QUICK KICKS

>>This is Arkansas' 13th-appearance in the SEC Tournament in program history, including its fourth-straight under head coach Colby Hale. The Razorbacks have also made three-straight trips to the title game.

>> The Razorbacks secured the programs first SEC title, regular season or tournament, with a 3-1 win at Tennessee on Thurs., Oct. 31. Arkansas' eight conference wins matched a program record for a single season.

>> Hale was named SEC Coach of the Year on Nov. 3 by the conference after guiding Arkansas to its highest ranking in the United Soccer Coaches poll.

>> Haley VanFossen and Anna Podojil became the first Razorbacks in school history to win SEC Co-Defender of the Year and SEC Freshman of the Year, respectively.

>> VanFossen and Podoiil were joined by Parker Goins and Taylor Malham on the All-SEC First Team. Four Razorbacks making the first team is the most since 1993, the only other occurrence in school history. VanFossen is just the third player to make the first team is back-to-back seasons.

>> Bryana Hunter and Katie Lund were also named to the All-SEC Second Team, anchoring a defense that has the conference's best goals-against-average (0.376) this season.

>> Since the start of October, the Razorbacks are 6-0-1 and have outscored opponents 25-4.

>> Anna Podojil (12), Parker Goins (nine), Stefani Doyle (eight) and Taylor Malham (seven) have scored 36 of Arkansas' 54 goals this season. The 54 goals by the Razorbacks leads the conference and ranks third nationally.

>> Arkansas also leads the conference with 166 points, 58 assists and a scoring offense averaging three goals per game. The Razorbacks rank in the top four nationally in all three categories.

>> Razorback 'keeper Katie Lund leads the conference in both save percentage (.881) and goals-against-average (.393).



Junior Haley VanFossen is leading a Razorback defense that has allowed just six goals in regulation this season. The Broken Arrow, Okla. native was named to the MAC Hermann Preseason Watch List earlier in the season.

Razorbacks haul in SEC Postseason honors

>> Head coach Colby Hale became the first Razorback to be named SEC Coach of the Year on Nov. 3 the league announced.

>> Haley VanFossen and Anna Podojil became the first Arkansas players to win the SEC Co-Defender and Freshman of the Year awards, respectively.

>> The Hogs also put four on the All-SEC First Team, matching a program record for a single season, and two on the Second Team.

Arkansas wins at Tennessee, takes first conference crown in program history

>> With its win at Tennessee on Oct. 31, the Razorbacks won the outright conference championship with 25 points against SEC foes.

>> It's the first regular season or tournament title in Arkansas history.

Razorbacks down No. 18 Aggies, clinch SEC West

>> With Arkansas' road win over Texas A&M on Friday, Oct. 18, the Razorbacks clinched the SEC West division and at least a two seed at the SEC Tournament.

>> It's just the second time in program history that the Razorbacks have won a division crown.

Defense, defense, defense

>> The Razorback defense has put together 11 shutouts in 18 matches this season.

>> In 2019 Arkansas has allowed just six goals in regulation.

>> Razorback opponents are averaging just 0.39 goals scored per game.

The O on a roll

>> In the month of October the Arkansas attack outscored opponents 25–4.

>> The Razorbacks are outshooting opponents 306-164, including a margin of 17-9.1 in shots per game this season.

RAZORBACK NOTES

>> The Razorbacks have hit program highs in all three rankings with their No. 6 ranking in the USC and RPI polls and the five spot by TDS.

Podojil named USC and SEC Player of the Week

>> Freshman Anna Podojil was named Player of the Week by the USC on Oct. 15. It's the second time the rookie has been awarded the honor.

>> Podojil scored four goals in the week, including a hat trick against Mississippi State.

Razorbacks score 10 goals in Week 8

>> On Oct. 10, the Razorbacks downed LSU in Baton Rouge, 4–0. It was the largest margin of victory against the Tigers since 1997.

>> Arkansas followed that up with a 6-1 win against Mississppi State. The six goals by the Razorbacks was the most against any conference foe in program history and the most goals the Bulldogs have allowed since 2013.

Beating the best

>>After last week's win against No. 15 Vanderbilt, Arkansas is now 3-1 in its last four matches against ranked competition, including a win over No. 1 North Carolina.

Lund and Podojil awarded weekly honors

>> 'Keeper Katie Lund was named SEC Defensive Player of the Week by the conference on Sept. 23.She helped shutout Alabama on Sunday and has allowed just two goals all season.

>> Anna Podojil was named the conference

>> The Razorbacks are making an appearance in the polls for the third-straight week.

>> The Hogs are ranked 15th in the Coaches Poll and 24th by Top Drawer Soccer.

>> Arkansas made its first appearance in the rankings after upsets over Baylor and North Carolina.

Razorbacks rack up the honors in Week 4

>> Haley VanFossen was awarded SEC Defensive Player of the Week while Bryana Hunter was named to the Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week.

