- Arkansas will face Northern Kentucky Saturday Nov. 30 in the final game of the Roadshow.

Versus Georgia Tech

- This will be the seventh meeting between Arkansas and Georgia Tech.
 The Yellow Jackets have won five straight in the series and are 5-1 all-time.
- Arkansas' lone victory came in the inaugural meeting, 74-42, on Dec. 20, 1961 in Greenville, S.C. at the Poinsettia Classic.

Non-Conference Road Trips

- (HogStats): This season will be just the second time in the 21st century that the Razorbacks have had 3+ true road non-conference games in the regular season (i.e. excluding NIT games).
- 2019-20 at Georgia Tech, Western Kentucky and Indiana
- 2014-15 at SMU, Iowa State and Clemson
- Arkansas, Oklahoma and Boston College are the only Power 5 teams to play three true non-conference road games this season.
 Oklahoma will play its three games consecutively in early December (North Texas, Wichita State and Creighton).

Rare Trip to ACC for Hogs

- This year will mark the first time Arkansas has played at Georgia Tech since Jan. 28, 1966.
- Arkansas will be traveling to an ACC gym for just the 10th time and first time since the 2015-16 season.

Hogs' 3D Bests 'Yotes

- The Arkansas-South Dakota contest was billed as one that the 3-point line could decided the game ... and perhaps it did.
- ^ South Dakota entered the game leading (and still leads) the NCAA in 3PT FG% at 51.1 pct (47-of-92), making 9.4 per game and taking 18.4. ^ Also, Coyote Tyler Hagedorn entered the game leading the NCAA in 3-point shooting (84 percent 16-of-19, including 8-of-8 one game).
- ^ Arkansas entered the game ranked third in the NCAA in 3PT FG% Defense at 11.6 percent with no team making more that two treys.

FAYETTEVILLE – Jose Alvarado scored 20 points to help Georgia Tech hold on in the closing minutes for a 69-65 win at Arkansas.

Alvarado was 9-of-15 from the field and added nine rebounds. James Banks III finished with a double-double (14 points and 15 rebounds) and Michael Devoe contributed 11 points and Khalid Moore had 10 in the win.

Mason Jones led Arkansas with 17 points, while Daniel Gafford added 14 and Isaiah Joe 13.

Arkansas trailed by as many as 11 points in the first half while opening the game 1-of-11 from the field, including 0-of-8 on 3-pointers.

The Razorbacks, however, hit 6-of-9 3-point attempts to close out the half – with Jones and Joe combining for five – and rallied to take a 32-31 halftime lead.

Arkansas maintained its halftime lead until Tech's Khalid Moore's layup with 10:49 left gave Georgia Tech a 45-43 lead.

The lead changed hands seven times over the next four-plus minutes. Banks made two free throws with 1:47 left to give Georgia Tech a one-point lead, one it would not relinquish.

Jones sank two free throws with 39 seconds left to make it a one-possession game, 65-62, only to see Tech's Moore push the lead back to five by making two at the charity stripe.

Jones scored his 17th point of the night on a 3-pointer with five seconds left to make it a two-point game, but Moore sank two more free throws with one second left to seal the victory.

Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketbal coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including four as a head coach at Nevada and 14 as a professiona head coach.

In his four years as Nevada head coach, Musselman won at least 24 games each season (24, 28, 29 and 29) to post a 110-34 record and .764 winning percentage - sixth-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined winning percentage of .626 (553-330).

Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons Michael and Matthew and the couple has a daughter Mariah.

Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA



South Dakota was the first team to make three 3-pointers versus Arkansas this season when Cody Kelley sank a triple to score the Coyotes' final points with 2:11 left in the game

- Arkansas' defense has been impressive in the season-opening wins, especially the Razorbacks' 3-point defense.
- Only one team has made more than two 3-pointers in a game this year (South Dakota made three) and opponents are a combined 11-of-81 from long range.
- ^ Arkansas' 11.6% 3-point defense ranks 1st in the NCAA.
- Arkansas has held its five opponents to 56 points or less, including three teams less
- ^ Arkansas' 47.8 ppg scoring defense ranks 2nd in the NCAA.
- Only one team has shot above 34 percent against Arkansas, including a lows of 28.6 by Rice and North Texas, who missed its first 11 shots against the Hogs.
- ^ Arkansas' 33.7% FG pct defense ranks 6th in the NCAA.
- Arkansas forced Rice into 27 turnovers, Montana into 23 and Texas Southern into 24.
- ^ The 21.0 turnovers forced ranks 11th in the NCAA.
- Arkansas has had double-digit steals in the first four games, including 14 vs Rice, 13 vs Texas Southern and 11 each versus North Texas and Montana.
- ^ Arkansas' 11.4 steals per game ranks 10th in the NCAA.

- Did you know, Arkansas' defense forced two opponents to miss a combined 32 consecutive 3-pointers over the first two games?
- ^ Rice missed its first 3PT attempt, made two and missed its last 22.
- ^ North Texas missed its first 10 and finished the game making 2-of-its-last-7.
- THEN, Montana missed its first 10 (0-of-6 in the first half) and finished the game making 2-of-its-last-6.
- Over a three-game span (first half of Rice, all of North Texas and into second half of Montana, Arkansas held its opponents to 2-of-49 (4.1 percent) from 3-point range.

