## Versus MVSU

• This will be the sixth meeting between Arkansas and Mississippi Valley State – all taking place in Fayetteville – and first since 2011-12. The Razorbacks own a 5-0 advantage in the series.

**LAST TIME THEY MET** – Nov. 30, 2011 – Fayetteville

- Mardracus Wade scored a career-high 20 points to lead Arkansas to a 97-64 victory over Mississippi Valley State at Bud Walton Arena.
- The Razorbacks led the whole way, making 59.3 percent of their field goal attempts, including 11 of 23 from beyond the arc.
- Wade scored 15 points by intermission, giving Arkansas a 47-30 halftime lead.
- Julysses Nobles added 16 points for the Razorbacks while Devonta Abron scored 13 and BJ Young and Rickey Scott each added 11.
- Terrence Joyner and Cor-J Cox each scored 15 points to lead the Delta Devils.
- While the majority of their points came from its guards, the Razorbacks dominated in the interior and scored 34 points in the paint with 20 second-chance points.

## For Openers

- Arkansas opens the second season of the Eric Musselman era by hosting Mississippi Valley State.
- The Razorbacks have won 45 straight home openers, including a 27-0 record in openers inside Bud Walton Arena. Overall, the Razorbacks have won 46 of the last 49 seasons openers.
- The Razorbacks had a streak of 23 consecutive season openers end two seasons ago with an overtime loss to Texas in the 2018 ESPN Armed Forces Classic in El Paso.
- Eric Musselman is 5-0 in both home and season openers. Over the last four seasons, his season opener was also his home opener. In his first year as a collegiate head coach, Nevada opened the season with a win in Hawaii and returned to Reno to win its home opener.

## #5 Recruiting Class; 3 Top Grad Transfers

- Arkansas' 2020 recruiting class was a consensus top 10 haul. The group included four, four-stars and all are Arkansas natives.
- The ranking did not include three of the top 20 graduate transfers and two players among the nation's top 50 sit-out transfers.

## Sills Named Preseason All-SEC

- The Southeastern Conference unveiled its 17th annual men's basketball coaches preseason All-SEC team Thursday with Arkansas junior guard Desi Sills being named to the second team.
- The coaches' preseason All-SEC first and second teams consist of a minimum of eight players on each squad, voted on by the SEC basketball coaches. No ties were broken and no predicted order of finish was made.
- The Jonesboro product is one of three Razorbacks to play all 66 Arkansas games over the last two seasons (along with former Hogs Adrio Bailey and Jalen Harris). Sills showed great improvement from his freshman to his sophomore season as nearly all his numbers virtually doubled including his scoring (5.3 avg. to 10.6 avg.), his minutes (from 16.9 avg. to 31.2 avg.), 3-pointers made (29 to 47) and rebounds (1.3 avg. to 3.0 avg.).
- While Sills started 24 of 32 games last season, he came on strong over the final 14 games, six coming as a back-up to give much-needed firepower off the bench for the Razorbacks. He shot 32.9 percent from 3-pt for the season including a team-best 45.6 percent (31-of-68) from long range over the last 14 games. In coming off the bench the last six games, Sills poured in a then career-high 17 points in a win over Missouri, a career-high 21 points at Georgia and 20 points in the SEC tournament win versus Vanderbilt.

### LAST YEAR...

- Arkansas was 1-of-4 SEC teams and 1-of-10 teams nationally who have played two or fewer games against teams ranked above 200 in the NET.
- Arkansas' schedule was 40th on the NCAA Toughest Schedule Report - as opponents' winning percentage was .589 (617-431).
- Here is a quick recap of Arkansas' 2019-20 non-conference season:
  - ▲ The NCAA NET had Arkansas' non-conference Strength of Schedule at 12th - 2nd-best in the SEC (LSU is 8).
  - ▲ The NCAA NET had Arkansas' overall Strength of Schedule at 25th.
  - ▲ WarrenNolan.com had Arkansas' non-conference RPI as 4th and non-conference SOS is 11th.

## Baybe to Out

- Redshirt junior Abayomi (Baybe) Iyiola tore his right ACL in the summer (prior to team activities) and will be out until around the first part of January.
- Iyiola played his first two seasons at Stetson prior to transferring to Arkansas in the summer of 2019. He scored 656 points (10.4 ppg) and grabbed 434 rebounds (6.9 rpg) for his two-year career.



- A group of Razorback student-athlete leaders launched an initiative in September to foster and work toward equality for all members of the Razorback family. The program and its mission were developed out of ongoing discussions by various student-athletes on a number of important topics impacting society.

- The initiative was brought forward by the Razorback Athletics African-American Student-Athlete Leadership Council - including freshman guard **MOSES MOODY** - as part of continuing diversity and inclusion efforts as part of the department's **Hogs UNITED** program.

- Joe was selected by the Philadelphia 76ers in the second round (49th overall pick) in the 2020 NBA Draft.
  - ^ Joe is the 39th Razorback to be drafted in the NBA and the 20th within the first two rounds.
- Jones, named All-America honorable mention and SEC co-Player of the Year by the Associated Press this past season, signed a two-way contract as a free agent with the Houston Rockets.
  - ^ ones was also tabbed consensus first team All-SEC (including unanimous by the media), both USBWA and NABC All-District, and a finalist for the Jerry West Award, presented to the nation's top shooting guard.

## Razorbacks Face Cowboys in SEC/Big 12 Challenge Game

- For the third time in seven seasons, Arkansas will face Oklahoma State in the annual SEC/Big 12 Challenge, the Southeastern Conference announced. The contest is set for Jan. 30, 2021, and will be played in Stillwater, Okla.
- The Razorbacks and Cowboys met in back-to-back years of the Challenge in 2017 and 2018. Oklahoma State won the first meeting, 99-71, in Stillwater and Arkansas won, 66-65, the following year in Bud Walton Arena.
- Overall, Oklahoma State owns a 37-15 advantage in the all-time series with the Razorbacks, including a 13-4 mark in Stillwater. Arkansas won the last meeting between the two schools, 66-65 in The Challenge, to snap a five game losing steak dating back to 1990.
- This will be the eighth year of the SEC/Big 12 Challenge and it will feature 10 games between two premier college basketball conferences.
- In 2020, the two conferences shared the Challenge title with both leagues earning five wins, including Arkansas' 78-67 victory over TCU. Over the last four years of the Challenge, both conferences have won 20 games.
- ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU will combine to televise the contests. Start times and network designations will be announced at a later date.

Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including five as a collegiate head coach and 14 as a professional head coach.

In his five years as a collegiate head coach, Musselman has won at least 20 games each season (24, 28, 29, 29 and 20) to post a 130-46 record and .739 winning percentage - ninth-best among active Division I coaches. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He has won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined winning percentage of .626 (553-330).

Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons, Michael and Matthew, and the couple has a daughter, Mariah.

Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

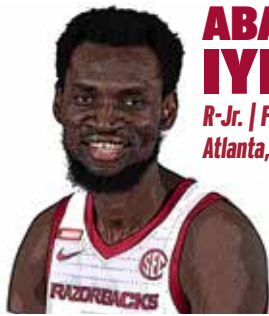