>> The pair has anchored a defensive line that has allowed just 18 shots on goal this season.

>> Freshman Anna Podojil was named the USC Player of the Week and the SEC Freshman of the Week for the second time this year.

>> Podojil scored in both of Arkansas' upsets wins over Baylor and UNC.

Back-to-back upsets

>> Arkansas snapped Baylor's 15-match unbeaten streak at home with its 2-0 win in Waco, Texas on Sept. 12.

>> Days later, the Razorbacks dropped the topranked North Carolina Tar Heels at Razorback Field.

>> The win against UNC was the first victory over a No. 1 squad in program history and first time for an SEC school to beat the Tar Heels by two or more goals. In 963 matches in UNC history, this was just the 25th game they trailed by two goals.

>> The wins over then No. 22 Baylor and the No. 1 Tar Heels marked the first back-to-back wi

Hogs net 14 goals in Week 3

>> In two matches against Lamar and McNeese, the Razorbacks tallied a pair of 7-0 shutout wins.

>> Arkansas outshot its opponents by a 49–2 margin.

>> The Razorbacks avenged a 3–2 double overtime loss in Lake Charles, La. last season to McNeese State.

Podojil named SEC Freshman of the Week

>> The Cincinnati, Ohio native was named SEC Freshman of the Week by the conference on Sept. 3.

>> Podojil notched goals against Minnesota (Aug. 29) and SEMO (Sept. 1) to go along with her two assists from the season opener against UNC-Greensboro.

>> The freshman is tied for the team lead with six points through the first four matches.

Razorbacks pick up win and draw at Rebel Classice

>> Arkansas went to double overtime for the second-straight match in its 1-1 draw with Minnesota in Oxford, Miss.

>> Tori Cannata led the Razorback attack with a pair of goals in a 5–0 shutout win against Southeast Missouri State.

Arkansas splits in Week 1

>> The Razorbacks earned a road win in their regular season opener at UNC-Greensboro, 3–0.

>> After a scoreless opening half, Arkansas exploded for three goals in the final 30 minutes. The Razorbacks outshot UNC-Greensboro, 27–2.

>> In front of a crowd of 2, 241 at Razorback Field, the Hogs went into extra time against the Oklahoma Sooners. Arkansas would eventually fall in the 105th-minute after OU put home a rebound inside the six-yard box.

National Reach

>> Arkansas will have four of its matches in 2019 televised nationally by the ESPN family of networks.

>>Along with the home matches against conference foes Alabama (Sept. 22) and LSU (Oct. 10), this weekends home match between the Razorbacks and Sooners will be televised on the SEC Network.

>> Of the remaining home matches and road conference matches, all conference games in SEC play for Arkansas will be broadcast via SEC Network+, the online-only arm of the SEC Network.

>> The highlight of Arkansas' television schedule will be a home matchup home games against last year's national runner-up the North Carolina Tar Heels (Sept. 15).

Six Razorbacks Named To SEC Players to Watch List

>> Senior Stefani Doyle (MF) is making her thirdstraight appearance on the list while Tori Cannata is making her first. Doyle was named to the SEC Tournament All-Tournament team as she helped guide the Razorbacks to their third-straight conference title match.

>> Doyle and Cannata combined for 44 starts, 33 points and 12 goals in 2018.

>> Three juniors, including Parker Goins, Taylor Malham and Haley VanFossen were named to the watch lists for the second-straight season.

>>Malham led the squad last season in shots (75), shots on goal (33) and assists (9) and second with 21 points. Her six goals were second most on the team.

>> Sophomore Bryana Hunter is the lone underclassman. She'll be anchoring a defensive line this year that recorded eight shutouts in 2018.

VanFossen Named To Hermann Trophy Watch List

>> The Missouri Athletic Club announced on August 1st that junior Haley VanFossen was named to the preseason Hermann Trophy Watch List heading into the .

>> Last season, VanFossen became the first Razorback named to the AII-SEC First Team since Claire Kelley was tabbed in 2016 and just the seventh overall in program history.

>>VanFossen was tabbed as SEC Defensive PLayer of the Week (Sept. 24) after playing in all 180 minutes in wins over No. 2 Texas A&M and Alabama.

>> In 2018, the Broken Arrow, Okla. native made a start in 22 of 23 games.

>> The MAC Hermann Trophy is given out annually by the United Soccer Coaches National Players of the Year in Division I on both the men's and women's side.

Colby Hale enters his eighth season as head soccer coach at the University of Arkansas after being named to the position on Dec. 21, 2011.

Since Hale took over the program, the Razorbacks have reached the NCAA Tournament five times, the only times the program has ever reached the postseason. He's also overseen nine all-region players, 12 all-conference selections, one Academic All-American, one scholar All-American and 105 Fall SEC Academic Honor Roll selections.

