ANNA COCKRELL OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AND TYLER DAY OF NORTHERN ARIZONA HEADLINE 2020 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® DIVISION I CROSS COUNTRY/TRACK & FIELD TEAMS

AUSTIN, Texas – Graduate student Anna Cockrell of the University of Southern California and senior Tyler Day of Northern Arizona University headline the 2020 Academic All-America® Division I Track & Field/Cross Country teams, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).

Cockrell, who carries a 3.98 GPA in a public policy graduate program and earned her undergraduate degree in communications, has been named the 2020 Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year for Division I women's track & field/cross country. Day, a journalism major with a 3.75 GPA, has been named the 2020 Academic All-America® Team Member of the Year for Division I men's track & field/cross country.

Cockrell, from Charlotte, N.C., was the 2019 NCAA 400m hurdles champion and is a 10-time All-American. A three-time captain, she ranks third on both of USC's 100-meter hurdle and 400-meter hurdle lists. Cockrell has run on three of USC's all-time top-10 4x400m relays and ranks third in the 60-meter hurdles and seventh in the 200-meters on USC's all-time indoor list.

Day had an award-winning final indoor track & field season this spring, earning NCAA Men's Track Athlete of the Year honors after breaking the American collegiate record in the 5000m in January. The Gilbert, Ariz. native set a new American collegiate 5K record (13:16.95), which places him third all-time in the collegiate ranks. His lifetime-best performance in the 3K (7:45.70) also ranked him third nationally this season and ranks 12th all-time in the collegiate top 15.

Of the 47 members on the Academic All-America® Division I women's track & field/cross country team, 17 boast a perfect 4.0 GPA. The 15 members of the first team have an average GPA of 3.90 Eleven others join Cockrell as repeat selections on Academic All-America® Division I men's track & field / cross country team from previous years — Ariane Ballner (Oklahoma State University), Abby Bateman (University of Tennessee at Chattanooga), Shelby Gunnells (North Dakota State University), Sage Hurta (University of Colorado), Taylor Knibb (Cornell University), Daija Lampkin (University of Alabama), Bria Matthews (Georgia Tech), Alicia Monson (University of Wisconsin), Lynne Mooradian (United States Military Academy), Twanisha "Tee Tee" Terry (University of Southern California) and Taylor Werner (University of Arkansas).

Of the 46 members on the Academic All-America® Division I men's track & field / cross country team, 11 boast a perfect 4.0 GPA. The 15 members of the first team have an average GPA of 3.84. Eleven others join Day as repeat selections on Academic All-America® Division I men's track & field / cross country team from previous years – Joshua Anadu (Oklahoma State University), Zach Anderson (University of South Dakota), Geordie Beamish (Northern Arizona University), Kevin Cahoy (University of Nebraska), Arinze Chance (University of South Carolina), Christopher Henry (University of Wyoming), T.J. Lawson (Kent State University), Nick Monkemeyer (Creighton University), Alec Nehring (Montana State University), Ben Petrella (United States Military Academy) and Elliott Stone (North Dakota State University).
