PREGAME NOTES

• The Razorbacks wore cardinal helmets, white jerseys and white pants.

- Arkansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half.
- Arkansas' captains were seniors Rakeem Boyd, Feleipe Franks, Grant Morgan and Jonathan Marshall. They will serve as captains for every game this season. Franks was the Razorback's coin toss representative.
- Weather 64 degrees, wind out of the N at 4 mph.

GENERAL NOTES

- Saturday marked the 13th time Arkansas and Florida have played and the first time since 2016. Its the first time the two have met at Florida since 2013.
- The announced attendance for the game: 16,116

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Arkansas scored a TD on its first offensive possession for the second time this season as QB Feleipe Franks hooked up with WR Mike Woods for a 47-yard score.
- RB Trelon Smith ran 83 yards for Arkansas' second score of the night. It's the longest Razorback TD run against an SEC opponent since a 92-yard TD by Joe Adams in 2011 against Auburn.
- RB Rakeem Boyd scored his third TD of the season 13th of his career on Arkansas' first possession of the second half, on a 12-yard rush.
- WR Mike Woods scored his second TD of the game on a career-long 82-yard reception in the fourth quarter.
- QB K.J. Jefferson scored on a 12-yard run in the fourth quarter for Arkansas final TD.
- Arkansas scored on its first possession of the second half for the third consecutive game and sixth time this season.
- The Razorbacks scored two rushing TDs in a game for the first time this season.
- Arakansas had two one-play drives of 80+ yards.
- The Razorbacks registered 458 total yards and rushed for 208 yards on 6.5 yards per carry.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- LB Grant Morgan led the team with 15 tackles.
- S Jalen Catalon made his third interception of the season, and second in as many weeks.
- Arkansas entered the game with a nation leading 12 interceptions and now have 13 picks on the year.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

• P Reid Bauer punted five times for 217 yards (43.4 ypp) with a long of 51 yards and two downed inside the 20.

PLAYER NOTES

RB Rakeem Boyd

- Rushed 12 times for 56 yards (4.7 ypc) with a TD and caught two passes for 10 yards.
- Scored on a 12-yard TD rush, his third of the season 13th of his career on Arkansas' first possession of the second half.

WR Treylon Burks

Made three catches for 47 yards with a long reception of 25 yards.

QB Feleipe Franks

- Completed 15-of-19 passes for 250 yards and two TDs.
- Did not throw an interception for his third straight game.
- Has thrown for 200 or more yards in all seven games this season.
- Thrown for two or more TDs in three straight games.
- Threw a season-long pass of 82 yards to WR Mike Woods.

TE Blake Kern

• Tied his career-high and led the team with four receptions for 31 yards.



RB Trelon Smith

- Registered a career-high 118 rushing yards, its his first 100+ yard game
- Recorded the longest run of his career, scampering 83 yards for a TD in the second quarter.
- His run is the longest Razorback touchdown rush against an SEC opponent since Joe Adams (92 yards) in 2011 against Auburn.

WR De'Vion Warren

- Registered a team season-long 32 yard kickoff return.
- Made two catches for 17 yards.

WR Mike Woods

- Totaled two grabs for career-high 129 yards and two TDs, while eclipsing 1,000 career receiving yards (1,042).
- Made his third TD grab of the year eighth of his career on a 47-yard reception, scoring on the Razorbacks first offensive drive.
- Scored his second TD of the game, fourth of the season and nine of his career on a career-long 82-yard reception in the fourth quarter.
- Scored two touchdowns in a game for the first time in his career.
- Surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards on his second TD catch.
- First Razorback to have two TD catches and 100+ yards in a game against the Gators in series history.

S Jalen Catalon

- Finished the game with 12 tackles an interception and two passes broken up.
- Made an interception for the second straight game.
- Broke up a career-high two passes.
- Registered 10 tackles in the first half for the second straight game.

BS Joe Foucha

- . Made his fourth consecutive start.
- Recorded nine tackles, his second-best total of the season, while also adding 0.5 tackles for loss.

DT Jonathan Marshall

- Totaled three tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss.
- Registered a tackle for loss in his fifth straight game.

LB Grant Morgan

- Led the team making 15 tackles.
- Registered his fifth 10+ tackle performance of the season.
- Entered tonight's game averaging 11.7 tackles per game, the second best mark in the SEC.

S Myles Slusher

• Recorded a career-high four tackles.
