STARTING FIVE

- Ole Miss opens its SEC slate against Arkansas for the second straight season and the third in the previous four. The Rebels have won three straight SEC openers but have not won an SEC road opener since 2006-07 (Jan. 4, 2007, at Auburn, 74-66).
- The Rebels lead the all-time series vs. Arkansas, 26-16, but the Razorbacks have taken seven of the last 10 contests against Ole Miss. In Fayetteville, the Razorbacks hold an 11-5 advantage.
- Ole Miss finished the non-conference season at 10-3, the fifth year in all five of the **Matt Insell** era to feature at least nine non-conference wins. The Rebels have beaten three teams currently in the NCAA RPI Top-150: South Alabama (91), Middle Tennessee (110) and Temple (139).
- Since the injury to senior Preseason All-SEC selection **Shandricka Sessom** on Nov. 29, guards **Madinah Muhammad** (17.8 PPG overall) and **Alissa Alston** (15.8 PPG overall) are averaging a combined 34.6 PPG.
- Ole Miss ranks in the national top-25 in blocks (12th, 5.7/game) and free throws made (24th, 194).

CREDENTIALS

Please contact the Athletics Communications office for game credentials. Requests for credentials should be made in writing on official letterhead and faxed to 662-915-7006 or emailed to tjwooten@olemiss.edu, and will be limited to working members of the media. Credentials will be held at the will-call entrance located at the media entrance on the Hill Drive side of The Pavilion at Ole Miss. Space problems on press row do occur because of lack of seating. As a result, priority will be given to the media that cover Ole Miss basketball on a regular basis. Credentials are non-transferable and unauthorized use is strictly prohibited.

INTERVIEW POLICY

All interview requests - coaches and players - MUST be coordinated through Tyler Wooten in the Athletics Communications office. During the week, head coach Matt Insell and Rebel players will be available for interview after practice unless arranged otherwise. There will be no gameday player interviews until after the game. Coach Insell will be available for pregame interviews (if requested) following the team's shoot-around the day of the game.

PRACTICE POLICY

Ole Miss basketball practices are open to the media. Please contact Tyler Wooten at least 24 hours in advance if you plan on attending practice. The Ole Miss women's basketball schedule is subject to change, but practice is normally from 1:30-4:30 p.m. at the Tuohy Basketball Practice Facility.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Both team locker rooms are **CLOSED** to the media following the game, by facility policy. Coach Insell will address the media approximately 10 minutes after the game. Selected players will be brought into the interview room with the head coach. Visiting coach and player interviews will be coordinated through the visiting team's media relations contact.

GAMEDAY SERVICES

Complete pregame notes with team and individual statistics will be distributed to the media when entering The Pavilion. Following the game, final and halftime box scores, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be provided. Pregame food service will be available approximately 60 minutes prior to tipoff.

RADIO LINES

The Ole Miss Communications office has phone lines available to visiting radio stations on a first-come, first-serve basis. Priority will be given to commercial radio over student radio.

MEDIA TIMEOUTS

Media timeouts (2:45 in length) will be taken in the following manner:

- One per quarter (First called timeout prior to the 5 min mark or the first deadball at or below the 5 min mark)
- Quarter breaks may be used as media timeout
- First called timeout in the second half becomes a media timeout.
- If it is a free throw situation, the shots will be taken following the timeout per NCAA regulations

Fifth-year Rebels head coach Matt Insell has Ole Miss women's basketball on the rise entering the 2017-18 season following several highly-touted recruiting classes and a pair of trips back to the postseason.

Insell, the son of Hall of Fame coach Rick Insell at Middle Tennessee State, is 58-68 through four seasons with the Rebels, which includes four top-25 wins and two 17-plus win seasons amidst the intense strength of schedule in the SEC. Insell was named the eighth head women's basketball coach in Ole Miss history on March 28, 2013, following five seasons coaching against the Rebels as an assistant on Matthew Mitchell's staff at Kentucky.

The Insell-led Rebels are coming off a successful 2016-17 campaign that saw at 17-14 record and a return trip to the postseason with a WNIT berth. Ole Miss opened its brand-new arena, The Pavilion at Ole Miss, with 12-straight home wins — the most home wins in the Insell era and the most since the late 1980s when Ole Miss won 15 straight. Ole Miss also set a new attendance record for the third straight year with 8,088 fans in attendance to see the Rebels earn their 800th win in program history over Jackson State.

