Morantes a Finalist for Strickland Award

- Associate head coach **Gustavo Morantes** (*Pronounced Goose-Tah-Vo More-Ahn-Tess*) was one of five finalists for the 2026 Jan Strickland Outstanding Division I Assistant Coach Award.
- Other finalists are Dustin Groves (UVA), Noah Goldman (UNC), Jace Long (LSU), and James Vargas (TX Tech).
- Morantes leads the Razorbacks' recruiting efforts and the 2026 class was ranked ninth by the Golf Channel. The class includes two of the top 25 recruits in the world, with Lev Grinberg ranking 13th and Guus Lafeber ranking 21st. In his first year with the Hogs, Morantes helped land the #4 recruiting class in the nation, headlined by #14 Gerardo Gomez and #22 Erich Fortlage.
- Prior to Morantes coming to Arkansas, the Razorbacks had only won two team events in the previous four years. Since joining the program for the 2023-24 season, Arkansas has won six team events, including three this season.

Regional Streak Reaches 18; 27th NCAA App

- Arkansas is making its 27th NCAA Championship dating back to 1971. Five additional times an individual qualified for nationals, including 1963 NCAA champion R.H. Sikes.
- Arkansas earned an NCAA Regional bid for the 32nd time in the 37-year history of NCAA Regionals (starting 1989).
- Arkansas has an NCAA Regional streak of 18 years (note, there was no postseason in 2020 due to COVID).
 - ^ That ties LSU, Illinois and Virginia for the 10th-longest current consecutive streak for a team berth at an NCAA Regional. Oklahoma State and Texas are the only teams to play in all 37 NCAA Regionals.