Best 5-Game Defensive Stretch Since....

- Arkansas has only allowed 239 points this season holding all five teams to 56 or less.
- Arkansas ranks third in the NCAA in scoring defense at 45.8 ppg.
- The 239 points allowed over five games is Arkansas' best five-game total since the 1980-81 season - pre-shot clock and pre-3-point line - when the Razorbacks held five Southwest Conference opponents to just 230 points.
- The 183 points allowed over four games to start the season is the lowest since 1945-46 when Hog opponents only scored 203 – three versus military installations.

Free Throw Improvement

- Arkansas was 11-of-12 at the free throw line vs South Dakota and ranks 21st the NCAA and second in the SEC in free throw percentage (.791).
- That may not seem like something to brag about unless you consider that last year, the Hogs were 306th (of 351 teams) in free throw percentage (.668).
- The team's percentage is bolstered by Mason Jones, who is 27-of-27 (and has made 36 straight dating back to last year). He is 1 of 16 players in the NCAA to be 100% at the line.

5-0

- Arkansas is off to a 5-0 start for the first time since 2014-15 and the 11th time since 198-82 (39 years).
- Arkansas won its first six in 2014-15, its first eight in 1997-98, its first 10 en route to a National Championship in 1993-94, its first 14 in both 1982-83 and 1977-78, and won a school-record 15 straight to open the 1928-29 season (finishing 19-1).
- The last time a first year Arkansas head men's basketball coach started 5-0 was Nolan Richardson, who started 5-0 in 1985-86.
- The only other first-year Razorback head coach to start 5-0 was Eugene Lambert, who was 10-0 in 1942-43.

Recapping the Texas Southern Win

Arkansas held the NCAA's leading 3-point shooting team to 25 percent from beyond the arc and graduate senior Jimmy Whitt Jr., tied a career high with 24 points while adding

seen rebounds to lead the Razorbacks (5-0) to a 77-56 victory over South Dakota (5-1) Friday night at Bud Walton Arena in the teams' third game of the Collegiate Hoops Roadshow, presented by AtmosAir.

- · Whitt was 11-of-14 from the field and 2-of-3 from the free throw line. He set an Arkansas record for most points by a guard in the 3-point era without attempting a 3-pointer (@HogStats.com - the previous mark was 23 points by Corey Beck versus Jackson State on Dec. 18, 1993). Whitt led the Razorbacks with 10 first-half points. In the second half, South Dakota cut its deficit to 10 twice before Whitt answered on the other end each time, the second to start a 13-0 run to seal the win
- South Dakota entered the game shooting 51.1 percent (47-of-92) from 3-point range and making 9.4 triples per game. The Razorbacks entered the game third in the NCAA in 3-point field goal defense (11.6 percent). The Coyotes were the first team to make as many as three 3-pinters in a game versus the Razorbacks, who have now held opponents to just 11-of-81 (13.6 percent).
- Mason Jones added 14 points and seven rebounds for the Razorbacks, while Isaiah Joe had five boards and five assists. Arkansas' bench outscored the Coyotes 21-7.
- · South Dakota put three players in double figures including Tyler Hagedorn (15), Stanley Umude (13) and Cody Kelley

Arkansas Receives Votes

- After getting 11 votes in the first AP regular-season poll. Arkansas received just three votes in the second AP poll. which would equate to #43 ranking, despite two more convincing wins. Arkansas received nine votes in the Coaches Poll -#37.
- Arkansas has not been ranked since Jan. 2018 (22nd), starting 11-2. However, the Razorbacks dropped out after losses to Mississippi State (1/2/18) and Auburn (1/6/18).
- Arkansas, which started 6-1, received votes on three consecutive weeks by the AP last season, including one vote on Nov. 19, six votes on Nov. 26 and three votes on Dec. 3.

Turnover Turnaround

- An area of improvement Coach Musselman identified for this team is the amount of turnovers it has had 18 each exhibition win and 21 in the season opener versus Rice.
- After the season openers across the nation, Arkansas ranked 280th of 305 DI teams for turnovers and the 21 turnovers tied for the most by an Eric Musselman-coached team.
- Arkansas only committed 10 turnovers vs. North Texas, 13 vs. Montana and 10 vs. Texas Southern and eight versus South Dakota and are down to 90th in the NCAA and 4th in the SEC (12.4).

 Arkansas went 4-0 and won the Hardwood Classic last season with home wins over UC Davis, Indiana, Montana State and UT Arlington.

- · For the first time ever, Arkansas will play seven games in the month of November this season. Also, Nov. 5 is the earliest Arkansas has opened a season.
- Arkansas has played as many as six times in the month on 10 occasions.
- Arkansas is 124-40 (.756) all-time in the month of November.
- Eric Musselman is 30-4 (.882) as head coach in the month of November.
- · Arkansas did not play in the month of November until the 1969-70 season and only played seven total games in the month over the next 10 years.
- Arkansas has played at least once in November dating back to the 1993-94 championship season when they beat Murray State, 93-62, on Nov. 29.