Ole Miss recorded some significant wins in 2016-17, knocking off eventual Elite Eight school and 25th-ranked Oregon at home, 83-67 — marking the third-straight season with a top-25 win under Insell. The Rebels also ended a pair of long losing streaks during the year, breaking a 26-game losing streak that dated back to 1996 against Tennessee (67-62), as well as picking up the first win over Texas A&M since 1997 on Senior Night with a 62-49 victory.

On the court, senior Erika Sisk and junior Shandricka Sessom became the 27th and 28th 1,000-point scorers in Ole Miss history, while sophomore Madinah Muhammad increased her offensive production by nearly six points from her freshman campaign.

Insell led a young team in 2015-16 with just two seniors and only two returnees that had been in the program for more than two seasons, but the Rebels still produced some exciting moments on the court.

For the second consecutive season, the Rebels knocked off a ranked foe with a 67-59 victory over No. 9 Kentucky — Insell's old school of five years. The win was the first over a top-10 school for Ole Miss since 2010, when the Rebels took down No. 8 Georgia (66-65). For her career-best 21 points against the Wildcats, junior Shequilia Joseph was named SEC Player of the Week.

With a group that featured eight underclassmen, Insell and his staff were instrumental in the growth of sophomore Shandricka Sessom. Sessom, who averaged just 5.3 points as a freshman, increased her scoring to 15.6 points per game and was ranked in the top-10 of the SEC for scoring all season. Additionally, freshman Madinah Muhammad was a bright spot. The Chicago native, averaged 7.5 points per game as rookie, which was third best on the Ole Miss squad. That number increased to 8.4 points per game against SEC competition, which trailed just Sessom's 13.4 points per game against SEC foes.

Additionally, the Rebels saw several exciting moments at Tad Smith Coliseum before moving to their new home, The Pavilion at Ole Miss, in January. Freshman Torri Lewis set the single-game record for three-point field goals with 10 triples in a win over New Orleans. Her 10 triples tied her with former Ole Miss men's player Marshall Henderson for the most three-pointers made at Tad Smith Coliseum. Ole Miss also closed the "Tad Pad" in style on Jan. 3, 2016, with junior Erika Sisk nailing a buzzer-beater for a 55-52 win over Vanderbilt.

In just his second year at Ole Miss, Insell took the Rebels to new heights in 2014-15 with 19 wins and seven victories in SEC play, the most overall wins since the 2009-10 season. The Rebels also returned to the postseason with a third-round foray into the WNIT.

The Rebels, who improved seven wins in 2014-15, posted four wins over NCAA Tournament participants, and, after being picked to finish last in the SEC preseason coaches and media poll, closed the season tied for No. 7 in the league standings. Ole Miss garnered the No. 8 seed for the SEC Tournament — the highest seed for the Rebels in five seasons.

Leading a young team that featured eight newcomers, Insell was able to develop his team throughout the season. Freshman A'Queen Hayes took over the starting point guard position midway through the season and excelled, earning her SEC Freshman of the Week honors on January 12 and a spot on the All-Freshman team. Senior forward Tia Faleru picked up where she left off during her junior campaign and became the first SEC player to average a double-double since Georgia's Porsha Phillips in 2010-11. She also became the first player to lead the league in rebounding in back-to-back seasons since LSU's Sylvia Fowles led the league from 2006-08. For her efforts, Faleru was an All-SEC First-Team selection and the only unanimous selection on the Associated Press' All-SEC First-Team. She also earned Honorable Mention AP All-American accolades.

Insell and the Rebels knocked off ranked foes in No. 13 Kentucky and No. 18 Georgia — the first time in five years Ole Miss had defeated a ranked foe. The season also saw Ole Miss pick up its 400th win at Tad Smith Coliseum. One of the high points of the season was when Insell and his father made women's basketball history by becoming the first father-son duo to play against each other in NCAA women's basketball when Middle Tennessee made the trip to Oxford in November.

Insell laid the foundation for the Rebels during his first season in 2013-14, leading Ole Miss to a 10-6 non-conference record and a seven-game winning streak — the longest streak for the Rebels since the 2007-08 season. Insell led Ole Miss to a near non-conference upset of eventual Sweet 16 team Baylor, who battled back in the final minutes to win 87-80 — but, giving fans a glimpse of the success to come under the vision of Insell in the process.

