ALL-TIME SERIES VS KENTUCKY

Wednesday's match marks the first meeting of the season between Arkansas and Kentucky and the 39th in the series. The Wildcats have won the previous six meetings. Arkansas has won nine of the 19 matches played at Barnhill Arena.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS AUBURN

Arkansas owns a 17-4 advantage in home matches against Auburn and has won four of the past five in Fayetteville. In the last 15 meetings overall, the Tigers have an 8-7 edge. Auburn won the first meeting this season (Oct. 6).

LAST TIME OUT

Okiana Valle had a match-high 15 digs while Hailey Dirrigl and Pilar Victoria tallied 15 and 12 kills, respectively, in a four-set road loss at Missouri (Nov. 19). With the setback, Arkansas dropped to 8-8 in SEC play.

RPI WATCH

Arkansas faces a pair of top-50 RPI opponents in the final week of the regular season. Kentucky comes to town as the No. 1 team in the latest release of the RPI while Auburn is 49th in the rankings.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Redshirt senior Pilar Victoria enters the week as the NCAA leader with 599 kills and is second in the nation with 5.45 kills per set. With one kill, she will become just the second player in program history with 600 kills in a single season.

VALLE DIGS INTO TOP 3

With 15 digs against Missouri (Nov. 19), junior Okiana Valle moved into third on the program's career digs list. With her seventh dig of the match, she moved past Yarleen Santiago and enters the match with 1,286 career digs.

Hailey Dirrigl is the 10th freshman in program history with 300 kills in a single season, and the first to reach the mark since 2009. The Phoenix, Ariz., native is averaging 3.06 kills per set and hitting .250 during SEC play

RIPPEE MAKES SIX

With her second assist at Missouri (Nov. 19), Rachel Rippee became the sixth Arkansas setter to record 1,200 assists in a single season. Rippee enters the match ranked second in the SEC and 21st in the NCAA with 11.25 assists per set.

BALANCING ACT

For the 10th time this season, Arkansas had at least three players with 10+ kills in its win at South Carolina (Nov. 12). Hailey Dirrigl and Pilar Victoria had 13 kills while Elizabeth Pamphile tied her career high with 12 kills.

IT STARTS WITH A SERVE

The Razorbacks are third in the SEC with 134 service aces and have six players with double-digit aces. Three players have 20 or more aces including Pilar Victoria who leads the team with 32. She is the first Razorback to reach 30 aces in a season since 2010.

WE'RE GOING FIVE

Arkansas' five-set win over Texas A&M (Nov. 5) marked the Razorbacks' 10th five setter of the season and is the sixth time the program has played 10 or more five-set matches. The program record is 12 five setters in 2009.

SETTER OF THE WEEK, PT II

After averaging 12.11 assists per set over road matches at Georgia and Ole Miss, sophomore setter Rachel Rippee was named SEC Setter of the Week (Oct. 30). It marked her



Redshirt senior Pilar Victoria had 26 kills to go along with a career-high 20 digs in Arkansas' five-set win at 0le Miss (Oct. 29). She is the first Razorback with a 20–20 outing since 2010 and the 14th overall to do so.

1,000-KILL CLUB

With her 16th of 27 kills at Georgia (Oct. 25), Pilar Victoria became the 16th Razorback in program history with 1,000 career kills. She reached the milestone in her 52nd match as a Razorback.

WHITE-HOT OFFENSE

Arkansas' .430 hitting effiency (45–8–86) in its straightset win over Mississippi State (Oct. 23) tied the sixth-best hitting percentage for a single match in program history. It also marks the third highest by a team in SEC play this year.

TW0 F0R 20

With their efforts at Alabama (Sept. 27), Pilar Victoria and Hailey Dirrigl became the first Razorback pair with 20 kills apiece since 2011. Victoria had 29 kills in the match while Dirrigl had a career-high 20 kills.