- · Joe is coming off a record-setting freshman campaign as he drained 113 3-pointers for the Razorbacks. The Fort Smith native set the school record for 3-pointers made, set the SEC freshman record for 3-pointers made per game (3.32), tied the SEC freshman record for 3-pointers made and ranks fourth in NCAA history for 3-pointers made by a freshman in a season. Joe additionally was just the fourth SEC freshman to lead the league in 3-point field goal percentage for a season (.414). Joe was additionally just one of seven players in the NCAA to make at least 110 3-pointers and shoot at least 41 percent from long range.
- Joe is one of seven SEC players to make the 20-person watch list, joining Anthony Edwards (Georgia), Tyrese Maxey (Kentucky), Skylar Mays (LSU), Breein Tyree (Ole Miss), A.J. Lawson (South Carolina) and Jordan Bowden (Tennessee).

Joe Picked SEC Preseason 2nd Team; Razorbacks 11th

- · University of Arkansas sophomore Isaiah Joe was named to the media and coaches 2019-20 preseason AI-SEC team while the Razorbacks were predicted to finish 11th by the media this season, it was announced today by the league office.
- \cdot Joe, who was named second team AII-SEC last season, is one of the top returning scorers in the SEC. The Fort Smith product averaged 13.85 points per game last season and ranks third among returning players in the league trailing Ole Miss' Breein Tyree (17.91 ppg) and Texas A&M's Savion Flagg (13.88 ppg).
- While the Hogs are picked 11th, Arkansas has exceeded its preseason predictions in each of the last six years.

Joe: Just As Valuable on Defense as Offense ... and In Other Areas

- · Isaiah Joe is nearly matching his 3-pointers made with his deflections on defense.
- Joe has made 129 career 3-pointers and only needs 24 more to enter the school's all-time top 10.
- Joe has 121 career deflections. Joe also led the team in steals (51) and charges drawn (27) last season.
- When he's not racking up deflections, steals and charges, Joe is just plain solid on defense.

Hogs Sign Davonte Davis

- Arkansas head coach Eric Musselman announced on Nov. 19 that Davonte Davis, a fourstar recruit from Jacksonville, signed a National Letter of Intent with the Razorbacks.
- Davis (6-4, 175) is rated 80th on the ESPN Top 100 while ESPN has him the 18th-best shooting guard, the 18th-best player in the region and the second-best player in the state of Arkansas.
- "Our coaching staff is so excited to announce the signing of Davonte "Devo" Davis," Musselman said. "Devo will bring tremendous toughness and versatility to our Arkansas Razorbacks team. We love Devo's ability to be both a playmaker and a scorer at all three levels. He is an elite free throw attempt player and does a great job finishing through contact. From a defensive perspective, Devo will add a long, athletic defender that can guard multiple positions. He is an exhilarating, exciting point guard that Hog fans will love to watch and teammates will love to play with him."
- In other recruiting services, Davis is 100th on the 247Sports Composite and 16th among point guards. Rivals has him ranked 128th nationally and 29th at his position while 247Sports puts him 139th nationally and 21st among point guards. He is also #3 in the state by 247Sports.
- Davis was named to the 2019 USA TODAY All-Arkansas first team as a junior as he averaged 18.5 points, 5.3 rebounds and six assists per game. He played for Woodz Elite in the Nike FYRI
- He is a three-time Arkansas Activities Association All-State selection, making the 2019 5A team with Jacksonville HS and the 2A teams in 2017 and 2018 while playing at Jacksonville Lighthouse.
- As a sophomore, Davis averaged 18.4 points, 8 assists, 7 rebounds and 2 steals. As a freshman, Davis averaged 16 points and seven rebounds in leading Lighthouse to conference and regional championships as well as the Class 2A state semifinal.



Nolan Richardson Court

- Last March, the University of Arkansas System Board of Trustees unanimously approved a resolution to name the court at Bud Walton Arena for Hall of Fame coach Nolan Richardson.
- The University unveiled Nolan Richardson Court at Bud Walton Arena on October 20 prior to exhibition game with Little Rock. Arkansas won the game 79-64 on the newly-named court.
- Richardson was 389-169 in 17 seasons as Arkansas head coach and set a school record for wins. Among his many honors are NABC and Naismith Coach of the Year (1994), USBWA Most Courageous Award (1995), University of Arkansas Sports Hall of Honor (1996), Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame (1998), College Basketball Hall of Fame (2008) and the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2014). He was honored with a banner in the rafters of Bud Walton Arena in 2015.
- He led the Razorbacks to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances including six Sweet 16's (1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996), four Elite Eights (1990, 1991, 1994, 1995), three Final Fours (1990, 1994, 1995) a national runner-up finish (1995) and the 1994 NCAA Championship.
- In Richardson's 22 combined years as a head coach at the collegiate level at Western Texas Junior College, the University of Tulsa and the University of Arkansas he compiled a record of 508-206 (.711) and became the only head coach in college basketball history to win a National Junior College Championship, NIT Championship and NCAA Championship.
