FASTBREAK POINTS

Northern Kentucky Points

- NKU defeated Midway (Ky.) 86-56 on Monday night to move to 5-2 on the year.
- NKU travels to Arkansas for a Saturday evening tilt at Bud Walton Arena, marking the second SEC foe of the year for the Norse. They fell at Mizzou, 71-56, on Nov. 8.
- The Norse are in search of their first win against a Power 5 or BIG EAST program in the DI era, as they sit at 0-17. Including the DII era, NKU is 2-22 all-time versus teams currently in those six conferences. The two wins came against Xavier in the late 1970s.
- Since the start of the 2016-17 campaign, NKU is 44-6 (.880) at BB&T Arena. The Norse also sold a program-record 1,403 season tickets this year.
- The Norse have ripped off 69 steals so far, a total that ranks 15th in the nation. The team's 9.9 steals per game also rank 29th.
- Offensively, the Norse are letting it rain from long range this year. The team ranks 12th in the country in 3-point field-goal attempts (208th) and 16th in made threes (69).
- NKU is in the first year of the Darin Horn era, as the Kentucky native is just the sixth head coach in the 49th season of the program. In his 10th year as a head coach, Horn has a career record of 176-113.
- NKU is coming off of its second trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last three years, where it fell 72-57 to No. 3 Texas Tech, which finished as the national runner-up.
- NKU has been the most-dominant team in the Horizon League over the last three seasons, amassing a 46-15 mark against league foes while winning four of the combined six league championships (regular season and tournament).
- With a DI-era record 26 wins last year, NKU secured a third-straight 20-win season for the first time in the DI era and just the third time in program history.
- Since the start of the 2016-17 season, NKU is a combined 77-32 (.706), has won the Horizon League regular season twice (2018, 2019) and league tourney twice (2017, 2019), and has played in both the NCAA Tournament (2017, 2019) and NIT (2018). No other team in DI history has registered this level of accomplishments in its first three years with active status.

Norse Points

- Over the last three games against DI competition, F **Dantez Walton** has averaged 25.0 points and 8.3 rebounds per game.
- A senior for the Norse, Walton is currently averaging 14.7 points and 6.6 rebounds per game.
- Walton registered a career-high 33 points and 10 rebounds for his second career double-double in the loss against Texas Southern. The effort earned him his first Horizon League Player of the Week nod.
- Walton's career night put him into the top-50 all-time scorers at NKU. He has 772 points to rank No. 47.
- G **Trevon Faulkner** is one of four returning starters for NKU this year. The sophomore guard is averaging 12.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game.
- Faulkner used 9-of-16 shooting to tally a career-best 24 points versus Texas Southern.
- W **Karl Harris** registered his first career double-double with 21 points and 10 boards versus Midway(Ky.).
- G **Bryson Langdon** has started the last four games for Northern Kentucky and averaged 6.0 assists in the outings.
- Langdon netted 17 points on 7-for-9 shooting against Midway.
- G **Tyler Sharpe**, a Preseason All-Horizon League Second-Team honoree, is averaging 12.9 points per game for the Norse.
- Though early in his third season as a Norse, Sharpe moved into the top-50 all-time scorers at NKU with his 18-point showing at Missouri. He now ranks 44th with 803 points as a Norse.
- F **Silas Adheke** hauled in 12 boards against Texas Southern and is averaging 5.9 rebounds per game.

NOTES

LAST GAME: MIDWAY (KY.)

Karl Harris registered his first career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds, the latter of which is a new career mark for boards, as Northern Kentucky dispatched Midway on Monday night at BB&T Arena. **Bryson Langdon** contributed 17 points and five dimes, while **Adham Eleeda** dropped a career-best 12 points and corralled five boards. All 12 Norse that saw the court scored in the game that was dominated by NKU, which never trailed in the game.

