LEADING OFF --

- No. 22 Arkansas opens its 94th season of baseball and 14th under head coach Dave Van Horn this weekend by hosting defending Mid-American Conference (MAC) West Division champs Central Michigan at Baum Stadium. All three games will be available on SEC Network+ and the WatchESPN app.
- Arkansas enters the season ranked in four preseason polls, highlighted by the No. 22 spot in both the USA Today Coaches poll and the USBWA poll. Arkansas played its last 24 games in 2015 ranked in the top 25.
- Arkansas was tabbed to finish third in the SEC West in the preseason SEC Coaches Poll released on Thursday.
- The Razorbacks are 45-11 in season openers since the 1960 season, including 21 consecutive wins. Arkansas is 13-0 in season openers under coach Van Horn, outscoring its opponents 114-31 along the way.
- Arkansas has opened its season at Baum Stadium in each of the last eight years dating back to 2008, compiling a 22-2 record, while winning all eight threegames series.
- Fueled by a 91-15 (.858) mark under coach Van Horn, Arkansas is 256-75-1 (.771) all-time in the month of February.
- Entering this weekend's series against Central Michigan, the Razorbacks have won 15 straight and 19 of their last 20 at Baum Stadium in February. Under coach Van Horn, Arkansas is 68-5 at Baum Stadium in February, winning its first 21 games under the skipper.

Fast Start

Arkansas has put together seven 40-win seasons in the last nine years under head coach Dave Van Horn. A big part of the Razorbacks' seven 40-win campaigns has been getting off to a hot start. Under Van Horn, Arkansas is 91-15 in the month of February. Below is a year-by-year breakdown in the month of February under coach Van Horn, including Arkansas' home record and run production.

The Road To Omaha

- The Razorbacks are one of just five teams in the nation to advance to the NCAA Tournament each of the last 14 years. Arkansas is joined by Cal State Fullerton, Florida State, Miami (Fla.) and Rice as the only programs to accomplish the feat.
- The Razorbacks are one of 10 teams in the country to advance to at least three of the last seven College World Series, joining Florida, LSU, North Carolina, South Carolina, TCU, Texas, UCLA, Vanderbilt and Virginia.

Opening Day Starters

For the fifth time in the last six years and the 10th time under head coach Dave Van Horn, a right-hander will start opening day for Arkansas when junior Dominic Taccolini delivers the first pitch of the 2016 campaign.

- Out of 11 pitchers (DJ Baxendale started twice and James Teague is a junior) that have started opening day for Van Horn, nine have been drafted, including six top 10 round selections.
- The Arkansas starter has won 11 times during Arkansas' current 13-0 record in season openers under
- DJ Baxendale (2011, 12) and Dallas Keuchel (2008, 09) are the last two Arkansas pitchers to earn the win in back-to-back season openers. Keuchel's first season-opening win came in relief in 2008 when he tossed 5.1 no-hit innings with six strikeouts. Over his two appearances on opening day, Keuchel went 2-0 with 11 strikeouts while allowing just two earned runs and four hits over 11.1 innings of work.

Schedule by the Numbers

Arkansas' regular season schedule features **31** games against teams ranked in one of the preseason top 25 polls.

Arkansas will take on 13 different opponents in the regular season who will start the season in the top 25.

Starting in late April into May, Arkansas will take on 11 straight opponents ranked in a preseason top 25 poll.

Van Horn by the Numbers

- Dave Van Horn made his sixth career appearance in the College World Series during the 2015 season, more than any other head coach in the SEC.
- In his 13 seasons at Arkansas, Van Horn has led the Razorbacks to four College World Series appearances, five Super Regionals and 13 NCAA Tournament berths.
- The skipper eclipsed the 500-win mark at Arkansas on April 5 against Auburn and has a total of 524 wins, averaging more than 40 wins per season.

Quick Hits

- The Razorbacks have won 40 or more games in six of the last seven seasons.
- Arkansas is the only team in the SEC to advance to each of the last 14 NCAA Regionals, and head coach Dave Van Horn is the only current head coach in the league to make six appearances in the College World Series.
- Arkansas had four players selected in the 2015 MLB Draft, as Andrew Benintendi went seventh overall to the Boston Red Sox, Trey Killian went in the ninth round to the Colorado Rockies, Bobby Wernes went in the 30th round to the Houston Astros and Tyler Spoon went in the 35th round to the Boston Red Sox. The Razorbacks have had 21 players drafted in the last the years.

Scouting Central Michigan

- The reigning MAC West champs, Central Michigan was picked to defend their title in the preseason coaches poll released on Wednesday.
- The Chippewas posted a 35-22 record last year, including a 20-7 mark in MAC play.
- Friday starter Sean Renzi began last season in the bullpen before emerging as the staff ace during the conference regular season en route to earning All-MAC first team honors.
- Central Michigan visited Baum Stadium in 1998 for the only two meetings between the two programs. Arkansas won the two mid-week non-conference tilts, 4-2 and 7-2, respectively.

