#### **RAZORBACK NOTES**

ROAD TRIPPIN' - Arkansas will hit the road for the first time in 2017 when it travels to Ruston, La., for a two-game midweek series with C-USA foe Louisiana Tech. The Hogs will be away from Baum Stadium for the next five games before returning home on March 7 to face ULM. Arkansas has won at least 15 games away from Baum Stadium in four of the last five seasons including 13 true road victories in 2015 en route to a berth in the College World Series.

BIG AL GETS THE CALL - Redshirt senior Josh Alberius will make his first career start on the mound Tuesday night against Louisiana Tech. Alberius has had an interesting road to this point. Recruited as an infielder. Alberius was moved to the outfield upon arriving on campus and became a full-time pitcher in 2015. Over the last three seasons including this year. Alberius has

made 50 appearances and has garnered a 3.49 career ERA. He was one of Arkansas' most effective pitchers out of the bullpen in 2016, striking out 40 batters, good for fourth on the team, in only 32.1 innings.

THE BIG STICK - After a brief slow start to the vear, catcher Grant Koch has become the hottest hitter for the Razorbacks through six games. Last week against Bryant, Koch went 7-for-15 (.467) and hit his second home run of the year along with one double and one triple. Currently hitting a team-leading .407, the Fayetteville native is having the best six-game start, offensively, by a Razorback catcher in 13 years. Brady Toops began the 2004 season hitting .421 with seven RBIs, three doubles, and two walks, but Koch has topped him with nine RBIs, two home runs, which both lead the team.

#### **RAZORBACK NOTES (CONT'D)**

HOT OFF THE BENCH - Freshman Jaxon Williams has only started in one game and appeared in four games this year, but his pinch-hitting approach may be earning him more playing time in the future. Last weekend, Williams came off the bench to pinch hit for Hunter Wilson in the sixth inning with Arkansas down by four. Williams hit a two RBI single, which led to a go-ahead Jake Arledge home run. Williams ended up recording five RBIs in the game, which were the most by a Razorback freshman since Dominic Ficociello in 2011 against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Williams currently is tied for the team lead with nine RBIs in only seven at-bats.

#### **HOGS CRACK INTO NATIONAL RANKINGS -**

Arkansas' offensive outburst through the first two weekends of the season have been noticed by the national publications as D1Baseball.com placed the Hogs at No. 24 in their Week 2 rankings. Its the first national ranking of the year for Arkansas and first since Week 7 of the 2016 season when the Hogs were No. 21 in the country by USA Today.

RUNS A PLENTY - After dispatching Bryant in three games last week, the Hogs moved to 6-0 on the year and have done so by scoring in bunches. In each of its three games with Bryant, Arkansas scored 10 or more runs, and have scored 10 or more runs in four straight games dating back to its series finale with Miami (Ohio). Through six games this year, the Razorbacks have touched the plate 63 times. It's the second most through six games in the last 12 seasons. Against Bryant, alone, Arkansas hit .292 as a team with 31 hits, 10 for extra bases, including four home runs, and a staggering 21 walks. The 63 runs scored is the fifth-highest among all SEC teams.

**CANNON BEHIND THE PLATE** - Sophomore catcher Grant Koch will provide one of the stronger bats in Arkansas' lineup this year, but his defense returns as one of the best in the SEC. Last year, Koch threw out 11 would be base stealers, which were the most among all freshman catchers. That total is the sixth-highest among

returning catchers in the SEC.

**BONAFIDE BONFIELD -** Prior to the season, out-fielder Luke Bonfield was named to the preseason All-SEC second team by the league coaches. The New Jersey native is coming off his best season as a Razorback in 2016 and had one of the best bats in the league as he notched 14 multi-hit games and tied for the team high with nine multi-RBI games.

JOHNSON RETURNS TO HOME STATE - 2017 will mark the first season with the Razorbacks for new pitching coach Wes Johnson. A Sherwood, Arkansas native, Johnson takes over for long time pitching coach Dave Jorn, who stepped down last summer. Johnson spent one season at Mississippi State and four seasons at Dallas Baptist before arriving at Arkansas. Last season, with the Bulldogs, Johnson developed a pitching staff that improved its ERA by more than a full run and won 44 games, its most since 1997.

**EARLY RECOGNITION -** Seven Razorbacks have earned some early love by one of the top college baseball publications in the nation. D1Baseball. com listed what it thought were the best players in the nation at each position and seven Hogs earned one of those coveted spots. Carson Shaddy leads with the highest ranking at No. 13 in the second baseman's list.

After finishing his 14th season at the helm of the Arkansas baseball program in 2015-16, head coach Dave Van Horn continues to elevate the Razorbacks to one of the nation's premier teams year in and year out. Over his 14 seasons as head Hog, Van Horn has led Arkansas to four College World Series appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament berths, one Southeastern Conference overall title, three SEC Western Division championships and a total of 550 wins.

The highly decorated coach has both individual and team honors throughout his 27-year coaching resume, beginning at Texarkana (Texas) Community College all the way through the present. Individually, he has been named national coach of the year twice, regional coach of the year twice and conference coach of the year four times. His teams have made six College World Series appearances, won five outright conference championships, a Division II National Championship and 17 appearances in the NCAA Tournament. Van Horn is one of only 11 coaches in NCAA history to lead two programs to the College World Series.

Since joining the Razorbacks as head coach, Van Horn has led his teams to an SEC Championship, three SEC Western Division titles, 14 NCAA Tournament berths and four College World Series appearances. His players have earned 17 All-America honors, 24 All-SEC nods, 104 SEC Academic Honor Roll spots and 11 Capital One Academic All-District accolades. Not resting on his laurels, Van Horn has kept his competitive juices flowing as he seeks to bring a national championship to his alma mater.

With Van Horn's success over the years, fans have also flocked to Baum Stadium and last year was no different. In 2016, Arkansas finished fourth in the nation in average attendance (7,815) and fifth in total attendance (265,718). It's the fourth straight year that Arkansas has finished in the top-five nationally in attendance, while boasting one of the best stadiums in college baseball.