SCOUTING: RV/RV ARKANSAS

Arkansas is receiving votes in both major polls, AP Top-25 and Coaches Poll, thanks to a perfect 6-0 mark. The Razorbacks are also a perfect 5-0 at Bud Walton Arena. Mason Jones leads a trio of player that provide the offensive firepower. He shoots nearly 51 percent (34-of-67) from the floor and averages 18.5 points per game. Jones is also a 92 percent (32-of-37) free-throw shooter. Isaiah Joe contributes 16.7 points per game and Jimmy Whitt, Jr. adds 12.7. Arkansas scores at a clip of 73.7 points per game, but hangs its hat on stifling defense. Opponents are making a meager 14.1 percent of 3-point attempts against the Razorbacks, an average that tops the country. They also only allow teams to score 50.0 points per game, which is third-best nationally, and the 21.3 turnovers forced each outing are fourth-best.

SERIES STUFF

Arkansas is one of eight first-time opponents for the Norse this season, joining Ball State, Coppin State, Illinois State, Midway, Mizzou, Texas Southern and UNC Greensboro. NKU dropped its decisions against Missouri (71-56) and Texas Southern (98-96 in double overtime), but defeated Coppin State (82-70) Ball State (59-57) and Midway (86-56) to sit at 3-2 against first-time opponents. NKU is 0-4 all-time against the SEC, while sitting at 2-22 against teams currently in the Power-5 and BIG EAST, but 0-17 versus those opponents in the DI era.

A NEW ERA

The 2019-20 Norse embark on a new era of basketball, as **Darrin Horn** takes over the reins as the sixth head coach in program history. Horn is no stranger to the Bluegrass State. Not only is he a product of Lexington's Bates Creek HS, where he led the program to its only state championship game, Horn played for Western Kentucky, scoring 1,115 career points and leading the Hilltoppers to three-straight NCAA Tournaments between 1993-95, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 1993, and the 1992 NIT. Horn later served as head coach of WKU from 2003-08, amassing a 111-48 record across the five seasons and guiding the Hilltopper to a pair of NIT appearances along with an NCAA Tournament bid in which Western Kentucky reached the Sweet 16. In his 10th year as a head coach, Horn's career record sits at 176-113 taking into account a 60-63 mark as head coach at South Carolina and 5-2 record with the Norse.

HOME SWEET HOME

Northern Kentucky has turned BB&T Arena into a tough venue for opponents. The Norse ...

- are 3-1 at BB&T Arena this year
- are 44-6 (.880) at home since the 2016-17 season

The Norse had 17 home wins last year, which

tied for the most in a single season in program history. NKU posted a perfect 17-0 mark in the 1982-83 campaign.

Northern Kentucky also sold a program-record 1,403 season tickets this year, eclipsing last year's mark and prior record of 1,322.

GRAND THEFT NORSE

NKU ranks among the nation's leaders in steals through the first two weeks of the season. The Norse have ripped off 69 steals so far, a total that ranks 15th in the country. The team's 9.9 steals per game also ranks 29th. The Norse register a steal in 10.6 percent of its opponents' possessions, a mark that is 90th-best nationally. **Tyler Sharpe** has a team-high 13 steals, which ranks 81st in the nation, and **Trevon Faulkner** has 11 to rank 176th. Including Sharpe (1.9 spg) and Faulkner (1.6), four Norse who've competed in all six games this year are averaging at least a steal per game. Both **Dantez Walton** and **Karl Harris** swipe 1.3 and 1.0 spg, respectively.

LET IT RAIN

The Norse have not been bashful when it comes to shooting the 3-ball. NKU has attempted 208 threes on the season, which equates to 47.4 percent of its field-goal attempts. Northern Kentucky is making 33 percent of those attempts, which has an effective field-goal percent of 50. Currently, the Norse are averaging 9.9 made treys a game. Both **Dantez Walton** and **Tyler Sharpe** lead the team with 16 made 3-pointers, while **Bryson Langdon** has made 10 and **Karl Harris** 9.

MAY I HELP YOU?

NKU averaged 16.9 assists per game, which ranked No. 11 in the country, last year. The Norse handed out at least 20 assists 10 times last season, which includes a whopping 33 dimes on 37 made field goals against Detroit Mercy (Feb. 7). The 33 tied for the most in a single game last year between two Division I teams. Michigan State had 33 assists on 41 made field goals against FGCU. Four Norse averaged at least 2.0 assists per game, led by **Jalen Tate's** 4.1 apg. **Drew McDonald** and **Dantez Walton** distributed 2.8 apg, while **Zaynah Robinson** came in at 2.5 apg.

