- Auburn and Arkansas are set to square off for the 53rd time in program history on Tuesday. Despite trailing the all-time series 33-19, the Tigers have won three of the last five.
- Auburn will look to make history as it has won just four times in Fayetteville in program history (1993, 2003, 2009, 2016). With a win Tuesday night, Bruce Pearl would become the first Auburn coach ever to win twice at Arkansas with the Tigers.
- The Tigers are coming off a historic Saturday inside Auburn Arena. College GameDay came to The Plains for the first time in show history to begin the day. The night was capped with No. 17 Auburn defeating No. 13 Kentucky in a top-20 matchup. It is the first time the Tigers have defeated the Wildcats twice in a row since 1989-90.
- After scoring 75 points against Kentucky, Auburn won its 29th consecutive game when scoring at least 70 points. That streak is the second-longest in the country, trailing only Gonzaga at 45.
- The Tigers appeared at No. 11 in the latest AP poll, marking the 16th consecutive poll that Auburn has been ranked. That streak is the third-longest in program history. The longest streaks are 31, held from Dec. 14, 1998 until March 13, 2000, and 23, held from Jan. 8. 2018 until Jan. 21. 2019.
- The 2019-20 Tigers have a chance to be the best defensive team under Coach Pearl at Auburn. The Tigers are allowing only 68.4 points per game and have held every opponent under its scoring average this season in regulation. The previous best defensive team under Pearl on The Plains was the 2018-19 team that allowed 68.8 points per game.

- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)
- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 24 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. - Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the sixth straight time in 2019-20, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000
- Auburn welcomed 138,650 fans inside Auburn Arena for the 2018-19 season. The total is the highest ever recorded in Auburn Arena history
- \cdot In 24 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 16 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 20 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past four seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 47-5 (.904), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 23 graduates in five years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport
- Auburn recently secured its third perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history
- In the past four years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease
- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitible work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.
- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1 million in only five golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

AUBURN VS. ARKANSAS SERIES

- » Auburn and Arkansas will meet on the hardwood for the 53rd time in series history Tuesday night inside Bud Walton Arena. The Razorbacks lead the all-time series 33-19, but the Tigers have taken three of the last five.
- » In last year's contest, Auburn took a 79-56 decision inside Auburn Arena. The Tigers knocked down 17 3-pointers and outrebounded the Razorbacks, 42-35.
- » Auburn is just 4-21 in Fayetteville all-time. It is the fourth-fewest wins by the Tigers at a SEC school, trailing Kentucky (two), Missouri (three) and Texas A&M (three). Auburn, however, has only play at Missouri five times and made six trips to Texas A&M since they joined the conference prior to the 2012-13 season.
- » Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl is 8-6 in his head coaching career against Arkansas. Pearl is 3-3 vs. the Razorbacks while leading the Tigers, which includes a road win in 2016.
- » Pearl has a chance to become the first coach in program history to win twice at Arkansas with a victory Tuesday night. Former head coaches Tommy Joe Eagles (1993), Cliff Ellis (2003) and Jeff Lebo (2009) each amassed just one win in Fayetteville at Auburn.

- » At Ole Miss, the Tigers were down by as many as 19 in the second half. Auburn staged what went down as a tie for the third-largest comeback win in program history.

- » According to ESPN Stats and Info, SEC teams entered the night 0-102 when trailing by 17 or more at halftime on the road over the last decade. Auburn was down 37-20 at the break.
- » On Saturday, Auburn took down Kentucky in a top-20 matchup. The Tigers have now won back-to-back games vs. the Wildcats for the first time since 1989-90.
- » After falling in 32 of the previous 33 series games, Auburn has won four of the last seven tilts with Kentucky, something that has only been done one other time in program history: 1987-90.

ROAD TRIPPIN'

- » Auburn is back on the road to continue conference play. The Tigers have won seven games away from Auburn Arena so far in 2019-20.
- » The seven wins are the most in the SEC away from home, leading Florida (six), LSU (five) and South Carolina (five).
- » After the first month of SEC action, road teams are 21-35 in league play.

- » Auburn has been solid on offense, scoring 79.0 points per game this season, good for third in the SEC and 21st in the country. But, what has made a huge difference has been the attention to detail on the defensive end as the Tigers have allowed only 68.4 points per game. That mark is the lowest under head coach Bruce Pearl.
- » Listed below are seasons in which the Tigers have averaged scoring over 75 points per game, while also holding opponents to fewer than 70 points per game.



Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

AUBURN ARENA SELLOUTS

- » Auburn posted its first sellout of the season vs. NC State and has done so six more times to bring its total to 35 in Auburn Arena history. The Tigers sold out the final three home non-conference games and then first two SEC contests, marking the first time in the building's history that it has been sold out for five straight games.
- » Of the 35 sellouts, 30 have come in the six seasons under head coach Bruce Pearl. Fifteen of the last 20 SEC games at Auburn Arena have been sold out.

TOP OF THE PACK

» The Tigers have clinched the best marks in the SEC in both wins and winning percentage in non-league regular-season games over the last four seasons. Auburn is the only SEC team that has won at least 10 regular-season non-conference games in each of the last four seasons. The Tigers' 47 non-conference regular-season wins over the last four seasons are a school record in a 4-year span.

AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS

- » Auburn is 69-213 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. Last season, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row spanning a SEC Tournament title and a trip to the Final Four.
- » Auburn is 12-22 as a ranked team vs. a ranked opponent all-time, but has won five of the last six occurances.

GETTING NETTY

- » Auburn appeared at No.7 in the NCAA's first release of the NET this season. It previously tied for the highest rating achieved by the Tigers, matching the NET on Dec. 8, 2018. Auburn has since achieved its highest NET ranking at No. 5 on Dec. 30. The Tigers currently stand at No. 19.
- » Auburn has appeared in the top 30 of the NET every day since Jan. 29 of last season. The Tigers are the only team in the SEC to be inside the top 30 in every NET ranking since Feb. 2 of last season.

ON THE RISE

- » Auburn earned its first top-5 ranking since Jan. 17, 2000 when it appeared at No. 5 in the AP poll on Jan. 6.
- » It is just the fifth season the program has been ranked in the top five in its history (1958-59, 1986-87, 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2019-20).
- » The last time the Tigers were ranked as high as No. 4 was when they were in that spot four consecutive weeks from Dec. 27, 1999-Jan. 17, 2000. The highest ranking achieved by Auburn is No. 2 on Nov. 22, 1999.
- » Coach Pearl is no stranger to being ranked inside the top five. His teams have achieved the benchmark in 10 of his 25 seasons as a head coach. Pearl and Southern Indiana were ranked in the top five every season from 1994-2001 reaching as high as No. 1 in 1995 and between 1997-99. Pearl's 2007 Tennessee team also reached No. 1

STREAKS COME TO A CLOSE

» Auburn's lost at Alabama marked the end of some of the best streaks in program history. The Tigers were off to their third-best start to a season in program history.

- » In the two previous seasons that Auburn had started 15-0, the Tigers combined for a final record of 48-7, including 26-4 in SEC play. The 1998-99 team had the previous single-season wins record (29) before the 2018-19 team that advanced to the Final Four won 30 games.
- » Including this season, head coach Bruce Pearl recorded two 15-0 starts in his career, but the 2019-20 season is the first of his tenure as a Division I head coach. He accomplished the feat in 2000-01 (16-0) while at Southern Indiana.
- » Auburn's 15-0 start this season became just the 12th start of at least 15-0 in SEC history. The Tigers, who have three starts of at least 15-0 in their history, join Kentucky (six) as the only schools that have multiple 15-0 starts in conference history. This year's Auburn's squad is the first SEC team to start a season 15-0 since South Carolina began the 2015-16 campaign with the same record.
- » Auburn tied for the third-longest winning streak in program history. The Tigers have produced win streaks of at least 10 games 10 times, including 2019-20. Below are the largest win streaks in program history.

- » Auburn, which won 14 straight during the 2017-18 season, 12 straight leading into last season's Final Four and 15 straight to begin the year has won at least 12 straight games in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. There have only been two other times in school history where Auburn has won at least 10 straight games in consecutive seasons.
- » Auburn is one of just four programs in the country to boast three separate 12-game winning streaks over the last three seasons, along with Gonzaga, Michigan State and Virginia.

MAKE ROOM IN THE TROPHY CASE

- » Since the 2017-18 season, Auburn has won four trophies: 2018 SEC title, 2019 SEC Tournament crown, 2019 NCAA Midwest Regional championship and the 2019 Legends Classic.
- » The Tigers lead the SEC in trophies in the last two-plus seasons. As a whole, the league has amassed 11 trophies through league championships, conference tournament championships, NCAA regional championships and in-season tournament championships. Auburn has four and Kentucky has three, while Florida, LSU, Tennessee and Texas A&M have all won one.

