Versus Texas A&M

- This will be the 158th meeting between Arkansas and Texas A&M. The Razorbacks own a 102-55 advantage in the series, including a slight 38-37 advantage in games played in College Station.
- Arkansas also holds a slight 6-4 advantage in games played since the Aggies joined the SEC for the 2012-13 season.

Oldest, Most Common Rival

- Texas A&M is one of two teams on this year's schedule that Arkansas played in its inaugural season in 1923-24. Texas is the other. It is no coincidence that both Texas A&M and Texas rank 1-2 as the most common opponents in Razorback history.
- The Aggies won each of the first two meetings in that 1923-24 season on back-to-back games in College Station, 35-27 and 32-17.
- With Texas A&M joining the SEC, the Aggies are the Razorbacks' most common opponent with 157 games played in the series.
- Even though Arkansas and Texas have only played six times since 2000, this year's season opener with the Longhorns was the 155th all-time meeting the two schools.

SEC Play Begins

- Arkansas will open conference play at Texas A&M before returning home to host Florida and LSU.
- Beginning its 28th season in the Southeastern Conference, Arkansas is 15-12 all-time in SEC openers.

Last Time Out for Razorbacks

- Keyshawn Embery-Simpson tied his career high with 14 points - all in the second half - to help Arkansas rally past Austin Peay, 76-65, on Friday night at Bud Walton Arena in the final non-conference game of the season for both teams.
- Embery-Simpson fueled a 20-5 Arkansas run that turned a 52-48 deficit into a 68-57 Razorback advantage. Embery-Simpson scored 12 during the run, including seven straight Arkansas points, and capped the rally with a 3-pointer with 4:12 left in the game.
- Gafford recorded his sixth double-double in 12 games this season as he scored 16 points and pulled down 10 rebounds while adding four blocked shots and three steals. Isaiah Joe had 15 points, making four 4-pointers, and Reggie Chaney scored a career-high 12 points.
- Arkansas had 21 assists on 27 made baskets. It is the fourth time Arkansas has had at least 20 assists in a game and the sixth time at least 70 percent of the team's made baskets came directly from an assist.
- Arkansas had a season-high 14 steals and it was the fourth time to record double-digits in steals.
- Arkansas only had 11 turnovers, but just four came in the second half. The 11 turnovers were the second-lowest total of the season by the Razorbacks, who a season-low seven versus both Colorado State and Western Kentucky in back-to-back games.

25th Anniversary of National Championship

- The 2018-19 season is the 25th anniversary of Arkansas defeating Duke, 76-72 in Charlotte, for the 1994 NCAA National Championship. The Razorbacks defeated Arizona, 91-82, in the Final Four.

The 1993-94 season for the Razorbacks was:

FAYETTEVILLE - Arkansas picked up its third home win against a ranked opponent this season, defeating then No. 21 Texas A&M Aggies 94-75 in front of a sold-out Bud Walton Arena.

The Razorbacks were led by Jaylen Barford and Daryl Macon, along with Daniel Gafford. Barford (21) and Macon (20) would combine for 41 points. Gafford accounted for 18 points of his own, going 7-of-8 from the floor with six rebounds, two assists, two blocks and a steal.

Arkansas opened the game on a 13-4 run. Texas A&M would settle in though, going on a 10-3 run of its own to cut the Arkansas lead to two. Gafford would score eight straight for Arkansas, part of a 17-6 Razorback run to give Arkansas its largest lead of the first half at 35-22.

After going back and forth for the first four-plus minutes of the second half, Arkansas was able to run off a 9-1 run, including a streak of seven straight to take a 16-point lead and cruised the rest of the way.

CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just four current Division I coaches with 15-plus years of head coaching experience and zero losing seasons. He is the only coach to accomplish the feat at three different programs.

Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has accomplished that and is in his eighth season at Arkansas – 17th as a head coach.

Anderson has brought Arkansas back national relevance by leading the Razorbacks to back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths and postseason appearances in four of the last five years. The Razorbacks won 49 games over the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons, rank among the top three in league wins over the last six seasons and the Hogs are one of just two teams in the SEC to finish with a .500 winning percentage or better in league play over the last six years. This success has helped Arkansas' last two recruiting classes rank among the nation's top 25, snagging seven of the top eight players in the state over the span.

During his first seven seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 156-88 record and is the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. Since his return to Fayetteville, the Razorbacks own the seventh-most home victories in the country with 117.

The success on-and-off the court has translated into great fan support as Arkansas has ranked among the top 25 in national attendance each of the last seven years, including No. 10 in 2017-18. Also, in August of 2018, Anderson was honored by the Burlsworth Foundation for his contributions to the state.