After battling through the always-challenging SEC schedule, the Rebels entered the SEC Tournament as the No. 14 seed, determined to take the momentum from a regular season finale victory over Auburn into the postseason tournament. Drawing the No. 11 seed Arkansas, the

Rebels took care of business with a 63-62 victory, giving Ole Miss a statement win for Insell's process. "I didn't look at it as rebuilding, I looked at it as a process of getting us back to the top," said Insell after the SEC Tournament win. "A win like this helps you get there."

Insell also led the Rebels to wins over in-state rival, Mississippi State, to give the first-year head coach his first SEC victory. In addition to the Rebels' battle with 2014 Elite Eight participant, Baylor, Ole Miss posted victories against women's basketball powerhouse, Louisiana Tech, and sent the Ole Miss senior class out in style with a Senior Day overtime win over Auburn at Tad Smith Coliseum.

Prior to his time leading the Rebels, Insell spent five years as an assistant coach for a very successful Kentucky Wildcat team under head coach Matthew Mitchell. While there, UK recorded four 20-win seasons and four trips to the NCAA Tournament — ending each of the last three seasons he spent in Lexington ranked in the top-25.

Insell, who was responsible for the guards while also having recruiting and player development duties, served as the top assistant coach and helped UK ink three top-10 recruiting classes and seven McDonald's All-Americans. During his time at Kentucky, Insell helped develop guard A'dia Mathies, a two-time SEC Player of the Year and All-America candidate, and Brianna Goss who was named SEC Freshman of the Year.

Before his time at Kentucky, Insell was the director of basketball operations at Louisiana Tech under head coach Chris Long.

Insell ended up at Louisiana Tech following an extremely successful career as one of the top AAU coaches in the country, leading the Tennessee Flight — a Nike Elite travel program. Insell made a national name for himself after coaching 41 of his former AAU players to play Division I basketball, including former Wildcats Victoria Dunlap and Crystal Riley. He also coached the Shelbyville Sports Shop 15-Under team to the AAU National Championship title in 2004.

Insell earned valuable basketball experience while attending the University of Tennessee from 2001-05. He worked closely with both the men's and women's basketball programs, serving as a student assistant and video coordinator under former men's head coach Buzz Peterson and as an instructor at Pat Summitt's summer basketball camps. The Shelbyville, Tenn., native transferred to Middle Tennessee State during the 2005-06 season where his father, Rick Insell, is the head women's basketball coach. He went on to earn his bachelor's degree in political science from MTSU in 2007.

TEAM NOTES

IT'S GO-TIME

After completing the non-conference season at 10-3, Ole Miss women's basketball stares down a grueling SEC slate with the conference opener at Arkansas.

The SEC sent eight teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2017 and ended with the two in the title game: defending national champions South Carolina and reigning NCAA runners-up Mississippi State.

In the non-conference season, the SEC went 132-39 (.772) overall -- the 13th-best conference winning percentage since 1990-91 and the 28th season in a row that the conference has won at least 70 percent of its non-conference games.

REBELS IN SEC OPENERS

Ole Miss is looking for its fourth-straight SEC opening win, but a win on Sunday in Fayetteville would be the first SEC road-opening victory for the Rebels since the 2006-07 Elite Eight team beat Auburn, 74-66, on Jan. 4, 2007.

All-time, the Rebels are 24-14 overall in general SEC openers (16-7 at home; 8-7 on the road). In home SEC openers, Ole Miss is 28-10 all-time, and on the road the Rebels are 14-23 in SEC openers.

VS. ARKANSAS

The Rebels lead the all-time series vs. Arkansas, 26-16, but the Razorbacks have taken seven of the last 10 contests against Ole Miss. In Fayetteville, the Razorbacks hold an 11-5 advantage.

The 10-game Ole Miss lead is tied for the second-largest against SEC opponents with a 34-24 lead against Alabama, falling short only of the 33-game lead the Rebels hold over Mississippi State (63-30).

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL NON-CON

Ole Miss finished the non-conference season at 10-3, the fifth year in all five of the Matt Insell era to feature at least nine non-conference wins and the third to record at least 10 wins.