THE GREATEST SEASON EVER

- » The Tigers reached the Final Four for the first time in program history. Auburn is the first program from the state of Alabama to reach the Final Four.
- » Auburn became the only team to defeat Kansas, Kentucky and North Carolina - the three winningest programs in NCAA history - in consecutive games in NCAA Tournament history.
- » The Tigers won four games in four days to capture their second SEC Tournament title (1985) all-time.
- » Auburn set a program record with 30 wins in the 2018-19 season.
- » Auburn broke the SEC record with 454 3-pointers as a team. The record was held previously by the 1995 Arkansas team with 361. The Tigers finished only 10 3-pointers away from matching the NCAA record of 464 currently held by the 2018 Villanova squad.
- " The Tigers won four straight games over AP Top-10 teams for the first time in program history following wins against No. 5 and No. 8 Tennessee, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 7 Kentucky. Auburn won five straight over top-25 opponents for the first time ever during its historic March run, which including triumphs over No. 5 and No. 8 Tennessee, No. 17 Kansas, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 7 Kentucky.
- » The Tigers made their 10th NCAA Tournament appearance in program history and first in back-to-back seasons since 1999-2000. Auburn is 16-10 all-time in NCAA Tournament play.

ICE OKOPO

- » After hitting the game-winning shot at South Alabama with 2.9 seconds left, Isaac Okoro earned the nickname "Ice." In that same game at South Alabama, he became the only Auburn player in the last 15 years with a stat line of 15 points, six rebounds, six assists, two steals and two blocks in a game.
- » Okoro ranks second on the team in scoring (13.0) and field goal percentage (.519) and third in steals (21) and blocks (19).
- » Okoro is one of just seven freshmen in the SEC to average double figures overall.

- » The Powder Springs, Ga. native scored in figures in the first six games of his career, becoming just the second freshman since 1990 to accomplish the feat and the first since Mustapha Heron in 2016. The previous record holder was All-American Wesley Person, who did it in his first 14 games. Okoro has scored in double figures in 12 of 17 games to begin his career.
- » Okoro's 51.9 field goal percentage ranks 10th in the country among freshmen. Of the top-shooting freshmen, Okoro is the only one to have made at least 10 3s (13-of-46).

- » Okoro was named SEC Freshman of the Week after Nov. 18 as well as Dec. 9. He is the fourth freshman in program history to earn the weekly recognition twice in a season, joining Jared Harper (2016-17), Aaron Swinson (1991-92) and Wesley Person (1990-91).
- » He is one of just five players in the country to have their high school jersey retired, joining Jordan Bowden (Tennessee), Landers Nolley II (Virginia Tech), Reggie Perry (Mississippi State) and Joe Quintana (LMU).

LEAVE NO DOUGHT(Y)

» After being a secondary scoring option last season, Samir Doughty has asserted himself as the top option in 2019-20. He's averaging a team-best 15.1 points per game. Last season, Doughty had an average of 7.3 points per game.

- » In Auburn's win at South Alabama, Doughty scored 10 points and tied a career-high with 10 rebounds. It was his second career double-double and first as a member of the Auburn Tigers. The Philadelphia, Pa. native had 10 points and 10 assists against Saint Joe's while suiting up for VCU on Feb. 14, 2017. Doughty's 10 rebounds matched his output vs. Dayton on Dec. 8, 2018.
- » Doughty followed up that performance with a career-high 33 points on 10-of-15 from the floor, including 6-of-8 from deep, in the Tigers' 116-70 triumph over CSUN. He also chimed in with eight boards and three assists.
- » In Auburn's win vs. Colgate, Doughty had a team-best 20 points on 7-of-13 shooting. In that game, Doughty produced a crossover, step-back 3-pointer that sent his defender flying and earned him the No. 1 spot on the Sportscenter Top 10 for Nov. 18.
- » The senior was named to the Legends Classic All-Tournament Team after scoring 19 points against New Mexico and 22 vs. Richmond, both team-highs.
- » Doughty had 23 points vs. Kentucky to elevate the Tigers in the top-20 battle. He went 14-of-15 from the charity stripe to highlight his outing. In the first half, Doughty nearly had half of Auburn's points (34) when he touted 16 on 4-of-6 shooting and 7-of-7 from the charity stripe.
- » Doughty has six 20-point games in the first 21 games this season after the senior entered the season with just two 20-point efforts in 75 career games.