So far this year, NKU is averaging 16.1 assists per game (64th in nation) and have had two games with at least 20 assists to its credit. The team's 60.9 assist rate ranks 32nd in the nation and its 113 total assists are the 31st most. Tate leads the way at 6.3 apg. **Bryson Langdon** is second on the team at 3.9 apg, while **Trevon Faulkner** and **Tyler Sharpe** both average 2.1 apg. **Dantez Walton** also dishes 1.9 dimes per game.

PRESEASON HONORS

Jalen Tate and **Tyler Sharpe** each made appearances on the Preseason All-Horizon League Teams. Tate was named to the preseason first team after averaging 13.7 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.2 assists per game a year ago. Tate made an appearance on the preseason second team last year. For Sharpe, this marks the first preseason superlative, as the sharpshooting guard earned a spot on the second team. Sharpe closed the 2018-19 campaign averaging 14.4 points on the strength of 90 made threes, which ranked 73rd-most in the nation.

Northern Kentucky was picked to finish second in the preseason poll for the third-straight year.

DEFYING PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

Northern Kentucky is making a habit of defying the preseason rankings, finishing better than its predicted place in each of its first four seasons in the Horizon League. Including this year, NKU has been tabbed second in the Horizon League preseason poll by League coaches, sports information directors and media members three-straight years. The Norse won the regular-season championship outright in 2017-18 and earned a share in 2018-19.

UNPRECEDENTED SUCCESS

Northern Kentucky has been an NCAA Division I member for eight years, but is in just its fourth season with active status. The Norse have strung together a level of success never before seen in a program's first three seasons as active DI members. After its first two seasons, NKU was the only team in NCAA DI history to have won a regular-season league title (2018), league tournament title (2017), played in the NCAA tournament (2017) and NIT (2018) - or a second NCAA tournament for that matter. All Northern Kentucky did in season No. 3 was add to all totals, winning another regular-season league title, league tourney title and made a second NCAA appearance.

NKU's unprecedented success the last three years:

- 2 NCAA Tournament Appearances ('17, '19)
- 1 NIT Appearance ('18)
- 2 Horizon League Regular-Season Titles ('18, '19)
- 2 Horizon League Tournament Titles ('17, '19)

Four other schools have come close to matching this success:

- North Dakota State won a regular-season crown, league tournament championship and went to the NCAA tournament in its first season (2009), but failed to post a winning record in its next two seasons.
- Beginning in 1970, Long Beach State won four-consecutive Pacific Coast Athletic Association (now the Big West) regular-season titles and earned appearances in the NCAA tournament, but the Big West did not sponsor a league tourney until the mid-1970s.
- FGCU won the Atlantic Sun Tournament and made the NCAA tourney in its second season (2013), when it reached the Sweet 16, but only won one regular-season crown (2014) during that time.
- Seattle played in the 1952 NIT, which was one season before being recognized with active Division I status. It then played in the 1953 NCAA Tournament. However, Seattle did not have membership in a conference at that time.

KINGS OF THE HORIZON

Northern Kentucky earned a share of the 2019 Horizon League regular-season championship with a 13-5 league mark, tied with Wright State.

NOTES

The championship is the second-straight regular-season title for the Norse, who took the 2018 crown with a 15-3 league mark. Between the six combined regular-season and tournament titles available the last three years, NKU has won four of the championships.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, NKU has been the class of the Horizon League and owns a 46-15 record (.754) against league foes. The total includes a 15-6 mark during the 2016-17 campaign and 15-4 mark in 2017-18. In that same span, Wright State (43-18) and Oakland (37-22) are 3.0 and 8.0 games behind, respectively.

POLLING

Over the course of the last three years, Northern Kentucky has become a fixture in the two mid-major polls, the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll and The Other Top-25 Poll, which is presented by Mid-Major Madness. NKU finished the 2018-19 campaign 23rd in College Insider's poll and receiving votes in Mid-Major Madness's. At the start of this season, NKU finds itself in the receiving votes category of the College Insider poll for the fourth-straight week.