- 1 of 2 NCAA Championship appearances as Arkansas returned to the national championship game the following year (1995) as well.

• The 1993-94 Razorbacks were led by Hall of Fame coach Nolan Richardson and current Head Hog Mike Anderson was an assistant on that staff.

- Arkansas was ranked #1 nine weeks during that season, was ranked among the top 6 all season, finished with a 31-1 record and was SEC regular-season champion.

- Current Razorback assistant coach Scotty Thurman, who scored 15 points, not only hit critical 3-pointer late in the game as the shot clock expired to break a 70-70 tie. He also hit a 3-pointer late in the first half to give Arkansas a 34-33 lead at the break.

- Corliss Williamson had a game-high 23 points.

- Corey Beck had a double-double (15 pts - 10 rebs).

Texas Connections

• Arkansas has three players with Texas connections, all in the Dallas-Ft. Worth metroplex. Mason Jones hails from DeSoto and Jordan Phillips is from Fort Worth. While Reggie Chaney is from Tulsa, he played at Frisco Liberty HS, where he was the #3 overall prospect in Texas, before he finished his career at Findlay Prep in Nevada.

• Also, Mason Jones' sister, Jordan, was a standout for the Aggies. (Drafted by WNBA, 2x SEC Defensive POY)

Harris Returns to Form

• Jalen Harris dished out seven assists and had just one turnover in the win over Austin Peay. In the two games prior to that, he played his "worst" two games of the season by having just five assists with four turnovers.

• However, Harris still ranks **THIRD IN THE NCAA** and **FIRST IN THE SEC** in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.71). He is also 13th nationally / 2nd in the SEC in assists (6.7 avg.).

• **WAY TOO EARLY RECORD WATCH:** With 20 guaranteed games left (regular-season and at least one at SEC Tourney), Jalen Harris is on pace to have 214 assists this season. The Arkansas single-season record for assists is 219, set by Kareem Reid in 1995-96.

No Ordinary Joe

• Isaiah Joe had also struggled the two games prior to Austin Peay, going just 4-of-17 from long range. However, he drained four treys in the win over the Governors and has made at least four 3-pointers in a game six times this season.

• He **RANKS SEVENTH THE NCAA** and **FIRST IN THE SEC** in 3-pointers made per game (3.83) and leads the SEC in 3-pointers made (46), ranking 17th nationally

• More impressively, while he is second in the SEC in 3-PT FG attempted, he is also second in the league in 3-point FG% (.455).

• **WAY TOO EARLY RECORD WATCH:** With 20 guaranteed games left (regular-season and at least one at SEC Tourney), Joe is on pace to finish with 122 3's made. That would shatter the Arkansas single-season mark of 102, set by Scotty Thurman in 1994-95. The SEC season record is 138 set by Marshall Henderson (Ole Miss) in 2013-14.

MASON-ry, Building a Nice Resume

• Mason Jones may be Arkansas' most consistent player this season. He has led the team in both scoring and assists versus Georgia Tech and Texas State. Overall, he has led the team in scoring a team-best five times, while leading the team in assists three times.

• Jones is second on the team in rebounding (5.1) and assists (39) while ranking third in scoring (13.4) and fourth in steals (13).

CHARGE!

• Gabe Osabuohien took two charges versus Texas State to give him a team-best nine for the season. Last season, Daniel Gafford led the team by taking nine charges and Osabuohien tied for second with eight.

• Overall, the Razorbacks took 47 charges last season and have taken 23 to date this season.

- The pair were at it again in the win over Austin Peay. Embery-Simpson matched his career high with 14 points – scoring 12 points during a decisive 20-5 run. Chaney added a career-high 12 points.

Block Party; 7th in NCAA

- Arkansas has turned away 48 shots over the last seven games – 6.8 average. Highlights include a season-high 11 vs. FIU, nine at Colorado State, eight vs. UTSA and six vs. Georgia Tech.
- The Razorbacks have blocked at least four shots in each game this season.
- Arkansas ranks seventh in the NCAA in blocked shots (6.2).

Helping Hand; 12th in the NCAA

- Head coach Mike Anderson has said, the team is starting to trust each other – passing up good shots for great shots – which has resulted in a high number of assists.
- Arkansas ranks 12th in the NCAA in assists (18.1).

