# **NEIGHBORS' PHILOSOPHY**

### **GRAD STUDENT DEVIN COSPER**

- »Only "senior" on the team
- »Missed the opening game last season after a death in the family
- »Averaged 6.4 ppg and 2.2 rpg last season and 7.7 ppg and 2.8 rpg for her career
- »Graduated in May 2017 with a degree in broadcast journalism
- »Interned at RSN, Arkansas' broadcast studio
- »Wears the SEC graduate patch on her jersey
- »Named "Comback Student-Athlete of the Year at annual HOGSPY awards after rebounding from an injury and a death in the family

### **FUNCTIONALLY FAST**

You will hear Mike Neighbors say this a lot. He wants his teams to play as fast as possible and still function at a high level. That may look different from possession to possession depending on what Arkansas is running.

### **TRUST, TALENT AND TIME**

My program will be built on three things. It's very simple.

**TRUST** - The highest form of loyalty that has to be earned, managed and sometimes re-earned. If we don't have this, nothing will work and the stool's legs will fall off and everything will collapse.

**TALENT** - It doesn't mean you can dribble, shoot, pass and rebound. It's a lot of other things like the ability to engage with the fan base and willingness to sign autographs for a 10-year-old child you might be inspiring.

**TIME** - It's just not being on time or making time. It's how you utilize your time and who you invest your time with and be around. Trust, talent and time. Those will be our pillars.

### **BESIDE US**

One of the things Mike Neighbors stressed when he was hired was his desire to take care of the players, the staff and the fans who have been loyal to the Razorback program. He has told our fans that he wants them to stand "Beside Us". Don't be behind us, stand next to us and go through the process of building our program.

### **SHOTS AND POSSESSIONS**

Mike Neighbors wants a lot of shots and a lot of possessions. Here's a look at the Razorbacks shots this year. The number is often determined by pace of play and Arkansas will push the tempo.

### **30 AND COUNTING**

This year, Arkansas director of operations Amber Shirey enters her 30th season as a Razorback. The former Amber Nicholas was a two-time All-Southwest Conference selection during her four-year playing career from 1989-92. She spent one season (1992-93) as a student coach helping Arkansas transition to the Southeastern Conference. She moved on to a graduate assistant and assistant coach from 1993-94 through the 2006-07 season. In 2007-08 Shirey transitioned to the director of operations position holding that spot until she returned to the sidelines as an assistant coach for the 2013 and 2014 seasons. She moved into her current position as the Executive Director of Operations in 2014-15. She has been a part of seven different head coach's staffs during her tenure.

### **OPPONENT**

### **ABOUT ABILENE CHRISTIAN**

»The Wildcats are 3-1 on the year and lead their conference in assist/turnover ratio at 1.09. They also rank first in assists per game (18.3), field goal percentage defense (34.8), offensive rebounds per game (21), rebound margin (+18.3), rebounds per game (50.75), scoring margin (+20.5) and 3-point field goals per game (9.8).

- »The Wildcats are paced by Dominique Golightly who averages 12.5 points per game and 5.5 rebounds per game.
- »Sara Williamson is also averaging double digits with 11.0 ppg.
- »Sierra Allen is the leading rebounder with 27 boards and a 6.8 rpg average.
- »ACU's wins have come against Southwest New Mexico, Schriener and Idaho and the lone loss is to SMU.
- »ACU has scored big numbers this season with two games at the 90+ mark and one in the 80's.
- »Three point shooting has been strong for the Wildcats with three of the four games boasting double-digit makes.

### Important Stats

**From Distance:** ACU is comfortable from distance averaging 9.8 3-pointers per game with 39 makes and a 32.5% efficiency. Those numbers rival the Razorbacks who make 8.3 3-pointers per game with 50 makes and a 27.5% efficiency.

**Turn Them Over:** ACU is averaging 16.8 turnovers a game with games of 16, 13, 18 and 20 miscues. Arkansas takes pretty good care of the ball with four of the Razorbacks' six games in single digit turnovers. Arkansas' opponents are committing 16.5 turnovers per contest.

That Arkansas head coach Mike Neighbors was cut from the Razorback baseball team? He walked on and legendary head coach Norm DiBryan nudged him in the coaching direction saying "You always seem to be in the right place but you don't always make the play."

### **THE SCHEDULE**

Arkansas' non-conference schedule features four teams who went to the post season a year ago. Arizona State played in the first round of the NCAA Tournament while Abilene Christian, UT-Arlington and Grambling were all WNIT teams a year ago. UTA was eliminated in the first round while Abilene Christian and Grambling both reached round two.

The always-tough SEC schedule features eight NCAA Tournament teams including the NCAA Champion South Carolina and the runner up, Mississippi State. Auburn and LSU were eliminated in the first round while Kentucky,

### **SEC OPENERS**

The Ole Miss conference opener snaps a three-game streak of road league openers and it is only the 10th time since joining the SEC that Arkansas has played its first SEC game at home.

### WHAT WE HAVE COMING BACK

Although Arkansas loses its best scorer in Jessica Jackson to graduation, the Razorbacks return its next four leading scorers from a year ago. Jackson accounted for 23% of the Razorback points last year but Malica Monk, Keiryn Swenson, Jailyn Mason and Devin Cosper combined for 48% of the scoring in 2016-17.

### THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Arkansas had four games away from Bud Walton Arena in November. The Razorbacks traveled to Nebraska and Oral Roberts before a two-game tournament at UTEP. There were three true road games and one neutral site. This is the most games away from home since 2012-13 when Arkansas opened at home, played two road games and three games in a tournament in Hawai'i.

### **AGAINST THE POLL**

This week's (Nov. 28) Associated Press poll features six SEC teams. Arkansas' schedule is headlined by No. 5 South Carolina with No. 6 Mississippi State right on the Gamecocks' heels. Tennessee is No. 12, followed by No. 18 Texas A&M, No. 19 Missouri and No. 20 Kentucky. Arizona State fell out of the polls but is receiving 26 votes along with Georgia with 3 votes.

This week's USA Today Coaches Poll has Mississippi State at No. 3, followed by No. 6 South Carolina, No. 13 Tennessee, No. 18 Missouri, No. 21 Texas A&M. Arizona State, Georgia and UT Arlington are all getting votes.

### FROM ROOKIE NOD TO NAISMITH NOMINEE

In four short years Mike Neighbors went from a Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year nominee in 2014, to a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year national semifinalist in 2017.

Neighbors guided UW to an historic campaign in 2016-17 leading the Huskies to 27 wins, it's second most in program history, and he was just one shy of the all-time a school record set in 1990 (28).

Picked to place third in the Pac-12 in the preseason poll, UW tied for second in the league with a 15-3 record, it's best conference finish since 2003. The Huskies' 15 conference wins tied for third most in program history. Washington, who entered conference play with the program-best 12 non-conference wins, clinched its first-ever bye in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. Washington put together an 11-game win streak and a six-game win streak in Pac-12 play in 2016-17.
