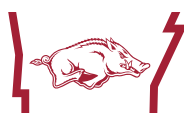

Versus Rice

• Rice is one of Arkansas' oldest rivals. In fact, the Owls are one of three teams on this year's schedule that Arkansas played in its first season of basketball (1923-24) along with Texas A&M and TCU.

• The Arkansas and Rice rivalry dates back to the Razorbacks' first season of basketball, 1923-24. The two squads played twice that year - both at Rice and it was Arkansas' second-to-last series of the year.

• Arkansas owns a 102-41 advantage in the series, including a 54-11 mark in games played in Fayetteville.

• Arkansas has won 15 straight in the series and 40 of the last 43. Rice is one of three teams Arkansas has beaten at least 100 times along with TCU (104) and Texas A&M (103).

• With 143 games played, Rice is Arkansas' fourth-most common opponent. The leaders being Texas A&M (158; 102-56), Texas (155; 87-68), SMU (155; 96-59), Rice (143; 102-41), Baylor (143; 95-48) and TCU (142; 104-38).

• However, the Razorbacks and Owls have only played once since Arkansas left the Southwest Conference to join the SEC for the 1991-92 season. That lone meeting was on Dec. 17, 2005 in Little Rock, a game Arkansas won 80-61.

For Openers

• Arkansas opens its 97th season of basketball in 2019-20 and the first under head coach Eric Musselman.

• Arkansas is 77-19 all-time in season openers and has opened the year in the win column in 45 of the last 48 seasons.

• The Razorbacks have won 44 straight home openers, including a 26-0 record in openers inside Bud Walton Arena.

• The Razorbacks had a streak of 23 consecutive season openers end last year with an overtime loss to Texas in the ESPN Armed Forces Classic in El Paso.

• Eric Musselman is 4-0 in both home and season openers. Over the last three seasons, his season opener was also his home opener. In his first year as a collegiate head coach, Nevada opened the season with a win in Hawaii and returned to Reno to win its home opener.

Exhibition Games

Versus UALR

• On a day the University unveiled Nolan Richardson Court at Bud Walton Arena, the 2019-20 Razorbacks honored the Hall of Fame coach with a 79-64 exhibition victory over Little Rock.

• Arkansas used a 19-3 run to start the game and a 21-6 run to start the second half to set the stage for the win.

Versus SWOSU

• Adrio Bailey was 7-of-7 from the field and Mason Jones scored a game-high 22 points to lead Arkansas to a 78-51 exhibition victory over Southwestern Oklahoma State at Bud Walton Arena.

Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including four as a head coach at Nevada and 14 as a professional head coach.

In his four years as Nevada head coach, Musselman won at least 24 games each season (24, 28, 29 and 29) to post a 110-34 record and .764 winning percentage - sixth-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined winning percentage of .626 (553-330).

Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons Michael and Matthew and the couple has a daughter Mariah.

Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

November to Remember

- For the first time ever, Arkansas will play seven games in the month of November this season. Also, Nov. 5 is the earliest Arkansas has opened a season.
- Arkansas has played as many as six times in the month on 10 occasions.
- Arkansas is 119-40 (.748) all-time in the month of November.
- Arkansas did not play in the month of November until the 1969-70 season and only played seven total games in the month over the next 10 years.
- Arkansas has played at least once in November dating back to the 1993-94 championship season when they beat Murray State, 93-62, on Nov. 29.

Cylla and Whitt Almost Have More Points Than 8 Returning Razorbacks

- Named after Class of 1980 Hall of Famer and 1959 NCAA Final Four Most Valuable Player Jerry West, the annual honor in its sixth year recognizes the top shooting guards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.
 - Joe is coming off a record-setting freshman campaign as he drained 113 3-pointers for the Razorbacks. The Fort Smith native set the school record for 3-pointers made, set the SEC freshman record for 3-pointers made per game (3.32), tied the SEC freshman record for 3-pointers made and ranks fourth in NCAA history for 3-pointers made by a freshman in a season. Joe additionally was just the fourth SEC freshman to lead the league in 3-point field goal percentage for a season (.414). Joe was additionally just one of seven players in the NCAA to make at least 110 3-pointers and shoot at least 41 percent from long range.
 - Joe is one of seven SEC players to make the 20-person watch list, joining Anthony Edwards (Georgia), Tyrese Maxey (Kentucky), Skylar Mays (LSU), Breein Tyree (Ole Miss), A.J. Lawson (South Carolina) and Jordan Bowden (Tennessee).

Joe Picked SEC Preseason 2nd Team; Razorbacks 11th

- University of Arkansas sophomore Isaiah Joe was named to the media's 2019-20 preseason All-SEC team while the Razorbacks were predicted to finish 11th this season, it was announced today by the league office.
- Joe, who was named second team All-SEC last season, is one of the top returning scorers in the SEC. The Fort Smith product averaged 13.85 points per game last season and ranks third among returning players in the league trailing Ole Miss' Breein Tyree (17.91 ppg) and Texas A&M's Savion Flagg (13.88 ppg).
- Joe set several records by making 113 3-pointers last season – setting an Arkansas single-season mark and tying an SEC freshman record. His 113 triples were the fourth-most ever by an NCAA freshman in a season and his 3.32 3-pointers made per game set an SEC single-season record by a freshman. Joe additionally led the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage, becoming just the fourth SEC freshman to accomplish the feat.
- Joe not only made a name for himself on the offensive end, but he ranked 10th in the

- Arkansas is embarking on the first year with Eric Musselman as Razorback head coach. Last year, Arkansas had one of the youngest teams in the NCAA, having no seniors. This year, Arkansas will have a veteran squad featuring three seniors - including two graduate transfers that have combined for nearly 2,000 points, four returning starters and eight returning lettermen with no freshmen. Also, despite losing NBA draft pick and last year's leading scorer/rebounder Daniel Gafford, Arkansas still returns 68.8 percent of its scoring, 62.6 percent of its rebounding, 88.0 percent of its 3-pointers made, 83.2 percent of its assists and 68.8 percent of its steals.
- While the Hogs are picked 11th, Arkansas has exceeded its preseason predictions in each of the last six years.

