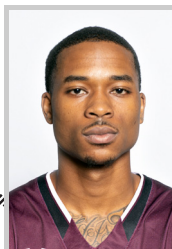

PREGAME

- Texas Southern prepares for game two of the four-game Collegiate Hoops Roadshow Tuesday night as they'll head to Fayetteville, Ark. to face the University of Arkansas.
- This marks the second year for TSU head coach **Johnny Jones**. Jones went 24-14 in his inaugural year as head coach with three Power 5 conference wins. TSU fell in the finals of the 2019 SWAC Tournament and competed in the CIT. TSU advanced to the semifinals of the CIT last season.
- TSU has to replace three key starters from last year's squad but has several returnees who had made starts last year that will have to step up. Point guard **Tyrik Armstrong**, shooting guard **John Jones** and forward **Eden Ewing** will be counted on to lead the charge as Armstrong and Jones are top returning scorers while Ewing is the top returning rebounder.
- Head coach **Johnny Jones** is 55-37 all-time in the month of November and 3-7 at TSU.
- Jones is 46-63 all-time against the SEC and 5-6 against Arkansas.
- Arkansas is 6-0 against TSU all-time as this is the first meeting since 2011.
- TSU was picked second in the Southwestern Athletic Conference preseason poll as senior forward **Eden Ewing** was named to the All-SWAC Preseason First Team.
- **Eden Ewing** was granted a sixth year of eligibility in the summer while forward **John Walker III** was recently granted a waiver to participate immediately after spending the past season at Texas A&M University.
- TSU's home game on Nov. 30 marks the first time since 2014 the team will host a Division I foe as a non-conference opponent.
- Three of TSU's first three opponents (San Diego State, Wichita State, Arkansas) are ranked in the Ken Pomeroy Basketball Ratings Top 100 and the final four non-conference opponents are also ranked in the top 100 (Nevada, Oregon, Arizona State, Texas A&M).
- Arkansas head coach **Eric Musselman** was the associate head coach at LSU under head coach **Johnny Jones** in 2014-15. He moved to Nevada as head coach in 2015 and hired Jones in the same capacity in 2017. TSU assistant coach **Brandon Chambers** and video coordinator **Derek Saich** both worked under Musselman at Nevada.

Mardracus Wade scored 18 points to lead Arkansas to a 77-49 victory against Texas Southern on Friday night.

Wade made four 3-pointers. The sophomore guard is shooting 49.2 percent from beyond the arc this season for the Razorbacks (10-3), who won their fifth straight.

Arkansas led 7-0 just 1:12 into the game and never trailed. The Razorbacks led 39-19 at halftime and by 31 points in the second half.

Arkansas forced Texas Southern (1-11) into 25 turnovers, scoring 30 points off of the miscues. The Tigers made only 18 of 56 field-goal attempts en route to their 10th loss in a row.

Fred Sturdivant led Texas Southern with 19 points and 13 rebounds.

NON-CONFERENCE TRAVELS

Texas Southern will play 11 non-conference games on the road this fall with two games at home. The team will play in 10 states during that span and two time zones. The furthest TSU will travel east is to the state of Kentucky and California to the west.

MEMORIES

Texas Southern Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics **Kevin Granger** has fond memories of Arkansas as he was a player on the 1993 TSU squad which met sitting President of the United States **Bill Clinton**. It was believed to be the first time a sitting President had attended a college basketball game.

Arkansas won the game that night but Granger nearly had the last laugh a year later as TSU fell to Arkansas 79-78 in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament after a late rally.

ARMED AND STRONG

Texas Southern senior point guard **Tyrrik Armstrong** is the perfect example of being at the right place at the right time. Last year, he only made one start during non-conference play and saw limited minutes as SWAC play began.

He returned to the starting lineup seven games in SWAC play and scored a season-high 15 points at the time. He didn't start the next game but was reinserted back into the lineup right after and never sat down as he averaged 11.8 points with a high of 32 points against ULM in the CIT.

BACK IN THE FOLD

Senior **Eden Ewing** will play his first full year as a Tiger and is expected to have a large role this fall. Ewing joined the team in December of 2018 and averaged 9.5 points while ranking sixth in the SWAC with 7.2 rebounds.

He posted seven double-doubles on the season while shooting 53 percent from the field. He had eight games with 10-plus rebounds with a high of 13 against Grambling State (twice) and Jackson State. Ewing came on strong in the CIT Invitational as he scored 23 points and grabbed 11 boards at Louisiana Monroe while scoring 11 points and nine rebounds at Green Bay.

RERUNS

This year's schedule features seven teams who were on TSU's 2018-19 schedule in San Diego State, Lamar, Gonzaga, Concordia, Oregon, Arizona State and Texas A&M.