IT'S BEEN AWHILE

Freshman Hailey Dirrigl put down a career-high 20 kills at Alabama (Sept. 29), hitting .486 in the match. She became the first Arkansas freshman since 2009 (Jasmine Norton) with 20 kills in a match.

30 AND COUNTING...

With 30 kills against No. 3 Florida (Sept. 24), Pilar Victoria posted her fourth 30-kill performance of the season. Of the 32 30-kill efforts in the NCAA this year (23 players), she has four and is one of five with multiple.

NON-CONFERENCE SNAPSHOT

For the fourth time in program history, Arkansas went into SEC play with double-digit wins. The Razorbacks previously hit the mark in 1997, 1999 and 2015. The team faced

four teams that played in last year's NCAA Tournament and its only losses came to No. 6 Wisconsin and No. 19 USC.

MAKE IT THREE

For a third-straight week, team co-captain Pilar Victoria was named SEC Offensive Player of the Week (Sept. 18), the fifth weekly conference honor of her career. She tallied two Player of the Week selections in 2015.

RIPPEE DISHES IT OUT

In directing the team to a .348 hitting percentage, setter Rachel Rippee dished out 50 assists in Arkansas' sweep of Yale (Sept. 8). With the performance, she became just the fourth Arkansas setter with 50 or more assists in a threeset match and first since 2003.

RIPPEE GARNERS SEC ACCOLADES

Averaging 11.80 assists per set and directing the offense to a .274 hitting percentage during the Arkansas Classic, Rachel Rippee was named the SEC Setter of the Week. She is the second Razorback (Adrien Wohlschlaeger) to win the award since its inception in 2015.

TOP-10 OUTBURST

Arkansas beat Utah State (Aug. 26) behind its .422 team hitting percentage, the 10th-highest single-match figure in program history. After committing seven attack errors in the opening set, the Razorbacks had just three combined errors in the next two sets.

AYE AYE, CAPTAIN

By way of a team vote, seniors Kori Ortiz and Pilar Victoria will serve as the Razorbacks' team captains. Ortiz entered the season with 600 career digs while Victoria returns to the floor after a redshirt season in 2016.

FRESH(MAN) FACES

Arkansas heads into the 2017 season with nine freshmen on the roster, the most in program history. Previously, the high was six freshmen on five other occasions, most recently in 2014. The latest incoming class earned Highest Honorable Mention accolades from PrepVolleyball.com.

HEAD COACH JASON WATSON | 2ND YEAR AT ARKANSAS (13TH OVERALL)



Jason Watson was named the head coach of the University of Arkansas volleyball team on January 7, 2016, to become the third head coach in program history. In 11 priors seasons as a head coach at BYU (2005–07) and Arizona State (2008–15), Watson enters the 2017 season with a 209–169 (.553) record and has guided his teams to seven NCAA Tournament selections.

The Razorbacks matched their SEC output from the previous season with a 7–11 mark in league play during Watson's first year including six wins in their last nine matches of the year. Individually, senior Danielle Harbin emerged to finish third in the SEC with 4.22 kills per set on her way to AVCA AII–South Region honors.

In eight years in Tempe, Ariz., Watson transformed ASU Volley-ball from a perennial sub-.500 program into a postseason regular. In his last four seasons, the Sun Devils averaged more than 19 wins per season with four-consecutive bids to the NCAA Tournament. Watson also coached a pair of All-America performers, one in each of the past two seasons, for ASU's first national honorees since 2000.

Arizona State began the 2015 campaign with a 15–0 record and reached as high as No. 5 in the AVCA Top 25 poll. The Sun Devils also opened conference play with their best start in the Pac-10/12 era with four wins including the program's first win over Stanford in 15 years.

In 2014, ASU opened the season with six straight wins on the way to a 20–14 record. The Sun Devils were ranked in each AVCA regular season poll. Making its third straight trip to the NCAA Tournament, ASU defeated Texas A&M 3–1 to advance to the second round of the Tournament for the first time since 2006.

