Head Coach
Fifth Season

Matilda Mossman is in her fifth season at The University of Tulsa after being appointed as the head women's basketball coach on March 22, 2011. Mossman took over a five-win team and in just her second year won a conference championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

In her first season at the helm of the program, the Hurricane posted 13 wins, and finished league play with an 8-8 record and a sixth-place finish, but a year later, the program took another big step forward as the Hurricane captured the Conference USA tournament title, advanced to the NCAA Tournament and posted the first non-losing record (17-17) since 2006.

During the 2013-14 season, Tulsa posted a 12-16 overall record, including a 6-10 mark in Conference USA, but bounced back to tally the first winning record (18-14) since 2006 and advance to the WNIT Second Round during the 2014-15 season.

During her tenure, Mossman has coached two-time all-Conference USA performer Taleya Mayberry, and helped Kelsee Grovey earn C-USA All-Freshman team accolades, as well as Mayberry, Grovey and Tiffani Couisnard receive C-USA All-Tournament team recognition in 2013. She also coached Ashley Clark to all-C-USA second team accolades as a sophomore, and second team all-conference accolades and Sixth Man of the Year recognition as a junior in the American Athletic Conference.

In 13 years as a collegiate head coach, Mossman has registered an overall 207-158 record. She had a 67-27 mark at Arkansas (1981-84), an 80-66 mark at Kansas State (1984-89), and has a 60-65 record in five seasons at Tulsa. She also coached on the high school level for nine seasons. In 22 years as a head coach, Mossman has compiled a 398-211 record for a .653 winning percentage.

Mossman earned a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1979 and her graduate degree in education in 1980, both from Western Kentucky.

She has two sons, Scott and Matt.

#### **Tulsa to Face Arkansas on Monday**

The Tulsa women's basketball team will take to the road to face Arkansas on Monday, November 23. Game time is set for 7:00 pm at Bud Walton Arena in Fayetteville, Ark.

#### The Last Game

Oral Roberts held off the Tulsa Golden Hurricane to capture a 59-53 victory in the annual PSO Mayor's Cup at the Donald W. Reynolds Center Friday night in front of 1,171 fans.

Tulsa freshman Crystal Polk had a game-high 13 points, while senior Kelsee Grovey added 12 points.

Shooting was a struggle for TU, as the Hurricane shot 32-percent from the fleld and just 12-percent from three-point range.

### The Opponent

Arkansas has a 2-1 overall record, but are coming off a 69-76 loss to South Dakota State on November 18th. The Lady Razorbacks are led by Jessica Jackson with a team-best 19.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. Kelsey Brooks also averages double-digit points with 11.0, followed closely by Jordan Danberry with 9.7 ppg.

#### **Series History**

This is the 22nd meeting between Tulsa and Arkansas, as UA leads the series, 19-2. The Razorbacks have won the last flve-straight games, including a 64-53 decision in Tulsa last season.

#### On the Bench

The Golden Hurricane returns eight letterwinners, including three starters, and one squad member, and welcomes flve newcomers this season. The roster features three seniors - Ashley Clark, Kelsee Grovey and Antoinet Webster; four juniors - Ashley Hughes, Jessica Pongonis, Teanna Reid and Te'era Williams; three sophomores - Jordyn Holmes, Liesl Spoerl and Erika Wakefleld; and four freshmen - Jasmine Butler, Tatyana Perez, Crystal Polk and Tyjae' Scales.

#### **Returning Starters**

Tulsa returns three starters from last season, including seniors Ashley Clark and Kelsee Grovey, and junior Teanna Reid. Clark averaged 14.5 ppg, 7.6 rpg and 2.1 apg, Grovey added 10.8 ppg, 2.5 rpg, 2.2 apg and 1.5 spg, and Reid tallied 7.1 ppg, 3.4 rpg, 3.1 apg and 1.4 spg.

### Clark Named to The American Preseason Team; Hurricane Picked Sixth

Tulsa guard Ashley Clark was named to the American Athletic Conference preseason all-conference second team, while the team was picked to flnish sixth in the Preseason Coaches' Poll.

In the coaches' poll, UConn was predicted to win the 2015-16 American Athletic Conference Championship, while USF was second and Temple third. East Carolina, Tulane, Tulsa, Memphis, SMU, UCF, Cincinnati and Houston round out the poll.