Hale's teams have shown a postseason prowess as the Razorbacks have been a force in November, especially over the last three seasons. Including reaching the SEC Tournament in six of the last seven seasons, Arkansas has reached the SEC Tournament final the last three seasons under Hale in 2016, 2017 and 2018.

In 2018 the Razorbacks recorded their third-straight 10+ win season, going undefeated at Razorback Field with wins over No. 2 Texas A&M and No. 21 Auburn.

The 2017 tournament run might have been the most improbable as the Razorbacks entered the conference tournament as the eight seed, but rolled off wins over nine-seed Ole Miss (1-0), one-seed South Carolina (1-0), and four-seed Vanderbilt (1-1, 4-2 on PK's) before bowing out against two-seed Texas A&M (2-1).

Arkansas became the lowest-seeded team to ever reach the tournament final and the run helped secure the school's ninth 10-win season and fourth NCAA Tournament appearance.

Attendance at Razorback Field has also seen an uptick since Hale's arrival n Fayetteville. During the 2017 season, Arkansas finished 10th in the nation in total attendance (13,538), fourth-best in the SEC and 10th in average attendance (1,354).

In the 2017 home opener against top-ranked Penn State, the Razorbacks set a single-game attendance record for 3.401, the fifth-straight season the single-game attendance record has been broken.

After a historic 18–5–1 season marked by several program milestones, Hale and Razorback Soccer concluded its 2016 season ranked No. 19 on the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) top 25 poll after peaking at

No. 11 following a school-record eight-straight wins from Sept. 9, 2016 to Oct. 9, 2016.

Hale guided the team to their first win against a top-10 opponent against then-No.2-ranked Duke on Aug. 26 in front of a record-breaking crowd at Razorback Field. Arkansas would also upset then-No. 4-ranked Florida 2-1 on Sept. 16 at home for the program's first victory against the Gators.

These two wins against top-five programs and other quality opponents would catapault Arkansas to its highest NCAA RPI ranking in school history, topping out at No. 9 on Sept. 28.

Hale would also gain the unique honor of being Arkansas' winningest soccer coach after earning his 46th career win as a Razorback following a 1-0 victory over North Texas on Sept. 11. He would later lead the team to its fourth SEC Tournament, and following wins against Vanderbilt and Auburn in the quarterfinals and semifinals, Arkansas competed in its first SEC Tournament championship match since 1996. The Razorbacks also earned their third NCAA Tournament bid in four years and hosted the program's first NCAA Tournament match at home in school history.

Soccer completed the 2015 season at 6–11–1. Season highlights included a 2-2 tie in double-overtime against No. 10 South Carolina, the program's first result against a top-10 program since 2007; the selection of hybrid defender/midfielder Carly Hoke as the 2015 SEC Freshman of the Year; and senior defender Teni Butler being named by the Razorback Foundation as a Red Tie Co-Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Hale and the Razorbacks finished the 2014 season with a 9-7-6 overall mark, giving the program its first back-toback winning season since the 2008 and 2009 seasons. Arkansas was also the No. 9 seed in the conference tournament and earned the program's second straight bid to the NCAA Tournament. After picking up a 3–2 overtime victory at Oklahoma in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament, the Razorbacks fell at No. 3 Stanford, 1–0, in the Round of 32 to end the season.

In just his second season at the helm, Hale posted the most successful season in Razorback soccer history at 15-8-1, leading his team to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in the program's 28 year history. In the team's tournament debut. Hale guided the Razorbacks past Oklahoma State and St. John's to the final round of 16.

Hale had a plan to take the program to the next level and set the bar high in his first season at Arkansas. In the 2012 preseason, he talked about the team's "identity" and "blue collar mentality," and how the Razorbacks would be dependent on a team concept and not the play of two or three stars. Hale and the Razorbacks saw the results of that blue collar mentality and hard work pay off with a dramatic turnaround

The Razorbacks were 4-14-0 and 2-9-0 in the Southeastern Conference the year before Hale arrived on campus (2011). In 2012, with a senior class of just two -Andrea Carlson and Allie Chandler - Hale led the Razorbacks to a 9-10-1 overall record and 6-6-1 finish in the SEC.

Hale became just the third of eight Arkansas soccer head coaches to win his first game as coach, topping Austin Peay 2–1 at home on Aug. 17 2012. Two days later, the Razorbacks secured their first big win of the season by beating Texas 1–0 for the first time in program history in Fayetteville.

Prior to landing the top spot at Arkansas, Hale helped quide multiple programs to success on the field and in the classroom. He moved to Arkansas after nine seasons at the University of Central Florida (UCF), helping the Knights to 130 wins (130-50-22) with six conference championships, seven NCAA Tournament bids and eight wins in the postseason. In seven years at Conference USA, UCF was 56-11-9 with four league titles.
