The Razorbacks took the Championship with a score of 854 over three days (297-280-277). Individual honors led by Jamie Marshall who shot a 211 (74-69-68). Fellow Razorback Austin Cook (72-72-68) tied for 2nd with two other competitors who each shot 212: Kelly Kraft of SMU (72-65-75) and Jerry He of UC-Irvine (73-71-68).