Gafford Backing POY Hype - ONE BLOCK FROM ENTERING SCHOOL TOP 10

- Daniel Gafford is on four National Player of the Year Watch lists and the sophomore has proven why.
- Has six double-doubles in 12 games this season after getting just three in 35 games as a freshman.
- In games Gafford has a double-double, he averages **19.7 pts 11.7 rebs** **Arkansas is 5-1**
- In games Gafford does not have a double-double, he averages **15.3 pts 7.0 rebs** **Arkansas is 4-2**
- Gafford ranks 12th in the NCAA in field goal percentage (.658). In the SEC, Gafford also ranks second in rebounding (9.3), second in blocked shots (2.5) and third in scoring (17.5) – **the only player in the league to rank among the top five in each category.**
- Named **SEC Player of the Week** for his play in leading Arkansas to a win over Indiana, scoring a career-high 27 points and tying a then career-high with 12 rebounds.
- Gafford tied a school record, making 8-of-8 shots from the field versus Montana State. He is the 8th Razorback to make at least all 8 shot attempts in a game and the first to do so twice in his career (also going 8-of-8 versus Minnesota last season).
- Versus UTA, Gafford made a career-best nine free throws and tied a career-high with 10 attempts. Prior to UTA, Gafford had only made 13 free throws on 28 attempts.

- Gafford scored a career-high 27 points and tied his career high with 12 rebounds while adding three blocked shots and two steals. Gafford was most effective in the second half, scoring 19 points, grabbing seven rebounds and getting two steals. In fact, he was 9-for-10 shooting from the field in the period while the rest of the team was just 5-of-23 from the field and scored 16 points.
- Three times in within the final 11 minutes, Indiana took a one-point lead and, each time, Gafford answered to put the Razorbacks back on top. He additionally broke a 63-63 tie with 5:46 left with one of his four dunks on the evening. In the final seconds, Gafford tipped the ball out after a missed shot that led to a Mason Jones rebound and eventual game-winning free throw with 2.5 seconds left.

Joe Named SEC Player of the Week

- Isaiah Joe was named the Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. Joe scored 34 points - 17 in each half - and made 10-of-13 shots from 3-point range to lead the Razorbacks to a 121-89 victory over FIU.
- Joe joins Courtney Fortson (Dec. 15, 2009) as the only Razorback freshman to be named SEC Player of the Week.
- The 34 points are second (tied) on the Arkansas all-time list for most points by a freshman in a game. Bobby Portis scored 35 as a freshman versus Alabama in 2014. Scotty Thurman scored 34 twice as a freshman.
- He is just the fourth Razorback (fifth time in school history) to make at least 10 3-pointers in a game and just the 10th player in SEC history (11th time in league history) to make at least 10 in a game. (Arkansas' Rotnei Clarke had at least 10, 3's twice in his career).
- Joe was 10-for-13 from 3-point range and that .764 percentage ties for the best percentage in SEC history for those that made at least 10 in a game. (Alabama's John Petty was also 10-of-13 last season.)

- He threw down a school-record 75 dunks, which was more than six SEC teams last season and just two dunks behind Missouri, which finished the season with 77.

- In the eight years of the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has 115 home wins, sixth-most in the NCAA over the span.
- For the second straight year, Arkansas will play five Saturday games in Bud Walton Arena, including each of the Razorbacks' last four home games of the regular season.
- Arkansas is an impressive 25-5 in Saturday SEC home games under head coach Mike Anderson, including a streak of nine consecutive wins.

Familiar Foe in the Big 12/SEC Challenge

- Arkansas will travel to Lubbock, Texas to play in the Big 12/SEC Challenge versus Texas Tech, which reached the Elite 8 last season before falling to eventual national champion, Villanova.
- In the 78 previous meetings with the Red Raiders, Arkansas and Texas Tech are all square at 39-39.

- The last time the teams met, which was in the 2016 edition of the Big 12/SEC Challenge, the Razorbacks won, 75-68, in overtime. Arkansas has won five of the last six in the series with Texas Tech and 11 of the last 15.
- Arkansas will be playing in its fifth consecutive Big 12/SEC Challenge. The Razorbacks are 2-2 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge with wins over Texas Tech (2016) and Oklahoma State (2018). Arkansas lost at Iowa State (2015) and at Oklahoma State (2017).