THE BIG MAN IS HUNGRY

- » Austin Wiley is as healthy as he's ever been and it's showing. The senior has scored in double figures in 13 of 21 games and has double-digit rebounds nine times so far this season. Wiley has eight double-doubles this season after entering the season with just two in his career.
- » Where Wiley has shown the most progress is at the charity stripe. Coming into the season as a 52.5 percent free throw shooter, the senior is 85-of-120 from the charity stripe (70.8 percent).

- » Wiley draws 7.6 fouls per 40 minutes, the sixth-most of any player in the country trailing only Lamine Diane of CSUN (8.9), Darius Williams of Prairie View A&M (8.0), Derek Culver of West Virginia (7.9), Vernon Carey of Duke (7.9) and Markus Howard of Marquette (7.8).
- » He was named the SEC Player of the Week on Dec. 2 the first in his career after averaging 16 points and 10.5 rebounds per game en route to being named the MVP at the Legends Classic. He became the fourth center in program history to earn the weekly award, joining Mamadou N'diaye (1999), Aaron Swinson (1994) and Jeff Moore (1987).

WE'VE GOT J'VON

- » While replacing Jared Harper's name in the popular song "We've Got Jared" to "We've Got J'Von" is easy, the replacement of Jared on the court was going to be a challenge heading into the 2019-20 season.
- » McCormick has stepped in and already made a huge impact. The senior is third in the league with a 1.98 assist-turnover ratio and fourth with 4.6 assists per game, highlighted by a single-game program record of 16 vs. CSUN.
- » The previous record of 15 was held by Eddie Johnson vs. LSU on Jan. 3, 1976. Former floor general Jared Harper was next in line with 14 assists vs. Vanderbilt on Feb. 3, 2018.
- » McCormick's 16 assists are tied for the ninth-most in SEC single-game history and are the most by any player in the league since Phil Pressley (Missouri) had 19 dimes in 2013.
- » McCormick's 16 assists are tied for the second-most by any player in the country this season, tying Cameron Parker (Sacred Heart), who also owns the top spot with 24.
- » The New Orleans, La. native was named the SEC Player of the Week on Jan. 6 after scoring 28 points in a win at Mississippi State. It was the most points by an Auburn player in a road SEC win since since KT Harrell dropped 28 at LSU Feb. 5, 2015.

MCLEMORE UP FOR PRESTIGIOUS AWARD

- » Anfernee McLemore is in contention for the Senior CLASS Award as he was recently named one of the 30 candidates up for the annual honor.
- » To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Senior CLASS Award encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

RETURN TO SENDER

- After setting a program record with 190 blocks last season, the Tigers have had four of the program's top-11 single-season block totals during Bruce Pearl's five seasons on the Plains.
- A big key to that has been the brick wall of Anfernee McLemore, who is inside the top five in program history in career blocks.

PEARL WINS HIS 100TH GAME AT AUBURN

- Auburn's win over Kentucky in the Elite Eight was Bruce Pearl's 100th win in his 171st game as Auburn's head coach. Pearl is the first head coach in Auburn history to win 100 games in his first five seasons. This includes a 5-3 mark in the NCAA Tournament as Pearl matches Cliff Ellis (5-3) for the second-most NCAA Tournament wins by a head coach in Auburn history. Pearl and Ellis only trail Sonny Smith, who led the Tigers to a 7-5 record in five straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 1984-88.
- With a win at Vanderbilt on Feb. 16, Coach Pearl picked up his 100th SEC win. Pearl became the 23rd coach in conference history to amass 100 victories and just the fifth to accomplish the feat while coaching two schools.
- The other coaches to have 100 SEC wins while leading two programs include C.M. Newton (195, Alabama and Vanderbilt), Tubby Smith (139, Georgia and Kentucky), Don DeVoe (110, Tennessee and Florida) and John Mauer (103, Tennessee and Florida).
- Coach Pearl is one of just two active coaches to tally 100 conference wins in the league, joining Kentucky head coach John Calipari.