Watson led ASU to a 19–13 overall record in 2013 including a 3–0 upset of then–NCAA defending champion Texas. The Sun Devils started the season without dropping a set in their first seven matches. Making its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. ASU dropped a five–set match to BYU in the first round.

In 2012, the Sun Devil squad opened with an 11–2 record, the best start since 1992. The Sun Devils finished with 20 wins — the most in a single season at ASU since 1993. The nine conference wins equaled the most since 2000. ASU made the program's 16th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and Watson became just the fifth coach from ASU to guide the Sun Devils to a NCAA postseason herth

Watson arrived as the head coach at ASU in 2008. In 2013, he was also named head coach of the sand volleyball team when the sport was added to the athletics program.

In June 2015, Watson was selected by USA Volleyball to serve as the head coach of the U.S. Collegiate National Team on a six—match tour of China.

In his three seasons at the helm of the BYU program, Watson compiled a 74–18 (.804) overall record while leading BYU to three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. During his first season as head coach, Watson was named Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year after leading his team to a 25–4 record, the program's best mark since 1998. In addition to leading BYU to the MWC regular–season title, Watson also helped lead the Cougars back to the NCAA Tournament.

In 2007, he led the Cougars to a 24–8 overall record and an Elite 8 finish in the NCAA Regional Final. His team also finished the year ranked 12th nationally, and at one point through the season, the Cougars held a rank as high as ninth in the country. No stranger to the best competition, Watson's teams have been ranked as high as eighth on RPI, showing the character and strength of the teams he builds. Never backing down from challenges are also another hallmark trait of Watson–led teams.

Prior to his head—coaching debut, Watson had amassed 11 years as an assistant coach at four universities. After an All—American playing career at BYU, Watson coached for two years under his former coach, Carl McGown, before beginning his career in women's volleyball with extremely successful stints at Kansas State, Arkansas State, and Montana State.

Watson had an All-American playing career at BYU from 1990– 1994, where he was a four-year starter and two-time captain. He graduated from BYU in 1995 with a degree in physical education and sports business management after leaving his native home of Homebush, Australia.

He and his wife, Larissa, have two sons and a daughter.

As part of their 2017 slate, the Razorbacks are scheduled to play 10 matches against eight teams that advanced to last year's NCAA Tournament. Arkansas will also face eight teams that appear in the AVCA preseason poll.

WHAT SAY YOU, COACHES?

For a second-consecutive year, redshirt senior Pilar Victoria was named to the All-SEC Preseason Team. She tallied 525 kills in 2015 but missed last season with an injury. In the SEC preseason coaches poll, Arkansas was picked to finish eighth in the league.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

For the second time in program history, Arkansas earned an AVCA Team Academic Award for the 2016–17 academic year. To be recognized, teams had to maintain a collective 3.30 or higher cumulative GPA. The team was previously honored for the 2014–15 academic year.

ANOTHER SUMMER ABROAD

Associate head coach Jon Newman–Gonchar served as a consultant coach for the U.S. Women's National Team this summer. During that time, Team USA won gold at the Pan Am Cup in June and advanced to the final round of the FIVB Grand Prix in China.

REPRESENTING THEIR COUNTRY

Pilar Victoria and Fernanda Güitron donned the jerseys of

their respective home countries of Puerto Rico and Mexico during the XVI Pan American Cup in June. Victoria tallied 10 points to help Puerto Rico beat host Peru in the bronze medal match.

SIDELINE ADDITION

Megan Wargo-Kearney joined the Razorbacks as assistant coach in March after eight seasons at Truman State. During that time, she helped guide the Bulldogs to six Division II NCAA Tournament appearances and two Great Lakes Valley Tournament titles.

SHE LOOKS FAMILIAR

A two-time AVCA All-America Honorable Mention pick as a Razorback (2013–14), Meredith Hays is back in Cardinal and White as the program's director of operations. She registered 962 kills in two seasons in Fayetteville.