Anderson Honored by Brandon Burlsworth Foundation

- This past August, University of Arkansas head basketball coach Mike Anderson was honored at the annual Brandon Burlsworth Foundation Legends Dinner. Anderson is the ninth Legend the Burlsworth Foundation has honored.
- "The Legends Dinner recognizes a person each year who has made great contributions to our state," said Marty Burlsworth, Chairman/CEO and Founder of the Brandon Burlsworth Foundation. "Coach Anderson has a long history with the University and the state of Arkansas, so it was an easy choice for our board of directors to honor him in this way."
- Anderson is one of four Division I coaches with 15-plus years of head coaching experience and has never experienced a losing season while being the only coach to accomplish the feat at three different programs. In his first 16 years of being a head coach, Anderson has led his teams to 11 postseason berths, including nine NCAA Tournament appearances, and posted 11, 20-win seasons.
- While his on-court success is evident, Coach Anderson is equally a champion in the community. He created his own Mike Anderson Foundation, which provides funding for programs focused on preventative health care education and assists organizations that offer nutritional support for children. Anderson is active with the Yvonne Richardson Center and Samaritan's Feet. Also, each year at the annual Red-White Game, fans get in free with a canned food item, which helps support the Northwest Arkansas Food Bank. In fact, Anderson has done similar food drives as the head coach at Missouri and UAB as well as assist with Special Olympics at all three stops.

Moncrief Enshrined in Hall of Fame; Joins Richardson and Sutton in Hall

- Last March, Arkansas legend Sidney Moncrief was elected to the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2018. The ceremony was **Sunday, Nov. 18** in Kansas City. Others being inducted into the class are Arizona's Sean Elliott, Houston's Otis Birdsong, North Carolina's Sam Perkins, Morgan State's Marvin Webster and USC's Paul Westphal will join former Charleston coach John Kresse and former Oregon Tech coach Danny Miles.
- Moncrief becomes the third Razorback to be inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame, joining his former coach Eddie Sutton who was selected in 2011 and Nolan Richardson who entered in 2008. All three Arkansas legends have a banner hanging in the rafters of Bud Walton Arena.
- One of the Arkansas' famed "Triplets", Moncrief ended his career as Arkansas's leader in scoring (he ranks second now behind Todd Day) with 2,066 points from 1976-79. He poured in 600-plus points each of his last two years in Fayetteville, one of just four Razorbacks to score more than 600 points during two separate seasons.
- Moncrief helped lead Arkansas to two Elite Eight appearances and the 1978 Final Four, when the Razorbacks recorded Arkansas' first of five total 30-win seasons in program history, going 32-4 overall. A 14-time All-American, Moncrief's name is scattered all through Arkansas' record book and he was named All-Southwest Conference his last three years as a Razorback, while being named to the 1978 NCAA Tournament All-Regional West Team and to the 1979 All-Regional Midwest Team.
- Moncrief was drafted fifth overall in the 1979 NBA Draft to the Milwaukee Bucks, where he spent his first 11 NBA seasons, before finishing his career in Atlanta in 1990-91. The Little Rock native was just the second Razorback in school history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft and remains as the only player to be taken in the top five. While in Milwaukee, Moncrief earned All-NBA first team honors once (1983) and second team honors four times (1982-85 and 1986). The five-time All-Star was also named to the NBA's All-Defensive first team four years (1983-86) and second team in 1982, along with earning NBA Defensive Player of the Year honors two seasons (1982-83 and 1983-84). During his 12-year NBA career, Moncrief averaged 15.6 points, 4.7 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game.

Arkansas Signs Justice Hill

- Arkansas men's head basketball coach Mike Anderson announced Justice Hill signed a National Letter of Intent.
- "Obviously, we are very excited to have Justice join our family," Anderson said. "He committed to us as a freshman and has continued to grow both as a player and a person. He is an excellent student and athlete who comes from an outstanding family. Justice possesses good court vision, has really good basketball instincts and is athletic. He will be a perfect fit for our 'FASTEST40' style of play."

In the playoffs, accounted for seven touchdowns in the both the quarterfinals and semifinals ... **Was the game MVP in leading the Warriors to their first state championship** beating four-time defending champion Pulaski Academy ... 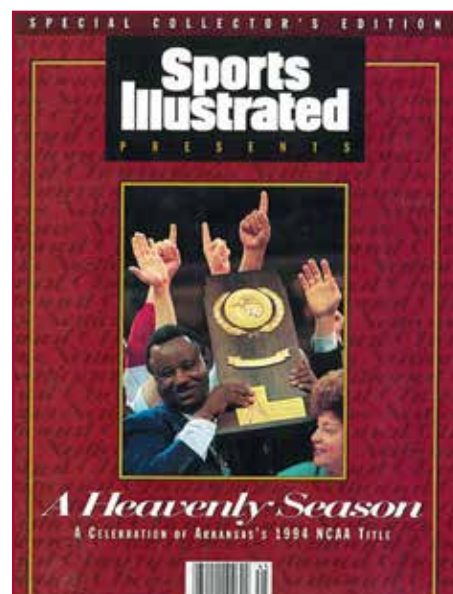