- » In the latest 2020 NBA Mock Draft on ESPN.com, freshman Isaac Okoro was projected to be picked 10th.
- "He is one of the most gifted athletes in this class. He has a shredded, 225-pound frame that makes it impossible to dislodge him on straight line drives. He also has outstanding feet getting over the top of screens or mirroring opponents in one-on-one situations. His 6-foot-10 wingspan should allow him to see time guarding power forwards in smaller lineups, but he's at his best right now smothering point guards. Seven games into the season, there's little doubt that Okoro has established himself as one of the best defenders in college basketball." Jonathan Givony
- » The Athletic's Sam Vecenie tabs Okoro to go 14th overall.
- » "To call him defense first is real. Okoro might be the best defensive wing in the country right now, and he's only 18 years old. He's an absolute monster athletically, and he flies around and makes plays while also consistently staying close enough guarding position to handle his man. Okoro is an exceptional finisher due to that leaping ability, and his feel for the game is strong. He makes plays for his teammates, and can pass it a bit." Sam Vecenie

EARLY BRACKETOLOGY

» Auburn is currently projected as a No. 4 seed in the South Regional by ESPN.com's Joe Lunardi and Sporting News' Mike DeCourcy. The Tigers are a No. 5 seed in the West Regional by CBS Sports' Jerry Palm.

HIGH-QUALITY OPPONENTS

» Auburn has played seven opponents picked to finish in the top three of its league. The Tigers were the only team in the SEC to play seven top-3 projected finishers in their first eight games of the season.

» Auburn played Georgia Southern (third), Davidson (second), South Alabama (first), CSUN (third), Colgate (first) New Mexico (third) and Furman (third).

- » Auburn has posted a 29-0 home record against non-conference opponents over the last three-plus seasons, including an 8-0 mark last season, 7-0 in 2017-18 and 6-0 in 2016-17.
- » During Bruce Pearl's five years as Auburn's head coach, the Tigers have posted a 40-3 (.930) mark against non-conference opponents at Auburn Arena.

WHAT'S RETURNING?

- » Auburn returns just two starters from last season's Final Four and SEC Tournament championship winning team in Samir Doughty and Anfernee McLemore.
- » The Tigers return just 32 percent of their 3,188 points from a season ago. Auburn lost five of its top eight scorers, including its top three from last year's team.

ROSTER NUGGETS

- » Auburn boasts a unique roster heading into the 2019-20 season. The Tigers have seven seniors, zero juniors, five sophomores and eight freshmen
- Auburn's eight newcomers is tied with Florida for second-most in the SEC behind Georgia's
 10. It is the second-most newcomers Bruce Pearl has had at Auburn, trailing only 10 in 2016-17.
- » Auburn has 10 players who are 6-foot-6 or taller, which is the most Coach Pearl has had at Auburn and tied for the most he's ever had (10 in 2010-11 at Tennessee).
- » Auburn is one of just two programs to have two sets of father-son combinations on its roster: Head coach Bruce Pearl and assistant coach Steven Pearl, as well as assistant coach Wes Flanigan and freshman Allen Flanigan. Utah's combinations include head coach Larry Krystkowiak and freshman Luc Krystkowiak, as well as director of operations Chris Jones and freshman Rylan Jones.

AUBURN TO PLAY IN ORLANDO IN 2020

- » Auburn is slated to take part in the 2020 Orlando Invitational Nov. 26-29 next season at HP Field House at ESPN Wide World of Sports near Orlando, Fla.
- » The Tigers are joined in the eight-team field by Belmont, Boise State, Gonzaga, Michigan State, Saint Louis, Siena and Xavier.
- » It will be Auburn's first appearance in the annual tournament. The Tigers are 5-2 all-time in Orlando, which includes a tournament title at the 1985 Red Lobster Classic.

COOPER NAMED ALL-AMERICAN

- » Auburn signee Sharife Cooper was named a 2020 McDonald's All-American. The 5-star point guard is just the third signee in program history to be named a McDonald's All-American, joining Korvotney Barber (2005) and Frank Ford (1983).
- » Cooper, who plays at McEachern High School in Powder Springs, Ga., is the reigning USA Today National Player of the Year and was teammates with current Tigers Isaac Okoro and Babatunde Akingbola.

BURCHAM DEBUTS AS NEW VOICE

- » Andy Burcham has assumed his new role as Voice of the Auburn Tigers, taking the lead as the play-by-play radio broadcaster for the Auburn men's basketball, football and baseball programs. Burcham took over as Auburn's lead announcer this fall following the death in May of his best friend and baseball broadcast partner, Rod Bramblett.
- » After calling Auburn women's basketball games for 31 seasons, Burcham made his debut as the primary men's basketball announcer in the season-opening win vs. Georgia Southern on Nov. 5 what would have been Bramblett's 54th birthday.
- » Over the years, Burcham handled playby-play for a few men's basketball games when Bramblett was unavailable, most recently the season opener in 2013.


