


## ARKANSAS HIGH SCHOOL INVITATIONAL SATURDAY, JANUARY 18, 2020

## **MEET INFORMATION**

Entry Information	The Arkansas High School Invitational is open to high school athletes, grades 9–12, only. Athletes may compete for their high school, track club or as an unattached individual. Please note, high school athletes and coaches are responsible for knowing any competition restrictions from their state high school league. The University of Arkansas is not responsible for athletes who jeopardize their high school eligibility.	
	When entering, please submit marks that were achieved during the 2019 or 2020 season only. Meet management reserves the right to select which sections entrants will be placed.	
Entry Deadline	All entries are due online at <i>DirectAthletics.com</i> by <i>5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13.</i> No entries or entry changes will be accepted after the close of entries.	
Accepted Entries	A list of accepted entries will be sent to coaches by 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 14.	
Entry Fee Structure	Entry fees are \$20 per athlete per event and \$40 per relay. Entry fees will be calculated based on the number of entries received, not the number of athletes that are declared or ultimately compete. <i>All entry fees <u>must</u> be paid</i> <i>through Direct Athletics. Entries not paid online will <u>NOT</u> be accepted into the competition. No other forms of payment are accepted.</i>	
	It is important to note that entries cannot be altered once entry fees are paid. Please wait to complete the payment process until all entries are entered online with seed marks. Once entry fees are paid, not refunds can be given. Due to the nature of the structure of the meet, entry fees cannot be refunded for any reason, including weather and⁄or other unforeseen circumstances.	
Schedule of Events	The time schedule will be revised based upon the entries received. The final schedule will be sent to coaches and posted on <i>ArkansasRazorbacks.com</i> on Wednesday, January 15.	
Practice Times	The track at the Randal Tyson Track Center will be open for <u>SHAKE OUTS</u> for approximately one hour after the completion of the college Arkansas Invitational on Friday evening, at approximately 7:00 p.m. <u>No spikes will be</u> <u>allowed and runways/pits will NOT be open.</u> There are no other practice times available at the Tyson Center.	
Facility Access	The Randal Tyson Track Center will open to competitors and coaches on Saturday at 7:00 a.m. Only athletes will be permitted inside the competition areas.	
Spikes	Athletes may use only pyramid or Christmas tree spikes. Spikes will be checked and those not meeting the regulations must be replaced by the athlete. No pin⁄needle spikes will be allowed on the competition track or practice facility.	
Packets	High school coaches and individual athletes may pick up packets at the information booth inside the Randal Tyson Track Center on Friday from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.	
	We will distribute the packet to the first coach who arrives at the packet pick-up area. This packet will contain the access credentials for the entire team. <i>Please make arrangements to meet your team at a designated location</i> <i>outside the Tyson Center to distribute credentials if you are planning to arrive at different times. We will not hold</i> <i>the packet at the packet pick-up area.</i>	
Awards	Awards will be given to the top three overall finishers per event.	
Warm–up Areas	No warm-ups will be permitted on the track at any time. Athletes should use the warm-up facility located in the Fowler Training Center. Hurdles and starting blocks will be located there. The oval around the competition track <u>may</u> <u>not</u> be used for warm-ups during the meet. <u>No food or beverage, other than water, is allowed in the Fowler Center</u> .	
Implement Inspection	Implement inspection will begin on Saturday at 7:00 a.m. at the east end of the Fowler Center in the track storage room. All implements must be inspected NOT LATER THAN ninety minutes before the scheduled start of the event. Implements will be impounded until they are brought by the officials to the event site. The implement room will close one hour after the completion of the final throwing event of the day.