The Rebels have beaten three teams currently in the NCAA RPI Top-150: South Alabama (91), Middle Tennessee (110) and Temple (139). At the moment, Ole Miss ranks No. 79 in the RPI.

LAST TIME OUT (vs. Texas Southern)

Ole Miss needed a bounce-back win in a big way and came away with a solid victory over Texas Southern, topping the Lady Tigers, 73-58, at The Pavilion on Dec. 28.

Ole Miss started out hot, opening the game on a 12-0 run that ended with a 28-12 advantage by the end of the first quarter -- the most by the Rebels since scoring 30 in the first quarter vs. Delaware State.

Sophomore **Shelby Gibson** started at center for the first time this season, leading the way with a career-high 20 points on 7-of-8 shooting and a 5-of-7 clip from the charity stripe in 25 minutes played. Gibson also chipped in with six rebounds.

WINNING WHEN IT COUNTS

Ole Miss is 4-0 in games decided by 10 points or less, proving its ability to hang on throughout the non-conference season. In those games, the Rebels are only shooting .250 from three and are being out-rebounded by nearly four boards a game (44.8-40.2), but are finding a way to stay ahead with a .411 shooting percentage (while holding opponents to just .342 overall).

In those games, junior **Alissa Alston** is the Rebels' top scorer by far with 23.5 PPG and a .604 clip from the field and an .833 mark from the free throw line. Fellow junior **Madinah Muhammad** is second at 18.0 PPG with a blistering .923 mark from the charity stripe.

Last season, Ole Miss went 5-6 in games decided by 10 points or less -- including a 73-64 win over Arkansas at home.

SEVEN-GAME TEAR

The Rebels were in the throes of a seven-game winning streak and off to the best start at Ole Miss since 2000-01 at 9-1 before an 0-2 trip to the West Coast in tough contests against No. 9 Oregon (90-46) and Portland State (94-79).

During the streak, the Rebels were topping opponents by an average of 17.4 points per game and included victories over Delaware State (110-58, third-largest point total in Ole Miss history), reigning NCAA Tournament teams Troy (96-93) and Temple (64-48, on the road), perennial postseason player Middle Tennessee (65-56, on national TV), Arkansas State (74-48), South Alabama (66-59) and Southern Miss (68-59).

Ole Miss held opponents to 60.1 points per game throughout the streak (with just one opponent breaking 60; Troy, 93), and shot .439 while holding opponents to .320 from the field and a paltry .268 from beyond the arc.

FEARSOME DEFENSE

The Rebel defense has proved difficult to maneuver in the opening stages of the 2017-18 season, stifling opponents from the field. Ole Miss has held nine of its 13 opponents under 40 percent shooting, going 9-0 in such games. Just one Rebel opponent has eclipsed 50 percent shooting for a game (No. 9 Oregon, 50.0), whereas Ole Miss has done so three times (going 3-0 in those games). Furthermore, the Rebels have held seven of their 13 opponents to under 30 percent three-point shooting (going 6-1 in such games).

Ole Miss has also held opponents to under 60 points eight times this season, including five games in a row from Nov. 25 to Dec. 12 -- the longest-such streak since holding five straight opponents to under 60 in 2015 from Nov. 7 until Dec. 12.

Ole Miss ranks 12th nationally in blocks per game (5.7) and fourth in the SEC in three-point defense (.291).

THE BEST DEFENSE...

...is a good offense, and the Rebels possess a potent one -- even without senior and Preseason Second-Team All-SEC member **Shandricka Sessom**. Ole Miss currently averages 74.8 points per game -- the fifth-best average in the SEC -- which includes 78.3 PPG in wins.

GETTING TO THE LINE

After only being able to get to the line a total of 66 times in the first four games of the season, the Rebels visited the charity stripe an impressive 164 times in the following six games. The recent surge in trips to the free throw line began with 37 against Troy on Nov. 21 -- the most since Ole Miss attempted 38 vs. Florida on Jan. 8, 2015. The Rebels also sank 29 of those 37 free throw attempts, the most conversions since hitting 25 that same game vs. Florida in 2014-15. **Madinah Muhammad** was 12-

of-13 from the line in that game alone, the most in a game in the SEC this year and the most by a Rebel since **Alissa Alston** sank 12 vs. Auburn on Feb. 16, 2017.