The Baum Way

- Arkansas finished No. 2 in the country in average attendance for the third straight year with 8,290 fans per game in 2015. The Razorbacks posted school records in actual attendance and tickets sold for a single
- The actual crowd of 12.167 against Missouri State on June 6 was the largest crowd in Baum Stadium history. The 12,167 fans also marked the third largest Super Regional crowd in NCAA history.
- After setting the Baum Stadium attendance record in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional with 11,869, Razorback fans followed suit Saturday, breaking the record in less than 24 hours with 12,167 on hand. In the Fayetteville Super Regional, three of the top four attendance marks at the eight Super Regional sites were all at Baum Stadium, totaling 35,730 over the three games. Game 1: 11,869 | Game 2: 12,167 | Game 3:11.694
- The three NCAA Fayetteville Super Regional crowds marked the three largest crowds in Baum Stadium
- Arkansas was home to three of the top four postseason crowds in 2015 during Regionals and Super
- The 12,589 tickets sold against Mississippi State on April 25 marked the 14th largest on-campus crowd in NCAA history.

Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic

All three of Arkansas' games against No. 20 Rice, No. 12 Houston and No. 25 Texas Tech at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic held at Minute Maid Park in Houston next weekend can be seen on national TV. All three of Arkansas' games will be live nationally on MLB Network, but blacked out in Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Louisiana and New Mexico. The games will be broadcast in those aforementioned states on Cox Sports or Root Sports Southwest found on AT&T U-Verse (Ch. 758 and Ch. 1758) and DirecTV (Ch. 674).

Benintendi was selected by the Boston Red Sox with the seventh overall pick in the 2015 MLB Draft. He was the third-highest draft pick in program history and the eighth Razorback to be taken in • the first round.



Now entering his 14th season at the helm of the Arkansas [baseball program in 2015-16, head coach Dave Van Horn continues to elevate the Razorbacks to one of the nation's premier teams year in and year out. Over his first 13 seasons, Van Horn has led Arkansas to four College World Series appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament berths, one Southeastern Conference overall title, three SEC Western Division championships and a total of 524 wins, averaging more than 40 wins a season.

The Razorbacks defied all the odds in 2015, rebounding from a 15-15 record on April 4 to win 18 of their final 25 regular season games and surge into postseason play. After going 2-2 in the SEC Tournament, Arkansas became one of five teams in the country to advance to 14 consecutive NCAA Tournaments, claiming the No. 2 seed in the Stillwater Regional hosted by Oklahoma State.

In what is likely Van Horn's best coaching job in his 27-year career, the Razorbacks went 3-0 in the Stillwater Regional and came back home to host the second Super Regional in program history, knocking off Missouri State in three games for the most improbable College World Series appearance in Arkansas' storied history. Van Horn made his sixth trip to Omaha, including his fourth as the Razorback skipper. He currently has more College World Series appearances than any head coach in the SEC.

During the run to Omaha, sophomore outfielder Andrew Benintendi put together arguably the finest season in Razorback history. Benintendi became the first Arkansas player to win the Golden Spikes Award, given annually to the nation's best amateur player. He also won the Dick Howser Trophy and was named Baseball America Player of the Year and Collegiate Baseball Player of the Year as the nation's best collegiate player.



GAME CREDENTIALS

Credential requests should be made no later than noon (CT) the day before the scheduled contest and should be directed by e-mail to Patrick Pierson. Credential requests for away games should be made to the communications contact of the home team. Only fully accredited personnel directly involved in the coverage of the game will be admitted. Credentials are non-transferable.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Please direct all requests for interviews with coaches and players to Patrick Pierson. For home SEC weekends, Coach Dave Van Horn will hold his weekly press conference on Thursday with players and assistant coaches available prior to Thursday's practice. On road SEC weekends, Coach Van Horn will hold his weekly press conference on Wednesday with players and assistant coaches available prior to Wednesday's practice. Players are not available for interviews on gamedays, except for post-game interviews. Post-game press conferences are held in the indoor batting cages located down the third base line. Coach Van Horn will address the media first, followed by the two or three most requested Razorback players. In the event of a doubleheader, the only Arkansas player available between games for interviews is the starting pitcher of game one. The Arkansas clubhouse is off limits to the media at all times.

E-MAIL UPDATES

Members of the media may request to be added to the Arkansas communications baseball e-mail group. Subscribers will receive game notes, game stories and other information. To subscribe, send a request to David Beall. Please identify yourself and your organization in your request as this service is only available to members of the media.

GAMEDAY MEDIA SERVICES

The Arkansas communications staff provides scorecards, rosters, updated statistics and results for each team in the Baum Stadium press box prior to home games. Box scores, play-by-play and any postgame notes are disseminated approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game. An Associated Press-style game story is also produced by the communications office. Members of the media may request these stories be sent to their organization via e-mail by contacting a member of the communications office.

RAZORBACK SPORTS NETWORK

For the 24th consecutive season, every pitch of the Arkansas baseball season can be heard on the Razorback Sports Network from IMG College. The network spans the state of Arkansas and can also be heard in neighboring states as well as across the globe via the internet. The Razorback Baseball Radio Network is one of the largest collegiate baseball radio networks in the nation. With more than 20 affiliates, Razorback baseball games are never more than a dial away no matter where an Arkansas fan resides.