The Norse reached a program-record No. 10 on Dec. 4, 2017 in College Insider's poll, while a No. 18 ranking in the Mid-Major Madness poll on Nov. 20, 2017 is the program-best in that poll.

TAKEN BY TATE

Redshirt-junior **Jalen Tate** did not suffer a sophomore slump last year. The team's defensive stalwart in the backcourt as a freshman earned both Horizon League All-Defensive and All-Freshman Team accolades. While he had 37 steals as a sophomore and earned a second-straight nod to the all-defensive team, he demonstrated an

increased role in all other areas as well. Tate averaged 13.7 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.1 assists per game, significant improvements over his freshman marks of 5.7 ppg, 2.3 rpg and 2.0 apg. He also converted 53.9 percent (159-of-295) of his shots, which was the 54th-best in the country.

Tate closed the 2018-19 regular-season with a bang, earning his first Horizon League Player of the Week honor on March 4, 2019, after averaging 24 points, 5.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists in a pair of road wins at Milwaukee and Green Bay. Those wins provided the Norse with a share of the regular-season title. In the regular-season finale at Green Bay, Tate exploded for 30 points on 11-for-19 shooting, including a 4-for-5 effort from three.

Tate is averaging 8.3 points, 5.7 rebounds and 6.3 assists per game for the Norse.

TATE & LOU HENSON

Jalen Tate is on the Lou Henson Award Pre-season Watch List. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the nation's best mid-major player. Tate's inclusion marks the third-straight year NKU has had representation on the award's preseason watch list. In each of the last two years, Drew McDonald's name was called. McDonald was named a Lou Henson All-American both seasons as well. Will Tate have a similar fate?

SHARPE AS STEAL

After **Tyler Sharpe** was one of the nation's best walk-ons two years ago (2017-18), amassing 209 points (second only to Hawaii's Brocke Step-teau's 265 points), he earned a scholarship for the Norse as a junior.

Sharpe quickly made a name for himself as a 3-point shooter, but has also shown a knack for being equally disruptive on the defensive end. The guard hounded opposing backcourt players and swiped 52 steals, 119th-best in the country last season. Sharpe averaged 14.4 points per game, with seven 20-point showings that included a stellar 23-point outburst against Texas Tech in the NCAA Tournament. Sharpe converted 8-of-13 field goals and 4-of-7 threes versus the Red Raiders. His 90 made threes on the year were 70th-most in the country.

The walk-on turned starter entered NKU's list of top-50 scorers all-time this year, moving into the list following his 18-point out at Mizzou. He is currently No. 44 and has 803 career points. Sharpe is averaging 12.9 points per game.

WALTON'S WALTZIN'

Dantez Walton danced his way into the starting lineup for the final four games of the 2017-18 season and hasn't looked back. In his four starts to close his sophomore year, Walton averaged 8.3 points and 5.5 rebounds per game, significant improvements on his season averages of 5.3 ppg and 3.4 rpg.

Walton continued that ascent through his junior campaign, where he averaged 11.1 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game. Walton had a career-high 20-point performance at IUPUI, where he made 9-of-11 field-goal attempts, while adding seven rebounds and three assists. But, Walton had arguably the best game of his career with his first career double-double, a 15-point, 14-rebound effort, in the Horizon League Championship game against Wright State. That effort delivered NKU its second Hori-

zon League Tournament Title.

The senior hit the century mark in games played as a Norse this year and has now appeared in 103 contests. NKU has amassed a 77-32 record during Walton's four seasons. He recently went for a career-high 24 points against Coppin State, only to follow with 33 versus Texas Southern, establishing a new career mark twice in a three game span. He added 10 boards against TSU for his second career double-double. Walton is averaging 14.7 points, 6.6 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game.

ON TREVON

As a freshman, **Trevon Faulkner** was a steady presence for the Norse, averaging 4.7 ppg behind 59.1 percent shooting (68-of-115).

In NKU's Motor City Madness quarterfinal game, Faulkner poured in a then-career-high 20 points on the strength of 8-of-13 shooting. He was also tasked with guarding Detroit Mercy's scoring sensation Antoine Davis. While Davis still scored 30 points, it took 29 shots for the nation's third-leading scorer to hit the 30-point plateau with Faulkner in his pocket.