#### Adding Up

Tulsa junior Ashley Clark became the ninth women's basketball player in school history to score 1,000 career points and one game later Kelsee Grovey tallied her 1,000th point. Clark currently has 1,092 points and Grovey has 1,064 points.

#### Mossman Has 207 Career Wins

Matilda Mossman reached the 200-win milestone as Tulsa captured a 70-61 win over UCF on Jan. 31, 2015. Mossman had 67 wins at Arkansas, 80 wins at Kansas State and currently 60 wins at TU for 207 career victories.

#### In Tulsa's Top 10

Five current Tulsa women's basketball players have earned their way into Tulsa's Top 10 career lists.

- Ashley Clark is third in double-doubles (11), flfth in fleld goals made (430), seventh in rebounds (580), eighth in points (1,092), ninth in assists (217) and 10th in free throws made (193)
- Kelsee Grovey is second in three-point fleld goals made (169), eighth in assists (237) and free throw percentage with a .810 clip (171 of 211), ninth in fleld goals made (362) and three-point fleld goal percentage with a .362 clip (169 of 466), and 10th in points (1,064) and steals (138)
- Ashley Hughes is fourth in free throw percentage with a .833 clip (20 of 24) and 10th in three-point fleld goal percentage with a .358 clip (24 of 67)
- Teanna Reid is first in three-point field goal percentage with a .424 clip (36 of 85)
- Antoinet Webster is 10th in free throw percentage with a .809 clip (29 of 38)

#### The Non-Conference Slate

Tulsa's 11-game non-conference slate features seven games against 2015 postseason teams, flve home contests, including games against Oklahoma and Kansas State of the Big 12, and a trip to Las Vegas for the UNLV Lady Rebel Round-Up.

All 12 of TU's potential non-conference opponents finished last year with double-digit wins, while Arkansas, Oklahoma and UALR competed in the NCAA Tournament; Drake, Kansas State and Northern Iowa played in the WNIT; and Oral Roberts participated in the WBI.

Tulsa will play host to 10-time National Champion UConn, as well as NCAA Tournament participants USF and Tulane, in American Athletic Conference action.

Six teams in The American advanced to postseason play last year, as East Carolina, Temple and Tulsa competed in the Women's National Invitation Tournament.

### **UConn to Host American Championship**

UConn will host the 2016 American Athletic Conference Championship at Mohegan Sun Arena in Uncasville, Conn., from March 4-7.

### Tulsa Women's Hoops to Have 12 Games Broadcast Live

The Tulsa women's basketball team will play 12 games that will be broadcast live on either television or internet. The Hurricane will play six games on the American Digital Network, three games on ESPN3, two games on both ESPN3 and SportsNet New York (SNY), and one on ESPNU.

#### **Tulsa in Postseason**

Tulsa has made flve postseason appearances, including WNIT bids in 2004, 2005 and 2015, and NCAA bids in 2006 and 2013. TU lost in the flrst round in 2004 (Memphis), 2005 (Texas A&M) and 2013 (Stanford), but went 1-1 (W, North Carolina State; L, DePaul) in 2006 and 2015 (W, Missouri State; L, Eastern Michigan), for a 2-5 overall mark in postseason play.

#### Tulsa in The American

After nine seasons as a member of Conference USA, The University of Tulsa began its membership in the American Athletic Conference on July 1, 2014. The American membership consists of 11 institutions: Cincinnati, East Carolina, Houston, Memphis, SMU, Temple, Tulane, Tulsa, UCF, UConn and USF.

#### A Hurricane in Tulsa?

The Origination of The University of Tulsa nickname - Golden Hurricane - was created in 1922. A new football coach, Howard Archer came to town and inherited a slew of nicknames dating back to 1895. In the past, Tulsa had been named "Kendallites," "Presbyterians," "Tigers," "Orange and Black," "Tulsans," and of course, "Yellow Jackets." The team started working out in the fall with a new nickname "Yellow Jackets" which was apparently due to the fact that the team was wearing new black and yellow uniforms. The team opened the season and it was apparent that Tulsa was going to have a great year, and trying to seize some publicity for his team, Archer wanted to find a new nickname quickly. After a remark was made in practice one day about "roaring through opponents," and because of their new jersey colors, he thought of "Golden Tornadoes." But a check showed that Georgia Tech already had chosen that tag in 1917. From the tornado, he evolved meteorologically to the hurricane. A few days before the team left for a game against Texas A&M, Archer asked the squad to vote on the name, and thus "Golden Hurricane" was born.
