• Was 3-0 at 2019 SEC Championship Match Play with a par on the 18th hole in the final to clinch decisive third point.

• During SEC stroke play, was 8th with **3-under-par, 207** (66-67-74) ... The 207 ties for the fourth-best, 54-hole score by a Razorback at the SEC Championship.

• Tied for sixth with a 54-hole, **3-under-par score of 210** (67-72-71) at the NCAA Austin Regional ... Edged McNeese State's Blake Elliott (ranked 17th in the nation) by one shot to secure the lone spot for an individual to advance from the Austin Regional ... Perico led as various points during all three days of competition.

• Placed fourth at Gopher Invitational (68-74-67=209), three shots behind co-medalist and teammate William Buhl.

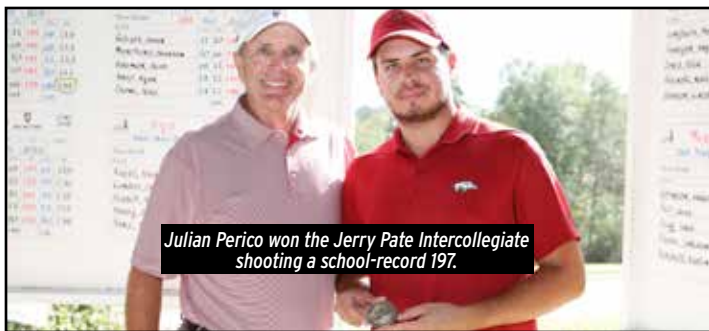

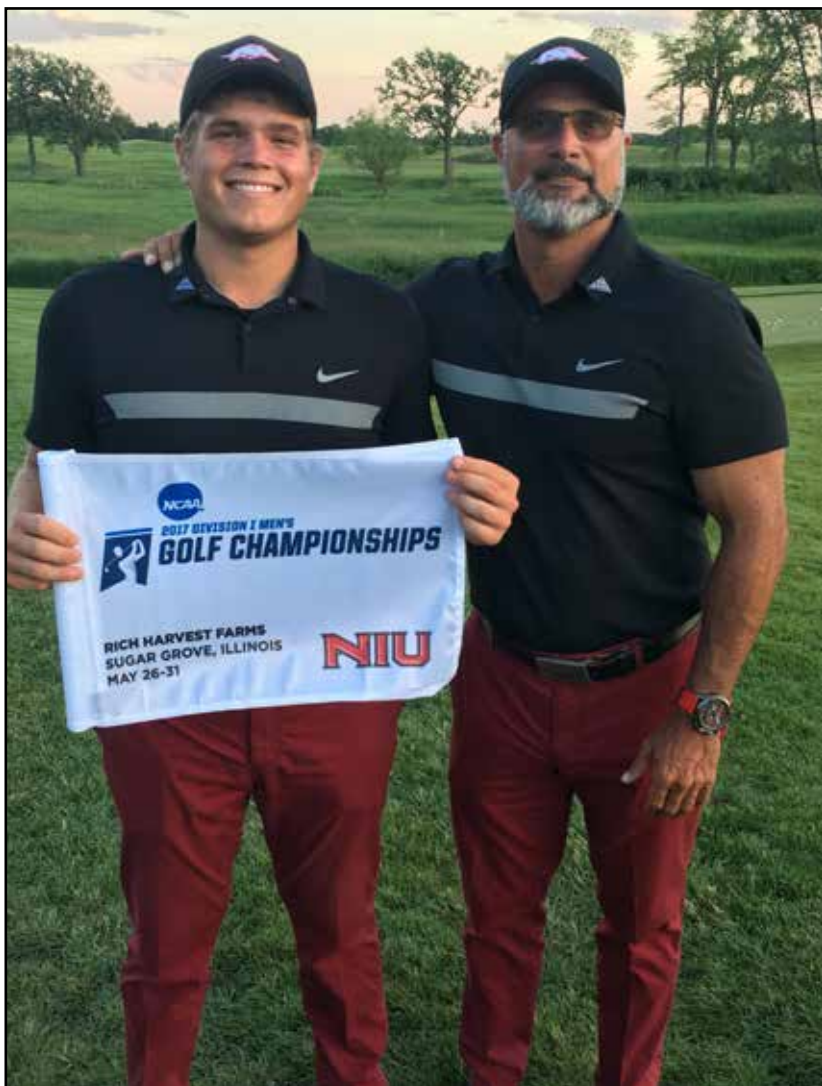