REUNION AGAIN

After Tuesday's game at Arkansas, another reunion will take place on Dec. 18 in Reno, Nev. as it'll mark a reunion for head coach **Johnny Jones** and a pair of staff members in assistant coach **Brandon Chambers** and **Derek Saich**. Jones, Chambers and Saich all were at Nevada under Arkansas head coach **Eric Musselman**.

TWIN POWER

The Tigers feature a pair of twins this season in **Ja'Mare** and **Ja'Mere Redus**. Ironically, the TSU women's team also features a set of twin student-athletes.

FORT BEND STRONG

The Houston area county of Fort Bend will be well-represented this season at TSU with five players from the district on the team in **Tyrrik Armstrong** (Elkins), **Eden Ewing** (Bush), **Bryson**

Etienne (Bush), **John Walker III** (Marshall) and **Kevin Granger, Jr.** (Ridge Point). Granger is the son of TSU Hall of Famer and current athletic director **Kevin Granger**.

BET YOU DIDN'T KNOW

- The entire nation had a opportunity to find out about Texas Southern University this fall as the university hosted the third Democratic presidential primary debate on Sept. 12 inside the H&PE Arena.

- TSU was formally established in 1947 with a mission to establish a credible college for African-American students.

- Texas Southern University (TSU) is one of the nation's largest historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs). TSU provides a first class educational experience, offering over 120 baccalaureate, masters and doctoral degree programs in nine schools and colleges. The University has assets exceeding \$250 million and currently has over 10,800 students enrolled.

- The Thurgood Marshall School of Law, was created as a consequence of a 1946 lawsuit brought by **Heman M. Sweatt**. Under the Texas Constitution, which required separate but equal treatment, Mr. Sweatt was refused admission to the University of Texas School of Law because he was black. As a result, the legislature provided for an interim and separate law school for Negroes.

- **Good Morning America** host and NFL Hall of Famer **Michael Strahan** played at TSU from 1989-92.

GAME 1 **San Diego State 77,** **TSU 42** **11/5/19**

A slow start in the first half set the tone as TSU dropped its season opener at San Diego State Tuesday night.

The Tigers were neck-and-neck with the Aztecs to open the game as it was a 10-6 margin within the first four minutes. However, TSU missed its next seven shots over the next six minutes as they were outscored 7-0 for an 11-point deficit. Justin Hopkins would score the next five points for TSU but unfortunately, the scoring would cease for nearly five minutes. By the time TSU scored its next basket at the 4:03 mark, the Aztecs put together a 20-0 surge as they went into the half ahead 48-13. In addition to the team's offensive production, the Tigers struggled to hold on to the ball as they committed 15 turnovers which led to 17 points by the Aztecs.

Despite a rough start, the Tigers came out in the second half and played San Diego State evenly as both teams scored 29 points apiece. TSU also found its way to the free throw line more while cutting back on its turnovers.

Tyrik Armstrong led TSU with 10 points, two assists and a steal while Eden Ewing and Quinton Brigham led TSU on the boards with eight rebounds each.

GAME 2 **Wichita State 69,** **TSU 63** **11/9/19**

Texas Southern's chance at a huge road win fell short in the final minutes as Wichita State held on for a 69-63 win Saturday afternoon.

The first half was about defense as TSU held the Shockers to only five field goals as TSU led for the final 15 minutes of the half. Two free throws by freshman Ja'mare Redus gave TSU a seven-point (16-9) lead with 6:29 left. The Tigers held ground throughout the remainder of the half as they went into the break ahead 24-23.

WSU would tie the contest at 27-all with 18:30 left in the second

quarter. TSU would regain the lead shortly thereafter after a John Jones' three-pointer as it began a back-and-forth affair which saw the lead change four times over the next 12 minutes as neither team would lead by more than three points.

With 6:03 left and the contest tied at 50-all, Wichita State went up 51-50 after a free throw but Yahuza Rasas made 1-of-2 free throws to tie the contest at 51. WSU answered with a jumper on its next possession to move ahead 53-51 but TSU's Justin Hopkins scored a jumper of his own to tie the game once again at 53 with 5:19 on the clock.

WSU would miss a three-pointer on its next attempt but regained the rebound and connected on a trey from Dexter Dennis to move ahead 56-53. TSU would miss its attempt from beyond the arc and the Shockers upped the margin to five after a pair of free throws. The Tigers would close to three with 2:13 left but couldn't get over the hump as WSU hit 7-of-8 free throws to seal the contest.