The Rebels followed that up with a crucial game on the free throw line vs. Middle Tennessee, going 26-of-31. Much of that came from Alston, who went 14-of-16 -- the most makes since **Tia Faleru** hit 15 at Missouri on Feb. 15, 2015. Alston was just two shy of the single-game record set by **Armintie Price** at UAB in 2006-07.

At the moment, Ole Miss ranks as one of the top free-throw teams in the NCAA, sitting 14th nationally in attempts (295) and 24th in free throws made (194).

BLOCK PARTY

Ole Miss has been a dominant force in shot blocking this season, thanks primarily to freshman center **Promise Taylor**. The Rebels rank 12th in the NCAA in blocks per game (5.7) and 11th in total blocks (74) -- 39 of which come from Taylor, who ranks fifth in total blocks and ninth in blocks per game (3.0). The Rebels have blocked at least five shots in all but four games this season and have swatted seven or more on five different occasions.

Because of the surge in blocked shots, the Rebels -- at 5.7 blocks per game -- are currently on pace for 170 total blocks by season's end, potentially destroying the current single-season record of 129 set in 1982-83.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

SHELBY'S BIG NIGHT

After entering Thursday's game vs. Texas Southern averaging just 3.4 points and 10.3 minutes a game this season, sophomore **Shelby Gibson** started at center for the first time this season and didn't disappoint with a career-day. Gibson led Ole Miss in scoring for the first time since Jan. 26, 2017 (15 at Kentucky) with a career-high 20 points on 7-of-8 shooting and a 5-of-7 clip from the charity stripe in 25 minutes played. Gibson also chipped in with six rebounds.

#SplashSisters, PART DEUX?

With one half of the **#SplashSisters**, senior guard **Shandricka Sessom**, out for the season due to a torn ACL, it's been junior point guard **Alissa Alston** that has picked up the slack and formed a formidable duo with fellow junior **Madinah Muhammad**.

At the time of her injury, both Sessom and Muhammad were scoring a combined 38.2 points per game -- 45.7 percent of all Rebel scoring at that point. Since that game vs. Middle Tennessee, Alston has given Ole Miss a boost with 17.6 PPG in those seven games -- including a career-high 27 points vs. South Alabama and additional 20-point outings vs. Middle Tennessee (22) and at Portland State (21).

Since Sessom's injury, both Alston and Muhammad have combined for 33.2 PPG and are shooting a combined .398 from the field and .839 from the free throw line for 72 total free throws.

SLICE AND DICE

Junior point guard **Alissa Alston** has begun to shore up her scoring bonafides as a legitimate threat off the dribble this season. Alston has eclipsed the 20-point mark four times, including leading the way vs. South Alabama with a career-high 27 points on a near-perfect 10-of-11 shooting day

from the field. Alston also owns a 26-point performance vs. Troy on Nov. 21 (then a career-high), 22 points on national TV in a win vs. Middle Tennessee on Nov. 29 and a 21-point outing at Portland State.

OH MY, SHE'S ON FIRE

Junior guard **Madinah Muhammad** has barely had a cold moment on the floor this season on the way to an incredible start as the top scorer for the Rebels.

Muhammad currently ranks seventh in the SEC at 17.8 points per game and has only been held under double-digit twice in 13 games played this year. Additionally, Muhammad has scored at least 19 points seven times this season, she has eclipsed 20 five times and she recorded the first 30-point game at Ole Miss since 2015 with a career-high 30 vs. Arkansas State.

She opened the season with five straight games in double-digits, the second streak in her career of at least five in a row (her career-long streak is six from Jan. 22 to Feb. 12 last season). Muhammad also scored three straight games with at least 20 points for the first time in her Rebel career during that time.

SETTING MILESTONES

Madinah Muhammad is on pace to be one of the top scorers by the end of her Ole Miss career. The Chicago native just recently passed 800 career points, currently sitting at 823 and a career average of 11.6 PPG. At her current season pace of 17.8 points per game, Muhammad is on pace to reach 1,125 by season's end -- putting her well within the realm of becoming the 29th Rebel to score 1,000 points in a career. If she does, she will become the second junior in as many years to do so (senior **Shandricka Sessom** did so in 2016-17), and the third in the last six seasons (**Valencia McFarland**, 2012-13).