Faulkner has started his sophomore campaign averaging 12.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game. Faulkner went for a career-high 24 points behind 9-of-16 shooting against Texas Southern.

LANGDON DROPPING DIMES

Guard **Bryson Langdon** entered the starting lineup four games ago and has averaged 6.0 assists per game in those contests. On the season, he's handing out 3.9 assists per outing while also contributing 8.4 points per game.

WELCOME ABOARD

Norse head coach **Darrin Horn** signed two players during the NCAA's signing period in November. Guards **Trey Robinson** (Hamilton, Ohio/Hamilton HS) and **Marques Warrick** (Lexington, Ky./Henry Clay HS) inked their National Letters of Intent on Wednesday, Nov. 13. At 6-6, Robinson adds positional size for the Norse. He was a second-team all-conference honoree after averaging 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds per game as a junior. Warrick is 6-3 and brings a high basketball IQ as well as great shooting ability. He averaged 22.0 points and 5.0 assists per game last year.

WHO ARE THE NORSE?

As one of just two athletics programs across any division in any collegiate association in the country bearing the nickname Norse, Northern Kentucky boasts one of the most unique nicknames in college athletics. So, who are the Norse? The Norse were the people who occupied the Northern Scandinavian region between the 8th and 11th centuries. Today, Norse are frequently confused with Vikings, a term used in the Middle Ages to refer to the profession of raiding and pillaging practiced by some, but not all, Norse. NKU selected the nickname shortly after beginning collegiate athletics in 1971. It was selected in a campus-wide vote because NKU is located at the highest point in Northern Kentucky. The term Norse is both singular and plural and can be used as either an adjective or noun.

DARRIN HORN



Darrin Horn was named the sixth men's basketball coach in NKU history by Director of Athletics Ken Bothof on April 23, 2019. Horn was most recently the Associate Head Coach at Texas under Shaka Smart.

Prior to being promoted to associate head coach, Horn was an assistant at Texas for three seasons. During his four years with the Longhorns, Horn helped develop Texas' frontcourt players, which included Mohamed Bamba, who was drafted No. 6 overall in the 2018 NBA Draft and Jarrett Allen, who was drafted No. 22 overall in the 2017 NBA Draft. In his four years at Texas, Horn helped the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and an NIT championship.

Horn also has head coaching experience. From 2008-12, he was the head coach at South Carolina. In his first season at South Carolina, he led the team to a 21-10 record, which included an SEC Eastern Division Co-Championship and an NIT appearance. The 2009-10 South Carolina team upset No. 1 Kentucky, which was the Gamecocks first win over a top-ranked opponent in the team's history. Horn finished his tenure at South Carolina with a 60-63 record.

Before taking over at South Carolina, Horn was the head coach at Western Kentucky, his alma mater. In his five seasons at WKU, Horn accumulated a 111-48 (.698) record and led the team to two NIT appearances and an NCAA Tournament berth. His 2007-08 team finished the season with a 29-7 record, and earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16. As a No. 12 seed, the Hilltoppers defeated No. 5 seed Drake and No. 13 seed San Diego, before falling to top-seeded UCLA in the Sweet 16.

Horn was a standout player at Western Kentucky. A four-time letterwinner and three-year starter at guard for the Hilltoppers, Horn amassed 1,115 points and 139 steals. He helped WKU reach national postseason play in four-straight seasons. After an NIT berth in 1992, Horn helped the Hilltoppers earn NCAA Tournament berths over the next three years. During his sophomore season (1992-93), WKU recorded a 26-6 overall record and advanced to the Sweet 16. Horn was an All-Sun Belt selection in his senior year (1994-95), and the Hilltoppers went 27-4, including a 17-1 mark in Sun Belt play. WKU won the Sun Belt regular-season and tournament titles to advance to the NCAA Tournament, where the Hilltoppers defeated Michigan in the First Round.

Horn is a native of Lexington, Kentucky. He and his wife Carla have a daughter, Caroline, and a son, Walker.