Eden Ewing led TSU with 18 points and six rebounds while Tyrik Armstrong and John Jones added 11 each. TSU finished with eight blocks defensively as Jethro Tshisumpa led with three blocks while John Walker III added two blocks.

The Tigers will have a week to recuperate as they'll head to Vermillion, S.D. to face South Dakota on Friday, Nov. 15 at 7 p.m. The series begins the four-game Collegiate Hoops Roadshow.

GAME 3 **South Dakota 88** **TSU 69** **11/15/19**

Tyler Hagedorn had a career-high 33 points as South Dakota defeated Texas Southern 88-69 on Friday night.

Hagedorn's eight 3-pointers without a miss are a Summit League record. He added eight rebounds and three blocks.

Hagedorn scored 20 points in the first half, making five of his 3-pointers as the Coyotes shot 53% in building a 46-25 halftime lead. Texas Southern made 4 of 7 3-pointers in the half, but only 4 of 23 inside the arc for 27% overall.

South Dakota led by at least 14 points throughout the second half and the lead peaked at 26 with eight minutes remaining.

Stanley Umude had 12 points for South Dakota (4-0). Tyler Peterson added 12 points. Cody Kelley had 11 points for the Coyotes.

Yahuza Rasas had 12 points for the

Tigers (0-3). Tyrik Armstrong added 10 points.

South Dakota takes on Southern Illinois-Edwardsville at home on Monday. Texas Southern plays Arkansas on the road on Tuesday.

JOHNNY JONES HEAD COACH



Johnny Jones begins his second season as Texas Southern's head men's basketball coach. Prior to arriving at TSU, Jones served as the Nevada Wolf Pack's associate head coach for one season. Jones came to Nevada after five seasons as the head coach at LSU.

Jones quickly made his mark on the TSU program as he led the Tigers on a history-making season in 2018-19 which included wins over three teams from Power 5 Conferences.

He quickly set the tone with a win over Baylor in his TSU debut as it marked the first-ever loss by Baylor to a team from the Southwestern Athletic Conference. Several weeks later, Jones once again made headlines as the Tigers knocked off No. 18 Oregon on the road. The loss was only the fourth non-conference defeat for Oregon since the Ducks opened Matthew Knight Arena in 2011. The Tigers capped off non-conference play with a solid win over Texas A&M of the SEC as the Tigers recorded their first-ever win over Tex-

as A&M since the series began.

The Tigers completed the 2018-19 regular season with a 14-4 SWAC mark and the No. 2 seed in postseason play. The Tigers advanced to the finals of the 2019 SWAC Tournament for the third consecutive season and was selected to participate in the CollegenInsider.com Postseason Tournament. TSU turned its play up another level in postseason play as they embarked on its longest postseason run since winning the 1977 NAIA Tournament with a 3-1 record and an appearance in the semifinal round.

Under Jones, senior forward Jeremy Combs had a breakout year as he was named Honorable Mention All-American by the Associated Press and was the SWAC's Player and Newcomer of the Year. The 6-7 standout also earned the league's player of the week award five times.

Jones spent one season (2017-18) at the University of Nevada before moving on to TSU. Jones helped the Wolf Pack win a second consecutive Mountain West outright regular season title going 15-3 in conference play and 29-8 overall. The 29 wins tied the school record. The Pack made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and reached the Sweet 16 for the second time in school history.

Prior to Nevada, Jones spent five years as head coach at his alma mater, LSU. He won 90 games in his five years as the head coach at LSU, the most of any head coach at LSU in their first five years. He was the fourth-winningest coach in LSU history. The DeRidder, La. native led the LSU Tigers to two postseason appearances, an NIT and NCAA tournament bid, and coached the 2016 No. 1 overall pick in the NBA draft Ben Simmons.

While at LSU, Coach Jones also recruited future NBA players Tim Quarterman, Johnny O'Bryant, Jordan Mickey and Jarrell Martin. Among those he helped recruit to LSU in his assistant days were NBA superstar and Naismith Hall of Famer, Shaquille O'Neal. He also was involved in the recruiting of two-time All-American Chris Jackson (now Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf) and national high school player of the year (and an assistant coach under Jones), Randy Livingston.

Jones was also a head coach at North Texas for 11 seasons from 2001-12. He led the Mean Green to two NCAA tournament berths and five top-three conference finishes. Overall, Jones has 34 years of Division I coaching experience, including 18 seasons as a head coach.

During the 1999-2000 season Jones was the interim head coach at Memphis and led the Tigers to a 15-16 record.

Jones played his college ball at LSU. He was a part of the 1981 Final Four team and joined head coach Dale Brown's staff after his playing time, helping lead the Tigers to another Final Four in 1986. Jones and his wife Kelli have two children, John and Jillian.