MARLEE TO THE RESCUE

Junior **Marlee Hatcher** helped spark a comeback effort for the Rebels at Portland State in her most significant playing time of the season with 16 minutes played against the Vikings. Hatcher nailed threes on back-to-back possessions, initiating a 24-4 Rebel run that nearly erased what was once a 27-point deficit. Hatcher was a sharp shooter at Itawamba Community College, shooting 41 percent from three and leading her team to the national tournament. Hatcher's mother, **Wanda Austin**, played at Ole Miss from 1978-81 and was a team captain.

THE KID CAN PLAY

True freshman **Promise Taylor** has wasted no time in cementing herself as a valuable piece of the Rebel puzzle this season, earning SEC Freshman of the Week honors twice this year. Taylor has been dominant on both ends of the floor, currently ranking ninth nationally in blocks per game (3.0) and sixth in the SEC in shooting percentage (.585).

ON PACE FOR GREATNESS

Freshman **Promise Taylor** is on pace to annihilate the single-season blocks record. At her current pace of 3.0 per game, Taylor would have 90 total blocks by season's end -- dismantling the previous record of 67 set by Shawn Goff in 2007-08.

HEARTBREAKING LOSS

Senior and Preseason Second-Team All-SEC member **Shandricka Sessom** tore her ACL during the closing minutes of the first quarter vs. Middle Tennessee on Wednesday, ending her season. Sessom, who was averaging 17.7 PPG entering Wednesday, will redshirt and return in 2018-19.

Sessom currently ranks as the 24th-best scorer in Ole Miss history with 1,131 career points scored.

TOURNAMENT TEAMS ON THE DOCKET

Ole Miss plays 12 schools in 2017-18 that advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2016-17. The Rebels came out victorious against the first, Troy (96-93), and won at Temple, 64-48, before losing at No. 9 Oregon on Dec. 17. This Thursday's tilt vs. Texas Southern is the final of the non-conference NCAA teams before a grueling SEC schedule that features eight Tournament teams.

THE PAVILION AT OLE MISS

The centerpiece of the Forward Together campaign is the state-of-the-art \$96.5-million Pavilion at Ole Miss. On July 31, 2014, ground was broken on the 225,000-square foot arena that officially opened its doors on January 7, 2016 with the Rebel men's basketball team's victory over Alabama.

Designed by AECOM and built by BL Harbert, The Pavilion boasts a capacity of 9,500 fans and includes a number of first-class amenities, including court-side and baseline seating for students, three premium club areas for fans and more than 1,700 premium seats all within an intimate seating bowl. The men's and women's locker rooms measure almost 1,500 square feet, while the facility also houses two visiting team locker rooms, officials' locker rooms, a volleyball locker room and green room space.

Ole Miss worked with Daktronics to design, manufacture and install one of the largest center-hung video display boards in college sports with nearly 2,400 square feet of LED. The center-hung configuration consists of 13 video displays for a total of more than 3.6 million LEDs. It includes four main video displays, two undermount video displays, four corner displays and three 360-degree rings.

The main entrance and north lobby of The Pavilion features the C Spire Speedzone, an interactive lounge through partnership with C Spire that also includes Steak 'n Shake, Raising Cane's, The Rebel Shop a Fanatics Experience and a ticket office. The C Spire Speedzone offers a lightning fast, 1 gigabit-per-second, fiber optic-enabled Wi-Fi network as well as social media digital displays, power port enabled charging stations and a kiosk to purchase mobile devices and accessories.

The Pavilion also includes a five-story parking garage with 800 spaces that services the entire campus community.

The placement of The Pavilion allows Ole Miss to further enhance its athletics complex - better connecting athletics to the heart of the best campus in higher education. This centralized location creates an impressive "front door" for Rebel Athletics and a destination point not only on a gameday but every day of the week.

The Pavilion at Ole Miss is the crown jewel of the Forward Together Campaign, which surpassed its original goal of \$150 million in just more than four years and continues toward its new goal of \$200 million. Other components of the campaign include a north end zone expansion and suite renovations at Vaught-Hemingway Stadium, renovation of the Gillom Center, FedEx Academic Support Center and Starnes Athletic Training Center, as well as other future projects.