Non-Conference Road Trips

- (HogStats): This season will be just the second time in the 21st century that the Razorbacks have had 3+ true road non-conference games in the regular season (i.e. excluding NIT games).
- 2019-20 - at Georgia Tech, Western Kentucky and Indiana
- 2014-15 - at SMU, Iowa State and Clemson
- Arkansas, Oklahoma and Boston College are the only Power 5 teams to play three true non-conference road games this season.**
 - ^ Oklahoma will play its three games consecutively in early December (North Texas, Wichita State and Creighton).

Rare Trips to ACC & Big 10 for Hogs

- This year will mark just the first time Arkansas has played at Georgia Tech since Jan. 28, 1966 and the first time Arkansas has played a regular-season game at Indiana since the 1949-50 season. (NOTE: Arkansas played at Indiana in the second round of last year's NIT.)
- Arkansas will be traveling to an ACC gym for just the ninth time and first time since the 2015-16 season. This will be just the eighth time Arkansas has played at a Big 10 opponent.

Non-Conference Opponents

- Arkansas owns a 271-111 record versus its 2019-20 non-conference opponents.
- Arkansas will be facing Montana, Northern Kentucky and Valparaiso for the first time.
- Arkansas is a combined 25-0 versus Austin Peay (4-0), North Texas (14-0), South Dakota (1-0) and Texas Southern (6-0).

New Arc, No Problem

- The 3-point arc has been moved back nearly two feet for the 2019-20 season. However, Arkansas has experience with the new arc as it was used during last year's NIT.
- The Razorbacks shot nearly 40 percentage points better in its two NIT games from 3-point range (.383) compared to the rest of the season (.342).
- The Razorbacks made their first five 3-point attempts at Providence and finished the game making 10-of-21 - 47.6%.
- Overall, the Razorbacks ended the season shooting the ball well from long range. Over their last seven games, the Razorbacks made over 45 percent from 3-point range five times, including:

 - * **JEANTAL CYLLA** is a graduate transfer from UNC Wilmington and member of the Haitian national team. He played his first two years at Florida Atlantic before transferring to UNCW. In his three-year collegiate career, Cylla has scored 984 points in 96 career games.
 - * **JIMMY WHITT JR.** played his freshman season at Arkansas and played his last two seasons at SMU. Whitt has scored 910 points in his 92 career games.
 - * **CONNOR VANOVER** will have to sit the 2019-20 season per NCAA transfer rules. Vanover played his freshman campaign last season at Cal. Vanover is a native of Little Rock and played with current Razorback sophomore Reggie Chaney at Findley (Nev.) Prep.
 - * **JD NOTAE** will have to sit the 2019-20 season per NCAA transfer rules. Notae played two seasons at Jacksonville University where he tallied 929 points (15.5 avg.), 328 rebounds (5.5 avg.), 163 assists (2.7 avg.) and 101 steals (1.7 avg.).

Nolan Richardson Court

- Last March, the University of Arkansas System Board of Trustees unanimously approved a resolution to name the court at Bud Walton Arena for Hall of Fame coach Nolan Richardson.
- The University unveiled Nolan Richardson Court at Bud Walton Arena on October 20 prior to exhibition game with Little Rock. Arkansas won the game 79-64 on the newly-named court.
- Richardson was 389-169 in 17 seasons as Arkansas head coach and set a school record for wins. Among his many honors are NABC and Naismith Coach of the Year (1994), USBWA Most Courageous Award (1995), University of Arkansas Sports Hall of Honor (1996), Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame (1998), College Basketball Hall of Fame (2008) and the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2014). He was honored with a banner in the rafters of Bud Walton Arena in 2015.
- He led the Razorbacks to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances including six Sweet 16's (1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996), four Elite Eights (1990, 1991, 1994, 1995), three Final Fours (1990, 1994, 1995) a national runner-up finish (1995) and the 1994 NCAA Championship.
- In Richardson's 22 combined years as a head coach at the collegiate level – at Western Texas Junior College, the University of Tulsa and the University of Arkansas – he compiled a record of 508-206 (.711) and became the only head coach in college basketball history to win a National Junior College Championship, NIT Championship and NCAA Championship.

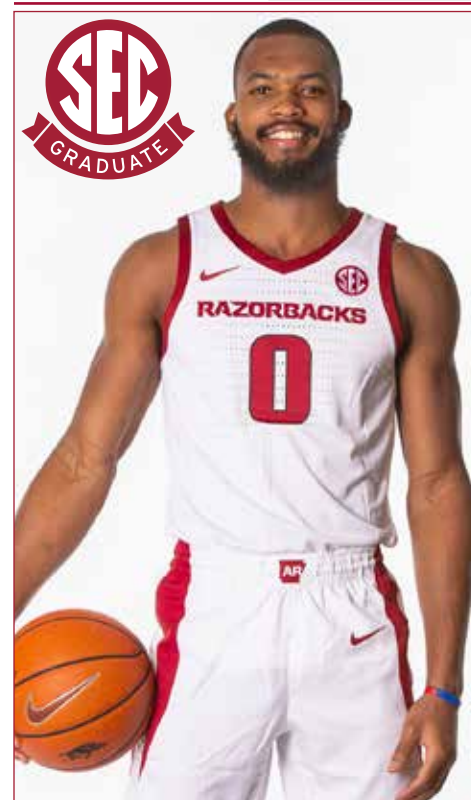
