GAINESVILLE, Fla. - Alabama used timely buckets down the stretch to take down Florida in Gainesville for the first time since 2010, 63-54, Thursday night in Exactech Arena.

"We had great toughness tonight," said head coach Kristy Curry. "You have to rebound, and we outrebounded them by nine, and you have to take care of the ball on the road, those two things are in our control. We only had 12 (turnovers), the goal is always 13 or less, and nine people on the roster scored, so there's a lot of reasons for the win tonight."

The Crimson Tide (11-4, 1-1 SEC) outscored the Gators (8-7, 0-2 SEC) 32-14 in the paint to earn its first Southeastern Conference win of the season.

The Gators took the 54-52 lead with 5:21 left in the game, before the Tide held UF scoreless for the remainder of the game, while rattling off 11-straight points to earn the victory.

Senior Ashley Williams led the way with 12 points and five rebounds, while senior Hannah Cook finished with 11 points and junior Shaguera Wade came up with big baskets in the fourth guarter, ending the contest with nine points and five boards.

The Tide controlled the first half from the opening tip, after taking the 6-4 lead with 6:20 remaining in the first quarter UA never surrendered the advantage at the end of 20 minutes, taking the 31-26 edge into halftime. At the break, Alabama had nine different players in the scoring column, to go along with 44 percent shooting from the floor.

In the second half, UA continued to hold the lead, going up by as many as 10 in the third guarter before UF cut the deficit down to 48-42 heading into the final quarter.

The two teams battled back-and-forth for the first five minutes of the fourth quarter, when Williams hit two shots within two minutes of each other to break the 54-54 tie, and give the Tide the four-point advantage with 2:42 remaining. Sophomore Jordan Lewis pushed the UA lead to six with a driving layup on the right side with 1:48 left in the game. Three free throws in the final minute of the contest prevented the Gators from getting back into the game.

NEWS AND NOTES

OPENING TIP

- Alabama will be playing its second Southeastern Conference road game of the week when it takes on Arkansas in Fayetteville on Sunday.
- Last time out, the Crimson Tide picked up its first win in Gainesville over Florida since 2010 with the 63-54 victory. Alabama ended the game on an 11-0 run to seal the win.
- UA enters the game with a 3-1 record in true road games, picking up wins at Georgia Southern, Lipscomb and Florida. The one loss came at TCU.

SCOUTING ALABAMA

- Alabama enters Sunday's game with an 11-4 overall and a 1-1 mark in Southeastern Conference play.
- The Crimson Tide is led in scoring and rebounding by senior Hannah Cook, who averages 11.1 points and in rebounding by senior Ashley Williams, who contributes 6.6 boards per contest. Sophomore Jordan Lewis leads the way in assists with 3.4 per game.
- Sophomore Ashley Knight leads the team and ranks third in the SEC and 12th nationally in blocks per game with an average of 2.93.
- As a team, the Crimson Tide is averaging 68.9 points per game, 13.7 more than its opponents, and is outrebounding the opposition 43.1-36.7.
- After finishing the 2016-17 season last in the SEC in free throw percentage, Alabama has jumped up to fifth, hitting 72.0 percent of its attempts as a team.

SCOUTING ARKANSAS

- Arkansas stands at 10-5 overall and 1-1 in Southeastern Conference play heading into Sunday's matchup.
- The Razorbacks are 8-0 in home games this season.
- Last time out, Arkansas dropped a 111-69 decision at Mississippi State.
- The Razorbacks are led in scoring by junior Malika Monk and senior Devin Cosper, who average 16.3 points and 16.2 points, respectively. Sophomore Kiara Williams collected a teambest 7.8 rebounds, while Monk also leads in assists with 4.3 per contest.
- As a team, Arkansas is averaging 70.6 points per game and 41.5 rebounds per contest.
- Arkansas is coached by Mike Neighbors, who is in his first year with the Razorbacks after having coached at Washington for four years.

SEC GRADUATE PATCH

• Three Crimson Tide student-athletes now have the SEC Graduate patch on their jerseys following December commencement. Ashley Williams earned hers a season ago, while Hannah Cook and DaiJia Ruffin added theirs after graduating on December 16.

COOK, WILLIAMS AND KNIGHT ALL 1,000 POINT SCORERS

- Senior Meoshonti Knight joined fellow classmates Hannah Cook and Ashley Williams in the 1,000 Point Club after her 14-point performance against Elon on Nov. 24.
- This is the first season in program history that Alabama has had three 1,000 point scorers on its team at the same time.

FAMILIAR FACES

 Alabama returns its entire team from last year's squad that won 22 games, the most wins since 1997-98, and advanced to the SEC tournament and WNIT quarterfinals.

CAPTAINS BY COMMITTEE

- Instead of selecting permanent captains before the season, the team decided to vote on weekly captains for the duration of the year. They will be chosen based both on and off the court actions.
- Captains will be voted on by the four coaches, and each one is given three votes.
- This week's captains are Ashley Williams, Shaquera Wade, Alana da Silva and Jordan Lewis.

- Senior Hannah Cook was one of 20 from across the nation selected to the inaugural Cheryl Miller Award watch list, which will be presented to the nation's top small forward.
- The watch list will be narrowed to 10 semifinalists by mid-February and then five finalists in March. The winner will be announced during the telecast of the national semifinal games in the 2018 NCAA Final Four on Friday, March 30.

BERRY SURPRISED WITH SCHOLARSHIP ON FIRST DAY OF PRACTICE

- Junior Taylor Berry was surprised with a scholarship on the first day of official practice in October.
- Coach Curry realized her team had 14 players and 14 core values, and devised a plan to have each player open her own envelope with one of the values to read. Berry's final envelope finished with the big news.
- The letter in Berry's envelope read: "Grit and gratitude are the last of our 14 core values today that we will mention. We want to be the hardest-working team in the SEC on the court, in the classroom, and in the community with a faithful heart. Taylor, because you represent all 14 of the 14 core values we have reviewed today, it is my honor to award you a full scholarship."


