POSTGAME NOTES: Texas A&M 24, Arkansas 17

PREGAME NOTES

- This is the eighth Southwest Classic between Arkansas and Texas A&M at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas.
- The Razorbacks wore cardinal helmets, white jerseys and white pants.
- Arkansas won the coin toss, its first of the season, and elected to defer until the second-half.
- Arkansas' matchup with Texas A&M marked just the second time in six years the Razorbacks didn't open conference play against the Aggies.
- Captains for the game were De'Jon Harris, Hjalte Froholdt, Dre Greenlaw, and Santos Ramirez.
- Flag bearers were Shane Clenin, and Montaric Brown.

GENERAL NOTES

- Attendance: 55,383
- Second-straight week that the Razorbacks have converted the opening possession of the second-half into a field goal.
- This was the 32nd game of the series decided by seven points or less. Arkansas leads the series 18-11-3 in such games.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- The seven-play, 75-yard drive in the second quarter, and the six-play 75-yard drive in the fourth quarter tie for the fourth-longest drives of the season.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Reid Bauer's booted two 50-yard punts, the longest in his career. Coming into the game his longest was 42 yards.
- Bauer averaged 43.2 yards on eight punts and pinned Texas A&M inside its own 20-yard line once.
- Connor Limpert booted a 47-yard field goal in the third quarter, his second field goal this season over 40 yards.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Arkansas forced one 3-and-out drive versus Texas A&M to run its season total to 17.

CHAD MORRIS NOTES

- It's the 12th time a Chad Morris coached team has tallied three or more sacks in a game.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER NOTES

QB Ty Storey

- Made his second-consecutive start, starting consecutive games for the first time in his career, and third overall of the season.
- His 14 completions were a career high, attempting 25 or more passes for the second-consecutive game.

QB Cole Kelley

- Recorded his fourth-career rushing touchdown in the second quarter on a 1-yard run.

RB Rakeem Boyd

- Made his first-career start for the Razorbacks Saturday afternoon.
- Extended his consecutive games with a catch streak to three (3) with a five-yard reception in the first quarter.
- Led the team in receptions (4), rushing attempts (10), rushing yards (47) and all-purpose yards (80).

TE Cheyenne O'Grady

- Recorded the longest catch of his career on a 36-yard catch and run in the second quarter.
- This was the second completed pass of 35-yards or more to a tight end this season.
- Finished with a career-high 77 yards on three catches surpassing his previous high of 40 yards vs. Virginia Tech (2016).

WR Deon Stewart

- Extended his consecutive games with a catch streak to 13 with a 6-yard reception in the third quarter.

WR Michael Woods

- Made his first-career start for the Razorbacks Saturday afternoon.
- Recorded his first-career touchdown reception in the fourth quarter on a career-long 29-yard reception.

WR Jared Cornelius

- Has recorded a catch in 23 of 27 games played, extending his consecutive games with a catch streak to three (3) with an 11-yard reception in the third quarter.
- Caught one pass for a first down and now has 29 of his 42 career catches go for a first down.

WR Jordan Jones

- Has recorded a catch in 15 of 17-career games, including nine multi-catch games.

OL Hjalte Froholdt

- Started his 30th-straight game on the offensive line dating back to Sept. 3, 2016 vs. Louisiana Tech.

OL Johnny Gibson, Jr.

- Started his 20th-straight game on the offensive line, second-most on the team.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER NOTES

LB Hayden Henry

- Made his first-career start for the Razorbacks Saturday afternoon.

DB Santos Ramirez

- Finished the day with 10 total tackles, his second double-digit tackling effort of the season and the third of his career.

LB Dre Greenlaw

- He made his 33rd career start, the most among active Razorbacks.
- Finished with 13 tackles, his 12th career double-digit tackle performance, the second this season.
- He made recorded his second and third-career interceptions, the first since the season opener in 2016 vs. Louisiana Tech.
- First Razorback with multiple interceptions in a game since Henre' Toliver in 2017 vs. Missouri.

LB De'Jon Harris

- Finished with a career-high 16 tackles and his first sack of the season, leading the team in tackles for the third time this season.
- 12 of his 16 tackles were solo efforts.
- His 2.0 tackles for loss tied for his career high, and the third time he's recorded multiple tackles for loss yardage.
- This is the 11th career double-digit tackle game of Harris' career, the third of this season.
- Has recorded a tackle for loss in three of the last four games.

DT Armon Watts

- Posted five total tackles, recorded his fourth sack of the season.
- His four sacks are the most in a season since Jeremiah Ledbetter 5.5. in 2016.
- Watts has recorded a sack in four of five games this season.
