RAZORBACK NOTES

ALL-TIME SERIES VS ALABAMA

Arkansas owns a 32-11 advantage in the program's alltime series against Alabama. However, the Crimson Tide has won the last four meetings. The Razorbacks have won 18 of 22 matches played against Alabama in Fayetteville.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS AUBURN

Arkansas owns a 35-9 lead in the program's all-time series against Auburn. The Razorbacks are 17-3 in matches played at Barnhill Arena. The teams split the two meetings last season. Arkansas has won six of the last nine.

VALLE CRACKS TOP 20

With her fourth dig vs No. 23 Kentucky (Oct. 14), sophomore libero Okiana Valle moved into the program's top 20 in career digs. She averaged 6.29 digs per set last weekend in road matches at Kentucky and Tennessee, and enters the weekend third in the SEC at 4.07 digs per set.

BUILDING BLOCKS

With a season-high eight total blocks at Tennessee (Oct. 16), Ana Sofia Jusino became the 15th player in program history with 300 career blocks. With 11 matches left, she is 50 blocks shy of cracking the program's top-10 list.

SEASON HIGH FOR JONES

In a season-high performance, Breana Jones registered a season-high 13 kills at Tennessee (Oct. 16) to go along with a .423 hitting percentage. She enters the weekend hitting .360 in SEC play, good for ninth in the conference.

500 FOR HARBIN

With her third kill against Texas A&M (Oct. 5), Danielle Harbin became the 32nd player in program history to record 500 career kills. With double figures in 15 of 19 matches this season, Harbin enters the weekend second in the SEC and 35th in the NCAA with 4.13 kills per set.

CAREER HIGH FOR ROBINSON

In response to her second-career start, freshman Reagan Robinson put down nine kills at Missouri (Oct. 9). She replaced her previous best of seven kills off the bench against Kansas State (Sept. 16).

IT'S A FIRST

Senior co-captain Danielle Harbin had 22 kills and 10 digs against Ole Miss (Oct. 2) for the first double-double of her career. The 10 digs also represented a career best.

SEASON HIGH FOR DAPIC

Senior Barbara Dapic put down a season-high 14 kills in a five setter at Ole Miss (Oct. 2). In the process, she posted a .409 hitting percentage. It was her third double-digit performance of the year, and 12th of her career.

TRIO IN DOUBLE FIGURES

For the second time this season, Arkansas had a three players reach double figures (at Ole Miss, Oct. 2). Danielle Harbin had a match-high 22 kills. She was joined by Barbara Dapic (14) and Savannah Voelzke (11). Arkansas also accomplished the feat against Chicago State (Sept. 2).

A GOOD (SEC) START

With a win over LSU (Sept. 25), Arkansas has won its last four SEC openers. Overall, the Razorbacks are 14–9 in SEC openers and improved to 28–18 against LSU.

SEASON-HIGH TEAM EFFICIENCY

Arkansas opened SEC play with a season-best .374 hitting percentage in a road sweep of LSU (Sept. 25). The Razor-backs had a season-low 10 attack errors in the match.

HARBIN JOINS 25-KILL CLUB

With her effort against UMKC (Sept. 17), senior co-captain Danielle Harbin became the 18th player in program history to reach 25 (or more) kills in a match.

TOP-10 HOME CROWD

In hosting No. 25 Kansas State (Sept. 16), the Razorbacks played in front of 1,283 fans, the ninth-largest home crowd in program history. Five of the top-10 attendance figures have come over the past three seasons.

DEFENSIVE HIGH

Senior Savannah Voelzke tallied a pair of career highs with 17 digs and five total blocks against Southern Miss (Sept. 16). She has four double-doubles this season and ranks second on the team with 2.64 digs per set.

ALL-TOURNAMENT PERFORMANCE

For the second–consecutive weekend to open the season, senior co–captain Danielle Harbin earned all–tournament accolades for her work during the Kansas Invitational. She averaged 4.15 kills per set in three matches with a career high of 22 kills against No. 4 Kansas.

BIG BLOCK

In pushing No. 4 Kansas to five sets (Sept. 3), seniors Breana Jones and Barbara Dapic tallied career highs of 11 and 10 blocks, respectively. Jones enters the week with six matches of four or more total blocks.

THE GIRL IN THE DIFFERENT JERSEY

Sophomore libero Okiana Valle collected a season-high 28 digs against No. 4 Kansas (Sept. 3), a mark that also equals the high mark in the SEC this season. In three matches at the Kansas Invitational, she averaged 5.00 digs per set.

OPENING ACT

Senior Danielle Harbin tied her then-career high with 14 kills in the season opener at No. 14 Illinois (Aug. 26), tying the mark first established as a freshman in 2012. She went on to earn Illini Classic All-Tournament Team accolades.

In pacing the team with 11 kills against Xavier (Aug. 27), senior Barbara Dapic tallied the 10th double-digit effort of her career. She equaled that mark with 11 kills in a fourset win over Chicago State (Sept. 2).

SEC PRESEASON VOTE

For a second-consecutive year, the Razorbacks have been picked to finish fifth in the SEC with the release of the league's preseason coaches' poll. Additionally, senior Pilar Victoria was voted to the Preseason All-SEC Team.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN



GRADUATE SALUTE

Senior middle blocker Ana Sofia Jusino is one of 11 Razorback student-athletes competing this fall that has earned their degree with remaining eligibility. In recognition, those student-athletes will wear an SEC Graduate patch on their jerseys during competition.

WATSON ERA

Jason Watson is in his first season as Arkansas' head coach and 12th overall after stops at BYU and Arizona State. He becomes the third head coach in program history. Watson owns a 200-147 career record entering the year.

Associate head coach Jon Newman-Gonchar represented Team USA this summer as a member of the coaching staff at the Pan American Cup. The team came away with bronze during the two-week event in the Dominican Republic.


