

2022-23 (So. at Arkansas):

Granted a medical redshirt after he suffered a season-ending knee (ACL) injury in the first half of the UNC Greensboro contest (game nine of the season) ... Averaged 11.8 points and 6.0 rebounds ... Was the team's top 3-point shooter (37.9%; 11-of-29) ... In the season opener versus North Dakota State, recorded his first career double-double with a then career-highs of 21 points and 12 rebounds ... Made 7-of-14 FG and a then career-high 3-of-6 3PT ... Posted his second career double-double versus South Dakota State with 13 points (5-9 FG • 1-1 3PT • 2-2 FT) and 10 rebounds ... In the Maui Invitational, scored 17 points versus Creighton, making a season-high seven field goals with a season-high three blocked shots ... Followed that with a breakout game versus San Diego State as he led his team in scoring with 20 points and added nine rebounds while playing a season-high 40:05 minutes ... Scored 18 of his 20 after halftime, including 16 in the second half (4-of-7 FG • 3-of-4 3PT • 5-of-6 FT) ... Had a key steal with Arkansas down two and seven seconds left to set-up the game-tying basket to force overtime ... In his final full game prior to the injury - versus San Jose State - led his team in scoring with a career-high 23 points ... Was a career-best 8-of-9 from the field and made a career-high six free throws (6-of-8 FT).

2021-22 (Freshman at Mizzou):

Missed the first eight games of the season with an undisclosed medical condition ... Came off the bench in his first two games played for the season (Eastern Illinois and at Kansas) before starting the final 22 games of the year ... Played in 24 games with 22 starts last season and led the Tigers in blocked shots in 20 games ... Averaged 6.3 points and 5.0 rebounds ... Ranked third in the SEC (47th in the NCAA) in blocked shots (1.92 average) ... Was sixth among NCAA Division I freshmen in blocked shots per game ... His 1.92 blocks per game ranked third on the Missouri single-season list ... Had a blocked shot in 20 of his 24 games played ... Recorded a block in 12-straight games, including a stretch of 11-straight with multiple blocks ... Had a career-high six blocks against Illinois, which tied for the fourth-most in a single game by any Mizzou player and the third-most by any MU freshman ... Added 11 points ... Scored a season-high 15 points in the Tigers' season finale versus LSU in the SEC Tournament ... Had a season-high 10 rebounds with four blocked shots in the Tigers' regular-season finale versus Georgia, including five offensive boards ... Made a season-high 2-of-3 from 3-point range and scored 10 points with two blocked shots at Kansas ... Recorded 11 points at LSU ... Just missed a double-double in the first-round SEC Tournament win over Ole Miss with nine points and nine rebounds ... Had a season high in free throws made and attempts (5-of-7) ... Had five-plus rebounds 14 times (including eight times with seven-plus boards).
